[Music] greetings brother and welcome to another wednesday night bible study uh sorry about the opening there just clicked on the wrong button so it looked like we were going to study colossians but in fact it is uh psalms tonight uh god willing will study uh psalms 104 and it really is a good idea to go back into the archives because all of the scriptures tie together and the more we understand one book the better we'll understand another book and so we just have to be constantly going back through the different books as we increase our understanding and especially the book of revelation as i mentioned um this evening god willing will cover uh psalm 104. uh such a beautiful psalm and as i was studying this psalm i couldn't help but think of my my aunt her name is eldica and i'd appreciate your your prayers for her um she is every year on my birthday when i speak to her uh she will always remind me that i was a newborn baby in a basket at her wedding and she always just gets a little chuckle out of reminding me of that so sort of think of baby moses but instead of on the river uh at a wedding so this year though uh when i called her and i spoke with her and i had to remind her

that i was at her wedding and she just did not remember she said sorry she doesn't remember her mind is not flat her mind is going funny she said and then shortly after that uh two days later uh she was out at the bank and fell and really struck her head

very very hard and so there's internal bleeding she's in the hospital now and i just appreciate your prayers for her again her name is eldika so thank you for that brethren also just a quick point that we had mentioned

um getting together with some of you who have been following us for a while and we

we know you uh kind of virtually but have never met uh we're going to be doing we were planning on doing a social this sunday but the timing didn't work well

and neither does next sunday so we're going to put this off uh for this i believe the date is the 21st uh i think the third sunday in uh february so uh you know reach out to us and we'll be reaching out to some of you

and just looking forward to uh getting to know you face to face and we have a platform that we'll be using for that let's open with the word of prayer and then get into tonight's study heavenly father we we come before you lord god almighty and just praise you we praise you father for

your glorious character and your glorious works and your great mercy toward your people and ultimately toward all of mankind

i thank you father for bringing us into

this covenant relationship with you

thank you for watching over us thank you

for your mercy

and thank you father that no matter how chaotic this world is in which we live

that we can be solid by standing on the

solid rock

and we can we can take consolation and

comfort

in your promises to the fathers the

patriarchs

thank you lord god almighty a bless our

study

deepen our understanding and deepen our

faith and conviction

we pray in jesus most holy name amen

amen brethren so let's um get into the

study

for today and uh we want to

look at psalm 104 but um

before we go to psalm 14 psalm 104 is

kind of a sister to psalm 103

they open and close in a very similar

fashion i remember with psalm 103 it

opened with bless the lord o my soul

and all that is within me bless his holy

name

and then it concluded with bless the

lord all his works in all places of his

dominion

and then it went on to say bless the

lord o my soul

now this psalm 103 was really an

exhortation

to to praise god now psalm 104 is going

to open in a similar way

but it's more about looking at the

creation

and understanding how powerful god is

from the creation

and the psalmist now when we when we

read this psalm you just get a sense of

great intimacy and awe and really knowing god through through his works um and and i just think of again these are sort of in this enthronement victory book of the saltery so just try to think of the time now god is on earth and his people know him they're no longer strained estranged from him they know him and they're able to serve as physical priests on the earth to the rest of humanity and and the condition today in isaiah 8 and verse 17 isaiah writes and i will wait upon the lord and he describes him as he that hides his face from the house of jacob so this intimate knowledge of god that we're about to read in psalm 104 jacob doesn't have this understanding today they don't have this intimate relationship with god today but it's coming and that's his promise to abraham that's his promise to jacob in fact when these men are resurrected they will see god's promises fulfilled and so we are going to see a time when the children of israel will in fact know god with the intimacy that we're about to read about but here isaiah says i will look for him and and to fulfill that to sort of looking forward to that time when this will no longer be the case where god hides his face from jacob jeremiah says and they shall teach no more every man his neighbor and every man his brother saying you

should know the for they shall all know me he says from the least of them unto the greatest of them says the lord for i will forgive their iniquity and people want to say how how evil the jews are and that they couldn't possibly be god's people no they are god's people and he will cleanse them he will purify them and he will forgive their iniquity and remember their sin no more so as we fast forward into the future we are going to have these tribes of israel and specifically the tribe of judah in a very um prestigious position an exalted position on the earth and then people around the earth will be saying you know you're a jew i want to hold on to your garment and go with you to jerusalem and be taught about the god of israel from you so this all of that to say there's quite solid understanding of god and this is written thousands of years ago and there's quite a solid understanding of who god is in this psalm now i said it it reminds me of my aunt eldika because every time i call her she's such a genuine person and she just has this awe of god and she will always find in in our conversation

a genuine person and she just has this awe of god and she will always find in in our conversation to remind me of how mighty god is and so she'll point out just how vast the creation is and that this god we serve looks after the entire creation and and while she tells me and she tells me like in every conversation i have

with her while she tells me this it's like she's realizing herself just how profound our god is and and this that's what we're going to read here in psalm 104 just a great sense of how profound our god is so he says here bless the lord o my soul so similar to psalm 103 which we're going to see a different uh take on it here where he's going to really focus not so much on continuing to exhort people to praise god but just to point out how powerful this god is bless the lord oh my soul oh lord my god you are very great and again this is my my aunt uh when i talk to her she's just she's in awe of god and what how he holds the whole creation together and she'll remind me of how many people there are on the earth and that he looks after all of these people she says he says you are very great you are clothed with honor and majesty this is somebody who knows god and understands god and is able to say god is clothed with honor and majesty who covers yourself with light as with a garment who stretches out the heavens like a curtain so so he he he covers himself with light the way the way we put on clothes god puts on light and this is how glorious he is and then he's able to stretch out the heavens the way we would we would stretch out a curtain who lays the beams let's get my mouse working here who lays the beams of his chambers

in the waters who makes the clouds his

chariot

who walks upon the wings of the wind and

i don't think

the psalmist here is speaking

figuratively

i i think this is real he makes the

clouds his chariot

and and he's returning with the clouds

and and ezekiel had a vision of him

coming in

in a chariot and he walks upon the wings

of the wind

and and we will we will be born into his

family we will be just

like him and we will also operate in

this fashion

he says who makes his angels

spirits his ministers a flaming fire

this is how powerful the this angelic

realm is

uh it is an extremely powerful creation

that he has made in the angels and then

this the

apostle paul believe it's paul in

hebrews

quotes this very thing when he is

talking of the glory of jesus christ

and he quotes in psalm hebrews 1 and

verse 7

and of the angels he says who makes his

angels spirits

and his ministers flames of fire so he

is also quoting this psalm

but he's quoting it to position how

great

jesus christ is and the psalmist himself

is saying the same thing

oh lord you are very great extremely

great

you you make these angels that are so

incredibly powerful and glorious and

you're the creator of

this power he says who laid the foundations of the earth that it should not be removed forever and i think this is a very important psalm that the earth itself is the foundation or or he laid the foundations of the earth and listen to what he says that it should not be removed forever so the earth is forever and i saw a bit of discussion uh today in the chat or sorry in slack about um the earth and whether in the future god will turn the earth into something spiritual as opposed to material and i think brethren we just have to be very very careful it's a good question but we have to be careful about how we think about the earth that the earth is something that god glories in the material earth and matter is something that matters to god and we need to be careful that we don't fall into this sort of and it's something that's easy to do to fall into this platonic way of seeing creation and the platonic or the greek way of seeing creation is that matter is evil matter is just completely something that should be despised and and satan put this into man so that man rejects the earth the way he did and is seeking to live in heaven in this spiritual realm and have no regard for the earth the way he had no regard for the earth but god created the earth and after satan rejected it god came to earth and made a replica of himself

from the earth to demonstrate just how much he

he loves the earth and his vision and plan for the earth

and so he says here that he laid the foundations of the earth

that it should not be removed forever and it's not just the earth there's a

whole massive universe

that is made out of matter and and god has plans

for this matter uh matter was not made uh for for temporary human beings matter was made for the for for spiritual beings

uh the the temporary human beings the

this is just a a six thousand year phase in fact in job 38 in verse four when when job was getting a bit uppity in terms of his role in the earth god says where were you job when i laid the foundations of the earth and here we just read that the foundations of the earth

he laid them that they should not be removed forever but god asked job where were you when you when i laid the foundation of the earth declare if you have understanding do you really understand what what i'm doing with the earth who has laid the measures thereof if you know

or who has stretched the line upon it whereupon are the foundations thereof fastened

or who laid the corner stone thereof like where were you job well you weren't there in fact no human being was there but let me tell you who was there he says

when the morning stars that's the angels

spiritual beings
before they had no clue about human
beings being created from the earth
but when when god created and brought
the physical universe into existence
the angels sang together and
all the sons of god shouted for joy
and where were you job when this
happened these were spiritual beings
and god created this physical matter and
they shouted for joy over the physical
matter

and we now are going to inherit this and we're going to inherit all things with christ

and so we are going to be spiritual beings but we are going to inherit this physical universe and and we're going to unlock all the secrets of matter

that that matter has tremendous secrets imagine that that god himself can come down to this ball of matter and out of it

create a living replica of himself now that gives you a sense of what is what is embedded in this matter and the type of

energy that can be released and the science that the deep science that needs to be understood to fully unlock

the potentiality of matter so so we need to reject plato and we need to reject

greek philosophy that would want us to despise things physical god god rejoices over this and the the angels when when he created physical matter they rejoice because they they saw the whole potential of what can be done and what can be unlocked and they were probably astonished

when they saw god come to earth and make a rep a living replica of himself they probably didn't realize that that was possible so so this psalmist now is just amazed at the foundations of the earth and and what god has done he says you covered it with the deep as with a garment the water stood above the mountains and so you know this whole creation before uh was covered in water and the water stood above the mountains at your rebuke and and through noah he flooded the earth with water but at your rebuke they fled at the voice of your thunder they hasted away and so that could refer to genesis the creation account in genesis 1 could also refer to the the flood account with noah and what happened there and how he caused the the waters to to recede at your rebuke the waters fled and water is powerful water is tremendously powerful again talk about the power of matter water is an extremely powerful force but at the word of god they fled and you even think of christ in the storm when he just rebuked the storm and the waters just subsided at your rebuke they fled at the voice of your thunder they hasted away they go up by the mountains they go down by the valleys unto the place where you have founded them and again what the the subject matter here is the waters and and the psalmist is iust so amazed at god's way with the water so so this is something again as we

consider how great god is we need to consider just just the waters

and how wonderful these waters are and so if you just uh look at this here to see just how beautiful and powerful water is and god god is the orchestrator of all of this

that god looks after all of this it's absolutely amazing

he says that and just keep

valley

is just

keep this image in mind and he says here they go up by the mountains they go down by the valleys unto the place where you have found for them you can see the water just falling into the

and then creating a stream and going to the place where god has designed and goes to the place which you have found it for them

you have set a bound that they may not pass over

so as powerful as water is uh and and how irresistible water is to human beings water will have its way with us

and yet god has set a boundary on this water

that it cannot pass over the boundaries that god has set for it that they turn not again to cover the

that they turn not again to cover the earth and and what's amazing here as we read this um

psalmist's uh praise of god and his work in the creation

is is thousands of years ago that the hebrews understood that god is very much involved in his creation that it's not that god

uh you know first of all you know the people who believe that there's no such

thing as god the psalmist is able to look at the creation the way my aunt does and just think like wow she would always say what a mighty god we serve and this is what the psalmist is of what a mighty god we serve but he understands as well the psalmist understands forget the atheists they're fools but there's also the deist that says well okay we accept that this creation of course it has to be created it couldn't just evolve or just come out of nothing so we we acknowledge that there's a creator but then there the dia says well the creator is more like a watchmaker that he designs the watch but once the watch is up and running that's it everything just works and and and that the watchmaker is no longer involved in the life of the watch well here the hebrew mindset is fully understand that that's just not true that in order for the creation to continue to function

involved in the life of the watch

that in order for the creation to

the creator needs to be fully involved
and that's what he's showing here that
all of these um
powerful and awesome uh
just feats of nature that the designer
the creator
is very much involved and this just
brings him into this incredible state of
praise

water is oceans and seas and rivers and lakes there are boundaries for this water you have set a boundary that they may not pass over

of god so that the past powerful as

that they turn not again to cover the earth even though the earth was fully immersed

in water it's impossible now for this to ever happen again

you know every time we see the rainbow we know god's promise

that this will never ever ever ever happen again

the earth is going to be covered in fire that we know that

but water will never cover the earth again and this this is the promise of god so

i i think it'd be easy to prove the bible a myth and and nonsensical just by showing being able to predict that one day the whole earth will be immersed in water again and the scripture the hebrew here says absolutely impossible it won't happen that there are boundaries to the water

he says he sends the springs into the valleys

which run among the hills and again you get the sense of the

the water falling into these valleys and then and then um

running along the valley into a spring uh and this is this is beautiful and and all of this water as it you know evaporates and then comes back down and it fills the

the reservoirs he says here and this is again

just every time i read this i just think of my aunt what a mighty god we serve she she he says here they give drink these waters give drink to every beast of the field

the wild donkeys quench their thirst so this is somebody who's really just taking into

the whole account and and how the whole creation just works harmoniously together and he's looking at this and saying wow this is amazing the waters are controlled and and in the boundaries that god has set for them they give drink to every beast of the field and the wild donkeys they're out there running and doing everything that they do and they get thirsty and they can quench their thirst with this water he says by them the waters shall the fowls of the heaven have their habitation which sing among the branches so the trees rely on this water in order to grow up and then provide shelter or lodging for the birds somebody that's just taking into the whole way the creation just works seamlessly together and he says which i say this is now christ when he was on earth so just think about what the psalmist observed how these trees provide lodging for the birds and when christ himself the creator was on earth in matthew 13 32 he says which indeed is the least of all seed speaking of the mustard seed but when it is grown and it depends on the waters to grow when it is grown it is the greatest among herbs and becomes a tree so that the birds of the air come and lodge in the branches thereof so this psalmist as he's looking at the creation and he's realizing just how amazing how well designed

the whole creation is and how these waters that once covered the entire earth

have now been controlled and and in instead of just destroying the earth they're controlled and they bring life to the earth and he's observing how the wild animals are able to be nourished from the water but even trees grow up as a result of the water and then the birds that fly through the air they have a place to land in these trees because of the water and then when the creator himself is on earth he he gives us this parable and he himself observes the beauty of the design that he himself created but he's

that he himself created but he's pointing out just how harmoniously and beautifully

all of this works in order to make the point that he's making about the mustard seed back to um psalm 103 104 verse 13

he says

that god god is actively involved in the creation we can't fall into this deist

mentality that yes god created everything but he's not involved anymore it all just sort of runs automatically no the psalmist is saying no in order god is not just the creator he's also the sustainer and he says he waters the hills from his chambers the earth is satisfied with the fruit of your works so all of this works from from god is active making all of this happen and sustaining it and then again in this observation of what is going on in the earth

what does he say he says this

let me just go back a little bit mouse seems to be acting up he says this that he causes the grass to grow for the cattle and again you can just uh imagine this that the cattle the these beasts of of a burden these beasts of the earth he causes the grass through this miracle of the water this miraculous nature of the water that he then causes the the earth uh or the grass to grow uh for the cattle and the herb for the service of man and and so many of our medicines actually depend upon these herbs and and these herbs

serve us

and this is all in the creation that he may bring forth food out of the earth this is what god is doing that that the whole creation can benefit

from what god does and not only that but and wine that makes glad the heart of man

so the psalmist acknowledges that wine is a blessing of god and unlike some religious religions that teach that men mustn't touch alcohol and that they're very strict and you know they'll punish you if you touch alcohol you know the he the

psalmist and looking at what the creator has done

is acknowledging that even wine is in the design of this great god and wine that makes the makes glad the heart of man so man is able to

just enjoy fellowship in at a level a different level when when wine and this food is served

and then even

you know god himself when he was with

abraham a bread and wine and oil to make his face to shine and bread which strengthens man's heart and all of this depends on god's orchestration with the water and what god does with the water he says the trees of the lord are full of sap again this is depending on the water that the sap requires the water so the trees require the water to grow up and provide um habitation for the birds and and herbs for for the service of man um but also they're full of sap from the water and the cedars of lebanon which he has planted so these and we you know we don't fully appreciate this but at the time to understand these powerful trees these massive trees which god has planted where the birds make their nests and as for the stork the fur trees are her house so there's just again this fascination with the birds and just seeing how these birds that just fly through the sky that that these powerful these these big trees massive trees they're able to make their nests in these trees and historic fir trees are her house so this beauty of creation all around us he says the high hills are a refuge for the wild goats and the rocks for the colonies this is somebody who really appreciates creation and the natural order and how it all works harmoniously together but understands that it's the creator and the sustainer that is making all of this works so

phenomenally and this is what's causing him to just say god you are very great look what you look what you're doing here now this also speaks to the whole notion of environmentalism that man thinks that he has to step in to save the planet and and you know man thinks that because of him everything's going sideways and unless he steps in then you know the whole creation will fall apart and that is an atheistic statement here the psalmist understands no god is running all of this and god loves the earth and god will in fact look after the earth and the earth is not going anywhere he laid the foundations in such a way that the earth will abide forever so we don't need these arrogant um environmentalists who are who are dreaming up this communistic religion where the creation becomes more important than man and man must die in order to save a blade of grass and man means nothing man is garbage this is this is a wrong mindset and god is what the psalmist is saying is god is very much able to look after his creation thank you very much and the earth is not going anywhere and in fact we know from revelation 11 revelation 11 and verse 18 he says and the nations were angry this is a looking looking forward now just a few years ahead of us

and the nations were angry and your wrath has come god is angry brethren god god is returning with wrath we need to know this your wrath has come and the time of the dead that they should be judged and that you should give reward unto your servants the prophets so they're all looking forward to their resurrection and to the saints and them that fear your name and we're all looking forward to our change or our resurrection this is real this is happening this is just around the corner small and great and what else and should destroy them which destroy the earth satan hates the earth god loves the earth and god doesn't need environmentalists to save the earth he is very well capable and the psalmist is realizing just how glorious the the earth is and how it all works together so intricately because god is still involved and god is very much involved in psalm 24 and verse 1 we read the earth is the lord's the earth belongs to god and the fullness thereof all this spectacular harmony that the psalmist in 104 is looking at all of this belongs to god all of the wealth and and the abundance that the earth yields it all belongs to god the earth is the lord and the fullness thereof the world and them that dwell therein so these um atheists who believe that they're the only ones that can save the planet

uh we don't need this this uh communistic atheistic religion to take us over and cause us to exalt the creation above man and and men can no longer eat a man can heart men can no longer breathe we we we're just despite we must despise ourselves and cover our faces in shame and and not realize we're made in god's image and god very much is concerned with the earth and god glorifies the earth and he will be glorified in the earth the earth isn't going anywhere psalm 104 and verse 19 he appointed the moon for seasons and uh i think most of us would know to to that this word seasons is the the hebrew word which is appointed times and we know that is exactly what we see in genesis so he

appointed the reason he the moon is there so the psalmist is looking at this creation and realizes that the moon is part of a time keeping system and he appointed the moon the months for seasons

so we would know which month are these appointed times the sun knows it's going down so the sun is there as part of the day cycle and the moon is there for the monthly cycle and here in genesis 1 14 and most of us are aware of this but i'll just mention it and god said let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night and let them be for signs and the word

here seasons and let them be for seasons is again that same hebrew word so they're there for seasons or better appointed festivals so there are there the god has a worship system that he has created which in fact is a prophetic system that when we understand in leviticus 23 when we understand the outline of these appointed times that man is called and summoned to worship the creator at these particular times that they are in fact prophetic that taken together they they show the plan of god and they unfold for us the plan of god he says let them be for signs and seasons and for days and years he says you make darkness and it is night so he he's the one that created this pattern of night and day and and this this worshiper of god is looking and saying you actually make darkness and it's night we're in all the beasts of the field do creep forth so at night he sees all these insects and mammals and reptiles and all these animals come out at night in the forest and they function they have eyes that can see at night they can function at night and that's what happens when when the night falls they come forth he says the young lions do roar after their prey so he's even looking at the power of these lions and saying man this is

this is something incredible

that when he looks at these lions and

sees how they roar after their prey just look look at this one here it's this um video we see here with these lions

he says this is majestic the lions roar after their prey and seek their meat from god so yeah this is pretty this is pretty vicious

but the psalmist is saying this is god's design this is how they actually look to god to be fed so they seek their meat from god he says the son arises they gather themselves

together

and

this is this is the psalmist scene they sun arises they gather themselves together and lay them down in their dens so they're out at night hunting and looking for

food from god and then when the sun comes up

they rest they go and they lie themselves down and then when the sun comes up and they go and lie down man goes forth unto his work so so we actually absolutely depend on the light

less so now because of electricity but certainly um we we understand that daytime is when uh men are designed to work and so we see all this busyness during the day man goes forth unto his work and to his labor

until the evening and that certainly is the natural course of events where men are working during the day uh because that we need the light of the sun and then when the sun goes down we go down but when the sun go down the beasts come out and they do all of their hunting and and

the insects and everything that operates at night and then when when the day comes they all do their resting and man comes forth and does his work and to his labor until the evening he's just fascinated at how all of this works and this is this is really what men should do is just pause and just go into the natural world and look how it all works so gloriously and the hebrew mindset is to understand this is not just on automatic pilot that god did not just create this he also sustains it he says oh lord you can just hear the praise oh lord how manifold or various are your works exclamation mark like wow again what my aunt would say what a mighty god we serve she just surveys all of this oh lord how manifold are thy works in wisdom you have made them all so there was a design that went behind all of this and a very deep and profound wisdom and and we we will fully understand when god is here and explains to us the design but we can still appreciate it even though we don't fully understand it he says in wisdom you have made them all the earth is full of your riches so is this great and wide sea where are things creeping innumerable both small and great beasts so if we were to go into the sea uh you know we're all we're trying to get out to to mars and but we still have not discovered all the things that are in the sea

and and he says here to us that uh if in fact we could

go into the sea we we just see all of these

creeping and innumerable beasts both small and great all kinds there that are extremely powerful this is what he he sees

in and this is he's looking at the earth but then he's looking into the water and seeing what god is doing there as

well

he says let me just

beast that is

get my mouse here there go the ships there is that leviathan and i think this is some kind of a

powerful sea creature i just think of the biggest whale that we can think of and maybe it's even bigger than that there go the ships so these powerful ships go on the sea

and there is that leviathan whom you have made

to play therein that this is like incredible to him that god is able to make such a powerful

refined or restricted to the sea uh and it's such a powerful beast and it plays in the sea

and god has made it this way so you think of a puppy or a dog when it's not you see when dogs play well animals play and to see this massive beast in the sea play

it's like wow what a mighty god we serve these wait all upon you notice that every single creature in the creation waits upon god he says these wait all upon all of these everything that i've just outlined is waiting upon you that you may give them their meat in due season and this word season now is it's a different hebrew word it's not moa dem it's just in the right time so all of these creatures depend on god and god is actively involved in sustaining

this incredible creation that you give them

that you give them they gather you open your hand

they are filled with good so what they they depend whatever god gives them that's what they're able to get and he he's the one that opens his hand so that they're filled with good he's actively involved in this

mighty creation you hide your face they are troubled so so for whatever reason

god decides no no rain or whatever these animals suffer the creation the trees the foil the foliage everything will suffer

unless god provides you hide your face they are troubled

you take away their breath they die so they depend on on this breath from god

and if god takes that away that's the end as mighty as this leviathan is god can just cause it to cease to live you take away their breath they die and they and return to their dust you send forth your spirit they are created

so this is the the there's a spirit that

nephesh requires this this breathing this breath of life uh to live and so he gives them that and they are created and you renew

the face of the earth earth isn't going anywhere god is very aware of the earth and he is sustaining the earth

the glory of the lord shall endure forever and this this glory is reflected in his creation and it will be reflected in israel forever the glory of the lord shall endure forever the lord shall rejoice in his works so this these are his works and we must be careful not to adopt this platonic mentality that that despises the earth and despises matter god loves matter god is glorified with matter and he wants us to look at the matter and the intricacy i remember as a boy my father buying us a microscope and looking at the smallest things through this microsoft microscope and just being stunned i had no idea these things were invisible to the to the naked eye and just being stunned at the intricacy and the perfection in in the smallest detail god wants us to see that god wants to see that every detail has been considered and that he is glorified in his works and will be forever the lord and he and he rejoices in these words when god looks at all of this the psalmist is looking at all of this and he's in awe and he acknowledges and realizes that god himself rejoices in his works you know you think of the the six days of of creation and on the seventh day he's looking at everything and saying this is very good this is he rejoicing it and wanting to share it

with mankind he looks upon the earth and it trembles he touches the hills and they smoke and then the psalmist concluding says so all of this the whole time

he's just the whole psalm is all about the creation

and the glory of the creation and how it all just works together so so beautifully and then he can he's now coming to the conclusion by saying you

i will sing unto the lord as long as i

and no one's gonna stop me i am so full of

aw that i can't help

know what

but praise god i will sing unto the lord as long as i live i will sing praise to my god

while i have my being and i think this is this is just

very healthy for us to just pause and and a lot of these nature shows to watch these nature shows and just see how how glorious god's creation is and to take the time to to to uh just see the glory of god's creation

and praise him and and when we sing to really sing

with a sense of of awe of what god is doing

so he says here

i will sing unto the lord as long as i live

i will sing praise to my god while i have

my being my meditation of him shall be sweet my meditation of him shall be sweet

i will be glad in the lord and i think that's something that again nobody can take away from us it's

as crazy as this world is as chaotic as it is as it unravels all around us this joy that we have in god they can't take that away it's impossible to take that away that comes from the inside out and it comes from acknowledging just how great our god is he says my meditation of him shall be sweet i just just when i think about god it's just it's sweet and i will be glad in the lord and then he says so as much as he rejoices in in god he's not naive he understands that there are many that have decided to worship satan there are many that have decided to dishonor god and not understand just how majestic this god is and he says let the sinners be destroyed out of the earth this is the man of god this is the man of god he's not just he's not saying oh let jesus come and just give the whole world a big hug because jesus just loves the whole world god is coming in wrath and as much as this psalmist is able to worship god and be in awe of him he also realizes that satan is active in the earth and and hijacks the minds of men who want to destroy the earth

satan is active in the earth and and hijacks the minds of men who want to destroy the earth and so he concludes by saying let the sinners be destroyed out of the earth he doesn't want to see an earth full of sinners you know the whole creation works so beautifully together except for sinful man so he's looking forward and saying yeah let's get this phase over with let's

remove sinful man from the earth and then let's have human beings made in the image of god who function harmoniously with the whole creation

everything bringing glory to god's name let the sinners be destroyed out of the earth and let the wicked be no more excuse me so we'll have a taste of that through the millennium then there's going to be a little hiccup where the wicked will once again thrive

and then that's it then they'll be completely wiped out and

we go forward into eternity and the wicked the earth will abide forever but the wicked will be no more he says bless the lord o my soul praise you the lord and as and this is his conclusion this is the conclusion of his praise

as he's praising god he concludes by saying okay we've got to remove the wicked

let the sinners be destroyed out of the earth because they're the earth is just so glorious except for

these sinners let the sinners be removed out of the earth and let the wicked be no more bless the lord o my soul praise you the

lord

so he closes the very same way he opened very similar to psalm 103 and as i was reading this it just reminded me of revelation 1 verse 7. i always

i'm so amazed with how john writes this where he says behold he comes with clouds

he's going to be riding the clouds as he comes and every eye shall see him and they also

which pierced him and i think matthew 23 these are the jews who destroyed him but they're going to be looking forward to his return because he's coming to save them think zechariah 12 14. and then he says and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him the return of jesus christ is not a happy time for mankind it's a happy time for the saints and it's a happy time for the people of the covenant who are being destroyed and persecuted and he's coming to save them but for the rest of the tribes of the earth they're going to wail they're going to be terrified because of him and then what does john say he says all the kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him and then john says even so amen even so amen just like the psalmist is saying let the sinners be destroyed out of the earth and let the wicked be no more when christ is coming he's coming to put the wicked down and john says even so amen so i'm going to conclude the psalm today brethren with the same words that my aunt would say to me every time i speak with her and that is to say what a mighty god we serve jesus christ is lord god bless brethren amen you
