2:53 that the audio is good thank you sister donna uh very very good velma sister 2:58velma and also sister becky very very good okay so let us get into today's 3:06 passage psalm 119 and i wanted uh just before getting into 3:11 the psalm to just open with proverbs because it really does underline the 3:18 wisdom of god's word and we'll just open with this proverb counsel is mine 3:23 and sound wisdom i am understanding i have strength 3:29 by me kings reign and princes decree justice and obviously christ is 3:36 shepherding us into this role of governing the earth's affairs 3:41 with his wisdom because the leaders of this world have gone insane and they are destroying 3:46 everything that previous generations have set up and even god's own creation 3:53 by me prince's rule and nobles even all the judges of the 3:58 earth i love them that love me and those that seek me early shall find 4:04me so god is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him 4:10riches and honor are with me yes durable riches and righteousness so we are in a very 4:18strange time a very unusual unprecedented time in the history of mankind 4:24 let's just resolve to be faithful to the end no matter what 4:29when the elites say you will own nothing they mean it and they are really moving at an 4:35 accelerated pace to remove the concept of private property which is a biblical concept and 4:42so any riches in this world are fleeting even for the elite they think they can hold on to these riches 4:48that they're accumulating uh it's fleeting but as the psalmist said 4:53 more than precious than silver and gold are the riches of god's word and so let's get into god's

word for this

4:59 evening psalm 119 we'll begin at psalm verse 89 5:05 uh the hebrew word lamid or letter lemon so every this is an acrostic every 5:11 verse the eight verses in this stanza begin with the hebrew letter 5:18 for ever o lord thy word is settled in heaven god's 5:23 instructions his his teaching it's settled forever there's no way around this he says that 5:31 the word that he has spoken will not return to unto him void forever o lord thy word is settled in 5:38 heaven thy faithfulness is unto all generations 5:44 you have established the earth and it abides i find this a fascinating 5:50 verse given just what's going on uh in our world today 5:56 and this uh climate crisis and climate alarmists 6:02 where the psalmist understands something about god he has made promises 6:08that involve the earth so when these climate alarmists say that if we don't act now the world will 6:15 be destroyed in less than 10 years this is anti-christic talk 6:22 this does not align itself with the word of god 6:27 puny little man on the earth thinks that god is not present it is god who created the earth it is 6:34 god who has promised the earth as the inheritance to the saints and so his word abides forever it is 6:40settled in heaven so it cannot be tampered with we can who can go to heaven and edit god's word 6:47 it's settled all the promises that he has made are settled abraham understood this and he's 6:53 the father of the faithful god's faithfulness is unto all generations 6:59 oh here we are in our generation but every generation before us god has been faithful to his word and he will 7:06

continue to be until the end your faithfulness says until all generations 7:12

you have established so his word is settled in heaven and he has established the earth

7:18

the earth is established so running up and down climate crisis climate crisis the cows are going to

7:24

destroy the earth therefore we must destroy the cows uh sorry that contradicts god's word god says the

7:30

earth abides because he has plans for the earth and there's nothing that anybody on the 7:36

earth can do to alter god's plans for the earth and so we're in this climate crisis

7:43

where we must now cull cattle because of the methane

7:48

that they produce which is apparently poisoning the atmosphere and and therefore the 90 percent of cows

7:55

must be slaughtered in order to protect the climate but what does god's word say 8:02

genesis 1 and verse 24 god said let the earth

8:08

let the earth bring forth the living creature after its kind in other words

8:14

let cows reproduce do not interfere with god's creation

8:21

let the cattle reproduce after its kind and creeping thing and beast of the earth after its 8:29

kind and it was so and god made the beast of the earth after its kind and cows cattle after 8:36

their kind and everything that creeps upon the earth after its count kind so these cows 8:42

that god created uh did they not have a digestive system when god created them 8:49

or were they created just the way they are now eating grass digesting it

8:55

and and creating manure and creating methane gas in that process

9:00

and god saw that it was good so so the cycle

9:05

of cows being born being raised

9:11

consuming grass digesting it eliminating waste product

9:18 and that waste product being recycled into the earth's atmosphere god did that 9:24 and when god created that cycle he pronounced it good and now we have these arrogant 9:32 individuals who are coming along and saying the cow is evil 9:37 and must be destroyed and forcing farmers to cull their cattle 9:43 because of this cycle that god created and said it was good 9:50 god established the earth and this cycle will continue when jesus christ returns this cycle 9:57 will be established now regarding the cows god says again we have to be very 10:05 sensitive to anti-christic language the language that takes us away from the word of god 10:12 regarding the cows god says speak unto the children of israel this is leviticus 11 verse 2 this is the child the book 10:19 regarding holiness how to be holy before the lord speak unto the children of israel saying these are the beasts which 10:26 you shall eat among all the beasts that are on the earth whatsoever parts the hoof 10:33 and is cloven-footed and chews the cut among the beasts 10:38 that you shall you eat and now these very powerful elites who 10:44 are drunk on their own power which which we gave them we supported them becoming so powerful 10:49 they now come along and say we must not eat the cattle they will tell us what we can and cannot 10:55 eat so they have put themselves as the state power above the word of god 11:02 in fact they've put themselves above god they have become god telling us what is good to eat and what 11:07 is not good to eat when god has said this is good and he created it said it's good and 11:12 said this is what you can eat this is what you should not eat regarding his word 11:18

being established in heaven so the earth abides forever and that whole cycle that he has set up on the earth 11:24 that he pronounced it good and not to be interfered with regarding 11:30 the fact that his word is in heaven and it cannot be tampered with 11:36 revelation 1 1 the revelation the revealing of jesus christ 11:42 which god the father gave unto him to show us his servants things which 11:48 must shortly come to pass and all these things that he shows us these things cannot be tampered with his word is 11:53 established and he sent and signified it by his angel 11:58 unto his servant john in in revelation 21 and verse 1 12:05 he says i saw a new heaven and a new earth for the first heaven and the first earth 12:10 were passed away there was no more sea so there is coming an end to this cycle and we'll come back to this later in 12:16 this part of the psalm that the earth is established forever but it's going to be renewed 12:23 the surface of the earth is going to be burned up and there's going to be a new earth that goes into eternity and it's going to be 12:29 a new heaven that goes into eternity but but nothing can tamper 12:34 with god's plan including no matter how powerful these men on earth are 12:39 so back to psalm 119 and verse 91 regarding the heavens and the earth 12:46 he says they continue this day according to thine ordinances and i 12:53 really should have highlighted this because we are highlighting those words 12:59 that are synonyms for god's law 13:05 god's instructions they continued he continued this day uh climate alarmists 13:10 notwithstanding the earth continues this day according to his ordinances his instructions which 13:15

nobody can tamper with for all of the creation are god's servants they do what he says 13:22 so these people are trying to terrify us with climate alarmism it contradicts god's word 13:29 in fact here in isaiah and verse 21 of chapter 40 he says haven't 13:35 you known haven't you heard has it not been told you from the beginning this is this if we should have 13:41 read this to the climate alarmists does hasn't has been told you from the beginning have you not understood 13:48 from the foundations of the earth it is he that sits upon the circle of the earth 13:54 they're thousands of years old and the text clearly communicates that the earth is a sphere when everybody thought the 13:59 earth was flat isaiah makes it clear the god of this the creator of this universe made the 14:06 earth a sphere and he sits upon the circle of the earth and the inhabitants thereof are as grasshoppers 14:14 so so the this is this is how god sees these powerful humans who are now 14:19 colluding and and uniting to control and enslave the earth and 14:24 eliminate much of mankind god just sees them as grasshoppers they they have a will they have a plan 14:32 agenda 2030 agenda 2050, they have a plan they have a will they're exerting that will god sees them as grasshoppers 14:39 his will will override theirs his word will override theirs the psalmist 14:44 understands this he sees the inhabitants of the earth as grasshoppers 14:50 he it is that stretches out the heavens as a curtain and spreads them out as a tent to dwell 14:56 in this is this is the god that we are servant this is our creator he brings princes to nothing 15:03 he makes the judges of the earth as vanity so his word will not return unto 15:09 him vain or void but the princes of the earth the judges of the earth he makes them nothing so we must not be terrified

15:15 as terrifying as they seek to be we as god's servants must be fixated 15:22 on his word on his promises and on his will psalm 119 verse 92 15:29 so having established this the permanence 15:35 of god's word the irresistibility of his will 15:42 he says unless your law had been my pleasure my delight 15:49 i would have perished in my affliction again we don't know what this affliction is but from 15:54 previous verses it was serious and it was life-threatening 16:00 and and clearly again he's establishing here that it was life-threatening he would have perished whatever this affliction was 16:06 but he came through it because god's law was his delight 16:12 and i think this is the way we have to think in order to navigate the dark days ahead 16:18 that we do not look to man for salvation we do not look to man for safety from 16:25 anything we look to the almighty and in doing so he will deliver us 16:32 but the law must be our pleasure we just love his word we study it 16:39 continually and there's a deep joy that we derive from this relationship that we 16:45 have with god and his word he says if this had not been the case if the law was not my pleasure i would have 16:52 perished in my affliction and this reminds me of the apostle paul 16:58 he says to the philippians but my god shall supply all your need 17:03 according to his riches in glory by christ jesus now unto god and our father be glory 17:10 forever and ever amen he says here i'm sorry this is not the i'm going to cover this but i wanted to 17:16 put this somewhere else just rushing this evening he says salute i'll come back to it salute every saint in christ

17:22 jesus the brethren which are with me greet you all the saints salute you in fact yeah 17:27 this is where i wanted to put this chiefly they that are of caesar's household the grace of our lord 17:35 jesus christ be with you it's this part here that he's in rome he's under house 17:40 arrest and all the saints from rome are greeting the saints in philippi 17:47 chiefly they that are of caesar's household so 17:53 the praetorian guard those that are serving caesar because of paul's commitment 17:59 and passion for god's word they were converted and now the praetorian guard these these 18:06 these um servants of rome who have become christians because of paul's passion for god's word are now 18:14 supporting paul and sending greetings to the saints so this is where i was seeing this in 18:22 psalm 919 verse 92 that if the law had not been paul's delight 18:29 his pleasure he would have perished in his affliction but because of his his passion for god's 18:35 word he was protected so much so the very guards who were guarding him 18:40 converted that this is again how we have to understand we walk by faith and not 18:46 by sight coming back to psalm 119 verse 93 he says i will never forget 18:52 thy precepts for with them you have quickened me or 18:57 brought me back to life so he was he was on the cost he was on the edge whatever it was but he stuck to god's word and he 19:04 followed the instructions in god's word and and by doing that he was brought back to the land of the living again we 19:12 just have to understand this experience that the psalmist had 19:17 and meditate on it and realize that for those of us who do live through 19:22 the very dark days ahead we are going to be saying the exact same thing to be successful we must never forget in

19:29 fact that's why revelation says blessed is he who reads and they that hear 19:35 the words of this prophecy and keep those things or we could say keep those 19:40 precepts that are written therein for the time is at hand 19:45 so so there is a love affair that we have to have a passion that we have to have for god's instructions to get 19:53 through the dark affliction he says i am thine 19:58 save me for i have sought your instructions i have sought your 20:04 precepts god says christ says when he was on earth regarding the relationship we must have 20:11 with his word in his prayer to the father he says i have given them your word 20:18 and so here we are 2 000 years later one generation passing it on to the next 20:24 to the next to the next here we are it's the same word i've given them your word 20:30 and the world hates them that's where the persecution comes from and he warned us you know they don't hate you personally 20:36 they hate christ and because we follow christ that's why they hate us 20:43 i've given them your word and the world has hated them so we are subject to the same level of affliction and persecution 20:49 that we see in psalm 119 because the world the world has hated them because they are not of the world 20:55 even as i am not of the world i pray not that you should take them out of the world but that you should keep them from 21:02 the evil how does he keep that keep us from the evil by us paying attention to his precepts 21:09 by us seeking his law by us seeking to be instructed by him by us 21:14 acknowledging his ways he says 21:21 that he should not that we should be taken out of the world we have to function in this world a world that hates us

21:27 hates christ but that we will be kept from evil 21:32 this is the power of god's word it will keep us from evil we will be right in the midst of a very dark world 21:38 but we will be clean and unspotted because of the power of god's word and this is what the psalmist is reflecting 21:44 on the power of god's words and instructions in the time of evil and danger 21:51 he says christ says sanctify them through your truth 21:56 your word is truth that this i think we all understand this this is 22:03 how we are sanctified through his truth which is his word 22:08 and this we're seeing the psalmist having this wonderful perception and understanding back to psalm 119 verse 95 22:18 again we will be able to say this is this exact sentiment the wicked 22:24 have waited for me to destroy me but i will consider thy testimonies 22:32 so again we walk by faith not by sight the times are changing 22:38 some of us are going to really suffer very severe persecution some of us are going to see our loved 22:44 ones suffer very severe persecution we're seeing the canaries in the coal mine dying off 22:51 that means something's going on a sort of the early warning signal it's not the end 22:56 it's just the beginning so we know this is coming all those that 23:01 desire to live godly in christ jesus shall suffer persecution the wicked have 23:07 waited for me why to destroy me oh that's a conspiracy theory no that's 23:13 god's word they hate god's word and therefore they hate anybody who loves god's word 23:19 the wicked have waited for me to destroy me but i'll consider thy testimonies and again this puts me in mind of the 23:25

apostle paul he says here in acts 9 or luke writes in exodus 9 verse 23 this is the study of 23:32 the book of acts is in the archive if you haven't studied that with us it's available online upon line bible academy 23:38 dot com he says and after that many days were fulfilled 23:44 the jews took council to kill him not unlike the wicked have waited to destroy 23:50 him but he considers god's testimonies so acts 9 23 after that many days were 23:55 fulfilled the jews took counsel to kill him but their lying await was known of saul 24:02 and they watch the gate day and night to kill him they're pretty serious about their intent 24:09 he's not getting away as far as they're concerned then the disciples took him by night 24:14 and let him down by the wall in a basket so they had so much love and respect for this for this teacher 24:22 that they would not allow him to be killed and so he escaped in a basket kind of like moses here um 24:29 despite the fact that they were intent to kill him lying in weight watching the gates day 24:34 and night just waiting for him waiting for the opportunity and yet god enables him to 24:40 escape not unlike the psalmist who considered god's testimony and that certainly was the apostle paul 24:47 taught by christ directly and considered his testimonies verse 96 back to psalm 24:52 119 i have seen an end of all perfection 24:58 but thy commandment is exceeding broad and this is where i was thinking of the revelation 21 passage that we read 25:05 earlier that john saw a new heavens and a new earth 25:11 and the old heaven and the old earth were passed away they died they perished 25:16 and then there was a new heaven and a new earth so the earth was cleansed 25:21

and renewed he says i've seen an end of all perfection so god's creation is is it

25:28 was all pronounced good and yet it's all coming to an end and it will be renewed 25:34 but it's all coming to an end but god's commandment will never end 25:39 it's exceedingly broad it has no limits christ himself said this 25:44 heaven and earth shall pass away there will be a new heaven and the old heaven and earth will die there will be 25:51 a new heaven and earth despite the fact that this heaven and earth god pronounced them good when he created 25:57 them but my words shall not pass away jesus christ is god 26:04 the logos the creator the almighty you know in revelation some people want to argue that christ is not god in 26:11 revelation john says in chapter 1 john to the seven churches which are in asia 26:18 grace be unto you and peace from who from him which is 26:24 and which was and which is to come and from the seven spirits which are before his throne and from jesus christ 26:32 and then he goes on to describe jesus christ as the faithful witness and the first begotten of the dead and the 26:37 prince of the kings of the earth and he's washed us in his own blood to make us uh priests and kings but then he says 26:43 john christ himself says i am alpha and omega the beginning and the ending 26:51 and and then christ himself describes himself as him which is and which was 26:57 and which is to come so god the father is he that is 27:03 and was and is to come and then christ describes himself 27:08 as he that is and was and is to come 27:13 and in case we had any doubt christ then adds describing himself the 27:18 almighty that christ himself describes himself as the almighty

27:26 so the almighty has spoken and the almighty christ says 27:31 heaven there will be an end to the perfection of heaven and earth 27:37 but my words are exceeding broad my words shall never pass away 27:43 so that is lamed just uh just the praising of god's word acknowledging the wisdom 27:52 in god's word we're gonna continue that now with the hebrew letter mem so again 27:57 it's an acrostic so all eight verses will begin with this hebrew letter mem 28:03 and just that i think it's obviously a mnemonic device a memory aid 28:08 but certainly incredible poetry and grasp of god's word 28:14 to be able to do this 28:20 thy law it is my meditation all the day 28:25 so there is a such a a deep wisdom in torah and you know 28:31 oh how love i thy law i think it would be very limiting to say this is the ten 28:37 commandments he's saying oh how love i thy torah the torah is instructions 28:44 oh how i love god's instructions i meditate on his instructions 28:49 continually from the moment i wake up until i put my head to rest if i wake up 28:56 in the middle of the night it's just constantly in my mind the wisdom of god's instructions the 29:02 intricacy the synergy the the longevity of god's word 29:08 this is he's just constantly in awe of the wisdom of god 29:15 he says you through your commandments and it's going to raise himself above 29:22 three different groups of people the first one you through your commandments have made me wiser 29:30 than my enemies for your commandments are ever with me 29:36

so this is amazing these these enemies are there but because of your commandments i'm 29:42 actually wiser than them they have no clue what they're doing in fact again the apostle paul 29:48 he says to the corinthians in first corinthians 1 20 where is the wise 29:54 where is the scribe where is the disputer of this world has not god made foolish 30:00 the wisdom of this world and boy are we seeing that today you know that the dr faucis and and the 30:07 others of them who think they're so wise and their judgments are awful 30:13 that they're actually stupid they're destructive they make they're illogical they're 30:19 they're self-contradicted and these this is the wise of this world this this is this is 30:25 who you have to present to us as your wise the psalmist says 30:30 through your commandments you've made me wiser than my enemies 30:37 he says here he says as it is written he that glories letting glory in the lord 30:44 us proverbs says my son walk not you in the way with them that's the wicked 30:50 refrain your foot from their path they have no clue what they're doing refrain your foot don't go along with them 30:57 refrain your foot from their path psalm 119 verse 102 i have not departed from your judgments 31:05 for you have taught me it's the search like remember the scriptures and and from whom you have been taught 31:12 so we're not going to depart from god's judgments for you have taught me 31:17 and that taught me is like again torah god's instructions how sweet 31:23 are thy words unto my taste yes sweeter than honey to my mouth and i think we've all experienced this 31:30 where there's just such a delight in the understanding that we're gaining 31:35 of god's word of his wisdom of his plan of his counsel 31:40

it's it's overwhelming and to see that we are included into this incredible plan 31:46

it's it's just overwhelming at times how sweet are they words unto my taste yes 31:51

sweeter than honey to my mouth through your precepts i get understanding 31:59

therefore i hate every false way we we we cannot participate

32:07

in falsehood live not by lies every fall in every way that is false

32:12

we want to exclude ourselves from that so that is psalm 119 that takes us up to

32:20

verse 104 and a celebration

32:25

of the wisdom of god's word so as we march through this psalm

32:32

hopefully we're seeing just how the depth of respect and awe

32:38

the psalmist has for torah for god's instructions and also the faithfulness of god and the power of his word

32:45

so this is i think just for us brethren just a wonderful way for us to gain

32:50

strength and momentum in our faith in the lord jesus christ

32:56

is the faithful witness he's the faithful witness from he's the alpha and the omega 33:03

and it's in him that we place our trust not in man's wisdom god bless you brother 33:54
