that we will be successful even if we have to be tried and our patience has to be developed 4:59 but god will uphold us and not give us more than we can bear he will uphold us according to his word 5:06 that we may live and let me not be ashamed of my hope 5:11 hold thou me up and i shall be safe and i will have respect unto thy statutes continually and i think so 5:18 that's i think i just got to 117 so i'll just pick up the last couple of verses of that stanza 5:26 you have trodden down all them that air from your statutes 5:32 for their deceit is falsehood you know i i i 5:37 i'm troubled by this verse because the impression that i get from it 5:43is these people who heir from his statutes were actually following the statutes 5:50it's not that they never knew it's that they knew and they were following for a while and then they deviated 5:55 and and christ warns us in the end time that many shall be offended and brother 6:02 shall betray brother and so we really have to be careful and pray for each other and pray for those 6:07 that we begin to see signs of deviation in fact what i'll say is the last two years of this 6:16 covid pandemic and the global government collaboration and lockdown 6:22 it was like a dress rehearsal and so i think it's worth for all of us 6:28 asking ourselves how did we perform were we faithful 6:34 or were we fearful did we do all we could to support our 6:39 brethren or were we quick to just cut loose uh i think it's worth taking the time 6:46 just to have a bit of introspection because if we did fall short and and we can acknowledge it and go to 6:52

jesus and acknowledge that we fell short we have the opportunity to change if we just live in denial and we don't 6:59 face ourselves well then that is evidence of how we will perform when the real 7:05 pressure comes upon us so so there these are clearly people 7:10 who were following the statutes and then they deviated from them 7:16 and their deceit is falsehood you put away 7:21 all the wicked of the earth like dross 7:27 therefore i love your testimonies uh greetings posing otto i just saw you 7:33 greeting there so the psalmist understands how god operates 7:39 and eventually it doesn't matter how powerful the wicked are it doesn't matter how wealthy the wicked are and 7:45 and the wealth that we're seeing today is unprecedented and you know heads of companies are more 7:52 powerful than countries and and yet these powerful companies and these powerful countries are now 8:00 collaborating which is basically fascism uh to to 8:06 deprive the poor of any wealth whatsoever to take even the little bit they have from 8:11 them and completely impoverish them but it doesn't matter 8:17 in the end god is allowing this for now but in the end god is going to pull the rug from under 8:23 their feet and he says he puts away all the wicked of the earth like dross 8:29 like this sort of um refining of silver and all this dross you just click keep cleaning it off it's 8:36 waste and and because he understands this therefore he loves god's testimonies and 8:44 he's not going to depart from them and he just understands how precious the word of god is 8:50 uh speaking of this uh dross cleansing process and again speaking of the fact 8:56

that there are those that knew the way of god and then deviated from it in malachi 3 9:01 and verse 2 he says but who may abide the day of his coming 9:08 when christ returns who will abide who shall stand when he appears 9:14 for he is like a refiner's fire and like fuller soap so so in the end there could be no 9:21 hypocrisy we have to be genuine we have to be authentic we have to be truly in the way 9:28 in order to stand when he appears and those that are playing church playing loose fast and loose with the 9:35 word of god it's not going to go well it's not going to go well it's it's a 9:41 horrific thought and then this um 9:46 psalm 119 finishes in verse 120 he says my flesh trembles 9:54 for fear of you and this is real trembling this is something that 9:59 i think we've lost i think because of the influence of traditional christianity and tell me 10:05 what you think brethren maybe type in the chat what you think i think because of the influence of 10:12 traditional christianity and this image of christ as this sort of long-haired 10:17 flowing robe sandals just loves everybody just really soft 10:23 we've lost the fear of god and i think also this sort of one saved 10:28 always saved mentality can get in our head and we can lose the fear of god this is 10:34 a genuine trembling a genuine fear not just respect but a trembling 10:40 out of fear of god and i am afraid of your judgments 10:46 and we know god's judgments god is as severe as he is merciful 10:52 and we know that his judgments are are terrible and the psalmist had this is a great 10:58 meditation this we have sort of this access this this um 11:04

it's like somebody's thinking out loud and we get to listen in so we have this access 11:10 to the psalmist meditation and in part of his meditation he really understands the judgment of 11:17 god and when he considers this judgment he's terrified to the point of trembling 11:24 now look at the judgment of god in revelation 18 and verse 8 11:30 he says therefore shall her plagues this is babylon come in one day so you know go ahead let 11:37 them have their fun let them have their way the judgment is coming and the psalmist is considering 11:43 the judgments of god and while the wicked are not considering this the psalmist is trembling for what these 11:51 judgments are when he fully comprehends them her plagues will come in one day and 11:56 this is just a sentence but it's a real ritual reality her plague shall come in one day death 12:01 and mourning and famine and she shall be utterly burned with fire 12:06 for strong is the lord god who judges her 12:11 this is the kind of judgment that our god will inflict 12:17 on the wicked and the psalmist spends some time meditating on this 12:22 now there's the wicked the babylonian wicked and then there's the wicked 12:28 within the covenant community and at the end of the book of revelation 12:35 john writes blessed are they who do his commandments so again we're meditating 12:40 on torah we're devoting our lives to torah we understand we are followers of the way 12:47 blessed are they that do his commandments that they may have right 12:53 to the tree of life and may enter in through the gates 12:58 into the city for without so if we don't make it through these gates 13:04 if we're locked out god forbid for without our dogs and sorcerers and whoremongers and murderers

13:13 and idolaters and whosoever loves and maketh a lie 13:18 this is the judgment of god and this is we have to acknowledge the severity not 13:26 just the kindness of god in the mercy of god but also his severity and clearly from the psalmist meditation 13:32 he understands the severity of god to the point of it causes him to tremble to tremble for the wicked to tremble for 13:39 those who deviate from the way back to psalm 119 121 we pick up the 13:47 next stanza in line is the next hebrew letter and it actually 13:53 represents the i and the way hebrew letters 13:58 were derived coming from the the canaanites 14:03 who who actually invented written language and the hebrews picked up from that 14:09 the very great innovation was in their oral language 14:15 what they did was they would they would write symbols so the symbol of an i 14:21 would make how that words began it just happens i and i it's just coincidence 14:28 for english or maybe a derivation but if you say i if they drew that 14:34 that symbol of an eye you would know that it makes that sound i 14:39 uh so so that's that's how they came to create this letter i was actually originally 14:46to symbolize an eye and then make that sound 14:51 interesting because in this stanza there's an emphasis on the eye and on 14:56 site we'll see shortly psalm 119 verse 121 ein so it's an 15:02 acrostic so every letter of every beginning every verse in the stanza begins with this letter 15:09 i have done judgment and justice leave me not to my oppressors 15:16 and clearly this is not social justice this is not you know

15:21 all of these environmental justice and marxism this is torah i've followed 15:26 torah i've done judgment and justice leave me not to my oppressors 15:32 and there are many oppressors there's always there's always been this opposition to god and this hunting of 15:39 god's people be surety for your servant for good let not the proud oppress me 15:47 and i think we can come with the same cry today as you see 15:53 men like bill gates uh buying up all of the farmland in america 15:58 uh you know just really understanding where how how and where to create wealth 16:04 i think that's one thing i respect is his ability to foresee 16:09 where future wealth can be created so originally when everybody would you know on the mainframe computer he 16:16 understood that the future was going to be in in microcomputers and then as everybody came to understand 16:22 that the future's going to be in micro computers he understood no the future's going to be in the operating system 16:28 and in the software in applications and then you know in 16:33 handhelds mobile and then in vaccines and now it's in farmland in agriculture 16:40 so he does have this ability to read the future and and profit as a result 16:48 but he is an oppressor no doubt about it i think that the halo people would used to think bill gates in the past uh you 16:54 know nice guy wealthy guy now i think the halo is shattered and then people are seeing this this is 17:01 an oppressor and no regard for human life 17:09 so we're in trouble we're in trouble the fut the future is dire 17:15 and because i don't want to sound hyperbolic but when we read the signs of times

17:21 uh the oppressors are really flexing their muscle and against christianity 17:27 against christianity in fact it was pastor murray i don't know if you uh we 17:32 had a couple of with our podcast um i don't know if you saw 17:38 uh something that he had shared with us here but this comrade patriot this this is just a 17:44 customer maybe you can type in the chat where you got this from but he says this is the literal definition of hate speech 17:49 this person is quoting somebody else jacob schlatowski who is just so honorable and 17:55 stands with ukraine but he says christianity is the plague that we need 18:00 to rid the world of christianity is a disease so that that's his understanding of 18:07 christianity and this is the sentiment that is just in all the western nations 18:13 that were built upon the christian ethic this is the the growing sentiment 18:19 uh is against christianity and again pastor murray uh he we we had 18:24 a podcast and he had mentioned this and he says the brother from bc had said brother warren lee okay so 18:30 brother warren lee uh sent that to pastor murray but wow 18:36 and that's a great basically everything we're seeing here and i mentioned in my sermon on sabbath 18:41 that it's really evidentiary that there's a problem 18:47 when we see what happened during covet and the the exertion of governments 18:54 to ensure that christians do not assemble because of covet 19:00 this pandemic this healthy emergency and now we're faced with another health emergency a monkey box 19:08 and like there's no no desire no effort in any way shape or form to try to 19:14 restrict in any way to try to restrict homosexual

activity even though clearly 90 more than 95 of the cases of monkey box are between 19:27 homosexual men engaged in homosexual activity that's where it's coming from that's what's spreading it and yet 19:34 their parades their basically their orgies are not blocked in any way in fact 19:39 they're promoted they're supported and so we have june pride month 19:45 followed by july outbreaks everywhere and yet nothing is said nothing is done there's no kind of 19:51 lockdown this is clear evidence that there's a problem at the at the top 19:58 with our with our elite and with their view of god's law and 20:03 with their view of the christian way that christian way can be disrupted and 20:09 prohibited and that that can be done with great enthusiasm but do not interfere in any way shape or 20:16 form with homosexual activity even if it's clear that this is this is how the this monkey pox which is far more deadly 20:24 uh and troubling and potential for incredible 20:30 harm to society do not interfere with it do not stigmatize in any way 20:36 so that is where we are hello there sister june welcome 20:42 so here we go um we were where were we 20:48 yes i wanted to go to jeremiah so he says let not the proud oppress me 20:54 which we certainly have to pray that there's this clear agenda 21:00 you know agenda 2030 it's real it was conspiracy before it's real it's a real 21:05 date that the elites of this world are working toward that 2031 is going to be a very 21:12 different world than pre-2013 so 21:18 we're heading there and it's going to be very troubling it's going to be very difficult 21:24

and you will own nothing and the claim is that you'll be happy that's just a claim the fact is vou'll vou'll own 21:29 nothing whether or not you'll be happy i guess that's going to be up to you is the cup half full or half empty and anyway it's 21:35 just a claim the reality is what they're working towards is you'll learn nothing 21:41 that's oppression god god ensures that his people have land that they are free 21:48 they're working against god's plan let not the proud oppress me 21:53 jeremiah says in 18 and verse 23 yet lord you know all their counsel 21:59 against me to slay me oh jeremiah conspiracy all these conspiracy theorists 22:05 there's conspiracy is a fact there are there are lunatics out there of course we're not going to follow 22:11 lunatics but this is not god's world and there are evil people who mean to do 22:18 harm to god's people and jeremiah understood that and he says here you know it's hard for 22:24 us to know but god knows you know all their counsel against us to slay us to oppress us 22:32 jeremiah says against me to slay me forgive not their iniquity 22:37 neither blot out their sin from your sight but let them be overthrown before you 22:43 deal thus with them in the time of your anger 22:48 so this is this is where jeremiah is coming for he the depth of evil 22:54 and wickedness that that he is aware of he is just appealing to god please god 23:03 his prayer is is appropriate for the evil and the wickedness 23:08 that he sees and he's asking god not to let the proud oppress him let them be overthrown before vou deal 23:15 thus with them in the time of your anger and there's god's judgment again 23:20 sister carlotta thanks very much god bless you back to psalm 119 23:26

my eyes so here it is i'm here's the emphasis on eyes my eyes fail for your salvation 23:34 and for the word of your righteousness he's so eagerly looking 23:40for god's word and to understand god's word he just his eyes cannot keep up with 23:45 his desire deal with your servant according to your mercy 23:51 and teach me your statutes so so god can deal with us according to 23:57 his strict judgment in which case none of us can stand before him 24:03 but he can also deal with us according to his cassette his covenant love 24:08 and we need to understand that we are in covenant and god has bound himself to his covenant 24:15 and so we need to understand the covenant we do our part god does his part it's an eternal relationship 24:22 and so this psalmist who i believe is king david as he meditates on this 24:27 and meditates on god's judgment he pleads with god to deal with him 24:33 according to this covenant love and he acknowledges his role in the covenant 24:40 your servant your slave the apostles would uh call themselves dolos 24:47 he's his slave and and take joy in that that's no that's no 24:52 insult how dare you call me a slave to be the slave of christ is an honor 24:58 and so the psalmist acknowledges his his position with with god yes 25:03 his son but happy to be his servant happy to carry out his will 25:09 for that's where blessing is that's where joy and fulfillment are and then he says to teach me 25:16 teach me your stats clearly from the way he's written this psalm he understands quite a bit 25:22 about god's statutes in god's way and torah but there's a humility here 25:28 and i think sometimes we can lack humility to say that knowledge puffs up 25:34

and we get a certain amount of knowledge and then we think we know everything instead of realizing wow yesterday i 25:40 thought i knew quite a bit and and today i've learned something that i didn't know yesterday so how much 25:46 more is out there that i don't know that i don't understand and also i think as we peel back the layers 25:52 and come to to understand more we realized wow if i if i didn't understand this before 26:00 and now it's so clear and evident i must be just scratching the surface we 26:05 are just scratching the surface somehow god has taken his mind 26:11 and his will and his purpose and he's put it in a book that we call the bible or a book of books 26:18 and god's mind is in this in this library so how on earth could we for a minute 26:24 believe oh i i know the bible i've read it several times and i just i really know the bible this is the mind of god 26:31 anything we know we're just scratching the surface and this is this is an eternal 26:36 relationship of us being a student of god's mind so i think i love this humility after 26:43 everything we can see he understands he turns to god and says teach me your statutes and deal with me 26:50 according to your covenant love we we see the apostles exhorting us the same 26:57 to have the same relationship with knowledge don't let it puff us up the lord is not slack oh sorry i didn't 27:03 want this scripture this is not the scripture that i want i wanted i wanted the scripture and maybe 27:08 somebody could look it up for me um i wanted the one that said um i thought it was in peter maybe it's first peter 3 9. 27:15 i wanted the one that said um grow in the grace of 27:21 grow grow in grace and the knowledge of our lord jesus christ that this is a 27:26

continual process that we are doing i'll just look in the chat if you guys somebody could look that up for me i'm growing the grace and 27:34 knowledge of our lord jesus christ that's what the reference that i wanted moving too fast there 27:40 verse 125 again he emphasizes this i am your servant i love your servant and 27:47 then again give me understanding that i may know your testimonies 27:53 give me understanding that i may know your testimonies this this is the the 27:59 testimonies and this is an interesting word give me understanding that i may 28:04 know your testimonies is second peter 3 18. thanks up pastor murray up so ii 28:10 peter 3 18. let me just pick that up very quickly just it bothers me when i have a loose end second peter 3 18 28:17 but grow in the grace and knowledge of our lord and savior jesus christ to 28:24 him be glory both now and forever so that's the that's the verse i wanted to pick up not not verse 19 but verse 18. 28:32 uh not verse nine but verse 18. uh so deal with your servant according to your mercy and teach me your statutes and 28:38 then he goes on to say i'm your servant give me understanding so this is this is the 28:44 perspective the approach the motivation that we should have in order to grow 28:50 in the grace and knowledge of our lord jesus christ give me understanding that i may know your testimonies and then 28:56 this is just an interesting this word translated testimonies 29:03 it's translated it means congregation assembled together 29:08 by appointment or acting concertedly 29:14 or it's another term would be like a pack uh or a swarm of bees 29:19 this is really interesting to me uh given that we are not to forsake 29:25

the assembling of ourselves together and he says give me understanding that i may know your testimonies 29:32 and so i think by implication here it might mean the again the significance 29:38 of us assembling together that i hear your testimony how how christ is 29:44 has intervened in your life the relationship you have with him and with his word 29:49 and that strengthens me and that gives me wisdom and that gives me understanding the more i'm with my brethren and i see how god is acting in 29:57 all of our lives and and confirming and acting according to his word this is how 30:02 my understanding deepens so just interesting testimonies is more than 30:09 just what we think just uh testimonies in the word that we study but actually in the congregation 30:16 he says verse 126 30:23 it is time for you it is time for you lord to work uh for they have made void your law it's 30:30 almost like he's saying it's high time god like uh how much longer and we know that god 30:36 says that he is patient and many think he's slack concerning his promise but he's not willing that 30:43 any man should perish and yet we see this outcry from god's faithful 30:48 that please act god it's it's high time it's time for you lord to work it's 30:54 this thing has just been running uninhibited they're getting out of control 31:00 they they believe they are now gods on earth they've got this nimrod complex 31:07 and they have no regard for your saints and and they've made void your law we we 31:13 want to keep torah and they are they are exerting themselves 31:19 as higher a higher authority than you jehovah it pleases that 31:25 we we cannot stop them and they're drunk on power 31:30 it's time for you to work oh lord they've made void your law we now it's we can't keep torah

except on pain of death that's where that's where it's headed and oh well we signed up for this it's okay we have 31:46 a long-term view but we look at your prophecies 31:52 and we know at some point you're going to intervene and the the psalmist is just looking at 31:57 the state of affairs and praying to god that he'll act and this was written thousands of years ago so we we must 32:03 have patience brethren but he says they've made void god's law 32:09 and again not only must we have patience we must have discernment and i'm saddened 32:15 by how many brethren think that global war anything with 32:21 global or world in it should be suspicious to us but i'm saddened by how many brethren think the world health 32:27 organization has their best interests at heart that the edicts of the world health 32:33 organization are for the good of christians i think we have to have the view that these people 32:39 who are flexing their muscle and and clearly degrading christianity and promoting the 32:47 lgbtq agenda these people are not acting in our interests 32:53 nor do they care for the law of god and yet so many of us think that they mean us well and we 33:00 should do what they say be careful brethren let god be true 33:07 and every man a liar let god be true and every man a liar 33:12 he says they've made void your law just wipe it aside like it's nothing 33:18 your law look at the high regard the psalmist has for torah and the 33:24 wicked have no regard for it at all therefore he says because of this 33:30 i love your commandments above gold these people are drunk on power 33:37 and they're seduced by money the psalmist wants none of it 33:42

he is so consumed by god's word and the value of god's 33:50 word that there's no amount of money you could present to him that's going to cause him to deviate that's going to get 33:56 his attention that this what he has uncovered the treasure 34:02 that he has uncovered in god's word gold 34:07 even fine gold it's not on the radar and these wicked people they're drunk 34:14 with money drunk on power because they don't understand that 34:20 that's why they're now so insane they want to make torah void 34:25 he says therefore therefore i esteem all your precepts concerning 34:32 all things to be right and i hate every false way it's beautiful 34:38 beautiful he says not only does he love god's commandments 34:43 above gold even fine gold but he esteems all of god's precepts concerning 34:48 everything to be right this is uh you know 34:54 what do humans esteem to be right you know i think that's the blessing 35:01 in disguise here as the world unravels and falls apart 35:08 that people who are arrogant towards god's word they're not wicked people like the 35:14 the elite i'm not i'm not talking about wicked evil people like the elite who have a 35:20 wicked agenda and they've given themselves over to satan i'm talking about just a typical human 35:27 being who doesn't have time for god doesn't have time for god's word thinks 35:32 all religion is nonsense believes in evolution i think the blessing in disguise now 35:38 is how do you understand we could ask them 35:44 what's your perception of the world and where it's going and how's this evolution thing working 35:49

out for you where men just seem to be getting better and better and you know first we started 35:55 out as a one cell amoeba somewhere along the line we became monkeys and then somewhere along the 36:01 line we became these really intelligent human beings and then we just keep getting better and better and better and 36:06 better and better how is that theory working when now we see globally 36:13 human beings behaving in ways that they're we're behaving in ways that are lower than animals 36:18 we're just we're disgusting and our intelligence level is clearly dropping 36:24 if you read the writings of of leaders 100 years ago 36:30 compared to today of philosophers 100 years ago compared to today 36:37 of the literature that was written 100 years ago compared to today to today 36:43 evolution is not really working is it so for us now we're laughed at or you 36:50 believe the bible that silly book you know what i'm sorry but 36:56 we esteem god's word concerning everything to be right 37:02 throw anything at us and we'll explain it with god's word it's all here 37:08 it's all here especially the prophetic word we can actually explain 37:14 the development of of man's situation over time and where it's heading with 37:21 the prophetic word perfectly it's amazing so maybe 37:26 some of these evolutionist atheist agnostics will humble themselves 37:32 and turn to god's word but we have to be bold brethren we have to be bold in preaching god's word not 37:39 apology why should we apologize everything in god's word is right why should we apologize 37:45 let's be bold therefore i esteem all thy precepts concerning all things to be right and 37:52 not only that or maybe because of that i hate every false way we're not going to cooperate

with falsehood we're not going to defend falsehood we're not going to compromise and try to 38:06 integrate with falsehood we're just going to declare it as falsehood and then state that we hate it 38:13 we want nothing to do with it it has nothing to do with god's word 38:18 which is so pure and beautiful and reflects the mind of god we're not going to pollute it 38:24 with these inventions of men and and ideas of men and corruption of 38:30 corrupt minds brethren please if you shake somebody 38:36 shake somebody you see some brethren drifting off we need to bring them back 38:43 we can't get mixed up with the world's ideas we hate every false way 38:50 there's so much lying and deception we have to hate it 38:56 let me for example it's finally coming out now the harm 39:02 of these vaccines at first we couldn't talk about it conspiracy theory 39:08 now the data is undeniable these vaccines cause harm 39:13 and it is absolutely ridiculous for anybody these governments think they're doctors they're not doctors it's 39:19 ridiculous for anybody to say carp launch everybody must have this injection 39:25 when every other medication they have to list the side effects and there's a there's a cost 39:31 risk and benefit analysis that has to be done should i take this medication my physiology is different 39:38 than yours maybe it's fine for you but as i look at it and i look at the side effects 39:44 and and the benefits that it could bring to me maybe my conclusion in my particular situation is i decline 39:52 this this notion that every single human being on the planet including newborn babies infants must be 40:00 injected with an experimental i was going to call it a medication i

if we do this this thing is so disgusting what's happening to these men and the where where the blisters are 50:40 appearing though these the pox because of their activities 50:46 that they could all of this could is unavoidable all of this harm and tragedy is 50:52 avoidable through god's word through understanding through wisdom 50:58 through judgment and discretion so this is this is the word of god it's a lamp it's a light 51:04 he says here's the mouth reference to the mouth i opened my mouth and panted 51:10 for i longed for your commandments in this um word panted it has the 51:16 impression or the implication of anger this is a as a woman in travail 51:25 to snuff up the wind to pants to to be eager for something and i was 51:32 reading another um lexicon that said it can give the impression of being angry about 51:38 something so this panting is real sense of urgency 51:44 because of long for the torah and everything that's happening around us we have to speak with urgency 51:52 look thou upon me and be merciful unto me as you used to do unto those that love 51:59 your name and this is this is again his understanding of the covenant 52:05 the covenant love and god's fulfillment and and mercy to those who love his name 52:11 in psalm 20 and verse 1 he says the lord hear you in the day of trouble 52:16 the name of the god of jacob defend you because it's a covenant 52:22 and so there's this covenant love and there's this covenant protection and and that's what the psalmist is praying for 52:29 verse 133 order my steps in your word 52:35 and let not any iniquity have dominion over me and again not only does the psalmist have such a wonderful grasp of

52:42 the torah how shall i say sort of externally 52:48 and and the role of torah in helping us navigate the world and what's going to happen to the wicked the 52:55 the inheritance of the righteous but clearly he has an understanding here 53:00 like the apostle paul of the inner life of the worshiper of jehovah 53:06 that we are born in iniquity we're riddled with human nature 53:12 the apostle paul struggled with his own human nature and instructed 53:17 in romans here romans 6 and verse 12 he says let not sin therefore reign 53:23 in your mortal body he's speaking to christians so so 53:29 it's not surprising that we will see christians who are caught up in gambling 53:34 and it gets away with them and they're overtaken i don't understand gambling 53:40 i don't understand these th again if you're a young person you're following proverbs through discretion we 53:45 can avoid these things but people get overwhelmed by things like gambling pornography fornication 53:52 adultery homosexuality 53:58 anger because these things grow it's a spiritual life form 54:04 it's a spiritual life and once it gets in if it's not checked 54:09 it grows and multiplies and overtakes and the psalmist understands this 54:16 and so clearly he's fighting this holy spirit battle in the mind 54:22 to to master himself and that is that is the life of the christian so this notion that all old 54:27 testament has nothing to do with the holy spirit i beg to differ this this is a real interesting insight 54:34 that he's asking god to order his steps in the word as we pray

54:40 and let not any iniquity have dominion this dominion over me that's real insight 54:46 holy spirit understanding paul backs up that same understanding 54:51 that let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body that you should obey it in 54:56 the lust thereof it's just very very powerful if it's not checked let's feel the whole days of unleavened 55:03 bread is this annual reminder of this battle getting to lebanon because it grows as a spiritual life form 55:11 in hebrews 4 and verse 12 he says for the word of god is quick 55:16 and powerful this this is how the study of god's word helps us overcome 55:23 this spiritual life form that we call leaven for the word of god is quick and 55:28 powerful and sharper than any two-edged sword piercing even to the dividing asunder of 55:33 soul and spirit and of the joints and marrow and is a discerner of the thoughts and 55:39 intents of the heart so so if we are cooperative with god and 55:45 his word it's going to find us out it's going to find out where our weaknesses are what 55:50 needs to be addressed and again we have to check it immediately because it it grows it's 11. 55:58 verse 134 he says deliver me from the oppression of man 56:06 so will i keep thy precepts and again they've made void the torah they're they're antichrist 56:12 and they're against the torah and they're trying to make it impossible to keep the sabbath 56:18 they're trying to make it impossible to keep the health laws we quarantine the healthy we don't 56:24 the sick are allowed to run wild and do their orgies while while the healthy must be locked 56:30 down it's a complete reversal of torah this is the world we live in they've made void the torah 56:36 and he says deliver me from the oppression of man they're buying up all the farmland they tell us we'll own nothing 56:45

they're too powerful for us we need god to deliver us deliver me from the oppression of man 56:52 so this way i will be able to keep your precepts in fact that is the definition of 56:59 salvation luke tells us in the the coming of christ he tells us 57:05 that he would grant unto us that we this is luke 1 verse 74 and luke 57:11 is in the archives that we he would grant unto us that we being delivered out of the hand of our enemies 57:17 might serve him without fear this is going right back to to pharaoh 57:22 when moses let my people go that they may worship me unmolested 57:29 they want to interfere with the worship of god see a note here from [Music] 57:37 brother allen 57:43 if we are faithless we won't give reverence to the lord thank you brother alan i'm not sure 57:49 which verse that was referring to but this is exactly right we cannot be faithless 57:55 and and think that we will revere the lord thank you brother 58:00 he says 58:07 so salvation christ has come to deliver israel out of the hand of 58:13 israel's enemies that israel may serve him without fear that that's what this is all about so 58:19 that means until christ comes there's going to be this molestation 58:24 of god's people and interference with the worship of god but we have to just 58:31 buckle down and face this study the word so that we'll be strengthened by the 58:37 lord until he returns he says [Music] 58:45 verse 135 psalm 119 make your face to shine upon your servant there it is 58:50 again this emphasis of your servant and teach me your statutes this emphasis 58:55 of just the humility as much as he knows he's still asking god to teach him to

teach him more here i have the the proper reference that i was looking for growing 59:06 grace in the knowledge of our lord and savior jesus christ to him be glory both now and forever so again this humility 59:14 with knowledge that as much as we know it just makes us realize how much we don't know 59:20 as much as we know it just makes us realize we're just scratching the surface there's so much more 59:26 and so we have a humility with knowledge not not a puffing up 59:33 and if we're growing in knowledge then we're constantly negating 59:38 this this influence of arrogance because that's what knowledge does but we're growing in knowledge but we're 59:44 also growing in grace verse 136 and this is where the stanza 59:51 ends rivers of waters run down my eyes because they keep not your law 59:58 again this is a meditation it means that he's spending time 1:00:04thinking through and what what does this lead to and what 1:00:10 does that lead to this cause and effect how does this all end and he sees it through to the end 1:00:16 and he cannot help but weep because they do not keep your law 1:00:23 they're playing fast and loose with the law and it wouldn't surprise me if 1:00:29 he's speaking of the covenant people here he's looking at his own covenant community 1:00:35 and they will not keep the law and he's just filled with such sorrow 1:00:41 because god god is not here right now christ is not with us so we can say whatever we want 1:00:46 we can believe whatever we want and we can become as arrogant as we like 1:00:52 until he returns and then he's going to separate the true worshipers from the false 1:01:00 and the psalmist is thinking this through and he can't help but be full of tears 1:01:05

and you think of certainly malachi 4 1 comes to mind for behold 1:01:12 the day comes that shall burn as an oven and all the proud 1:01:18 yes and all that do wickedly shall be stubble 1:01:24 that this is the future this is reality it's easy to be proud 1:01:30 it's easy to behave like we know everything 1:01:36 and then do wickedly but they shall be a stubble they shall be stubble 1:01:43 and the day that comes shall burn them up this is the judgment behold 1:01:49 the goodness and the severity of god 1:01:54 and the day that comes shall burn them up says the lord of hosts god is saying this 1:02:00 this is from god this is from jesus christ that i shall leave them 1:02:05 neither root nor branch rivers of waters rivers of waters run 1:02:11 down my eyes because they don't keep your law they don't they don't understand 1:02:16 they don't understand how beautiful your testimonies are they don't understand how beautiful the torah torah is 1:02:22 and they refuse to keep your law and as as the psalmist meditates on all 1:02:28 of this we see two things one is what we just saw 1:02:33 his deep sadness and regret 1:02:39 for the wicked who will not keep god's law for the wicked who deviate from torah 1:02:44 and the other is his rejoicing his joy 1:02:49 his commitment to the torah and in both cases because he's 1:02:55 meditating and he's thinking it through to the end and he sees two divergent paths 1:03:01 and he's overwhelmed with god's goodness because of torah 1:03:06 wonderful meditation this wonderful uh blessing that we have this this is this is a
