0:12 foreign [Music] 0:24 [Music] 0:40 foreign 0:50 [Music] 1:11 and welcome to another Wednesday night bible study where we study the 1:17 scriptures line upon line God willing this evening will cover uh two Psalms 1:22 Psalms 127 and 128 also God willing 1:28pastor Murray will join me at the end of covering these two Psalms he'll add some commentary as well and then we're open 1:34 for live q a so maybe you could be thinking about questions you might want to ask us about the songs we covered 1:40tonight songs we've covered previously the prophet Joel other sermons that we've given were just open to answer 1:47 your questions should be a fairly short evening this evening uh only covering two short songs and then depending on 1:54 the number of questions we have we'll see how long that takes us but let's open with a word of prayer and get into 2:00the study for this evening our heavenly father we bow before you Lord God 2:06Almighty just to to praise you and to thank you to acknowledge you to 2:12 ask you father to be with us in our Endeavor to understand your word more 2:18 deeply so that we might preach it more precisely and that it might transform us 2:23 father to to become christ-like more and more 2:29christ-like in our walk we thank you so much father for that we have each other 2:34

we certainly thank you for Jesus Christ and for your love for us and your faithfulness to your Covenant father we 2:41pray that you'll bless our evening now bless our study and we just thank you so much in Jesus most holy name amen so 2:50 let's get into the study for this evening I'll go ahead and share my screen 2:56 Psalm 1 27 remember we're going through the uh the Psalms of ascent so we can 3:04 look at this historically that this is what the children of Israel the children of Judah these are the Psalms they would 3:11 sing as they approached the city of Jerusalem and the temple during the days 3:18 of awe the leading up to the fall festivals and so we certainly want to 3:24 respect that and understand that and there's a certain amount of meaning we'll derive from that but also we want 3:29 to look at it prophetically with the understanding that ultimately God is 3:35 going to gather all of the children of Judah and bring them back to Jerusalem and have them worship and Lead Worship 3:41 in in the temple so the Psalms of ascent 3:47 prophetically really represent that time when Christ returns and he gathers his 3:52 elect from the four corners of the earth so with both of those views in mind let's begin with Psalm 127 this is a 4:01 Psalm of ascent for Solomon so this is specifically for Solomon and 4:06 it says now and since this is a Psalm we're very very familiar with except the 4:12 Lord build the house they labor in vain that build it 4:18so we need to understand this and and we there's a certain amount of wisdom this 4:24

is a psalm for Solomons a certain amount of wisdom here uh in this Psalm and many 4:29

of the Psalms are wisdom Psalms uh that as we Endeavor to build our homes 4:35

God Jesus Christ needs to be a part of our building effort he needs to be the 4:42 foundation of our building effort otherwise we're wasting our time and the whole thing the whole Endeavor is going 4:48 to collapse and we'll see ultimately that it was all in vain so we want to invite the Lord to be a 4:55 part of building our homes so accept the Lord build the house they labor in vain 5:01 that build it except the Lord keep the city 5:06 The Watchmen wake but in vain so you could try to guard your city is is the 5:13 the wisdom here but if God isn't with you it's going to be in vain it's going to be a fruitless exercise you're going to 5:20 be overwhelmed uh by your enemies which of course Judah did experience and this 5:25 is this is the voice of experience understand this is really Torah that there are blessings for obedience and 5:33 curses for Disobedience now usually when we read this except the Lord build the house they labor in vain that build it 5:39 we will think of our personal homes and that I think is entirely appropriate but 5:45 also as we think of this at a higher level the house very much would be God's house 5:52 and that these people who have the Torah who have the law of God who have the prophets who have all the teachings from 5:58 God if they turn their back on God and try to continue with this religiosity the whole exercise is in 6:06 vain and so this notion that they they bait that the house is God's house 6:11 especially as we think of this as a psalm for Solomon if we go to Second Chronicles 7 and verse 3 6:17 when all the children of Israel saw how the fire came down and the glory of the 6:22 Lord upon the house so this is the temple that Solomon had built for the Lord and the glory of the 6:29

Lord came down upon the house now now he was building this house for 6:34 God and then God supported the building of this house but if they turned their back on God 6:40 he's not going to support it they bowed themselves with their faces to the ground upon the pavement and 6:46 worshiped and praised the Lord saying for he is good for his Mercy endures forever and that really also has Echoes 6:54 of Prophecy as well it says Echoes of Torah as well that when God gathers his 6:59 people and brings them back into Jerusalem brings them back into the temple they will most definitely say 7:04 that he is good they will most definitely say that his Mercy endures forever as they bow themselves Down and 7:12 Worship Him and acknowledge Him as their God so so this first verse let's think 7:17 of it at a higher level that this is now speaking of the Lord's House and speaking of Jerusalem as the city and 7:24 they need to understand that God's need God needs to be with them otherwise they're facing Zechariah 14 verse 1. 7:32 and that's that's the curse of turning their back on God verse 2 it is vain for you to rise up 7:41 early to sit up late to eat the bread of Sorrows or anxiousness 7:47 for so he gives his beloved sleep so many people they work so hard they 7:54 have all of this wealth you think of what the news right now the news cycle is um the the Pelosi household you think 8:01 of all the wealth they have and yet there's a break-in and uh you know serious harm personal harm could have 8:08 been fatal uh this is this is the worry that that wealthy people have when they 8:14 have all of this wealth around them and especially when the economy crashes uh then these poor people are going to go 8:20

after you and I'm not sure what the motivation is in the case of the Pelosi household but certainly as inflation 8:26 continues to rise and impoverishes people uh the the people the elite who 8:32 are instituting these policies of inflation of just just more we need 8:38 more money let's just keep printing money and driving the cost up that's going to crash the economy and when the 8:43 economy crashes the elites are in trouble you know you're you're going to sleep 8:49 with anxiety as people seek food and shelter and they don't have any regard this is the history of man of man this 8:57 is what happens when you impoverish your people so these people will have a lot of anxiety trying to hold on to their 9:03 their belongings but God gives his beloved sleep and again 9:08 um ultimately not only is he going to protect us now and then bless us now and we're just in his hands so we don't need 9:15 to be anxious we're in his hands uh Micah 4 4 tells us of this time when 9:21 he'll give his beloved sleep again we want to look at this as ultimate fulfillment of Prophecy but they shall 9:26 set every man that is every Jewish man under his Vine and under his victory 9:32 and None Shall make them afraid that is only possible with God's intervention 9:37 only God can give this type of sleep this type of Peace None Shall make them 9:42 afraid for the mouth of the Lord of hosts has spoken it this is what he 9:48plans to do and nobody can stop it he will give his beloved sleep so those those Jews who respond to the gospel 9:56 and who turn to Christ at this time when he gathers his elect from the four corners of the earth after 10:01 all of this anxiety and persecution and humiliation 10:07

and suffering the worst the world has ever seen God is going to give his elect sleep those that repent 10:15 back to Psalm 127 verse 3 Lo children are a Heritage of the Lord and pastor 10:22 Murray wasn't with us last week but when he was with us two weeks ago we talked about children uh being the 10:29 arrows of of the mighty and he gave this wonderful sermon uh at 10:34 the feast on on calling all Fletchers about the the metaphor of children being 10:42 arrows and parents being Fletchers so it's interesting that we he wasn't with us last week God be praised he's he's 10:49 going to be with us this week and or he is with us and will join us later in in a few moments uh hopefully Pastor I'll 10:56 ask you to comment on this as well uh as you've just more if you have any more insight to add to this uh verse 3 of 11:03 Psalm 127 low children are a Heritage of the Lord this is this is God's blessing 11:10 this is something that God provides and the fruit of the womb is his reward 11:17 so be fruitful and multiply this is a blessing and when God gathers his elect 11:22 from the four corners of the Earth this is a blessing that they'll have to be able to reproduce fruitfully and peacefully and 11:30 and and having the protection of God because this is his reward this is this is the great one of the greatest 11:36 blessings God can give us a a beautiful home life a beautiful husband and wife a deep 11:43 Union in Christ and then the fruit of the womb the children that that come out of that that's his reward 11:51 as arrows are in the hand of a Mighty Man so are the children of the youth 11:58 this is this is a very powerful metaphor that pastor Murray brought out in the 12:04 during the Feast of Tabernacles in his sermon but this is really something if you think of a mighty man in battle

12:11 who is a tremendous uh has tremendous skill with archery and is able to take 12:17 down his enemies because of his use of his arrows God is saying this is what the children 12:23 of the Mighty the children of his blessed people are like they are like Warriors 12:28 and they will they will protect the blessings of the Lamb that God gives to his people they'll be protected through 12:35 their next generation you know we now in the west were destroying ourselves we're all just hung 12:42 up on abortion destroying the fruit of the womb God says it's a reward we say the opposite we say it's a punishment 12:47 it's terrible how could we cause women to have children so what if they're a 12:53 promiscuous that's their right but who who are we to say they should have the child that comes as a result of the 12:59 decisions the poor decisions that they make let's destroy those children let's kill those children that's our mindset 13:05 that's of the devil God is giving children as a reward as a blessing we see it as a curse and we 13:11 want to destroy these children and now the society is unable to to sustain itself 13:17 I think what they say is uh every couple should have 2.1 children it faces at least if a society is to sustain itself 13:24 by speaking to somebody today they have six children and so I said to him that's so rare these days 13:29 and clearly he's a Christian man but that's that's uh just a rarity that used to be the order of the day and that's 13:36 how societies would grow now people to earn other people are putting off children they're putting their career 13:41 first some are not having children at all just abortion after abortion after abortion and as a result the society is 13:47 collapsing upon itself and we're having to bring in people of other cultures with no vetting

and and there's just this massive Invasion and America has open borders and this massive Invasion this is the 14:01writing is on the wall we've lost our society we should have been blessed with 14:07 the fruit of the womb but but these children are are Mighty if you look at um judges three and we judges in the 14:14 archive but I just want to just call out this particular two verses one and two of Judges three now these are the 14:20 Nations which the Lord left to test Israel by these nations even as many of 14:27 Israel as had not known all the wars of Canaan so so these children the Next 14:34Generation had to learn Warfare and those Israelites that had lots of 14:39 children they could go into Warfare with a lot more confidence having the fruit of the womb in in verse two he says only 14:46 that the generations of the children of Israel might know to teach them War at the least such as before knew nothing 14:54 thereof so there was this expectation that they had to work to capture the 14:59 land and it wasn't just going to be handed to them they had to go in and obey God and remove the the Pagan nations from that 15:07 land and establish it gain a foothold in the land and establish it as as Holy 15:13 Land and not to mix with the pagan people there and the children of Israel in each 15:19 generation had to learn this and they had to work to to capture the land in 15:24 Zechariah I think again we want to look at this historically I want to look at this in the future as well just before 15:30 Christ returns or when Christ returns Zechariah 14 and verse 14 and Judah also 15:37 shall fight at Jerusalem God there's an expectation 15:43 that in order to to gain the land you're going to have to fight for you're going to have to work for it and so when

Christ returns he's going to empower thank God Zechariah 12. he's going to empower Judah to to push back their 15:55 enemies and to defeat their enemies and and the children of Judah will be 16:01 like arrows in this in this home and Judah also shall fight at Jerusalem and the wealth 16:07 of all the Heathen round about shall be gathered together in other words the Heathen will lose at the hands of the 16:14 empowered Judah the spirit empowered Judah for war and the wealth of all the Heathen 16:20 roundabout shall be gathered together gold and silver and apparel in great abundance 16:25 this is uh if you look at Zechariah 12 you'll just see how God is going to supernaturally empower Judah to put down 16:32 her enemies and then all of this wealth will be converted and offered through 16:37 Judah back to Psalm 127 verse 5 blessed 16:43 blessed is the man that has his quiver full of them this is this is hard for us to comprehend 16:49 because Satan has captured our society and we actually think the opposite that it's a curse to have children oh you 16:56 have so many children how do you manage how do you cope it's better to have one child two at the most 17:02 when when God wants families to have lots of children it's a blessing they're made in God's image and likeness 17:09 and if we have parents that know how to raise Godly children that's what God is looking for and and this is this is the 17:15 future this will be acknowledged the children families will have lots of children and then that will be a great 17:20 blessing so blessed is the man that has his quiver full of Godly use they shall not be ashamed but they shall 17:29 speak with their enemies in the gate so you raise a Godly family and you will 17:35

have confidence in this Society your your enemies are coming to the gate they want to invade they have to face your 17:40 children they have to face that that you that generation I was talking on the Sabbath about a wedding that we uh 17:46 pastor Murray officiated a couple of weeks ago and to see the young people it's full of 17:51 so much joy and dancing all night long basically like for hours Non-Stop and 17:58 you just think of the the cardio the cardiovascular health of these young 18:04 people as we get older we don't have that and to fight in battle you need card you need you need health you need 18:11 Fitness you need cardiovascular fitness and so when you have a tribe of of 18:18 children of powerful young men who are loyal to your tribe to your family and 18:24 can resist the enemies of the gate uh that that is quite quite a blessing and 18:29 and the gate was an important period of a place of judgment and again if you 18:34 have Godly children you will not be ashamed at this gate of judgment but if you have ungodly children well that's a 18:41 different matter if you look at the Torah Deuteronomy 21 and verse 18 if a man have a stubborn and rebellious son 18:48 which will not obey the voice of his father or the voice of his mother and that when they have chastened him he 18:54 will not hearken unto them then shall his father and his mother lay hold on him and bring him out unto the Elders of 19:01 his City and unto the Gate of his place and that that's a horrible shame that 19:07 you know that the whole the whole um Society the whole town is is talking 19:14 about this the shame of this child and the shame that this child is brought upon its parents but that's not the way 19:20 it should be the parents should be able to go to the gate without any fear without any

anxiety being looked up to being respected versus those parents that have to bring an ungodly and unruly child to 19:32 the gate and they're just full of Shame and the child will ultimately be be stoned to death uh here in Proverbs 31 19:38 and verse 23 again with a Godly wife that is helping to manage this household 19:44 he says in verse 23 her husband is known in the gates so when the elders are sitting in the 19:50 gates this man is respected he's managed his household well his his wife respects him his children 19:57 respect him the the town respects him and he's able to come to the gate and and he's respected her husband is known 20:04 in the gates when he sits among the Elders of the land so that was Psalm 127 20:10 let's go to Psalm 128 another Psalm of ascent verse 1 blessed is everyone 20:17 that fears the Lord that walks in his ways this is this is a 20:22 cause and effect this is science this is a spiritual science that when we walk in the ways of Torah 20:29 we are blessed and everyone that that respects Jehovah 20:35 that holds him in awe and reverence and walks in his ways is blessed so this is 20:41 a wisdom psalmist takes us all the way back to Psalm 1 many maybe years ago when we started Psalms 20:48 blessed is the man Psalm 1 verse 1 blessed is the man blessed are all men 20:55 that walk not in the counsel of the ungodly nor stand in the way of Sinners 21:01 nor sit in the seat of the scornful but his Delight is in the law of the Lord 21:08 this is the blessing this is this is the way of wisdom in Psalm 20 128 is reinforcing that 21:14 verse 2 Psalm 128 for you shall eat the labor of your 21:19 hands so we saw in Psalm 127 21:25 fruitless it's vanity we're laboring in vain

21:30 unless the Lord shall build the house so God is not a part of that you're 21:36 building the house on your own it's all in vain it's all going to come to nothing but here 21:41 those that obey God that hold him in reverence that walk in his ways it's 21:48 totally different you shall eat the labor of your hands bless shall you be 21:54 and it shall be well with you so this is not in vain this is in contrast to what we just saw in Psalm 127 he says your 22:01 wife shall be as a fruitful Vine by the sides of your house and that 22:08 fruitful Vine gives a sense again of the blessing of the Lord with children but 22:13 but fruitful as well just in terms of productivity a happy home with a happy wife as Christians this is what we 22:20 should have we should not see bitter unhappy marriages 22:26 sadness deep sadness disappointment in our marriages 22:32 this is this should not be in the Christian household if both parties 22:37 have given themselves to Christ and they are building on the foundation of Torah our homes should be blessed there should 22:46 be a peace in our homes that people just don't really understand how is there 22:51 this peace and this Joy oh marriage so many decades and and you act like newlyweds it's 22:58 clear that you have a great love and admiration and respect for each other that is the way of the Lord 23:03 and if we don't have that we really should repent we really should seek wisdom from God 23:10seek the wisdom from above and and pursue proactively having that peace having that Joy having 23:17 that Harmony in our homes so that our children can benefit from that our children are going to be far more all 23:23 the all the criminality that we see in in our societies today

23:28 99 of it when you examine these hardened criminals 23:34 you examine their their home life while there is none there's no father in the home there's no structure in the home 23:40there's chaos in the home and then this just warps the human mind but if we can provide this stability in 23:48 our homes it blesses the Next Generation and so here he says your wife shall be 23:53 as a fruitful Vine this is this is the blessing of following God and holding him in awe your wife shall be as a 24:00 fruitful Vine by the sides of your house your children like Olive plants round 24:07 about your table and it's just a beautiful thing especially when you have adult children 24:12 and some of you have grandchildren and you're able to sit around the table and and Converse with them and they have 24:19 their own minds and their own ideas and their own thoughts but they're so respectful they have a Godly Behavior 24:25 you have peace in your home this is the Christian way and all these people are pursuing these these bizarre Lifestyles 24:33 they should look at us with Envy and they know deep down inside they're 24:39 unhappy whatever they're doing it's not working and they're trying to go faster and faster in their deep deeper and deeper into depression and unhappiness 24:45 and they look at our homes and they know we fundamentally know what's right and 24:50 they look at our homes and they know boy I really wish I had that so these these children that are like 24:56 Olive plants they're just thriving that's another thing as well is our children should be thriving we shouldn't 25:02 see children that are just oppressed and not fruitful they should be productive and thriving and and and 25:08 enjoying and part of this patriarchy we should not be we should not be that we

never see our children we never see our grandchildren they're cut off from us this is this is ungodly this is satanic 25:20 this is demonic The Godly way is the the family just 25:25 keeps building and as the family keeps building I was talking to somebody this week actually and he his great 25:32 grandfather started this business and the family still runs the business it's like four generations later and they're 25:38 still running as a family business and that's really a Godly way that that's that's I think that's what 25:45 we'll see in the future when Christ returns this notion of patriarchy and that as the family as people marry and 25:52 have children the patriarch and I don't want to say Empire but the the just the patriarchy is growing that 26:01 that Family Kingdom is growing it's not that you have your your people are 26:06 married and they're having children and they're they're don't talk to their parents anymore that's demonic 26:13 God's way is is the role of the father keeps increasing the more people marry 26:19 and have children the world the exaltation of the father keeps increasing that's a spiritual thing 26:25 that as Christ marries and has children the exaltation of the father increases 26:32 and of the increase of his government there shall be no end this is The Godly way and so each family unit is a 26:39 building block of a tribe A Clan a family Clan 26:44 and ultimately the whole society the nation is built with these building blocks 26:50 round about your table here in Proverbs 14 and and this is 26:56 speaking of women but it's equally applies to men Proverbs 14 and verse 1 every wise woman 27:03 builds her house but the foolish plucks it down with her

27:09 hands and and I will add many times her hands are it's her tongue 27:15 what what the carelessness the callousness the the harshness 27:22 both male and female things the things that couples say to each other like hello do we have any wisdom 27:30 do you do you think you can hurt your spouse maybe embarrass them publicly 27:35 and this is how you build your house no the wise woman and the wise man 27:42 build their homes they speak words of strength and comfort and build it up 27:48 every every wise woman builds her house but the foolish plucks it down with her 27:53 hand so the vision here is that the wife should be a fruitful Vine by the sides of your house and your children like 27:59 Olive plants round about your table but everybody has to buy into the Torah for 28:05 that to happen Psalm 128 verse 4 behold 28:11 that thus shall the man be blessed that fears the Lord that fears Jehovah 28:18 so we we can have this we can claim this blessing now this is our blessing this 28:23 beautiful family life beautiful marriage life the the Deep trust that a husband and 28:30 wife and in fulfillment that a husband and wife can have in each other in the Lord this is our blessing now we claim 28:37 this now as first fruits and the blessing of having Godly children this is our blessing now 28:43 but prophetically this is the blessing of the future when God gathers his elect after going 28:50 through this time of tribulation and driven to their knees and driven to repentance and and driven to True 28:57 wholehearted Love of the Lord and then brought back to the land 29:03 and their children will be brought back to them and they'll have their families and they'll believe in God and they'll 29:10

worship God together this is a point this is pointing to the Future that all those people who repent and 29:17 they're brought back in the land this is how they'll be blessed they'll be blessed in their family lives in 29:22 Jerusalem Psalm 128 and verse 5 and this says the 29:28 Lord shall bless you out of Zion God is going to be in Zion he's going to bless 29:33 his people out of Zion and the whole world is going to come to Zion to learn about the ways of the Lord 29:41 the Lord shall bless you out of Zion and you shall see the good of Jerusalem all 29:47 the days of your life this this is this is not spoken in vain this is a Psalm of 29:52 ascent it's pointing to eternal life it's it's pointing to the Eternal blessing of 29:58 Judah in Jerusalem that's what this is pointing to and and let's just finish 30:03 with Zechariah 8 and verse 5 just to underline this Psalm 128 ends with verse 30:09 5 the Lord shall bless you out of Zion you the Jew 30:15 that obeys God and and and and truly worships him and then it has the blessing of Godly 30:22 marriage and the blessing of Godly children and the symbolic meaning of all 30:27 of that if you obey the Torah and you you submit to Torah the Lord will bless you out of 30:34 Zion and you shall see the good of Jerusalem all the days of your life and 30:39 in Zechariah 8 and verse 5 the prophet says and the streets of the city 30:45 shall be full of boys and girls this is after all the devastation this is after the city has been burned 30:51 to the ground after the Abomination that makes desolate has truly made desolate 30:56 after all of this when Christ acts and restores his people after all of the bombing and devastation 31:04 the streets of the City Jerusalem shall be full of boys and girls these children that 31:10 come from these Godly families shall be full of boys and girls playing in the

streets not being having their genitals mutilated

verse right now Psalm 128. thanks so much uh pastor Murray 33:12 verse six yeah yeah there we go it's beautiful yes you shall see your children's children 33:19 and peace upon Israel and again this is just beautiful because it's pointing ultimately 33:25 to the time of Christ and him establishing his kingdom and again it just shows the importance that as your 33:32 children marry and have children those Godly families are still part of your 33:38 family and you'll enjoy your grandchildren and your great grandchildren and as they have children 33:44 the role of the patriarch and The Matriarch grows in influence and 33:49 significance and that's why they're respected in the gates so I think this is uh thanks so much for for calling 33:54 this out pastor Murray and ultimately peace upon Israel that that little 34:01 phrase there is loaded and when if we understand the gospel as all the 34:07 prophets are teaching us the good news and what God plans to do the Council of the Lord this is what we're looking for 34:13 peace upon Jerusalem and peace upon Israel thanks pastor Murray yeah so so 34:19 much of their to unpack um a few things that jump out maybe we'll start with you had mentioned the fact that there are 34:26 two ways of looking at you this year but backwards at the Psalms are setting them look forward I think understanding and 34:32 remembering the timing of the Psalms that have to bring both of those together so we can we can take the fact 34:37 that uh what we got here is the seventh and sorry the eighth and the ninth days of the month 34:43 which are the two days right before the day of atonement which is which is significant here and those two obviously 34:49 the concept of those two Psalms they really work hand in hand they wouldn't surprise surprise me at all Solomon was

maybe I'll take a first crack at this pastor Murray and then you know your thoughts as well uh great question 41:26 um here uh brother Alan thank you for this and we we're grateful for all the 41:31 the ministers out there who are Faithfully teaching the word of God regardless of which organization they 41:39 may belong to if they're Faithfully teaching God's people and strengthening God's people we're grateful for them we 41:46 certainly don't want to create unnecessary contradiction but what I would say here in terms of making 41:52 doctrine of the Psalms is first let's Define doctrine I think we have a way of 41:57 using the word Doctrine as meaning you know these are this our statement of beliefs this is our Doctrine whereas in 42:05 in scripture the word Doctrine really means teachings so so as we teach torahs we teach good 42:12 behavior this is all good Doctrine good teaching and when Christ was on Earth 42:18 it's quite amazing how frequently he quoted the Psalms 42:23 so I think by his example he he leaned on the Psalms heavily in his 42:29 instructions and in his teachings so I think you know the question should we 42:35 make doctrine of the Psalms of Christ taught from the Psalms and and this 42:42 notion that the Psalms are just the sort of pleasant little songs that we sing to praise God you know for our services hey 42:49 let's sing a song or you know hey it's trying to Psalm a day and keep the devil 42:54 away uh these sort of superficial treatment of the Psalms I think Christ's Reliance on the Psalms when he was on 43:01 Earth teaching tells us there's much more to the Psalms than this sort of let's just feel good praising God so 43:08 that would be my take Pastor Maria on your thoughts 43:18

it really helps teach us how to react to various 43:24 um various issues that present themselves in our lives and we consider is there a wisdom songs there are Psalms 43:30 of there are songs of them and they're the imprecatory songs so those are those are very interesting when we 43:37 call down judgment but leave it in God's hands um um Messianic songs we learned so much 43:44 about the Messiah from them so so really when you do understand that Doctrine is 43:50 really the teachings of the scriptures and that there's a thread that goes from Genesis all the way to through to the 43:55 Revelation um the Psalms of Christy stock true um and teach us 44:02 um in addition to that you made the comment which we uh our local brother here would 44:08 be familiar with is that foreign inner understanding is 44:15 um just a reaction to to uh life's ofest that the Psalms also help us with really 44:23 our teaching moments that we can we can we can be hit from all sides with times 44:29 of Happiness sadness fear uh uh persecution disease and the Psalms 44:35 almost teach us how to to come through that beautiful beautiful uh lovely thanks so 44:41 much for that uh question brother and uh thanks pastor Murray for that another question here 44:48 uh brother Jeffrey you caught my interest with a gate is a place of 44:54 judgment any scripture references or further information to dig deeper on 44:59 that statement thanks as always so we did see uh Deuteronomy where we saw uh the Judgment that that gate would bring 45:06 the child to the gate and all the elders are gathered there and that's where the judgment will be rendered in this case 45:13 it's a fatal judgment but that's where the the elders will decide that the fate of the child another one that comes to 45:18

we don't have to do that our congregations just bestow upon us respect as we bestow upon them respect 56:47 and so there's this healthy Mutual regard that we have for one another and as pastor Murray just said yeah 56:53 everybody has to say it's a family you know when you have a family even the youngest child you you take their care 56:59 their concerns into consideration so hopefully we have healthy congregations 57:05 out there hopefully our women are being respected and valued and they're being 57:11 treated as intelligent humans not some sort of sub-rate b-class person that 57:18 doesn't come from from God's word very very good uh are you going to say something Pastor there's another 57:23 question here from Brother Alan again many 57:29 teachers teach that the Psalms are a poetic symbolic hyperbole poetic 57:35 symbolic hyperbole from a Christian apologist perspective how could I better respond to these 57:42 presented statements when they're presented to me now Pastor I'll take a quick crack at this as well and then uh 57:49 I would say and again when I um part two of the joy of the Lord I'm going to be talking about this not with the Psalms 57:56 per se I want to focus on the prophets but I would say the foundation of 58:02 understanding scripture is Torah so if we can outline what Moses taught 58:08 in the Torah what is the prophetic framework that Moses laid down in the 58:13 Torah and then Shaha all of the prophets build upon that framework and they align 58:20 and they comply with that framework there's not a single profit that violates or deviates from the framework 58:28 laid down by Moses even Jonah although he sort of comes at it from a different 58:34

angle showing the mercy of the Lord that's the framework that Moses laid down 58:39 so when we understand that framework from Torah how all the profits align to 58:45 it then we see in the Psalms that everything that's in the Psalms aligns 58:51 with this framework historically and prophetically that Moses laid down so that's what I would 58:57 say is is ground ourselves in Torah and then show how the Psalms are rooted in 59:03 Torah and therefore they're not uh poetic symbolic hyperbole they may be 59:09 poetic and there's places that are symbolic and there are certain parts of language that are hyperbolic but it's 59:16 not to be treated as something we can just dismiss when it is clearly grounded and rooted in Torah 59:22 thank you yeah completely agree um again echoing I think a few questions 59:28 ago we talked about the threat of uh of uh teaching that we find throughout 59:33 the Psalms and I think we're going to apply some of those comments here as well in addition to what you had just talked about 59:39 uh whereby uh the Psalms are just reflective of David's understanding of the Torah and all that had happened 59:47 prior to him becoming King and he had great inside I guess to what was coming down the road and an understanding of 59:54 Messiah and understanding of the kingdom of God and it's really just reflective of uh 1:00:00 his full understanding and not just David of course but the other the other psalmist writers but David's David is 1:00:07 prevalent there uh and uh all the other previous comments that we talked about about teaching uh and understanding uh 1:00:13 Doctrine uh especially our emotional reaction to to to 1:00:19 events around us really it it's there's so much teaching there reflective of God's way in the tour great great great 1:00:26
