the men and women and faithful servants who have preserved these texts 2:32

Through the Ages so that we have them Father when you know that evil men would love to extinguish your word

we thank you Father that your word is in our hearts and just pray father that will deeply deeply understand

you are our Fortress you are our Rock you are shield you are our deliverer

2:53

you're our stronghold we thank you Lord and we ask your blessing upon your Saints 3:00

we ask your blessing upon our study this evening and we pray in Jesus name amen 3:06

so let me just um confirm sound is good thank you very much it was an auto very very good and let us begin with Psalm

3:16

140 and then we'll follow on with Psalm 141 these seem to be

3:22

um two sides of one coin uh one is more external focused and one is more

3:27

internal focused and I think you'll see that as we go along so let's uh begin with Psalm 140 and this is both of these

3:36

are considered Psalms of David and this one begins uh to the chief

3:42

musician a Psalm of David and he begins right away

3:49

Deliver Me O Lord from the evil man preserve me

3:55

from the violent man so clearly this is a time of crisis

4:00

and I think through this Psalm we will learn how we ought to pray through these

4:07

times of crises this is a Time Of Violence Christ tells us

4:12

that right before his return it will be as in the days of Noah and the Earth

4:18

will be full of violence and we are certainly seeing that as our Western

4:24

Civilization turns away from the Christian ethic uh the the Eastern world

4:30

is already fully immersed in in a violent philosophies uh the Western World for

4:39 centuries has been less violent more civilized because of the influence of Jesus Christ

and as that influence is being removed from society we're seeing incredible violence in our world now and and no

doubt it's going to touch the Saints he cries out Deliver Me O Lord from the

5:00

evil man preserve me from the violent man which imagine mischiefs

5:07

in their heart continually are they gathered together for war and this is

5:15

really amazing this is written thousands of years ago it's as if he's commenting on our time today he says that they are

5:24

continually gathered together for war today they have these conferences and 5:30

and we see Ukraine as an example look at what they are spending

5:36

on this war in Ukraine which they they have vowed to fight Russia to the last

5:42

Ukrainian uh U.S 18.5 billion dollars

5:47

as of November they've poured into Ukraine look at us here in Canada

5:53

almost a billion dollars I guess we're over that by now and this is this is taxpayer money that 5:58

they're taking and if we believe this is actually going to ukrainians and all they're receiving all of this money well

6:05

we're very naive this is money laundering and this whole FTX Scandal is exposing just how corrupt

6:12

these people are but he says that they're just and this is so fascinating that they're the ones that are going to

6:19

lecture us on the environment and climate change and the carbon footprint and how

important it is for us to scale back and maybe turn down our air conditioner or turn down our heat because of climate

6:33

change and the most devastating impact on the environment nothing is worse than 6:38

War and they will not negotiate they're not interested in peace they're just interested in war 6:43

that's what David says he says that these people

6:49

he says are continually gathered together for war and Mischief is in

6:56

their hearts he says they have sharpened their tongues like a serpent

adders poison is under their lips so if they've

7:08

sharpened their tongues this is to speak of their skill their their rhetorical skill

7:13

these are retrovertitions these are orators these are philosophers these are people

7:19

who are skilled in communication and unfortunately

7:24

many of us are naive and we believe in these people

7:30

we believe in their promises we believe in their philosophy and their

7:36

social justice and and we throw our support behind them not realizing

7:41

all of that rhetoric is to destroy us all of that rhetoric is to lead us lead

7:47

our children to Suicide lead us to turn on each other it's all just rhetoric of

7:53

of of the devil but it sounds nice he says they're sharpened their tongue

7:58

like a serpent Adder is poison is under their lips

8:04

you know it's it's probably um honey it's on their lips but under their lips is poison

8:12

and we have to be Sharp we have to be loyal to the word of God

8:18

loyal to the Torah as long as we're anchored in the Torah their rhetoric has no power over us 8:24

if we're ignorant of the Torah then we're going to fall for their rhetoric he said Jeremiah in Jeremiah God

8:31

describes these Wicked people he says they bend their tongues like their bowl

8:39

for lies they bend their tongues like their bull

8:44

for lies so this is that they're just skilled they've developed a skill with this

8:49

tongue it's like a muscle that they've honed but they are not Valiant for the truth upon the Earth no indeed they're not

8:57

for they proceed from Evil to evil this

9:02

is the perfect description of our leaders just when we think that they've excelled

in their evil they go on to even greater evil with our podcast

9:13

keeping watch what we're just overwhelmed that the pace of the new

9:18

cycle and what what shall we talk about each week there's just so much to choose from as our society just collapses

9:26

they proceed from Evil to evil and they know not me says the Lord

9:33

verse 5 of Jeremiah 9 he says and they will deceive everyone his neighbor they

9:38

don't care about there's no there's no love thy neighbor there's no brotherly love they will deceive everyone his

9:44

neighbor and will not speak the truth they have taught their tongue to speak

9:51

lies and they worry themselves to commit iniquity does that not describe our

9:59

world today they weary themselves to commit iniquity

back to Psalm 140 verse 4 he says keep me O Lord

from the hands of the wicked they're out there

10:16

they have Global plans they don't want anybody to escape what they have in mind 10:22

David prays and we should pray Keep Me O Lord from the hands of the wicked preserve me from the violent man

10:31

who has purposed to overthrow my goings we know these Violent Men Brethren

10:38

they're in the earth they're speaking I think everybody's familiar with this man this uh homosexual atheist

10:46

who is whispering in the ears of Kings is the right-hand man of globalists of

leaders they're buying into his philosophy that humans are hackable animals that there is no God that Jesus

10:58

Christ is a myth these are violent people and they want to convince us that they

11:04

have our best interests at heart we know they don't he says

preserve me from the violent man who has purposed to overthrow my

goalings proud have hit a snare for me and chords they have spread a net by the wayside

they have set traps for me seal them that that's our situation

11:24

today Brethren let's not be naive the proud of said traps for us

so he says here the voice of my supplications oh Lord

oh God the Lord the strength of my salvation you have covered my head in the day of

battle Grant Not O Lord the desires of the

wicked further not his Wicked device lest they exalt themselves Selah so we

14:22

know in this end Time the wicked are going to have a degree of success But ultimately they will fail they don't

14:28

know that we know that because we know the scriptures and we should be praying accordingly to Grant not the desire they

14:35

have great desires that they want to be God on earth that is their desire we're praying that God puts this to an end

14:42

he says not to further their wicked device lest they exalt themselves Selah

14.49

to meditate on this as for the head of those that surround me about or the

14:55

ruler the chief of those that surround me let the Mischief of their own lips cover

15:01

them and that that is a prayer according to Torah that the Mischief of their own lips

should fall back upon them Deuteronomy and Moses says in verse 7 of Deuteronomy 30 and the Lord your God

15:15

will put all these curses upon your enemies and on them that hate you which

persecuted you so all of their designs that they have against the Covenant people when God acts he's going to take

15:29

all of that and he's going to put it on their own head so David's prayer is certainly according to Torah he says let

15:35

burning coals fall upon them so this is what's called a an imprecatory psalm it's a Psalm of curses

15:43

upon the enemy and that's what David is doing here let burning coals fall upon

them and this is according to Torah if we don't know Torah then we think oh this is an uncomfortable prayer we

15:54

shouldn't pray like this is according to Torah let burning coals fall upon them let 16:01

them be cast Into the Fire into deep pits that they rise not up again

16:06

and certainly we see that fulfilled in the end in Revelation 20 and verse 15

16:12

whosoever was not found written in the Book of Life is cast into

16:18

the Lake of Fire so when when David is praying that they be cast Into the Fire that's according to God's will

16:24

that is according to God's will verse 11 he says

16:30

let not an evil speaker be established in the earth and that is that is such an

16:36

interesting request because the speaker has a philosophy

16:44

and that philosophy when it enters men's Minds it changes how they think it

16:49

changes how they see things it changes how they see people we actually saw that

16:55

through the whole pandemic where maybe your loved ones turned on you

17:00

if you were not vaccinated and shunned you and when neighbors maybe you were very close to them one day and the next

17:07

day because of these Wicked speakers in the Earth and this wicked philosophy suddenly they 17:13

saw you as unclean as as a spreader of virus and they turned on us

that that's the power of philosophy just overnight people can change because of of wicked 17:26

philosophy being put into the Earth he says let not an evil speaker be

17:32

established in the earth evil shall hunt the violent man to overthrow him so again it's going to fall back on the

17:39

Wicked Man I know that the Lord will maintain the cause of The Afflicted

17:46

and the right of the poor and that its hard this this verse verse 12. is a

difficult verse when we're in the midst of trouble but this is something that we just have 17:57

to know that there will be an Affliction of the Saints there will be great

persecution and Great Tribulation in the Earth but we just have to know 18:09

that God will maintain the cause of The Afflicted and the right of the poor that

that is just embedded how God operates surely

18:20

the righteous shall give thanks unto thy name there it is again

18:25

surely the righteous shall give thanks unto thy name

18:31

God's name matters God's name has great meaning and there's a realization in the end 18:38

time what the name of God means and and this this realization

18:45

and and God acting according to his name just this overwhelming gratitude among 18:50

the saints and we shall give thanks unto his name the upright shall dwell in thy

presence and sort of the subtext to that is the wicked shall not dwell in the 19:02

presence of the Lord and Christ himself says in Matthew 25 34

19:08

then shall the king say unto them on his right hand Come Ye blessed of my father 19:13

inherit the Kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world so that 19:19

is Psalm 140 and and like some 140 and 141 go together Psalm 140 is looking 19:26

externally at the trouble that is in the earth that David is facing and

knowing that God is his deliverer and and we see through Psalm 140 how we

19:38

ought to pray as we Face some of these very very difficult times in

19:43

the days just ahead of us how the whole world is just setting up for a very very difficult period let's now look at Psalm

19:50

141 where David now looks internally so yes there's problems out there

19:57

amongst the wicked but then David is not unaware of his own

20:02

State and he prays about that simultaneously Psalm 141 a Psalm of David

20:10

Lord I cry unto you make haste unto me

20:16

give ear unto my voice when I cry unto you so again the same sense of trouble

20:22

of urgent trouble he says let my prayer be set forth

20:28

before you as incense just a beautiful thing so he's praying and he's saying

20:33

God allow my prayer to come before you like incense or accept my prayer and the

20:39

lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice and throughout the scripture we see the holy people of God lift up

20:48

their hands in prayer and and we should not be embarrassed about that we should not feel awkward about that it's kind of

20:53

fallen out of Uh custom but certainly throughout the scriptures there's a lot of support for lifting up our hands in

21:01

prayer he says in the lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice so clearly when 21:07

David prayer prayed he lifted up his hands said a watch O Lord before my

21:14

mouth keep the door of my lips this is a very deep Insight that David has as to his

21:21

own Human Nature and praying to God to help him to govern himself

21:28

beginning with the tongue and James gives us this understanding of just how

21:33

important it is to discipline the tongue and how being able to do that really

speaks to our whole character Christ himself said out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks in James 3 and

21:46

verse 5 James says even so the tongue is a little member and boasts great things 21:53

behold how great a matter a little fire Kindles and the tongue is a fire a world of 22:00

iniquity so is the tongue among our members that it defiles the whole body 22:07

and sets on fire the course of nature and it is set on fire of hell

22:13

in First Peter 3 10 Peter says for he that will love life and see good days

22:19

let him refrain his tongue from evil and his lips that they speak no guile so 22:27

David certainly had a deep understanding about the power of the tongue about his own character and how he was going to

22:34

gain control of his character and realizing he needs God's help to do this 22:40

continuing Psalm 141 and verse 4 he says incline not my heart to any evil thing 22:47

to practice Wicked works with men that work iniquity

22:53

let me not eat of their dainties so this is something Brethren that today we need 23:00

to be very very careful about that how did he word it let's just see how he words this he says 23:06

incline my heart unto thy test sorry in crime not my heart to any evil thing to 23:13

any evil thing to practice Wicked works with men that work iniquity

23:21

there are men in the Earth today that work iniquity

23:26

and they are trying to seduce others to join them they're certainly going after our children 23:32

and and that the television the the movie Street the streaming the music

23:39

everything is being set up to seduce and seduce and to seduce

23:44

and we just have to have this conviction that we're not going along with them what does David say he says incline not

my heart to any evil thing so he's got he realizes he has to control his tongue don't let any guile come out of his

23:58

tongue in order to build the character of God it really starts with the tongue

24:03

to get control of the heart and now he's asking God to to protect

24:08

his heart we need to pray like this all the wicked that surrounds us the wickedness that 24:14

surrounds us that surrounds our children maybe our grandchildren this is an evil evil World evil society and we need

24:21

God's help the way the mind the human mind works it just starts to um

24:26

participate in a little bit of evil that doesn't seem too bad and then it wants more and then it wants more and before

24:33

we know it who knows what we're involved in and we're not naive you know whether there are Christians

24:38

Among Us that that are struggling that are weak that are involved in all kinds it's so easy to be involved in all kinds

24:44

today we need to be careful we need to be fasting and praying and and just disciplining ourselves not to

24:51

participate he goes on to say and let me not eat of their deities

24:57

they're comfortable they have the best of everything and that's what they offer us

25:02

join us and and before you know it you're wearing you know Balenciaga you don't know what you're involved in

25:09

but it seems nice on the surface in Psalm 119 and verse 36

25:15

he doesn't you know here he doesn't want to be have his heart inclined to anything evil in Psalm 119 verse that

25:21

incline my heart unto thy testimonies and not to covetousness

25:26

so this whole Marxist philosophy depends on the covetousness in men

25:33

the appeal of Marxism is that we are Covetous people and if we can resist covetousness then 25:39

Marxism has no no influence over us Daniel in terms of let me not eat of

25:46

their dainties immediately we should think of of the Prophet Daniel he says in verse 8 of Daniel

25:53

but Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself

25:58

with the portion of the king's meat so he had an understanding that there are things that we can allow

26:04

into our body that will defile us before God

26:10

and he just set his mind okay I've I'm no longer in my environment where I can

control what what we eat and who we associate with now I'm in this foreign land 26:24

and there's all these dainty foods all around me it looks like my brethren are jumping right in and consuming that I'm

26:30

not doing that he purposed in his heart I'm not going to defile myself with that 26:36

stuff and if we're going to survive all of this we we have to purpose in our hearts

who knows what these people are doing with their nanotechnology and wanting to 26:46

inject that inside us and and just they they hate God

26:51

and they're laughing at us and they're doing everything they can to defile us 26:57

so that we find ourselves alienated from our God we have to purpose in our heart 27:03

that we will not defile ourselves with the king's meat just as David did nor with the wine which he drank

27:11

therefore he requested of the prince of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself it was just that important to

27:17

him and and I think we just have to be so so careful everything around us is designed 27:23

to defile the human male is not male female is not female children can't be children they want to 27:31

turn us against each other racially they just want to do everything to divide and defile us we have to resist this

verse 5 Psalm 141 verse 5. he says

27:44

let the righteous smite me it shall be a kindness

27:50

and let him reprove me it shall be an excellent oil

27:55

which shall not break my head so David is not so arrogant that he can't

28:02

be corrected he sees the wickedness in the earth he's going to resist that wickedness

28:08

but he's not self-righteous he realizes he he there's wickedness inside him as well and he's open

28:16

correction and if we're going to be successful brethren we too have to be open to

28:22

correction too many of us are just not open to correction

28:29

we we don't expect that we should be corrected David was very open to correction

28:35

he says it'll be a kindness to him in Proverbs

28:41

sorry he says for yet my prayer also shall be in their calamities so who's

28:48

speaking of the wicked he's he knows the wicked or are going to

28:53

fall to a calamitous end but even so he's open to correction in

29:00

Proverbs 27 and verse 6 the proverb says

29:05

faithful are the wounds of a friend but the kisses of an enemy are deceitful

29:12

sometimes we forget this we think that the governments

29.18

have our best interests that they're full of rhetoric but what do they do have we got it yet for our American

29:25

Brethren and I know most of you have got it but is there anybody out there among us that thinks that the Biden

29:31

Administration has good intentions toward Christians or towards Americans is there any decision over the last two

29:39

years that the Biden Administration has made that is to build up America that is 29:44

to protect Americans that is to prosper Americans

29:51

or despite all of their fancy talk and rhetoric have we seen every single thing that 29:57

they are doing is to destroy America build back better which means destroy America as a 30:05

superpower and boy are we seeing that uh hopefully everybody sees it by now hopefully none 30:12

of us think oh if you criticize the left you have to criticize the right it's all the same it's it's not all the same

30:18

there are degrees of wickedness and and what's coming upon us because of the collapse of America

30:24

is is epic and we need to be ready but Brethren now they'll accept the

30:31

rhetoric of the government and they'll fight for the rhetoric of these socialists

30:38

and they'll fight against their own Brethren they'll certainly resist the ministry the ministry should be limp

30:44

never correct anybody just do as we're told by the Brethren some brethren have this notion that we

30:52

will tell you the minister what you should preach and we don't want anything rough from you give us smooth things

30:57

but the scripture says faithful are the wounds of a friend

31:03

David understood that he says it'll be a it'll be a kindness to me I'll accept it as a kindness 31:08

some of us are not on that level Paul

31:15

in training Timothy says to him preach the word

31:21

be instant in season out of season listen reprove rebuke exhort

31.30

with all long-suffering and Doctrine reprove rebuke exhort you would think

31:37

that these this instruction is not in the scripture the way some brethren just say like you 31.43

should never correct anybody just everything's okay all the time

when when our young people are going astray oh we have to run after the young people we have to Molly coddle our young

31:55

people that's not what young people are looking for they're confused because there's no correction there are no

32:00

boundaries and then they become suicidal young people want to know that there are boundaries that there is a direction

32:06

there are people who actually know what's right from wrong and will tell them and we have some brethren like no no no

32:13

we mustn't hurt their feelings we must run after them oh they're crying for social justice let's try to give them

32:18

social justice this is this is a bad path we have to point them to the scriptures 32:25

and be willing to reprove rebuke and rebuke and exhort and mature Christians 32:31

like David we'll see it as a kindness and we'll understand that this is far

32:37

better than the sweet rhetoric of evil men

32:42

job certainly experienced this firsthand when we see how in lihu was very angry 32:49

with job and then was kindled the wrath of Elijah the son of barakal the buzite 32:56

the of the Kindred of ram against job was his wrath kindled why because job 33:02

Justified himself rather than God and bringing this to job's realization 33:08

even though it was painful and Elijah was very angry it was a benefit to job 33:15

this is a beautiful thing that somebody is loyal enough to tell us this is where 33:21

you are at fault so we do have to be like David Bradford and be willing to accept 33:28

correction be willing to accept rebuke and see it as a kindness

33:35

he says and and with long suffering we do it of course with long suffering 33:40

he says when there are Judges again this is the wicked when their judges are overthrown in Stony places

they shall hear my words for they are sweet and and the sense here that I get 33:54

is David is talking about people within the Covenant Community enemies within

34:00

the Covenant Community who really should know better and they've gone a wrong path they've 34:07

embraced evil they're they've taken path with wicked men and when it all collapses David says 34:14

they'll remember what I said to them that's when they'll remember what I said to them and here in Micah 7 and verse beginning

34:21

in verse two he says the good man is perished out of the

34:27

Earth foreign out of the Earth

34:36

and there is none upright none upright among men

34:44

they all lie in wait for blood they hunt every man his brother with a

34:52

net so this is within the Covenant Community something has gone horribly wrong Wicked speakers are putting smooth

34:58

rhetoric out there with poison philosophy and Brethren are falling for it and then

35:04

turning against each other they they fall for this they hunt every man his brother with a net why that they

35:13

may do evil with both hands earnestly the prince the leader asks and the judge

35:18

asks for a reward and the great man he utters his mischievous desire so they

35:24

wrap it up they're all in this together they're all after gain the best of them is as a prayer and Micah we've we've put

35:31

this in the archive if you want to get into a more detailed explanation of what the prophet is saying here but Christ

35:37

actually quoted this speaking of the end time this is what we have to look forward to 35:42

the best of them is as a prayer the most upright is sharper than a thorn Hedge

35:48

the day of thy Watchman and thy visitation comes now shall be their

35:53

perplexity and now they'll remember what I said to them when they turned and and

followed the ways of the wicked and I tried to warn them this is not a good path but they they took it

36:04

wholeheartedly and now shall come their perplexity and David says and then they'll remember 36:10

what I was saying to them trust you not in a friend put you not confidence in a guide 36:17

keep the doors of your mouth from her that lies in your bosom your friend your minister your spouse if they are not

filled with the Holy Spirit and they fall into this iniquity that's in the earth then everyone's turning

36:33

against everybody this is how important it is the crisis forsake not the assembling of yourselves 36:38

together that's how he's inspired the Apostle to warn us forsake not the assembling of yourselves

together as is the manner of some you know where we're blessed to have a congregation that everybody values the

congregation everyone's that I was going to say everybody's there on time everyone's there early and stays late

very very focused externally Psalm 141 the emphasis is really on his personal

Psalms has a total of 150 chapters these remaining chapters are not particularly

42:52

long so within a few weeks God willing into January we should we should

complete and conclude our study of the book of Psalms very very powerful

scripture I think it's it's a book that can be really underestimated

and we just tend to think oh I certainly thought of the Psalms as just nice praise worship music and not so much

filled with deep insight into Torah as well as prophetic utterances so Brethren
