the truth of your word and so father we
hunger and thirst for better
understanding so that we might
align our wills with your will
and that we can find ourselves father
walking in your path and
saying and doing those things and
meditating on those things
that please you and like christ who who
did everything to please you
that we would be conformed to christ and
everything that we do say
think will be conforming to the mind of
christ
and and pleasing to you father we are
continuing to call out to you uh
thanking you god for your mercy for our
sister lisa
we thank you for every news of progress
in her condition we thank you for your
mercy
we know father that she's in a very
grave
situation very precarious situation
but we know also father that she's in
your hands
and so we thank you for this
understanding we thank you for
as great as you are that you are a
personal god
who responds to prayer it's all the
prayers that are going on for our sister
and we thank you god in advance for your
mercy we praise you lord we ask these
blessings in jesus name
amen so i mentioned we're up to isaiah
chapter 27
uh god willing we'll cover that tonight
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and then we'll take a break for the month of august we'll resume then

god willing with chapter 28 in september so 27 actually closes off a section

so it's a nice place for us to go ahead and

take a pause um it's a short chapter so we'll get through it fairly quickly and then we'll have an opportunity for some q a so while i'm going through this chapter if you do have questions please go ahead and type those

in the chat and i did say i would just check to make sure audio is breaking up audio is good now

perfect so yeah i just was on the wrong network and i think that caused the uh the delay and the breaking up so we should be in good shape now let's get into uh chapter 27

of isaiah and here

okay thank you

we will go ahead and read uh the verse we actually covered last week verse one in that day so this is uh clearly eschatological this has to do with the end time

so so we're seeing here how even though the scroll opens with an incredible condemnation

of judah and jerusalem that's not the whole

story that's a very big part of the story but ultimately god is in covenant with jerusalem with judah and he will be their savior

he'll be the savior of israel and so this

is now uh isaiah 22 25 26 27 we're seeing this very clearly he says this in that day the lord

with his sore and great and strong sword now this is decisive he's coming to do battle and to do so decisively

so he has a sore a great and a strong sword

and with that sore and great and strong sword

he shall punish leviathan who's leviathan

the piercing serpent even leviathan that crooked serpent and he shall slay the dragon

that is in the sea so leviathan is identified as the piercing serpent he's identified as the crooked serpent and he's identified as the dragon that is in the sea i think very clearly we know this is speaking of satan so christ is coming to have a decisive victory over satan

we live in satan's world he has his puppets and henchmen and and he has his way but that's not for long

uh christ is coming to bring an end to it so leviathan was the sea monster the sea creature there are a lot of legends and myths around that

but symbolically it has to do with satan and christ is coming to destroy this dragon that is in the sea now that in the sea should bring us to revelation 13 that's in the archives if you missed it we did go line by line through the book of revelation and in chapter 13 and verse 1

john says and i stood upon the sand the sea

and saw a beast rise up out of sea so this beast comes out of the sea

having seven heads and ten horns and we exegeted this in in the study on

revelation so that's in the archive but i just want to point that this beast comes out of the sea and upon his horn ten his horns ten crowns and upon his heads

the name of blasphemy verse 4 and they worshipped the dragon so this is the dragon now which gave power unto the beast and they worshipped the beast

saying who is like unto the beast so humanity at this time cannot see beyond the beast who's able to make war with him

he's so powerful they've decided to all bow down

and to acquiesce and to submit to this force

in verse 11 and i beheld another beast coming up out of the earth and he had two horns like a lamb and he spoke as a dragon so these two beasts one from the sea one from the earth both of them are being empowered by satan and so when we read now that god is

going to take his strong and and then great sword and destroy leviathan that is striking

at satan and therefore this these beast powers will be destroyed

by christ and this great sword the sword is sort of a theme with christ as this

lord of hosts this warrior
and he says here in deuteronomy 32
and verse 41 if i wet
my glittering sword so he's a warrior
and we know he's coming to do battle and
on behalf of judah
to to free judah and israel uh if he
wets into wet is to
take a stone uh with water and to

sharpen the edge of these tools these sword so that you can do damage so so christ is a warrior and he says if i

sharpen my glittering sword and my hand take hold on judgment then what will happen

i will render vengeance to my enemies and will reward them that hate me and so this goes all the way back to torah and this is the way we have to think that

that satan is animating and activating hatred against christ and so christ has enemies and he's coming

to render vengeance to these enemies that that's the theme of the bible that that if you not you but if one takes exception to god's plan for mankind through israel and and fights against israel you're actually fighting against the lord and so he identifies through torah that the enemies of israel are his enemies and through torah and through the prophets so back to isaiah 27 and verse 2 so he's coming with his sword to do this in that day

with his sword to do this in that day sing you unto her what what should we sing

what's the song that god wants sung in the end time

a vineyard of red wine i the lord do keep it i will water it every moment lest any hurt it i will keep it night and day so we see the contrast between leviathan and the fate of leviathan

and the vineyard and when leviathan is put down

then we see so leviathan is is antithetical to christ it's it's the the the villain the the antagonist that's working against the plan of god and when that antagonist is put down there is now no opposition to the lord's will so so when that antagonist is put down well then what is the lord's will hey sing this song

a vineyard of red wine and the lord keeps it he looks after this vineyard and he will water it every moment you get a sense of the intimacy

the compassion and the passion that god has

when he says you know the zeal of the lord will accomplish this this is his zeal this this is what's uppermost in his mind he's going to water this vineyard every moment

it's such care and compassion lest any hurt

he will protect it and guard night and day

that when he comes there will be no harm even though there will be after a thousand years there's still going to be a push and an attempt to destroy the vineyard god is protecting it and he will rain down fire from heaven because now he's protecting this

vineyard now we've heard this metaphor of the vineyard before earlier in isaiah except it was very different in chapter five

here in chapter 27 god loves the vineyard it it's a productive vineyard it's it's

it's producing wine for him

and he's protecting it and keeping it and he's watering it all the time and just

making sure that all the grapes are looked after and that he can harvest the grapes and have the wine and nobody can harm this vineyard that's very very different from the same vineyard in chapter five

from the same vineyard in chapter five and we'll just really you know go back in the archive we did this uh in detail but let's just read it just to have the contrast chapter five verse one now will i sing to my well beloved so the prophet is singing to god a song of my beloved touching his vineyard

my well beloved has a vineyard in a very fruitful hill

and he fenced it gathered out the stones thereof

and planted it with the choicest vine and built a tower in the midst of it and also made a wine press therein so there's an expectation and he looked that it should bring forth grapes and it brought forth poisonous grapes poisonous grapes and now all inhabitants of jerusalem and men of judah judge i beg you between me and my vineyard what could

have been done more to my vineyard what would you suggest that i didn't do

that i should have done to save this vineyard and make it productive what could have been done more to my vineyard

that i have not done in it therefore when i look that it should bring forth grapes brought it forth poisonous grapes and now go to i will tell you what i will do to my vineyard i will take away the hedge there are

the protection and it shall be eaten up and break down the wall thereof and it shall be trodden down god is doing this god orchestrating this these are his people and i will lay at waste it shall not be pruned nor dug but there shall come up prayers

and thorns

i will also command the clouds that they rain

no rain upon it so this curse is definitely coming from god nobody can argue this

if there's just a drought and there's no water coming from the heavens then clearly god is against this vineyard then he explains for the vineyard of the lord of hosts

is the house of israel and that has never changed

from the very beginning god established israel as his

lord and the men of judah

his pleasant plant and he looked for judgment

but behold oppression so god has an expectation

of judgment according to torah and that's what he's looking for from the vineyard

we are first fruits even if we are gentiles

we are now grafted into judah we are spiritual jews and we are the first fruits

and the expectation is the same god wants

judgment according to torah and not the support of oppression

we must have the view of so he's looking for this

but instead he gets oppression for righteousness

but behold a cry so a cry of the victims so he wants righteousness in the in the land but instead of righteousness there's oppression and the victims are crying out and god said what is this is my vineyard so it was a very very different treatment of the vineyard in chapter five then in chapter 27 and chapter 5 gives us a sense of the extent of the evil of these people it's not just chapter 5 we'd have to read you know the whole scroll of isaiah to to really understand that the depth of depravity of these people the depravity notwithstanding because they're his people this is his vineyard and so when he removes the protection of the vineyard and allows the vineyard to be destroyed it's not so that the vineyard will be completely destroyed never to produce again it's so that the vineyard can actually be harvested and that's what we see here in chapter 27 where now he has a different song for the vineyard and we're to sing this song and rejoice over judah and jerusalem because god is now rejoicing over her and the rest of israel back to chapter 27 and verse 4 so coming from chapter 5 to see the anger the disappointment that god had with judah and now he says in chapter 27 and verse 4 fury is not in me so the anger is gone

who would set the prayers and thorns against me in battle and we saw the birds and thorns in chapter five so these are the people of god who have become his enemies go to saying like what is this who who would do this who who would want to fight me of my own people i would go through them i would burn them together so that's the destruction that awaits them however he says in verse 5 or let him take hold of my strength that he may make peace with me and this is what christ said to them you won't see me again until you shall say blessed is he who comes in the name of lord so this curse is upon you but it doesn't have to end this way so so god is driving this destruction to judah to drive them to repentance and this goes all the way back to deuteronomy 30 to torah so you can be destroyed so verse four is hey you want to be you want to do battle with me okay i'll the wicked will be ashes under the feet of the righteous so that's one option that's option a how about option b take hold of my strength that he may make peace with me and he shall make peace with me so this is like he reinforces that you you don't have to you don't have to be destroyed you can have peace with me you can have reconciliation how and why because of the sacrifice of christ jesus christ is the propitiation that it's through the sacrifice of christ israel can have peace with god judah can have peace with god and ultimately the world will have this

opportunity

so here's your choice be destroyed or have peace with god be in atonement

in

at one minute with god here he says this is what he will do and again we can spend

we don't have enough time to articulate the evil the wickedness the depravity of the jews and of the israelite nations it's just there's not there's not enough time to articulate all of this

so yes let's agree god's people are wicked

now that we've agreed so we don't need to argue over that

let's also agree that they are god's people

and god has designed a plan where his covenant people are are the front end

after christ of that plan and we are grafted in to this front end we are the front of the front end but but this is what god is doing and we can't understand what's happening in the earth

without this narrative that jacob the time of jacob is upon us it's going to be a great tribulation upon jacob

not to end jacob but to purge jacob the tribes of israel he shall cause them that come of jacob to take root satan thought he was getting his way the the puppets of satan thought they were getting their way god was actually having his way and his cause then is to cause them that come of jacob to take root

israel shall blossom and bud and israel here doesn't mean the small nation of israel in the middle east that's that's the tribe of judah or the southern kingdom judah

benjamin bit of levi maybe a bit of simian there but israel means all 12 tribes these are the tribes of israel jacob

so this is not just the little nation of israel but all the tribes of israel blossom and bad this is the future not the immediate future because in the immediate future there's great tribulation and that's what we see

happening now it's the setup for this great tribulation but the ultimate future

is that israel shall blossom and bud and fill the face of the world

with fruit this is the this is the purpose of the vineyard

this is why god has such this love and this compassion

and this careful attention to the vineyard so that it can fill the face of the world with fruit

that righteousness will ultimately cover the whole earth but it's going to emanate from and come from israel

has he smitten him as he smote those that smote him so it's a little bit awkward but saying so who are those that smoked so

him is israel and has god stricken israel the way he has stricken those who struck israel so babylon assyria

these are the edom these are the enemies of israel

and if we go back to torah moses told us that you will be stricken by your enemies

but once you repent then all these curses

that came upon you they will come upon your enemies

and god is saying here yes

my vineyard i had to destroy my vineyard but once i get the fruit i'm looking for

i'm then going to turn my attention on

these gentile nations

and they are going to experience the full

wrath my extreme wrath and it's going to be

far worse than what i subjected israel to

because i was kind of mitigating the full wrath with israel

because i was driving them to repentance but now that i have that repentance i have that remnant that faithful remnant now i'm going to push the wicket and it's going to be unmitigated

has he smitten him as he smote those that smote him

or is he slain is israel slain according to the slaughter

of them that are slain by him so so again

this just emphasizing that god is going to

slay the wicked he's going to slay the gentile wicked

and and in a way that's far worse than what happens to israel

because he's his purpose is rooted in israel

in measure when it shoots forth that will debate with it

he stays his rough wind in the day of the east wind again kind of awkward poetry here

but god is doing all the punishment of israel

in a measured way and it's going to be hard for us to fully digest but he's going to control the rough wind in the day of the east wind so when this calamity comes it's not completely without any control god is control

without any control god is controlling it because what he's looking for is the repentance of the remnant by this therefore because of this operation of the lord shall the iniquity of jacob be purged that's what's happening so we cannot get discouraged just to think that all of this chaos in the earth that there's no meaning to it we cannot get discouraged to see when our nations or those of us who i'm speaking to who are in the western nations

they're the judeo-christian nations uh when we see these nations being overtaken and and the judeo-christian values going out the window and being overtaken by bizarre perverse notions of virtue we need to understand that all of this has a purpose and ultimately jacob will take root and bear fruit

by this therefore by through all of this operation

shall the iniquity of jacob be purged that's what's happening that's what the purpose of the great tribulation is and this is all the fruit to take away his sin that's what god is doing when he makes all the stones of the altar

as chalk stones that are beaten in sunder

so eating of these stones the groves and images

shall not stand up so all of this is this this destruction and this up purishment so that god as

this um punishment so that god can can harvest

jacob and let's just quickly read micah

where there's this pattern and it's throughout the prophets but we constantly see this pattern of

destruction

followed by redemption in fact the destruction

leads to the redemption and that's how isaiah just you just have to read isaiah chapters one and two

you got the whole story the the these people that god has nurtured who rebel against him

and he's going to destroy them and then suddenly the whole world

is coming to them to learn righteousness there's the story

and the other prophets repeat the same thing and then it's not really from isaiah it's from moses

all the prophets are repeating and amplifying moses

so here micah as an example he says but truly

i am full of the power by the spirit of the lord

and of judgment that's what god wants and of

might to declare unto jacob

his transgression and to israel his sin so so god he's not holding back they need to know

their transgression they need to know their sin so they know what they need to repent of

hear this verse 9 i pray you you heads of the house of jacob you princess of the house of israel

that abhor judgment and pervert all equity so when god says here through micah

that they abhor judgment it doesn't mean that they're not making judgments it doesn't mean that they're not making their opinions known and they're doing some form of justice
and they feel good about their justice
it's that they abhor
judgment according to torah they hate it
it's too harsh and and micah's just
saying you are the leaders you need to
lead the people
to torah but you're a poor torah
and you pervert all equity so it's all
this kind of crazy
bizarre sense of virtue and justice
they build up zion so they're building
up zion

but they do it with blood and jerusalem with iniquity so they feel good about themselves

they know they're the people of god they're building up zion as the people of god

but they have departed from god and so they have every reason to seduce themselves and to be deluded into thinking yeah we're god's people look we're building up zion

but they're doing it in the wrong way they're not doing it with god the heads thereof judge for reward they don't just speak plainly they don't just give the judgment the way it should be

they give the judgment for the right reaction

hey if i judge like this will you like me and if i judge like this will you pay me and can we work it out so the judgment depends on what i can get versus this is the judgment according to torah and you know some

people might hate it

oh well this is what the judgment should be

the heads thereof judge for reward and

the priests thereof teach for hire even the priests and the prophets thereof even the prophets divine for money so everybody's in it for their own gain how does this make me look how does this make me feel am i am i aggrandizing myself am i enriching myself versus the will of the lord yet in all of this they will lean upon the lord and say is not the lord among us wow in all of this but the prophet is like wow in all of this yet they will lean upon the lord and they'll use righteous language and say isn't the lord among us no evil can come upon us because we're the people of god therefore shall zion for your sake be plowed as a field the wicked that are going to have their way with uh this is some this is an outcome that they cannot remotely imagine because they're building up zion and they're the people of god and the lord is among us for sure certainly the lord is here and mike is saying specifically for you zion will be plowed as a field and jerusalem shall become heaps and the mountain of the house as the high places of the forest and then immediately after this destruction just like isaiah just as moses prophesied he says but in the last days it shall come to pass that the mountain of the house of the lord shall be established in the top of the mountains and it shall be exalted above the hills

and people gentile people shall flow unto it so just like isaiah just like really moses all the prophets jeremiah ezekiel all of them see this that god's people are wicked they're really deranged and deluded and unrighteous even though they think they're righteous and for that they have to be punished this vineyard has to be plowed but the purpose of plowing the vineyard is not to completely wipe it out it's to turn it and once it turns to the lord then god is going to carry on with his plan from the beginning he's going to establish them as a kingdom of priests

that the whole world can come to and so here people are finally going to flow to zion

and god is not going to be in zion by himself he's going to be in zion with the first fruits and with judah and the tribes of israel and the people the people are going to come to these human beings while god beings are going to be overseeing this whole operation back to isaiah chapter 27 yet uh this is what isaiah's seeing now so he sees this glory of this vineyard but that he still says yet the defense city shall be desolate and the habitation forsaken so he's seeing the whole picture he sees the future

the ultimate future but he also sees the immediate future and he's able to digest the immediate future because he sees the ultimate future and i think for

for some of us who maybe get a bit discouraged

when when we're hearing what's the immediate future holds

maybe we just need to dive into the profits

and see the ultimate future and see how one leads to the other

so isaiah was able to digest this yep the defense city shall be desolate this

is the abomination that makes desolate

but that desolation is when the

blindness will be lifted from godfrey

so it's not a complete end yet the

defence city shall be desolate

and the habitation forsaken and left

like a wilderness

there shall the calf feed and there

shall he lie down

and consume the branches thereof so just

the sense of complete destruction

and the wild animals come and they're

just it's not a glorious city anymore

it's not a

thriving metropolis it's just wiped out

and you have the

the animals coming through and almost

scavenging with what they can eat

when the bows thereof are withered they

shall be broken off

the women come and set them on fire for it is a people of no understanding

therefore he that made them will not

have mercy on them this is what christ

said this is the abomination that makes

desolate

and he that formed them will show them

no favor

that's the immediate future

it shall come to pass in that day that

the lord shall beat off

from the channel of the river unto the

stream of egypt

and you shall be gathered one by one o

you children of israel so there's this great destruction and then earlier isaiah spoke of israel like an olive tree where it has to be beaten to to to break down whatever i'll bring down whatever olives are left so all of this process is about harvesting the remnant and so it's going to come to pass that god is going to be harvesting the remnant but what isaiah is very careful to say here that in this process of destruction god is looking for a remnant to turn to him but it's not this sort of wholesale let's just gather everybody he's going to gather one by one this implies a real relationship that each one has to have with christ so although this is destruction upon them it's not ultimate destruction as long as each one will turn to god and that's what he's looking for the ones that will turn so they're going to be gathered one by one o you children of israel and it shall come to pass again in that day that the great trumpet shall be blown and they shall come which were ready to perish in the land of assyria that's the north and the outer castes in the land of eat that's the south so this is the time of the king of the north and the south and these people have been captive and they were about to perish and then the trumpet blew this is really what should bring to mind matthew 24 where christ said except those days be

shortened no flesh should be saved alive and he was speaking specifically of jerusalem and the promised land and his people that that these nations are going to

that that these nations are going to surround them and they're going to be set to completely destroy them take them slaves completely remove them from the land

and it's going to be a complete destruction if satan has his way but then god is going to shorten it and he's going to come and save his people and he's going to gather them from all over the earth and bring them back to the promised land and so in that day the trumpet this is the feast of trumpets the great trumpet will be blown announcing the return of christ and then the angels are going to gather them which were ready to perish in the land of assyria

and the outcasts in the land of egypt and when he gathers them what shall what will they do

and they shall worship the lord in the holy mount

at jerusalem so the prophets are very very consistent

isaiah is very very consistent he doesn't hold any punches but at the same time he also understands the ultimate future

where is all of this heading we need to be very very clear very jerusalem focused

our future is in jerusalem so we need to be very very focused on jerusalem and a lot of christians if you stop and talk to them they couldn't care less about jerusalem it's the last thing on their mind it's the first thing on god's mind and it needs to be the first thing on our mind because the whole world centers on jerusalem so that is isaiah chapter 27.

i hope that you've enjoyed what we've covered so far we're not far from finishing first isaiah only has third unit only but has 39 chapters so we only have uh you know 27 we have 12 more chapters to go and uh some of these chapters are short so we might get through this um by the end of the year god will so let and then we'll go back to psalms so let me check now the chat and see if there are any questions i don't see any questions right now but i did see last week a comment that is kind of a question

that i want to comment on i appreciate that

the comment said

i spent a little bit of time last week speaking about george floyd and that came from

a passage in chapter 26 where isaiah said let favor be shown to the wicked yet will he not learn righteousness in the land of uprightness will he deal unjustly

and will not behold the majesty of the lord

so this was the assessment of the prophet that you can go ahead and show favor to the wicked but if their heart is fully setting them to do evil that's what they'll do

and that's what as i said and part of that i was talking about

so the social justice warriors and we need to be careful

that we judge righteous righteously and

not this um social justice which is really um we're being manipulated and being played so there was a comment then

afterwards that said mr george floyd was not called by god

as well as others in this age meaning others in this age are not called by god however his life still matters and the church needs to have compassion because in the sequence of prophecy the church of god is next

so appreciate the comment and i just want to unpack it

a bit uh first of all i'll say what i agree with

and then i'll say what i respectfully uh disagree with

so the church needs to have compassion i think that's a fair statement

i would agree with that we the church should have compassion um yeah i would not disagree with that

what do i what do i disagree with so first of all the signal right off the

bat so mr

floyd um clearly let's have respect for george floyd mr george uh as a minister i can tell you there are brethren

who would die first before they call a minister mister

you know and maybe it's from you know some past uh history

uh but they would never say mr adrian davis or pastor adrian or just hey yo adrian

um so there's a respect here that's being shown to george floyd which is fine uh we should pray for all men

um and we want to have respect but some i would say some people are not the same they're not this brother i think this is a very good attitude i see here but i'll tell you i've come across brethren who would clearly give respect to george floyd long before they give respect to the ministry so this is one one thing we want to be careful that we're not virtuous signal so we want to speak plainly and christians have lost ground lost significant ground we've given ground to the devil because of political correctness and and virtue signaling so the devil has trained us that if you want to get on in this world you have to virtue signal you need to show us that you're on board with the agenda and so and people are virtue signaling everywhere i'm a good person let me virtue signal well i'm not a good person and i'm not here to virtue signal and i'm not here to convince anybody that i'm a good person i'd rather convince you the opposite that in in me is no good thing i don't need to virtue save because i understand the human heart and the human condition what i want to do is i want to christ's signal i want to show christ's will i want to read the prophets and understand the prophets and understand the law and show what christ's mind is on any matter so so when i speak i'm trying to portray what the prophets are thinking and speaking and teaching and i know that that's going to fly in the face of our society i know that but i can't i didn't write the bible so i'm not going to apologize

for the bible so he was not called by god i will agree with that so that's something else i agree with he was not called by god as well as many others in this age not called by god however his life still matters well yes no yes and no so does human life matter yes and no from the biblical perspective human life should matter but in many cases it doesn't and christ himself is coming he says he's going to make man more scarce than gold he's coming to wipe out human life and in many ways when we read the prophets human life is like it's actually worthless to god and so unless humans repent and take on the image of god and receive the holy spirit what we find is human life actually doesn't matter and so does human does does does um human life matter the the jury is out the jury is out human life will matter when it is when we receive the holy spirit and god life is within us then human life matters other than that it's going to be like so let's be careful not to just automatically say every human life matters no there are some human lives that don't matter now does george and floyd's life matter well yes and no we are hoping that in the resurrection because we know he will be resurrected and we may even have the opportunity to teach him we are hoping
that he will then when everything is
shown to him and you know we don't know
what his history is but
when all of that is resolved and he's
shown the way of christ we're certainly
uh hopeful that he will choose christ
and then his life will really matter
it'll matter eternally but
when we say you know we have to virtue
signal
no we've lost ground as christians

no we've lost ground as christians because we are not calling evil evil george floyd was he's dead now and he's awaiting the resurrection but he was an evil man somebody needs to say it it's unfortunate

but he was a wicked man and somebody needs to have compassion for his victims you know to to to he was a pornographer and many of these women that are caught up in pornography they're slaves they don't want to be

they're slaves they don't want to be there they don't just to degrade themselves

so they're they're enslaved and and being a pornographer is a worshiper of satan

that is a vile thing to to have a pistol you know in a pregnant woman's spine

and say i will blow out your spine and i'll blow the child in your in your tummy

this is amazing these are foam this is the vulnerable of society a pregnant woman

and we see in matthew 24 that the viciousness of satan if you're a jew a jewish and you're pregnant

there'll be no mercy because that's the

viciousness of the devil human beings should naturally be protective of pregnant women so so this is this begs the question what is the son of belial what is the son of bilal that's one question that comes from this the other is this statement that in the sequence of prophecy the church of god is next so therefore we should judge with compassion because in the sequence of prophecy the church of god is next i would say that's a very slippery slope for us to go down and just bear with me as i unpack this and again we just care about the bible we're trying to iron sharpens iron again i appreciate this comment gives me some things to hopefully i can give you guys some things to reflect on as well ultimately we just want to be right with christ in a world that hates him in a world that is manipulating minds and seducing minds to choose courses that are anti-christic and antithetical to christ. so we don't even realize that we start developing these these certain value systems that are antichrist that's the world we live in so we just we need to go to scripture to say what does scripture say now in 2nd corinthians 10 and verse 5 he says casting nations and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of god so we should see when we see pride when we see things exalting themselves against

christ we're ready to cast those things down

and bringing into captivity every thought

to the obedience of christ we want to think like christ

it's not our natural way and and it's not going to agree

necessarily with with the world around us that has rejected christ

but we don't care what the world around us thinks we care what christ thinks and we're trying to conform the way we think to our understanding of how christ thinks which we find in the scriptures and then he says this and having in a readiness

to revenge all disobedience when your obedience is fulfilled so we are conforming to christ so that we can become soldiers with christ

we are conforming to torah so that we can judge according to torah and he says having in a readiness to revenge

all disobedience when your obedience is fulfilled

so we're not going to have this um sense that

you know what since i'm kind of disobedient i'm going to be lenient on others because i want them to be lenient on me no we're going to force ourselves and discipline ourselves to be obedient so that when christ gives us judgment we

so that when christ gives us judgment we will judge according to torah without looking for reward without looking for acceptance

we're just looking for what what would what would christ do how would he judge and i want to talk about this again this this you know we want to be careful how we judge

because uh in the sequence of prophecy the church of god is next judgment begins with the house of god i think samuel first samuel is a good example here

of what we need to be careful of in first samuel 15 and verse 20 saul and let me just maybe share my spirit here

first samuel

15 and verse 20 saul said unto samuel yes i have obeyed the voice of the lord and have gone the way which the lord sent me so in his mind i've obeyed god and i've brought ag the king of amalek and have utterly destroyed the amalekite so that was the instruction utterly destroyed the amalekites saul spared the king in his mind he's fully obeyed god and yet he served the king he destroyed the people but he spared the king

why would he do that he's setting a precedent israel themselves may come under attack

and if israel is captured he's setting a precedent

spare the king so he's thinking of himself well

i've got to judge in a way that if the judgment comes back on me i want to set a precedent hey you spare

want to set a precedent hey you spare the king

now so that's one thing we don't judge is sort of thinking

oh um let me be lenient here so hopefully i can have leniency that's that's not

how we when it comes to understanding the situation when we're assessing a situation

we judge according to torah now

we don't we're not condemning we know there's a resurrection we're not condemning people to oh i hope this person burns in the lake of fire we're not saying that but we understand the wickedness that's in the earth and people are calling evil good and calling good evil and christians are i've lost ground and we're cowering in the corner we're hiding in the closet and perverse men have taken over and they're they're injecting a different moral code and we can't go along with this we need you to speak plainly and people are not going to like it but we can't apologize for the bible here in chapter 2 of first samuel you know george floyd didn't know the lord and when we say george boy there are many george floyds he's really symbolic and the elite are using him as a symbol and they're telling us here are your heroes this is the best that you have these are your heroes they're not holding up martin luther kings and saying look at these honorable men look at these people who strove for noble goals these are your heroes no we're gonna take the dregs of society and we're gonna hold them up as your heroes this is this is to get your children to look to these people as heroes well no this is the son of beloved or he was a son of allah and i say that with all like this is this is just fact he was a son of belia he will have his chance

and we may even have the chance to educate him or certainly others like him we will

but that's going to come in the second resurrection but we have to be able to assess what's the situation today and here the sons of eli were sons of belial

they didn't know the lord it's not that well they didn't know the lord therefore we have to say well they're they're nice people they didn't no they didn't know the lord

and they were sons of allah that's why they were sons of belial because they didn't know the lord

now they were wiped out is that the end of them no they're going to come up in the resurrection

and they will have the chance to be educated properly and we hope that they will choose the right path but they didn't know the lord and therefore they were sons of the lord so just because somebody doesn't know the lord doesn't mean that hey we can't say anything about them

no they didn't know the lord they were sons of belial

in verse 22 eli was very old and he heard all that his sons did unto all israel

how they lay with the women that assembled at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation

this is what sons of belial do so you can't now come and tell me that the children of eli the sons of eli these are my heroes these are the people that i have to defend these are the people that i

should train my children look to the sons of eli and they didn't know the lord but hey this these are

good people and no they were sons of allah so there's a term in the bible and we can we could search it it's reused repeatedly sons of belial so who who are these sons of belial is this a term that we can use today or is it is it forbidden nobody can be a son of blood this doesn't mean that they're not going to be resurrected here in psalm 137 we will get here and many christians don't know how to answer this and many muslims that hear them in the debates they point to this to say what is this remember oh lord the children of edom in the day of jerusalem that's the future who said raise it raise it even to the foundation thereof o daughter of babylon who art to be destroyed blessed shall he be that rewards you as you have served us blessed shall he be that takes and dashes your little ones against the stones this is what why what but this is david's heart he is seeing the people of israel the children of israel destroyed he's

the people of israel
the children of israel destroyed he's
seeing the vulnerable the babies
being destroyed and he is just beside
himself
with compassion for the victims
and he's saying to he's saying like the
one that comes
and deals with babylon the way that
babylon dealt with
us that one will be blessed and that one
ultimately is christ
but christ is going to give his people
power he's going to empower them to

fight back but this is this is hard to digest but this is the will of the lord that the wicked will be destroyed and so we need to be able to call out wickedness and then we pray for the best but wickedness is wickedness and god is coming to judge wickedness and we can say well god just doesn't have any compassion people use this verse to say god is this this god of the bible is evil he has no compassion and we could even look at matthew 8 to say again christ could be accused of having no compassion he says in another of his disciples said unto him lord allow me first to go and bury my father i'd like to go and bury my father but jesus said unto him follow me and let the dead bury their dead does christ have no compassion i mean i just want to bury my father no you let the dead bury their dead and yet this christ is the orchestrator of the plan of god it is through christ that these dead have hope and yet he says to his disciples you better have your priorities straight so let's be careful we're in a time of manipulation we're in a time of brainwashing we're in a time of removing the christian value system from society so we just need to be careful that we are not being manipulated and we find ourselves being cowered and we can't speak plainly we can't speak according to the bible

so i want to just read the bible

and i just want to be true to the bible and

i'm not here i'm not running a popularity contest

i'm not hoping i say all the right things and then i get a pat on the head of people like me

i'm not here to be liked i i hope i'm respected

i hope i'm doing something of value but i i feel my mission is to teach the bible

and we're going to go through it line by line and i'm just going to teach what the bible says

and so isaiah calls out the wicked it says you can go ahead and give them your social justice they won't change and we're living in a time now where george floyd and again he's one man he's dead now and he's going to be in the resurrection

and he's going to be in the resurrection and we really do pray that we see him and all of his potential realized and he will be the image of god as he was intended to be

that's our hope for george floyd but george floyd still lives today there are many george flores and they're being led out of prison and lawlessness is abounding

and we're going to find ourselves very soon

in a position where these george floyds are going to touch us personally and they're going to touch our loved ones personally and it's not going to be this academic thing anymore it's going to be where we have suffered at the hands of these people and it's no longer academic it's real and so we have to have this biblical view

that is consistent that it doesn't

matter whether it happens to us personally

or it's a small baby that is destroyed or it's a a small child that is raped or it's a woman that is abused it's the vulnerable society

we don't have to be the victim to feel compassion for the victims

and to feel this this sigh and cry for the wickedness that's done in the earth it doesn't have to touch us personally before we wake up and say this is wrong and then

these are wicked people no we have the compassion

in the right place according to torah so i'm not saying that i hate george floyd and you know i'm glad

he's gone i'm not saying at all i know the plan of god

and i know he'll be resurrected and there's going to be very

powerful people all around him that have more power than he ever thought he had and he's going to have to choose does he go the way of christ or does he continue in this incorrigible uh attitude so that's george floyd and we we hope the best for him

but george floyd is everywhere and the elite

are releasing george floyd into society and and we have to be able to just call us bayless made and speak according to torah so that's

and speak according to torah so that's that's my position there i hope it's clear i hope i

i hope it's uh understood i appreciate where the brother was coming from that shared that and i think he made some good points

i just need we need to be careful we're being manipulated into a value system that doesn't come from the bible

let me just see if uh very very good yeah very good uh sister velma uh jesus said why are you calling me because there's none good but one and that's god so so when we have that understanding we don't need to virtue signal

these people who have people around us who've departed from christianity and departed from christian values they have to constantly virtue signal because they have this anxiety that they're not good people and so they're trying to do everything they can to prove that they're good people we don't suffer from that anxiety we know we're not good people there's nothing good in us but by the power of the holy spirit we're being transformed and we're

conforming to christ so i think that's great oh where do we post two questions right there alan right right where you're posting it you can post it right there

uh well the sons of belial shall be all of them as thorns thrust away because they cannot be taken with hands well this development's just right right on this very

very good i think that is it for tonight um we just we live in a we live in very difficult times brethren let's pray for each other let's look out for each other iron sharpens iron i don't have all the answers i don't

i don't have all the answers i don't think you

think you have all the answers either the bible has all the answers and we just have to mine it and work through it and iron sharpening iron and we'll get there in the end we know

we'll get there in the end we just have to have patience with each other and look out for each other and pray for each other these are very very difficult times the immediate future is very very difficult so let's keep our eyes through the immediate future to the ultimate future wonderful thank you brethren for staying with me up to chapter 27 as i mentioned we'll just take a small break now and then god willing in september will resume with uh isaiah chapter 28. god bless you brethren jesus christ is lord and savior amen you
