0:35OK.

- 0:36Very, very good.
- 0:39Ezekiel 13, we're shifting gears now and God is now after evaluating Judah, now he's really zeroing in and, and for the next few chapters, quite a few chapters.
- 0:53Actually, we're going to hear the judgments against Judah and not surprisingly, those judgments begin with the prophets with the leaders.
- 1:08So, so the people are condemned, but the root cause is how they've been led astray.
- 1:16So let's get into Ezekiel chapter 13 and we'll jump right in at verse one and he says, and the word of the Lord came unto me saying, Son of Man, prophesy against the prophets of Israel that prophesy.
- 1:35So, so this is active, they're, they're active and Ezekiel is to basically interrupt them in the midst of their activity and prophesy against them.
- 1:47So this is not that they're not there and he's just gonna be prophesying to the wind and hopefully somebody picks it up centuries later.
- 1:55No, this is active now happening now.
- 1:57So Son of Man prophesy against the prophets of Israel and we've established that the house of Israel and the house of Judah at times, these are synonyms.
- 2:08So prophesy against them that are actively prophesying and say you unto them, that prophesy out of their own hearts.
- 2:17So what they're saying, they, they're just making themselves feel good, you prophesy against them and say this.
- 2:24Hear you the word of the Lord.
- 2:27So right away in, in chapter, in verse two, here of chapter 13, we're seeing a contradiction.
- 2:34We're seeing a contrast between the prophets and the Lord and Ezekiel representing the Lord.
- 2:41These are prophets of God apparently.
- 2:44And yet they're message with all of their credentials and how they dress and how they speak and their titles.
- 2:50They're actually anti-god anti-christ, even though they have the appearance of representing God.
- 2:58So he says to them, they're, they're prophesying out of their own hearts.
- 3:01And there's then there's the word of the Lord to, to sort of bring this up to date for us.
- 3:06Let's bring Matthew 24 into this where Jesus warned his disciples when they asked him about this time that we're in now heading into the time of his return.
- 3:18This is the time they asked about and he warned them and he said, take heed, beware that no man deceive you.
- 3:27And I think previously in the time of America's hege hegemony and ascendancy, We would use this as a proof text.
- 3:39You know, don't, don't fall for the Trinity, don't fall for heaven and hell and don't be deceived.
- 3:46And it was more of a general deception now that we are in this time and, and, and we're in the beginning of sorrows.

- 3:54Now, we need to be more specific about what Christ meant when he said take heed that no man deceive you.
- 4:03And again, I've been trying to discipline myself that when I quote Matthew 24 I think Matthew 23 Matthew 2324 form a unit.
- 4:14So again, historically, we've separated Matthew 24 maybe we've tied it to revelation chapter six.
- 4:22So 24 revelation six that, that we've made that integration.
- 4:26But I think it's out of context if we don't pull in Matthew 23.
- 4:32And the context of Matthew 23 that sets up Matthew 24 is Christ cursing Jerusalem.
- 4:39Christ, pronouncing desolation on Jerusalem and then turning to his disciples and say, let no man deceive you.
- 4:47So understanding that and now tying that into the prophets who are also prophesying for the last days, take heed that no man deceive you.
- 4:57And then he says, many false prophets will rise and shall deceive many.
- 5:04So in the end time, we are going to have false prophets, Ezekiel Jeremiah Mica Amos, these prophets help us in, in their prophesying, help us understand the word of the Lord and the truth of the matter from the Lord's mouth.
- 5:24And then we can compare that to what these prophets of the day are saying to us and see is there a contrast.
- 5:33So already what we're seeing is there's gonna be a rise in profits that are prophesying out of their own hearts.
- 5:44These are the feel good prophets.
- 5:47These are the prophets of smooth things and then there's the word of the Lord, which is rough, it's rough.
- 5:55And then we have to decide, are we going to be faithful in delivering the word of the Lord, even though it's rough and intense?
- 6:04Or are we going to dilute it to make people feel good and, and cast our lot in with the false teachers of which there will be many before Christ returns.
- 6:16So the warning as we head into this time, beware, don't be deceived about Jerusalem and about my will concerning Jerusalem and false prophets are going to arise and try to mislead you about Jerusalem.
- 6:33And once you lose the plot line, you're, you're deceived, you're, you're, you're out of sync with the Lord verse three.
- 6:44Thus saith the Lord God.
- 6:47This is what God says.
- 6:49Whoa, cursing upon woe unto the foolish prophets.
- 6:58Their prophets.
- 6:58God is acknowledging their prophets, they're foolish and they're false and they're cursed.
- 7:05So we who, who are we gonna follow?
- 7:07Whoa, if we follow the foolish prophets, then these curses come upon us as well.
- 7:12Don't be deceived woe to the foolish prophets that follow their own spirit and have seen nothing.
- 7:22They have no clue what they're talking about.

- 7:27In fact, you know, I can't help, but I have to quote Benjamin Netanyahu here, our war against Hamas is a test for all of humanity.
- 7:42It is a struggle between the axis of evil of Iran Hezbollah and Hamas and the axis of freedom and progress.
- 7:51I am responsible for guaranteeing the future of this country.
- 7:54And now my role is to lead all Israelis, the state of Israel and the people of Israel to an overpowering victory.
- 8:02It is now a time to come together for one purpose to storm ahead, to achieve victory in joined with joint forces and a profound belief in our justness, a profound belief in the eternity of the Jewish people.
- 8:16We shall realize the prophecy of Isaiah.
- 8:21There will no longer be stealing at your borders and your gates will be of glory together.
- 8:29We will fight to get et cetera, et cetera.
- 8:34So he walks his eloquence quoting the prophet and hopefully, hopefully you heard that and saw that Benjamin Netanyahu Yahoo Prime Minister Netanyahu leader shepherd of the, the Jewish peoples quoting Isaiah and not telling them to believe in God, not telling them to believe in the eternal God, but to believe in the eternal victory of the Jewish people and to believe in their victory and, and the goodness of the Jews and that everything is gonna be ok.
- 9:05He's gonna lead them to victory and he's quoting the prophet Isaiah.
- 9:09This is a foolish prophet.
- 9:11This is a false prophet, this is a false teacher and, and he's leading the people into a false sense of security.
- 9:20More importantly, what he's doing is he's diluting the call to repentance.
- 9:28Why should, why should the people repent if they believe in their eternal justice and their eternal presence in the land?
- 9:34And there's no need to repent because this leader is going to lead them to victory.
- 9:39He and every and the evangelicals and, and everyone who's reassuring Judah that everything is gonna be fine.
- 9:46They, they speak of their own spirit, they, they speak of, they, they are divinations out of their own heart.
- 9:54These are smooth things.
- 9:56II, I would love nothing more than to speak smooth things, but I can't if I'm studying the word of God thus says to the Lord God whoa unto the foolish prophets that follow their own spirit and have seen nothing.
- 10:12Why are you quoting Isaiah chapter 60 when you haven't read the other 59 chapters that come before chapter 60 when you don't understand the context of what you're quoting or the the timing of what you're quoting and you're giving people false hope and you're trying to do that without God, you are going to bring this about without God.
- 10:33And not once do you point the people to the eternal God.
- 10:37Jeremiah saw this and what he says is this Jeremiah 29 and verse eight for thus saith the Lord of hosts.
- 10:46This is God speaking the Lord of armies, the God of Israel.
- 10:51Let not your prophets and your diviners that be in the midst of you, deceive you neither hearken to your dreams which you cause to be dreamed for.

- 11:04They prophesy falsely unto you in my name.
- 11:09I have not sent them saith the Lord.
- 11:13So we if we're going to preach in God's name and warning God's name, it better be with his words and not our imagination back to Ezekiel verse four.
- 11:26He says, o Israel, your profits are like the foxes in the deserts.
- 11:35And a better translation here would be they're like the jackals in the desolation.
- 11:43So when you just imagine absolute desolation and then you have these scavengers, these horrible skinny dogs just going through the desolation for anything they can find.
- 11:54That's what God says.
- 11:55These prophets are like that they are ev everything they're doing.
- 12:00They're motivated by self interest.
- 12:04They want to hold on to power, they want to grasp at wealth.
- 12:09If we look at what's happening now in a, in America and the current administration, they've sold America out.
- 12:18Anybody who has, who opens their wallet, they've sold America out and with that, with America, the Western world for money.
- 12:29In fact, President Biden, when he was a young senator, made it clear that you would agree that that your service in the Senate up to this point has not reflected any particular concern for the larger contributor.
- 12:45Well, so he's asked the question like your role in the, in the Senate.
- 12:50You haven't reflected the concerns of the larger contributors.
- 12:54And he basically goes on to say he tried, he said he literally used, he says he tried to prostitute himself to these large donors and they said he's too young, come back when you're older.
- 13:08But he made it clear I'm available to the highest bidder.
- 13:11The thing is I didn't have many larger contributors.
- 13:13And the only reason, see, I went to the big guys for the money.
- 13:16I was ready to prostitute myself in the ma the manner in which I talk about it.
- 13:20But what happened was they said come back when you're 40 son.
- 13:23And so I had to go out.
- 13:28That is just so funny that his character is such that he was happy to prostitute himself.
- 13:34And he made it clear, I'm for hire and that character has shown to be with him all his political career for five decades.
- 13:44And so in the desolation and the destruction of America, they don't care.
- 13:50Can they get wealthy from China?
- 13:51Can they get wealthy from what's going on in Ukraine?
- 13:54Can they get wealthy from what's going on in the Middle East?
- 13:57Can they launch another war?
- 14:00Can, can they launch another lockdown?
- 14:02It doesn't matter as long as money is coming into their account.
- 14:05So God says these people and then these prophets who are prophesying safety and peace, it's all in self interest and they're like jackals in the desolation instead of being concerned about the desolation and trying to pick up the pieces and, and help the people, they couldn't care less.
- 14:26They're just going through the desolation to see what they can pick out for themselves.

0:05It's all in self interest and they're like jackals in the desolation, instead of being concerned about the desolation and trying to pick up the pieces and, and help the people, they couldn't care less.

- 0:17They're just going through the desolation to see what they can pick out for themselves.
- 0:23He goes on here in Mica, this is all over the prophets.
- 0:27So when Christ says, don't be deceived and when he says, there'll be many false prophets, it's not just some new thing that he's making up.
- 0:37He's the one that inspired the prophets.
- 0:39And he's the one that is saying everything that inspired the prophets, it will come to pass.
- 0:45And so he's crystallizing what the prophets have already spoken.
- 0:49And so here's Micah three verse five thus says Jehovah, concerning the prophets that make my people err telling the people we will be victorious.
- 1:04We don't need God, we don't need to repent.
- 1:07We're, we're, we're the covenant people.
- 1:10We belong in this land no matter what we'll be successful, no matter what they are causing God's people to err thus says the Lord, concerning the prophets that make my people that bite with their teeth like jackals and cry peace, they want what they want but they oh peace.
- 1:29This is they cry peace because that's, that serves their agenda and he that puts not into their mouths, they even prepare war against him.
- 1:40So again, what's going on in America is just a real microcosm for us to study, to understand the dynamics of human nature because they don't change here.
- 1:49We're talking specifically of Judah, but the dynamics of power are the same.
- 1:55And in fact, much of Judah is influencing the leadership and in leadership roles in America and around the world as the Zionist elite.
- 2:05So yeah, it's all good as long as what you say agrees with their agenda.
- 2:10But if you speak out against their agenda, you might find yourself in jail and not only in jail in solitary confinement or just suddenly your life is over and they claim it's suicide.
- 2:24So this is the selfishness that goes with the quest and the lust for power back to Ezekiel.
- 2:32He says to these prophets, you have not gone up into the gaps, neither made up the hedge for the house of Israel to stand in the battle in the day of the Lord.
- 2:47So if we were to talk in sort of modern language that we would all understand, we would say you've opened up the borders, you've torn down the wall and now the country has no protection and her enemies are crossing the border.
- 3:0710,000 a day, people who absolutely despise her are entering her.
- 3:17People who call her the great Satan and who will strap explosives to themselves and do nothing but plot and imagine evil all day, every day.
- 3:30For years.
- 3:31These are the people that you've torn down your walls to let in and you have no desire to build up the walls.
- 3:41That, that's the sense here.
- 3:42There, there are gaps in the wall and you, you don't care, you're telling people peace, but you're, you're not making any effort to protect the people in this cc climactic time.

- 3:55That's coming these profits.
- 4:00They have seen vanity and lying divi nation.
- 4:05It is absolutely false.
- 4:08What they are dreaming up and speaking and saying thus saith the Lord, they've seen vanity and lying divination saying the Lord says, and the Lord has not sent them quoting Isaiah and, and the Lord has not authorized this messaging and and twisting it and applying Isaiah 60 to today.
- 4:29And they have made others to hope that they would confirm the word.
- 4:33It just sounds so good that we all want to believe this.
- 4:37So, you know, when we look at the absolute brutal demonic attack on October 7th, of course, people are hoping that Hamas can be destroyed and that Israel can defend herself.
- 4:55And so when, when Netanyahu speaks the way that he does, people hope that this is in fact going to be true.
- 5:03People who have some kind of conscience, but it's not from God.
- 5:09Have you not seen main vision and have you not spoken a lying divination?
- 5:16You're quoting the prophet and it's a lie.
- 5:20You're twisting the words of the prophet and giving this false hope to the people.
- 5:25Whereas you say the Lord says it, I'm quoting Isaiah, albeit I didn't say that you're twisting the words.
- 5:35So what did the Lord say concerning Jerusalem?
- 5:40Matthew 23.
- 5:41 Matthew 2324.
- 5:42Matthew 2324.
- 5:44Don't be deceived.
- 5:45What did the Lord say concerning Jerusalem?
- 5:49Verse 3723 0 Jerusalem.
- 5:55Jerusalem.
- 5:58You that killed the prophets.
- 6:00They didn't feed your agenda.
- 6:02So you destroyed them and stones them which are sent unto you, sent unto you from the Lord.
- 6:09How often would I have gathered your Children together?
- 6:12Even as a hen gathers her chickens under her wings, but you wouldn't have it.
- 6:18This is your choice.
- 6:19This is your doing.
- 6:21 You chose this path and now you want to claim God is with you.
- 6:28Behold your house is left unto you.
- 6:33Desolate.
- 6:34Desolation is prescribed for Jerusalem.
- 6:39And now we've got the jackals just doing what they running amongst the desolation, seeing how they can get power for themselves, seeing what wealth they can get for themselves, seeing anything they can grab from themselves as scavengers in the desolation.
- 6:56Jerusalem is desolate thus saith the Lord and now what we should be doing, how, how do we turn this around while that requires deep repentance of the people.

- 7:09It requires the people acknowledging their abomination.
- 7:13Let's have a conversation about what these young people were doing on the high holy day as the covenant people of God, who should have been instructed by their parents and their parents before them and should be preparing to teach their young people instead of engaging in abomination as the holy people of God or who should be the holy covenant people of God on God's high holy day.
- 7:41Behold Jerusalem.
- 7:43Let no man deceive you, beware that you be not deceived.
- 7:48Jerusalem is desolate.
- 7:51Despite what the prophets say, don't be deceived for I say unto you, you shall not see me from now on until you shall say blessed is He that comes in the name of the Lord.
- 8:06So somebody is going to be accurately preaching in the name of Jehovah.
- 8:13And as a result of that accurate preaching, unlike misquoting, the prophets, the prophet will be quoted precisely and the people will be brought to repentance as they suffer and they begin to realize their leaders cannot help them.
- 8:31They're going to hear a voice and it's going to be the voice of the true prophets.
- 8:36Somebody is going to be quoting the true prophets accurately and many of us who are understanding this word, who knows how God might use us, we better be prepared, who knows?
- 8:49We don't know God will open the doors.
- 8:51He opens we need to be students, we need to be disciples.
- 8:55And then suddenly God puts us in role and we're ready because we've been preparing.
- 9:00But this gospel will be preached and there will be those who endure unto the end preaching it accurately, regardless of the opposition.
- 9:09And because of that accurate preaching, finally, finally, the remnant gets it the remnant of the covenant community.
- 9:20And finally, they turned to the Lord and they acknowledge him and they bless his holy name, do not be deceived, Ezekiel 13 and verse eight.
- 9:34Therefore, thus saith the Lord God.
- 9:38This is a, this is what the Lord says.
- 9:40Th this is what the true prophets and teachers.
- 9:45In the end time we'll be teaching will be proclaiming, this is part of the true gospel.
- 9:54There has to be bad news in order to appreciate the good news.
- 9:58Therefore, thus saith the Lord God because you have spoken vanity, you prophets and seen lies.
- 10:07Therefore, behold, I am against you says the Lord.
- 10:13So this is really, really interesting because we're told by God we'll be hated by all nations.
- 10:19And sometimes when we read that, we immediately think of all these gentile nations, particularly these Islamic nations.
- 10:27We'll be hated by them, but it doesn't say all nations except one that all nations.
- 10:34And so the leaders of Judah will hate us as well as we preach this gospel.
- 10:41We stand alone, we stand with God and only those who are going to repent and come to God's side will understand and agree with us.
- 10:52Everyone else including Judah will hate and despise us will be hated by all nations.

- 10:57So God is against the prophets and we stand with God and preach God's word against the prophets and we are hated even though we are preaching accurately.
- 11:08God's name verse nine and my hand shall be upon the prophets that see vanity and that divine lies.
- 11:21So you, you quote Isaiah 60 you in, in, in incorrectly, you are bringing this curse upon yourself.
- 11:29You are bringing the wrath of God upon yourself because God wants His people to repent and you're diluting the call for repentance.
- 11:37You're, you're giving them false reassurance and God hates that.
- 11:42God hates that because He knows what's coming and, and he, he wants the, the wicked to turn from his wicked way and you're telling the people, oh, it's just young people having a good time.
- 11:52It's all fine and you have no regard for what God considers holy and my hand shall be upon the prophets that see vanity and that divine lies.
- 12:04They, they, these false teachers shall not be in the assembly of my people.
- 12:10Oh, so there is going to be an assembly of God's people, they will be excluded.
- 12:16So there as Moses said, there will be a repentance of the remnant.
- 12:22That's why this gospel has to be preached accurately because there will be a repent, a remnant that will repent.
- 12:29So why not us be in that role of preaching the gospel accurately and as, as things unfold, it's like, you know what we heard?
- 12:40Somebody actually teaching something like let's look them up.
- 12:43They were right right now.
- 12:45It might not seem right now.
- 12:47We might seem like we're crazy, but time will tell and somebody's gonna be preaching accurately.
- 12:53There is going to be a repentance.
- 12:55So says Moses of the covenant community, but these false teachers will be excluded.
- 13:03They shall not be in the assembly of my people.
- 13:06Neither shall they be written in the writing of the house of Israel.
- 13:12Good.
- 13:13OK.
- 13:15Neither shall they enter into the land of Israel.
- 13:17God's going to gather all his people of Israel from the four corners of the earth.
- 13:22And he so says, Moses and all the prophets, he's going to put them in the land that he gave to their fathers and they will inherit in them.
- 13:31They will be, he will be glorified in his people, in their land.
- 13:37But these false teachers will be excluded and you shall know that I am the Lord God.
- 13:45In other words, God is known by his ability to declare the end from the beginning and from ancient times, that which is not yet done, saying what I say will stand, what I have planned, will stand.
- 14:01And so as long as we're preaching God's word, we are showing them who the Lord really is.
- 14:07And when his word comes to pass, then they will know who is the true God?

0:04God is known by his ability to declare the end from the beginning and from ancient times, that which is not yet done, saying what I say will stand, what I have planned will stand.

0:19And so as long as we're preaching God's word, we are showing them who the Lord really is.

0:25And when his word comes to pass, then they will know who is the true God Isaiah in 28.

0:32And verse seven says this, but they also have air through wine.

0:40There's some Babylonian wine that they're participating in and it's caused them to air and through strong drink are out of the way.

0:50So these are metaphors for false ideology and doctrine that they have engaged in and it's warped their thinking away from the word of God, the priest and the prophet.

1:05So Ezekiel is really pushing the prophet Christ spoke of false prophets, but really, we can say this includes teachers.

1:15This includes priests, not just the prophet, anybody who is declaring God's word in the end time, there will be many false teachers.

1:26And so both the priest and the prophet are drunk with wine and strong drink and they have erred through strong drink.

1:33They are swallowed up of wine.

1:35So there's this wine being poured all over the world and it's so easy to get swept up in it instead of saying no, we stand with God and we don't care what it could be the most popular thing and everybody is going that way.

1:49We're not going that way.

1:51We're going to stand on God's word.

1:54But people, it's so easy for people to get swept up with the current thing.

1:58They are swallowed up of wine.

2:01They are out of the way through strong drink.

2:04They should be in the way, they should be teachers of the way.

2:07They're completely out of the way through strong drink.

2:10It's strong, it's heavy.

2:13Satan is broadcasting intensely and everybody's getting swept up and it's so easy.

2:19Just everybody around you is sort of saying the same thing.

2:22So well, why don't we just try to fit in instead of saying we will never teach other than what God has, we will never dilute God's word.

2:32It is what it is.

2:33We didn't write it.

2:34We don't have to apologize for it.

2:36We just have to preach it.

2:39They are out of the way priests and profits teaching and they're completely out of the way through strong drink.

2:50They err in vision.

2:51They, they don't, they don't see what God has laid out anymore.

- 2:54They're not studying the scriptures, they have this false vision and they air in vision and they stumble in judgment when they make judgments, you don't hear them referring to the Torah.
- 3:07They don't seem to understand the Torah.
- 3:09Their judgments are nice that you know, that sounds like a nice judgment.
- 3:13It's, you seem like a nice guy making nice judgments.
- 3:16You're just against the Torah.
- 3:19They stumble in judgment for all tables.
- 3:23This is God's evaluation of the tables.
- 3:26We might be proud of the tables.
- 3:28We might be hoping everybody can see how nice we are.
- 3:32God's evaluation.
- 3:33All tables are full of vomit.
- 3:37It's an abomination to God and filthiness so that there is no place clean.
- 3:44May God have mercy on us as congregations that when He comes in and evaluates our tables, we pray that he might find a clean place rooted in Torah with good judgments that the people understand and support and not Mr nice guy that everybody's just drifting out of the way and the tables are full of vomit.
- 4:12Then Isaiah goes on which leads into why we've labeled our study series and program line upon line.
- 4:23He goes on then in the context of this abomination of judgment and corruption of the priests and the prophets in this context where the prophets have gone astray and the priests have followed them and they err in vision through strong drink and strong wine.
- 4:42Well, then whom shall he teach knowledge?
- 4:45Who is going to get this and who shall he make to understand doctrine?
- 4:52They, they've polluted the doctrine.
- 4:55There's no good teaching.
- 4:56There's no place clean.
- 4:58So who will God be able to teach them that are weaned from the milk and drawn from the breasts?
- 5:06We've grown up.
- 5:08We used to depend on whatever the teacher said.
- 5:12And we didn't have to do our homework.
- 5:15We're not there anymore.
- 5:17We're studying for ourselves.
- 5:19And we're saying, wait a minute.
- 5:21That, that's not what the word says.
- 5:23I'm, I'm studying the word for myself and I'm now understanding God is God has a direct channel to me now, through His word.
- 5:34And I'm not, I'm not just going to err because the prophets have seen a vision that doesn't come from God.
- 5:41The teachers are laying down doctrine that doesn't come from God.

- 5:45So I, I show me in the word where you're getting this and show me across the prophets and through the Torah and I'm gonna be like the burns and I'm gonna search the scriptures to see if in fact, these things are.
- 5:59So because that's the only person that God can teach or those are the only people that God can reach in this time of great deception.
- 6:09When Christ says, beware, take heed that no man deceive you in that context in that time or in this time, who can God teach them that are weaned from the milk and drawn from the breast.
- 6:25We're, we're eating meat now and we're not depending on whatever the leader tells us.
- 6:32Not to say that, I mean, Deacon gave a great sermon, a two sermons actually on leaders matter.
- 6:39Oh yes, leaders matter.
- 6:42But it's not, it's not that leaders matter in a way where, you know, whatever the leader says we do and we don't have to think for ourselves.
- 6:55Leaders matter in co-operation with us.
- 6:57It's a collaboration.
- 6:59It's a working together.
- 7:00They have their part, we have ours.
- 7:03It's not this model where the leader is doing all the active work and the the the sheep are passive and we do nothing.
- 7:10We just listen.
- 7:12That's not the model.
- 7:14It's, it's co-operative.
- 7:16God blesses the leaders with an insight with knowledge that he wants to get to his people.
- 7:22The leaders teach that the people hear it, they go and they search for themselves.
- 7:28They put two and two together, they see more things, they bring their insights and it's a collaborate, an active collaboration of both parties because this is coming from God.
- 7:41So we don't, we don't want to dismiss leaders.
- 7:43We don't want to make it seem like leaders don't matter.
- 7:46And I would encourage you to listen to deacon Jan's messages on leaders matter very, very good, but they matter because it's now collaborative.
- 7:54We need our leaders but we have responsibility as well.
- 8:01He says for precept must be upon precept, precept, upon precept, line upon line, line upon line here a little and there a little.
- 8:20This is a puzzle.
- 8:23This the the, the, the knowledge that God wants to give us is actually a mystery and it's hidden and it's not for the superficial, it's not for somebody who doesn't really care.
- 8:38This knowledge is accessed only through effort and constant digging and staying with it.
- 8:45And we're in Ezekiel now, but we haven't forgotten what Isaiah says.
- 8:51And as we're remembering what Isaiah says, we're, we're linking that to revelation and remembering what the Lord taught because it's only by putting it all together that we really understand the Lord's will and the Lord's word, it's active and everyone else, they have no idea the wise will understand, but the wicked will have no idea for precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept, line upon line, line upon line here a little and there a little for with stammering lips and another tongue.

- 9:27Will he speak to this people?
- 9:30In other words, he's deliberately making it inaccessible or hard to, I should say inaccessible because it is accessible.
- 9:38It's just really hard and you have to be driven by the spirit and, and, and have a have a work ethic to get at it and then to whom much is given or to whom, who he, who has more will be given.
- 9:53But then to whom much is given, there'll be great expectation to whom he said, this is the rest wherewith you may cause the weary to rest.
- 10:04This, this is where we have peace and this is the refreshing yet.
- 10:09They wouldn't hear the, you, you want peace.
- 10:11You want to hear good news.
- 10:12This is where you'll find it, but they don't care about this.
- 10:15They don't want this, but the word of the Lord was unto them, precept upon precept this, this, it's this packaging that hides it from them.
- 10:28So we, they were, they were told this is where you'll find peace.
- 10:31They don't want it.
- 10:33So the word of the Lord was upon to them, precept upon precept, precept upon precept, line upon line, line upon line here a little and there a little.
- 10:42Why was it packaged like this?
- 10:44That they might go and fall backward and be broken and snared and take him that they, they will be deaf, dumb and blind.
- 10:56The wax of this.
- 10:57The heart of this people will wax fat, they'll have eyes to see, but they won't see ears to hear, but they won't hear why?
- 11:05So that all of these curses might come upon them and they'll know that the Lord is God.
- 11:10When everything he says comes, comes to light, we cannot be like this brethren.
- 11:15We have to be seeking out as I know we are putting it together line upon line, precept upon precept.
- 11:21This is not something that makes it inaccessible.
- 11:24It just makes it harder.
- 11:25We have to work a bit harder where hear the word of the Lord.
- 11:29You scornful man, you, you scornful man that rule this people which is in Jerusalem, you scornful men that rule this people, which is in Jerusalem that, that are blocking them from repentance, giving them false teaching, deceiving them about Jerusalem.
- 11:48Because you have said we have made a covenant with death and with hell are we at agreement?
- 11:56In, in other words, they no harm will come upon them that you can look at what happened on October 7th.
- 12:02And we don't have to worry about that because we, we have a covenant with death and with the grave, we are in agreement.
- 12:08When the overflowing scourge shall pass through, it shall not come unto us.
- 12:14So, yeah, you know, Hamas and Hezbollah and all this evil can come upon the land.
- 12:18It won't come unto us.
- 12:19We're, we, we've made a covenant at the elite level.

- 12:22We're actually negotiating with these people.
- 12:24We meet with these people behind closed doors and we allow them to do certain things and not, and we agree they won't do others.
- 12:31So we're cool.
- 12:32We're good.
- 12:32We'll just give the people false hope when the overflowing scourge, this, this army of, of devastation and desolation will pass through.
- 12:44So they know it's coming.
- 12:46But when it comes, we'll somehow we'll be fine.
- 12:50It's like what we saw in Lahaina, in, in, in Maui, in Hawaii, this, this overflowing scourge and somehow the elite refined, they didn't suffer it.
- 13:03It's, it's like that it won't come unto us for.
- 13:08We have made lies, our refuge and under falsehood, we have hid ourselves.
- 13:13I didn't write this.
- 13:16This is God's evaluation of his own people, of the leaders of his people.
- 13:21Now, regarding the leaders of the spiritual covenant community, Christ even warns us there and he says, but, and if that evil servant, the priest shall say in his heart, my Lord delays his coming, which which we could do.
- 13:44You know, I'm, I'm looking now at what's happening in the Middle East.
- 13:48And if we're saying no, no, no, it has to be Germany.
- 13:52It has to be Germany.
- 13:53We're, we're waiting for a resurrected Germany and Roman Empire.
- 13:57We'll just, we'll just hang out here and wait.
- 13:59So everything that's happening now.
- 14:00No cause for alarm.
- 14:02This, this is not it because look at the state of Germany completely given itself over to sodomy.
- 14:08Completely given itself over to de I completely given itself over to ca car net net zero climate carbon reducing carbon footprint, completely given itself over to de deindustrialization.
- 14:25Completely given itself over to weakening its military and destroying the, the European, the entire European economy.

- 0:05Completely given itself over to de I completely given itself over to ca car net net zero climate carbon reducing carbon footprint.
- 0:17Completely given itself over to de deindustrialization.
- 0:22Completely given itself over to weakening its military and destroying the, the European the entire European economy because Germany is the economic engine of Europe, completely opening its borders and letting in all of these people who, who are, who are antithetical to Christian values.
- 0:43But let's just keep waiting for them to rise up and let's not be worried about what's happening today in Jerusalem.
- 0:49So, so it can be, you know, my mom would just say to me when I was a young boy, look both ways before you cross the road.

- 0:57So yeah, we're gonna look west, but we'll also look east just in case something's coming from that way as well.
- 1:02No, I'm only looking west.
- 1:04I don't care.
- 1:04I don't care.
- 1:05I'm gonna cross the road only looking west because I know it's coming from the west.
- 1:12Look both ways.
- 1:14So it's possible that we have even despite all the warning signs, we just don't think it's the time yet.
- 1:22My Lord delays is coming.
- 1:24And then because of that false doctrine, that false vision that, that, that poor ideology, that poor understanding that getting drunk on wine and strong drink and erring out of the way.
- 1:40Then the urgency isn't there and the leader shall begin to smite his fellow servants say we're in this together.
- 1:47Why are you smiting us?
- 1:48Why are we smiting each other and shall begin to smite his fellow servants and to eat and drink with the drunken.
- 1:59This strong drink, this strong Babylonian wine, it's intense and it's everywhere.
- 2:07It's in all nations among all peoples.
- 2:13And it's just so much easier to drink of that cup and spread that doctrine and just just fit in and go along with it and accept these Babylonian institutions as, as having credibility and be and becoming a voice for them amongst the people of God, bringing their voice into the covenant community.
- 2:38That's the easy path.
- 2:41But because it's in contradiction, because the Babylonian spirit is in contradiction to God's spirit.
- 2:49Then if we, if we drink from that cup, we are automatically in contradiction to God's people.
- 2:58And now because of that contradiction, there's a bit of smiting that goes on and God doesn't, doesn't approve at all.
- 3:10So begin to smite his fellow servants because we, we've lost our vision here.
- 3:13We've lost our way.
- 3:15We're out of the way and to eat and drink with the drunken, the Lord of that servant shall come in a day when he looks not for him and in an hour that he's not aware of.
- 3:25So this whole thing in Matthew 24 is about not being deceived, keeping eyes on Jerusalem, understanding the season that we're in and being in the will of God and not being out of the way and getting swept up with the world and the prophets are doing this.
- 3:45Christ told us the prophets would do this back to Ezekiel.
- 3:50He says, speaking of the prophets because even because they've seduced my people, the people need to repent, the people need to acknowledge their, their abomination and their filth.
- 4:07But you've given them smooth talk and you've seduced my people saying peace, it's all gonna be ok.
- 4:15Look at our military power, we're gonna get them back.
- 4:18We're, it's all gonna be good.

- 4:20You have nothing to worry about.
- 4:21I'm here to protect you.
- 4:24They've seduced my people.
- 4:26God has declared desolation.
- 4:28Who are you to say?
- 4:29No?
- 4:29The desolation is not coming because even because they've seduced my people saying peace when there was no peace, the, the the condition, in fact, the opposite is there, the conditions for desolation, that's what's there.
- 4:48And they're looking at these conditions for desolation and because they're like jackals amongst the desolation, looking for what they can get what little wealth they can gather, what, what power they can gather for themselves.
- 5:00They're telling the people peace.
- 5:01They want to hold on to this and one built up a wall and low others daubed it with untempered mortar.
- 5:11So this is metaphorical language.
- 5:15But I think we understand that through human effort, they're putting something together.
- 5:23But the, the mortar is not good, it's not good mortar, it's not going to hold.
- 5:29So they're building up this wall, the sense of protection, but the enemy will have no problem tearing it down and you're giving the people a sense of peace with something that cannot bring protection.
- 5:43Isaiah says, again, we're looking are the conditions for peace there.
- 5:49You're going to pollute the high holy day with absolutely no regard for God.
- 5:59Does that make for peace?
- 6:02Isaiah 5721 says, there is no peace, says my God to the wicked.
- 6:09So this is our message to Judah to the house of Israel.
- 6:14There's no peace to the wicked.
- 6:17If you are engaged in abomination, if you reject Jesus Christ, there's no peace says my God to the wicked.
- 6:28You have to repent if you want peace.
- 6:30The others are just this, this wall that they're building up this false sense of security and, and the mortar isn't even prepared to hold the wall to get, it can barely hold the wall together.
- 6:43Never mind.
- 6:44When the, when the wall is attacked, Jeremiah says in 23 verse seven, they say still unto them that despise me.
- 6:54That's exactly what we see.
- 6:55Prime Minister Netanyahu doing.
- 6:58Watching the people despise God.
- 7:00And then saying still it's all good, it's all OK.
- 7:03I'll protect you.
- 7:04II, I will bring Isaias the prophecy of Isaiah 60.
- 7:08I will bring it to pass because of the eternal, the, the eternal nature of the Jewish people.
- 7:15We don't need to repent.

- 7:17They say still unto them that despise me.
- 7:21The Lord has said, you shall have peace and they say unto everyone that walks after the imagination of their own heart, doing all kinds of abomination and debauchery all night long. 7:35And they say unto them, no evil shall come upon you.
- 7:39I I will protect you in in chapter 14 of Jeremiah verse 13, he said, then said, I Lord God behold the prophet say unto them, you shall not see the sword, neither shall you have famine, but I will give you a shared peace in this place.
- 7:59Then the Lord said unto me, the prof prophesy lies in my name.
- 8:05I sent them not what neither have I commanded them, neither spoke.
- 8:10They prophesy unto you a false vision and divination and a thing of nothing and deceit of their heart.
- 8:19Therefore, thus says the Lord concerning the prophets that prophesy in my name and I sent them not, they, they coaching Isaiah and I didn't, I didn't say I, that, that is a misinterpretation of what I spoke through.
- 8:35Isaiah.
- 8:36I sent them not yet.
- 8:38They say sword and famine shall not be in this land by sword.
- 8:44And famine shall those prophets be destroyed?
- 8:48So, so II I hate it.
- 8:49It's sad for me to say this, but the sword is going to behead these profits and the economy is going to collapse and cause these same people who are seeking wealth among the desolation to starve to death.
- 9:08So says the Lord I it's it, this is the sad reality.
- 9:14It's not smooth, it's rough, especially when you see what these people are going through just to, to not offer relief to say, yeah, this is horrendous.
- 9:25It's demonic.
- 9:26Stay tuned more to come unless you repent.
- 9:32Jeremiah eight verse seven.
- 9:34For they have healed the hurt of the daughter of my people.
- 9:38October 7th 2023 was traumatic.
- 9:43And now here come the healers, they've healed the hurt of the daughter of my people slightly saying peace, peace.
- 9:52When there is no peace, the conditions for peace are not there in in fact, they themselves are destroying any opportunity for peace because they're diluting the call for repentance.
- 10:07Were they ashamed when they had committed abomination when they're desecrating the high holy day and committing abomination all night long?
- 10:18Were they ashamed?
- 10:20No, they were not at all ashamed.
- 10:23Neither could they even blush.
- 10:26Therefore, shall they fall among them that fall in the time of their visitation?
- 10:32They shall be cast down.
- 10:34Saith the Lord.
- 10:35This is the future of Jerusalem.
- 10:37This is the future of Judah.

- 10:39Unless they repent, we can't just say, oh, it's young people just having fun.
- 10:44This is the covenant community with an obligation to God in the holy land.
- 10:50Verse 15, we looked for peace but no good came and for a time of health and behold trouble back to Ezekiel verse 11.
- 11:08Say unto them, this is God's message to them as they have this patchwork of trying to put things back together.
- 11:16Say unto them which daub it with untempered mortar.
- 11:20This this mortar they're using has not been through the conditions that it will hold.
- 11:28Say unto them which daub it with untempered mortar that it shall fall, it shall fall.
- 11:35You're going up against the word of God.
- 11:38So you've got all the technology, you've got all the money pouring in whatever you think you have.
- 11:42What you don't have is the word of God.
- 11:46And we're telling you from the authority of the word of God, all of your efforts for peace shall fail.
- 11:53Send to them which daubed with untempered mortar that it shall fall.
- 11:57There shall be an overflowing shower and you, oh great hailstones shall fall and a stormy wind shall end it.
- 12:07And even when you think of this overflowing shower, you can almost picture the, the paraglider coming in with their terrorism more to come.
- 12:16Stay tuned more to come and no defense can save these people except repentance.
- 12:24That's the only defense and that's the last thing they're pursuing.
- 12:28They're daubing the wall with untempered mortar trying to build up a, a protection not in God.
- 12:34It has echoes of Christ's warning in Matthew seven and verse 27 that when this rain or God describes it here as a stormy wind and hail great hailstones.
- 12:46When this storm descends and the floods came and the winds blew and beat upon that house that was prophesized to be left, desolate, it fell and great was the fall of it.
- 13:00This is the future of Jerusalem.
- 13:02Let no man deceive you.
- 13:04They cannot go up against the word of God, no matter what they do, no matter what alliances they make, no matter what technology, iron dome, whatever technology they have, all of it will fail.
- 13:14It's all untempered mortar.
- 13:17Ezekiel 13 verse 12 low.
- 13:21When the wall is fallen, shall it not be set unto you?
- 13:25Where is the daubing wherewith you adopted?
- 13:28You were so confident what happened.
- 13:31Therefore, thus says the Lord God, I God, this, this is why we know that it will fail because God has an agenda and God has a will and he says in verse 13.
- 13:42Therefore, thus says the Lord God, I will even tear it with a stormy wind in my fury.
- 13:48God is the one sending the stormy wind.
- 13:52God is the one allowing Satan to have his way.

- 13:55This absolute demonic attack on October 7th that came out of the imagination of the devil and went into human minds.
- 14:04God allowed it.
- 14:06God authorized it God orchestrated it to drive His people to repentance.
- 14:11Moses told us this in Deuteronomy 30 that the enemy, in fact, Deuteronomy 28 and 29 and 30 the enemy will the God Israel's enemies will be used by God to destroy her.

- 0:41So God says, I will rend it with a stormy wind in my fury and there shall be an overflowing shower in my anger.
- 0:50So that iron dome is this phenomenal technology.
- 0:54It really wasn't built to defend itself against 7000 at bombs at once.
- 1:01Missiles at once more to come.
- 1:05There is no technology that can prevent what's coming.
- 1:10I will tear it with a stormy wind in my fury.
- 1:14You're going to desecrate the high holy day.
- 1:16God is furious with his people and there shall be an overflowing shower in my anger and you're gonna stand up there and say peace, peace and God is furious and great hailstones in my fury to destroy it.
- 1:32So will I break down the wall that you have dogged with untempered mortar, mortar that has nothing to do with God and bring it down to the ground so that the foundation thereof shall be discovered?
- 1:45So when there's no wall and there's no protection, the enemies can come in of their way and it shall fall and you shall be destroyed in the midst thereof has echoes of Zechariah 14 1.
- 1:59And then you will know and you shall know that I am Jehovah, I am Jehovah, Isaiah 30 verse nine, Isaiah says that this is a rebellious people.
- 2:18These people that call themselves the people of God that, that they, they are in covenant with God through Isaiah.
- 2:26God says this is a rebellious people.
- 2:29They're against God, lying Children, Children that will not hear the law of the Lord.
- 2:37They want to wax eloquent quoting Isaiah, but they don't want to hear the law of the Lord which say to the seers, see not and to the prophets prophesy, not unto us right things.
- 2:49They don't want to hear this.
- 2:51They don't want to hear Ezekiel, they don't wanna hear Jeremiah, they don't wanna hear Isaiah, they don't wanna hear Micah, they wanna hear their own imagination of how wonderful everything is and how they're the people of God which say to the seer sa we don't want, you don't, don't see that stuff and to the prophets, prophesy, not unto his right thing, speak unto us smooth things, prophesy deceits.
- 3:16And Christ tells us be not deceived, take, take, beware, take heed that you be not deceived. 3:23Why?
- 3:23Because this is the agenda to lull the people into sleep to give them smooth things.
- 3:31They don't want the rough things.
- 3:33God's word is rough.
- 3:35We've got to be loyal and faithful to it.
- 3:38Speak unto us.

- 3:39Smooth things.
- 3:40Tell us what we want to hear.
- 3:41Prophesy deceits, get you out of the way.
- 3:45They're, they're actually telling us, get out of God's way.
- 3:49Don't do bring us the Torah turn aside out of the, the path of the Torah.
- 3:54Let's have nicey, nicey popular things cause the holy one of Israel to cease from before us.
- 4:02We don't want to hear that stuff.
- 4:04Oh That's all old testament.
- 4:06We don't want to hear that.
- 4:07Give us a nice soft Jesus Ezekiel 13 verse 15.
- 4:13Thus, will I accomplish this is how I will accomplish my wrath upon the wall.
- 4:18So God isn't just angry with the people.
- 4:20He's angry with the wall that the people have constructed and he's going to accomplish his wrath upon the wall and upon them in addition to the wall upon them that have daubed it with untempered mortar.
- 4:34You think you can build this up without God.
- 4:37So God's wrath is gonna come upon the wall and upon the people that built it and will say to you the wall is no more.
- 4:48There's no more wall, neither they that do it.
- 4:52Both are gone to wit the prophets of Israel, which prophesy concerning Jerusalem again, House of Israel House of Judah synonymous in this context.
- 5:08And they're prophesying concerning Jerusalem.
- 5:11And Christ says to us, beware, take heed that you be not deceived.
- 5:18Many false prophets shall arise.
- 5:21And they're going to prophesy concerning Jerusalem to wit the prophets of Israel which prophesy concerning Jerusalem and which see visions of peace for her.
- 5:31Take heed Matthew 23 your house is left unto you desolate.
- 5:38And now now they're coming along to say they see visions of peace which see visions of peace for her and there is no peace, there's no peace to the wicked says the Lord likewise.
- 5:51So that's one set of profits that Isaiah is prophesying against.
- 5:58Now, there's a second set.
- 6:00He says in the same way, son of man, set your face against the doctors of my people.
- 6:10So now the women are involved and they're up to mischief as well.
- 6:15So now set your face against them which prophesy out of their own heart and prophesy you against them.
- 6:24So this is a time of, of feminine leadership and the and the feminization of the nation and not prophesy against them as well.
- 6:35Say thus saith for God woe to the women that so pillows to all armholes.
- 6:45I don't know, don't, don't ask me, I don't know, it's a reference of some sort of magical activity that the women of Jerusalem and the leaders in Jerusalem were involved in and giving false reassurance.
- 7:03So again, we can just take it as a symbolic of an intervention that is not from God and that is leaning on dark arts woe to the women that se pillows to all her arm holes and make kerchiefs upon the head of every stature with the purpose of hunting soul.

- 7:26So they're deceiving the people around some sort of dark arts and the people are falling for it and falling into destruction.
- 7:38Will you hunt the souls of my people and will you save the souls alive that come unto you?
- 7:45Isaiah says as for my people, chapter three verse 12, Children are their oppressors and women rule over them.
- 7:55This is the state of the nation, the the the leader, the masculine leadership has been lost.
- 8:02It's been neutralized and now Children are in charge and women are in charge.
- 8:09And there's been a emasculation of the nation as for my people, Children of their oppressors and women rule over them.
- 8:17All my people.
- 8:19They which lead you the women and the Children cause you to err and destroy the way of your paths.
- 8:26Verse 17, therefore, the Lord will smite with a scab the crown of the head of the daughters of Zion and the Lord will discover their secret parts.
- 8:38So God is against the women and I just thought I should check the chat to make sure that I have been frozen.
- 8:45And, we're still good.
- 8:48Yes, looks like I don't see any issue there.
- 8:52Very good.
- 8:53So, yes.
- 8:58So the women of Judah are antithetical to God's will and now Ezekiel is crying out against them.
- 9:08Verse 19.
- 9:10Will you pollute me among my people for handfuls of barley and for pieces of bread.
- 9:17So again, these are like the jackals just looking for what they can get for themselves.
- 9:22Even at the cost of polluting God's people to slay the souls that should not die and to save.
- 9:32So the souls alive that should not live.
- 9:34It's all upside down.
- 9:36So the people who are preaching the true gospel, thanks Pastor Murray, the people that are preaching the true gospel.
- 9:44They're the ones that are being put to death and the ones that are involved in abomination.
- 9:50They're the ones that are allowing to live by your lying to my people that hear your lies.
- 9:56Wherefore thus says the Lord God behold, I'm against your pillows.
- 10:01I'm against your magic.
- 10:03Where with you there hunt the souls to make them fly or to make them flourish, to make them prosper.
- 10:10And I will tear them from your arms and I will let the souls go.
- 10:15Even the souls that you hunt to make them fly.
- 10:18You're trying to somehow make them prosper with your magic and you're destroying them and God is gonna release them from all of that, your kerchiefs also will I tear and deliver my people out of your hand and they shall be no more in your hand to be hunted and you shall know, excuse me, excuse me, you shall know that I am the Lord.
- 10:43And so this God just keeps repeating this.

- 10:45They don't know that he's the Lord, but they're gonna be driven to this place where eventually they will say blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.
- 10:55Because finally, they know the Lord and they'll be able to teach the Lord, but they're not there right now.
- 11:02They don't know the Lord right now because with lies, you have made the heart of the righteous sad whom I've not made sad.
- 11:13So the righteous who understands the word of God and wants to preach the word of God.
- 11:18You've made him sad.
- 11:20And at the same time, you've strengthened the hands of the wicked.
- 11:24You're drunk with wine, you're full of strong drink.
- 11:30You've wandered out of the way.
- 11:33You're, you're, you're drinking wine with those that are intoxicated with the drunken and you're siding with them and you're strengthening their hands and then you're making the people of God sad.
- 11:50When God hasn't made them sad, you strengthen the hands of the wicked that he should not return from his wicked way, instead of shouting out against the wicked, instead of proclaiming God's judgment on the wicked, you're siding with them.
- 12:06So that he doesn't repent.
- 12:08You're neutralizing the call for repentance and this is what God hates you.
- 12:14You're calling for peace and giving the people a false sense of security.
- 12:19So they do not return from his wicked way by promising him life.
- 12:23It's all good.
- 12:24I'm gonna take care of everything.
- 12:25Everything's gonna be fine.
- 12:27We're the people of God.
- 12:29Therefore, you shall see no more vanity nor divine divinations for.
- 12:37I will deliver my people out of your hand and you shall know that I am the Lord.
- 12:46So they don't know that he's the Lord.
- 12:50But eventually they're going to know because somebody is preaching the gospel in the name of the Lord and teaching the true meaning of the name of Jehovah and the covenant.
- 13:03And whoever is doing that God says in Matthew 24 and verse nine, then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted because they don't know the Lord and they shall kill you.
- 13:12You'll be hated of all nations, even Judah and you shall be hated of all nations including Judah for my names sake.
- 13:23There's something we understand about the name of God, its connection to his covenant faithfulness.
- 13:30And we preach in a way that makes everybody unhappy because we preach right down the line, neither to the left nor the right.
- 13:40We're not here to please men.
- 13:42We're here to please God.
- 13:44So that is Isaiah sorry, Ezekiel chapter 13 and God is just gearing up with his judgments.
- 13:54Now, we've seen the evaluation.
- 13:57Now, the judgments are coming and it's gonna be intense and it's all upon Judah.
- 14:02And this is our message to do to Judah.

- 14:05You've been, you've been weighed in the balance and found wanting.
- 14:09And then God is gonna use the enemies of Judah to destroy her to bring down all of her protection and to absolutely bring them to desolation.
- 14:19But then God has judgments about these nations that He'll use all the surrounding Islamic nations that God will use to unleash the sword on Jerusalem.
