30-Amos-04-Transcript [Music] so [Music] [Applause] [Music] well good evening brethren and welcome to another wednesday night bible study where we do study the scripture line upon line this week we will cover god willing chapter 4 of the book of amos hopefully i'm coming through loudly and clearly maybe uh somebody could just go ahead and confirm that in the chat let's begin with a word of prayer our loving heavenly father we come before your throne we're just ever so grateful father that we have this relationship with you that we've been grafted into this covenant and that we can call upon you and that we are guided by you we thank you god for your word we thank you for the prophets and we thank you most of all for jesus christ in whose name we pray amen so we are audio pastor murray thank you very much uh so we are up to amos chapter four i just want to go back uh to chapter three just for a bit of continuity and uh just before i do that some of you have been asking about my sermon on sabbath um that was actually taken down it's entitled closer than a brother and we do have a local copy so if you wanted to review it or you have not heard it and wanted to hear it you just write to me directly adrian davis at cgicanada.org and i can send you a copy of that sermon

but it's not it's not available on our platforms so let's get into amos chapter four i'll go ahead and share my screen here and back in chapter three god poses this question to israel can two walk together except they be agreed and this really is the the gist of the the problem the issue with israel that god and israel do not agree more specifically israel israel has turned their back on god so the agreement goes back to exodus 19 and verse 8 that when moses was given the covenant and the law all the people answered together and said all that the lord has spoken we will do and moses returned the words of the people unto the lord so they at this point when the nation was was founded they were in agreement and they could walk together but something as terrible has happened and israel no longer agrees with god so god goes on in chapter three last week we looked at this and he makes this very chilling very chilling statement will a lion roar in the forest when he has no prey is it will a lion do that will a lion just roar in vain or does a lion roar when it's in in the process of the take down will a young lion cry out of his den if he has taken nothing this is chilling this is telling us that not only do israel and god not agree but they have become enemies and god is going to destroy personally destroy israel the god of israel is going to personally

destroy israel that's what this is saying verse 5 can a bird fall in the snare upon the earth where no trap is for him shall one take up a snare from the earth and have taken nothing at all so think about it if there's a trap set it's going to catch its prey and god has set a trap for israel now this snare christ speaks of in the end time we know that amos although there was an immediate application of his prophecies we know that there is a an end time application of the prophecies and in fact when we get to amos 9 none of those prophecies in amos 9 have taken place they are clearly pointing to the millennial future so christ speaking of this snare in luke 21 and verse 35 he says for as a snare shall it come on all them that dwell on the face of the whole earth and we know in in matthew 25 the church falls asleep so this snare is global and it affects everybody and yet the prophets will give us indications if we are willing to listen if we're not going to censor them so here in amos 3 and verse 6 he says shall a trumpet be blown in the city and the people not be afraid this is a warning signal a very definite warning that god is at war with his people and shouldn't the people be afraid in fact people today god's people are more afraid of their shadow than they are of

the almighty god and the people should not be afraid shall there be e calamity in a city and the lord has not done it so this this is something that we really have to come to terms with that it's it's comforting to say you know jesus loves everybody jesus loves me this i know for the bible tells me so and just have this syrupy and superficial understanding of christ or we can study his word and understand in every page in the bible we can come to understand his character and here in amos 3 or the book of amos the scroll of amos we can really understand his character and his expectations of his people so calamity is coming upon our cities and god is telling us that when we see this type of calamity he's behind it surely the lord god will do nothing reveals his secret unto his servants the prophets so today we don't have to be prophets but we have to honor the writings of the prophets and we have to dig deep and go into it and understand and not censor what the prophets are saying especially when christ says this snare is going to be global so when we see developments that are global it's antithetical to the scriptures to not speak about them the the god expects us to search the scriptures

to have a prophetic view of global developments and to share that with his people so that they can take warning in fact in amos 2 where we were two weeks ago speaking so he says that he doesn't do anything unless he reveals it first to his prophets so so his will is known if we're willing to dig for it in the prophets but in amos 2 and verse 11 he says this to israel that i raised up of your sons for prophets and your young men for nazarites he created this nation he founded this nation and then he developed people within the nation to be his spokesman to speak for him to communicate his will and he says isn't this isn't it even so are you children of israel do you not agree that i did this that i raised up your own sons for prophets says the lord but what did you do were you grateful did you pursue an understanding of did you did you understand that he reveals his secrets to the prophets and that as global developments take place you can search the scriptures to understand what god is doing so did you honor the word of the prophets or did you censor the prophets but you gave the nazirites wine to drink you wanted them to be drunk like you and you commanded the prophets saying prophesy not and in fact this is what i was talking about on sabbath when i was talking about mass formation that israel here is clearly falling victim to mass formation or group think and and what we need to break the spell

of mass formation is mass formation is a form of mass hypnosis and it is carried out through the spoken word it's it's narrative in the spoken word repeated over and over and that everybody gets swept up in it and what it needs in order for that spell to be broken is people who will stand up and provide a counter narrative and that's exactly what the prophets did they provided a counter narrative the kings of israel couldn't just have their way they couldn't just the government of the day couldn't just do as it pleases and all the people just agree with the government because the prophets stood up and they were not afraid of the government the prophet stood up and provided a counter narrative to break the spell of mass hypnosis but you said prophesy not because you have a narrative that is weak that cannot stand up to the scrutiny of the light of day and so because your narrative is weak you rely on censorship and so you say to the prophets prophesy not how does god respond to this censorship to to obstructing the counter-narrative that can only be brought by the prophets how does god respond he says behold i am pressed under you as a cart is pressed that is full of sheaves in other words when you oppress the people and you oppress the prophets it's like when christ said to paul why

are you persecuting me here when they're oppressing the prophets god is saying you're oppressing me i'm trying to speak to my people through the prophets and you're censoring them and you're oppressing me back to amos 3 and verse 8 again very chilling words we want to understand the character of christ he says the lion has roared you know we know that the lion doesn't just roar in vain the lion has roar god has roared the takedown is about to happen so who will not fear well those who are subject to mass formation those who are subject to mass hypnosis they won't fear they'll fear something else they won't fear god because they're not hearing the counter narrative but god wants his prophets to communicate what the roar means the lion has roared who will not fear the lord god has spoken who can but prophesy so although there was a lot of censors a very sensorious culture the kings were the government of the day was trying to have its way and and suppressing the counter-narrative that could come from the prophets but here amos who was a a farmer is saying god spoken god has spoken we have to prophesy we we have to communicate what god has spoken regardless of censorship here in 1st corinthians 9 and verse 16 paul

in very much the same spirit says for though i preached the gospel that's what he was doing preaching the gospel i have nothing to glory of oh great job paul you're so courageous paul is saying no nothing to glory of here for necessity is laid upon me yeah woe is unto me if i preach not the gospel that the lord god has spoken who cannot but preach who cannot but prophesy when god speaks

and he says in fact that if you

are ashamed of me before men

i'll be ashamed of you before my father so so we cannot help we you know the church

like the prophets of old

should be that counter narrative

and that if the church was doing this decades ago

society wouldn't be in the ruin that it is in today

but but the church had a noose put around its neck and in order not to lose you know charitable status and uh you know get along with the government uh the churches and i don't mean just the church of god churches in general around the world the christian church generally speaking

has become very weak but paul is saying woe unto me

if i preach not the gospel and woe unto all of us if we do not speak what god has spoken so with that as backdrop let's come into now amos chapter 4 and what is fascinating about amos 4

is the fact that he goes to root cause this situation that israel has found itself in

where it's actually oppressing god god says you're oppressing me and we

don't agree anymore amos goes to root cause here in chapter four he says this hear this word you cows of bashan he's quite biting you cows of bashan that are in the mountain of samaria which oppress the poor SO he is calling the rich women of israel the the women in the elite role within israel he's calling them fat cows you fat cows bashan is a very rich fertile land and you are the fat cows of bashan that's what he calls them and now he's getting to the root cause of the oppression that when you see you know this this centurious culture within israel even though it might be the king that's issuing the edicts what what amos is showing is it's the women it's the wives that are actually behind this and the king and the you think of that king what was his name uh married to jezebel um i'm thinking of ahaz but i don't think it was ahaz it was uh anyway somebody could type that in the chat uh jezebel's husband who he's the king but she's in control and this is what amos is showing that it is the elite women that are behind the oppression you fat cows of bashan he calls them that are in the mountain of samaria which oppress the poor you're doing this you you women you're doing this which oppress the poor which crush the needy which say to their masters or their

husbands bring and let us drink so they're clearly oh king ahab thank you thank you so clearly it's just a moment there i couldn't remember the name uh yeah so king ahab he's the king he's issuing the edicts he's censoring things but it's actually jezebel that's the power behind the throne so sometimes we have to see behind or or see reality behind the the image and here uh amos points to it you fat cows of bashan that are in the mountain of samaria which oppress the poor which crushed the needy and then you say to your husbands hey you come come bring bring a lettuce drink who clearly who's in control it's the women it's the wives 42 the lord god has sworn by his holiness so this is serious now this is what he swears by his holiness that lo the days shall come upon you that he will take you away with hooks this is a prophecy to specifically to the root cause this is a prophecy to the fat cows of bashan this is a prophecy to the women who are who are clearly pursuing their comfort their own comfort and in the process oppressing god's people and controlling their husbands the lord god has sworn in his holiness that lo the day shall come upon you that he will take you away with hooks and your posterity with fish hooks this is god's prophecy this is what's coming and you shall go out at the breaches every cow

at that which is before her and you shall cast them into the palace says the lord so you get this image of the cows just being led out in almost like a single file in a very orderly fashion and they have no choice now somebody they were oppressing and now somebody more powerful has come and is oppressing them and taking them captive then he says this come to bethel and transgress at gilgal multiply transgression and bring your sacrifices every morning and your tithes after three years and i don't know why the english says years the hebrew actually says yum three days so so hey you're so righteous do this every three days and a real bite of sarcasm here but he says and there's actually seven things here to come and transgress multiply transgression uh bring your sacrifices uh your tithes and you'll go on and count a few more things so we see seven things that they're involved in and it's all a charade so seven being the number of completeness it's a complete charade and this is this is speaking to the religious leaders the church of the day and so if we look for an end time application of this as god's church we cannot be complacent as god's church we need to say are we putting on a charade is this sort of you know hey we keep the sabbath but that's about all we do we're not willing to take a stand we're not willing to speak the voice of the prophets we just want to get along with

atheistic government and we just want to play religion and so bethel here in um if we look at bethel and gilgal in 1st kings 12 32 bethel was established by jeroboam and jeroboam ordained a feast in the 8th month on the 15th day of the month like unto the feast that is in judah this is speaking of the feast of tabernacles and he offered upon the altar pretending he's the high priest so did he in bethel so he established bethel as the religious center for samaria

sacrificing unto the cavs that he had made and he placed in bethel the priests of the high places which he had made so it's this whole uh counterfeit religion that they practiced wholeheartedly and felt very good about themselves because of their religiosity

with respect to gilgal joshua 5 verse 9 and the lord said to joshua this day have i rolled away the reproach of egypt from off you wherefore the name of the place is called gilgal unto this day so gilgal was another prominent location within samaria or the northern tribes and so uh so go ahead and play this religious game and the prophet continues and offer a sacrifice of thanksgiving with levin and proclaim and publish the free offerings

why

because you love to do this you love this religiosity you love to feel good about yourself that you're a righteous person because you know you you do these rituals but

your heart

really isn't in it

and you're completely unwilling to

experience any discomfort any inconvenience in standing up for god you you would rather just pursue the path of least resistance but at the same time you want to appear religious and so god says through amos to israel you love to do this you you love to play the hypocrite you love the the superficial appearance o you children of israel says the lord god and now the judgment and i also have given you cleanness of teeth in all your cities so that's just a way of saying hunger that if you're if your teeth are clean you haven't eaten anything there's nothing to floss right you have a good good steak or lamb or chicken you need to floss afterwards here there's no need to floss because he's given you cleanness of teeth and so it begs the question for us today with all of these supply chain disruptions and and we're just increasingly having trouble to have our goods our our food delivered to retail outlets so that we can just buy as we've always had in the past now it's it's disrupted but is anybody turning to god is anybody saying like wow we need to turn to god nobody can help us here but god or do they just complain and find hey

we're going to solve this we'll look to the president we'll look to the prime ministers we'll look to the kings of the day and they'll help us because they love us and i also have given you cleanness of teeth in all your cities and want of bread in all your places and so we're seeing something like this today globally yet have you not returned unto me says the lord this is the first time he calls them out that the reason he is inflicting this suffering upon them is to get them to turn the hebrew word ishuv to return to repent to turn around and come back to me so so i'm inflicting this suffering upon you but you won't return to me says the lord and this not returning to me goes back to deuteronomy goes back to torah deuteronomy 30 in verse 1. it shall come to pass when all these things are come upon you the blessing and the curse which i've said before you so now amos is giving them the curses and it's not just random curses it is deuteronomic covenant curses and the purpose of these curses is to to cause them to repent and moses is foreseeing this yeah they haven't even gone into the land yet and moses is foreseeing this and saying that both the blessing the deuteronomy the deuteronomic blessing and the deuteronomic curse are going to come upon you you'll start out well but then you'll deviate and then you shall call to mind among the nations where the lord your god has

driven you so god has done this and you shall shoot that as a result of these deuteronomic curses as as stiff-necked as israel is god is just going to keep pounding and pounding and pounding and eventually moses says you shall shoe you shall return unto the lord your god and shall obey his voice according to all that i command you this day you and your children with all your heart and with all your soul that is holy spirit language and so despite israel's stubbornness despite israel's rebellion what moses is saying from the very beginning is eventually god is not going to let up god is going to continue to inflict this suffering until eventually israel will break and return that then the lord your god will turn your captivity and have compassion upon you and he will shoot so you return and then he will return can two walk together unless they agree you've got to change when you change then god will return and gather you from all the nations where according to the curse you've been scattered so this is very deuteronomic language we see in amos and here in isaiah 9 13 he says for the people do not shoot they're not turning unto him that smites them they're stubborn so it's a it's a relationship that israel has with god where he inflicts punishment not to

destroy them but to get them to turn and yet isaiah says they won't turn to him that smites them neither do they seek the lord of hosts so this is what amos now is showing them that the purpose of all of this was to get you to turn but you won't so he goes on and says and also i have withheld the rain from you just from drought when there were yet three months to the harvest so you're looking forward to this great harvest and god spoils it by withholding the rain and i caused it to rain upon one city and caused it not to rain upon another city one piece was rained upon and the peace where upon it rained where it rained not withered so he's definitely showing israel i'm controlling all of this when will you get it when will you turn to me and so he says so two or three cities wandered on one city to drink water so they had to leave their city to go to this other city to drink water but they were not satisfied yet have you not returned unto me says the lord so this is the second time amos says it now so he clearly there's this objective that god has but israel is constantly resisting no matter what god does israel resists their that's how evil they are and and we need to be careful again as as the religious leaders and people are called out in amos's prophecy we should not be so

oh that doesn't reply to us maybe it does maybe it does and maybe some of the things that we are suffering now are opportunities for us to return to the lord wholeheartedly verse 9 i have smitten you with blasting and mildew so again this is not random and i've said many times that if you read the quran because israel disobeyed and broke the sabbath god was so angry that he turned them into apes and pigs well [Music] god lost control he was so angry he lost control and he turned them into apes and pigs that's what that's what muslims believe about jews but where is that in the scripture here when you have a true prophet of god cursing the people it's within the context of moses it's within the context of the torah deuteronomy i have smitten you with blasting and mildew when your gardens and your vineyards and your fig trees and your olive trees increased the palmer worm devoured them yet have you not returned unto me says the lord third time now he's just trying to get them to return but they won't and this this mildew that he cursed them with and we could go into deuteronomy and find all these curses but for example the mildew deuteronomy 28 verse 22 the lord shall smite you with a disease and with a fever and with an inflammation and with extreme burning and with the sword and with blasting and with mildew and they shall pursue you until you perish so these are not just

random curses that amos is just hey god is angry with you and today's going to do this and it's just this capricious god that's just random no it's it's all written that the bible is a complete story complete narrative back to amos 4 and verse 10

i have sent among you the pestilence after the manner of egypt again is this random that the way he uh plagued egypt is now the way he's he plagued egypt to cause his people to escape slavery and now that same way that he plagued egypt he says i'm going to plague israel the same way is that just random you're a young man have i slain with the sword and i've taken away your horses and i've made the stink of your camps to come up unto your nostrils

yet

have you not shove unto me says the lord i just

i'm doing all of this and i just you're just stubborn

instead of acknowledging that i'm the one that is there evil can evil come to a city and the lord calamity come and the lord god has not done it well if you were listening to the prophets you would figure it out well you want to suppress the prophets so now there's some other narrative that's going on and that people don't understand and they're unwilling to change now in deuteronomy 28 and verse 27 the lord will smite you with the botch of egypt this was written god is god is doing everything this shows the faithfulness of god to his covenant everything he does

he never breaks covenant

so israel broke the covenant therefore

that just activated the the covenant curses but god is still governing himself according to the covenant the lord will smite you with the botch of egypt and with the emirates and with the scab and with the itch whereof you cannot be healed but all of this is to drive you to return because he's in covenant with you amos 4 and verse 11. i have overthrown some of you as god overthrew sodom and gomorrah now how sad how depressing you know how how bad that his own people god has to treat them if the filth among his own people he has to treat them like sodom and gomorrah and you were as a firebrand plucked out of the burning yet have you not returned unto me that's the fifth time that all of these things are happening but they're happening so that you'll return to me but you won't you you keep suppressing the prophets so the people can't hear the word of god and they won't they won't repent but this um firebrand plucked out the burning out of the fire that should remind us of zechariah 3 and verse 2. the lord said unto satan the lord rebuke you o satan even the lord that has chosen jerusalem rebuke you is not this a brand plucked out of the fire so you get this impression that god's intention is not to completely destroy his people he'll take them to the edge but his intention is to get them to repent and then he's going to pull them out pull them back as moses prophesied from the beginning verse 12 therefore thus will i do unto you o israel this is

god so we got the root cause was the fat cows of bashan that they're the ones driving the agenda and now here's what god is going to do and the purpose of all of his actions is to get israel to repent but they won't therefore thus will i do unto you o israel and because i will do this unto you prepare to meet your god o israel that is chilling that's not um oh you know prepare to meet your god because he's gonna give you a big hug this is like a military statement get ready i'm gonna do this to you and i'm coming to destroy you so prepare to meet your god your your angry god and god is furious and prepared to meet a furious god for lo he that formed the mountains and created the wind and declares unto man what is his thought that's really fascinating that god will tell us even what we're thinking that makes the morning darkness and treads upon the high places of the earth the lord the god of hosts is his name so that is amos chapter four uh very powerful words of this prophet amos who unlike isaiah was just a common farmer but god raised him up and despite the resistance despite the oppression despite the censorious nation nature of the the culture of the time amos just preached that the lord god has spoken who can but prophesy and these are not smooth

prophecies these are not words that israel wanted to hear and yet hear them they must so we must be faithful like amos like isaiah like the ancient prophets we have their words and somebody has to declare all of this

so that people can can have a counter narrative and not just go along with the global uh mass media narrative but there can be a counter narrative to break the spell

and to cause people to seek their god before it's too late jesus christ is lord brethren god willing will carry on with amos chapter 5 next week what a mighty and faithful god we serve god bless brethren

you
