[Music] well greetings

well greetings brethren and welcome back today we're up to micah chapter five as we're on day five of the feast of tabernacles

hopefully you were with us last night uh last night at 7 30 pm we covered the whole book of micah and i covered uh slightly different content that i'm covering in this series that we're doing daily because we looked at the whole book and the structure of the book

if you happen to miss that can i encourage you to go into the archive and make sure that you study that because it just sort of pulls the whole

book together and you'll understand the structure of the book today we're up to uh micah chapter 5 and let's open with the word of prayer and then we can dive right in our heavenly father again we come before you lord

very very grateful lord for your mercy for your loving kindness for your commitment to your covenant your commitment to your people and we just want to thank you father on this fifth day of the feast for

pulling us out of this world for giving us an understanding of your counsel and giving us a part in this plan

we pray father that we would better understand and appreciate our part in in this great plan of yours and that we would deepen our understanding of your plan and our conviction we praise you lord god almighty and we thank you and we ask your blessing on our understanding and our study now in jesus name's holy name amen

uh micah chapter five we'll just continue here so we're in the midst of the good news and there's just a little uh context for this good news and again i spoke about this context for the good news god really wants his people to understand the state that they've fallen into so that they can appreciate his mercy when he acts in loving kindness micah 5 and verse 1 he says now gather yourself in troops oh daughter of troops so this is uh you know gather yourself in in sort of this uh battle array oh oh daughter of soldiers of this is um kind of pointing to uh israel's or judas how should i say their their departure from god and just depending on themselves and and doing that in a way that is not biblical as against the torah so

now you need to prepare he has laid siege against us and micah includes himself in this he being the assyrian has laid siege against us so not now they're in trouble they shall smite the judge of israel and this is referring to the king of judah with a rod upon the cheek so the king of judah will be thoroughly humiliated and god says this is the deuteronomic curse god says the lord shall bring a nation against you from far this is the curse of disobeying the covenant from the end of the earth as swift as the eagle flies a nation whose tongue thou shalt not understand and that's what's happening

in the midst of all of this
micah has tremendously good news
here is this good news
but you and this is a verse that we're
quite familiar with i think it's on
every christmas card or most christmas
cards back when they used to observe
when they were christians observing
christian christmas he says but you
bethlehem ephrathah
though you be little among the thousands
of judah yet out of you shall come forth
unto me
that is to be ruler in israel

that is to be ruler in israel who is going forth who is going forth have been from old from everlasting so if his goings forth have been from a bold from everlasting this is referring to god

god is going to come out of bethlehem ephrata

now

judah's rulers

have led her astray

but this is god who is going to be ruler in israel now this bethlehem ephrata why is it significant

in genesis 48 and verse 7

jacob says and as for me

when i came from padan

rachel died by me in the land of canaan

in the way

when yet there was but a little way to

come to

ephrath

and i buried her there in the way of

ephrath

the same is bethlehem so rachel was

buried in bethlehem

and then in

1st

samuel 17 so she was buried in bethlehem of judah

in 1st samuel 17 and verse 12

now david was the son of that aphrothite of bethlehem judah whose name was jesse so rachel died in bethlehem judah and was buried there and david was born of jesse who was an ephrathite from bethlehem iudah and he had eight sons and the man went among men for an old man in the days of saul SO the significance of bethlehem judah ephrathah was that david was born there and that's where rachel was buried now this is quoted in the in the gospel according to matthew verse 3 of matthew 2 when herod the king had heard these things he was troubled and all jerusalem with him and when he had gathered all the chief priests and scribes of the people together he demanded of them where the messiah should be born and they said unto him in bethlehem judah for thus it is written by the prophet the prophet being meka micah that we just read so this was written they understood this is amazing right micah because this is before the assyrian siege so that the assyrians crushed samaria in 721 bc and then attacked jude i believe in 701 bc so micah's prophecy predates 721 bc so some 700 plus years before christ was born micah prophesied that he would be born in bethlehem judah this is a phenomena and

they said to herod in bethlehem judah for thus it is written by the prophet and you bethlehem in the land of judah are not the least among the princes of judah for out of you shall come a governor that shall rule my people israel now in john 7 and verse 41 the significance of where christ was born is raised again in the gospel according to john verse 41 of chapter 7 others said this is the messiah

but some said they were they were they were knowledgeable of the scriptures so they were saying this is the messiah but others said shall the messiah come out of galilee that doesn't make any sense hasn't the scripture said so they all believe that he came out of galilee and and the others are disputing this can't be the messiah would the messiah come out of galilee hasn't the scripture said that christ comes of the seed of david and out of the town of bethlehem where david was so when it says the scripture says

that the messiah is to come out of the town of bethlehem they're referring to the scroll of micah now and and uh when it says the of the seed of david this is clearly from when we've read that in isaiah now

back to micah chapter 5 so this glorious prophecy that all of this salvation

is going to be made possible because god is going to come out of bethlehem judah verse 3 micah 5 therefore will he give them up them being judah until the time that she which travails has brought forth then the remnants of his brethren shall

return unto the children of israel so

this sense of her travailing can be dual it's uh it can be he's going to give them up until christ is born of mary

but also

you'll give them up in sort of the ultimate fulfillment when the nation of zion gives birth

to her children and the nation of israel is truly born of god

so isaiah speaks of this in isaiah 66 and verse 7

he says before she travailed she brought forth

before her pain came

she was delivered of a man-child so there isaiah speaks of mary or really judah

isaiah 9 verse 6 unto us son is born the tribe of judah being the one acknowledging that the messiah is born to them so judah is the one that is travailing but specifically it's in mary that she brought forth before her pain came she was deliberate of a man child and then immediately in verse 8 he says the other side of it

who has heard such a thing who has seen such things

shall the earth be made to bring forth in one day

or shall a nation be born at once for as soon as zion travailed matthew 24 all these the beginning of sorrows so zion has to go through these birth pangs

but as soon as she from god's perspective

you know three and a half years is not a long time to an eternal god for as soon as zion travailed she brought forth her children

back to micah verse 5 verse 4 and he shall stand and feed in the

strength of the lord in the majesty of the name of the lord his god this is what messiah will do and they shall abide this is what judah will do judah will be safe every man under his vine with his fig tree

none shall make them afraid because of messiah and they shall abide for now shall he be great unto the ends of the earth and micah told us he's going to rebuke st mighty nations from afar off

and so judah will be safe and this man

shall be the peace this messiah this is how peace will come to judah it's not through all of these negotiations and trying to set up this peace in the middle east that's not how it's going to come

how it's going to come is from this man this man this

this this god being who became a man and who will be on the earth with judah and this man shall be the peace when will he be the peace when the assyrian shall come into our land

and this assyrian of the assyrians obviously crushed samaria and they crushed judah as well but isaiah tells us that it will not be a full end when assyria crushed

judah and they would then be crushed and taken away by the babylonians some couple of hundred years later now

when the so he'll be the peace when the assyrian shall come into our land this is clearly in this prophecy going beyond you know 586 bc in in um

isaiah in micah's immediate prophecy or fulfillment of prophecy uh so they're seven

sorry 701 bc is when the assyrian came into their land this is clearly going beyond that

because this is when christ brings the peace

so the assyrian came into the land and then the babylonians came you know 150 or so years later

and this so there wasn't eternal peace for god's people then so mike is pointing to another time christ said he came to fulfill the prophets to fill it to

so the great tribulation

the full

is when this prophecy will be filled up to the full and so the assyrian will be back

and he will come into the land this is the king of the north this is the assyrian is north of their land and he will come in and when he shall tread in our palaces

so this is this is what's going to happen and then this man shall be the peace

this man this messiah will be the peace but when the assyrian comes into our land and does this and treads in our palaces and sets up the abomination that makes desolate then shall we raise against him seven shepherds and eight principal men not sure exactly what this means but clearly

micah sees a time when judah participates in their own salvation

that god is going to empower them to push back against the assyrian and we see this in zechariah's prophecy

he says in zechariah 12 6 in that day the same end time will i make the governors of judah like a hearth of fire among the wood they will be unstoppable and the wood being the heathen and like a torch of fire in a sheaf and they shall devour they judah shall devour all the people round about so he will be our peace but he's going to empower them to put down their enemies on the right hand and on the left and jerusalem shall be inhabited again in her own place even in jerusalem so as much as messiah is coming to save them part of that means he's going to empower them to push back against their enemies and re-establish jerusalem continuing in micah 5 6 and they shall lay waste and they shall waste the land of assyria with the sword they being judah judah will do this that that they will and so clearly this didn't happen in 701 bc so micah this prophecy is pointing to the time just before us and they shall waste the land of assyria they're going to completely waste this land with the sword which is by the way an islamic land and that hates judah that judah is going to be able to push back against successfully eventually when christ returns and they shall waste the land of assyria with the sword and in case we're confused about where the land of assyria is micah goes on to make it clear in this end time they shall waste the land of assyria with the sword and the land of nimrod in the entrances thereof so the way the hebrews speak they'll say something and then they'll say it again

to clarify it so really reinforce it sometimes they might say it's contradict but so that's sort of the parallel but in this case they're reinforcing they shall waste the land of assyria with the sword and the land of nimrod in the entrances thereof so we know the land of nimrod is iraq iraq and that's part of this babylonian empire that that assyria had taken took

iraq and that's part of this babylonian empire that that assyria had taken took control of that assyria has this whole land so today

we expect turkey to take control of iraq part of iran

uh part of syria but all of that is the ancient land of assyria thus this is how

messiah

shall deliver us from the assyrian this is the antichrist

this is how messiah will deliver us from the antichrist

when he comes into our land and when he treads within our borders

isaiah says the same thing in isaiah 10 verse 5 he says o assyrian the rod of my anger

so the assyrian as powerful as this this empire is going to be god enables it because it is the rod of his anger it's how he carries out his punishment of his people and the staff in their hand is my indignation god has indignation with his people and all of the military power of this empire is represents god's indignation

against his people so again this 85 billion dollar gift to the taliban this is the this is the this indignation of god

he's taking it away from the nations of israel and empowering these people

as many of whom are literal descendants of the assyrian people but all of this is going to be taken over by the assyrian and this is all the indignation of god in verse 12 he says therefore it shall come to pass that when the lord has performed his whole work upon mount zion and and on ierusalem habakkuk refers to this as his work his strange work this is a strange work that god is doing that people don't understand what god is doing but we understand that god is performing his whole work upon mount zion and on jerusalem and the reason we understand is because moses tells us what this work is isaiah tells us what this work is that they must be blinded until they are punished thoroughly so that they can come to true repentance this is the strange work that god is going to use gentile peoples to create the jewel of judah the prize of judah will actually be created through gentile nations this is god's strange work therefore shall come to pass that when the lord has performed his whole work upon mount zion and on jerusalem i will punish the fruit of the stout heart of the king of assyria in isaiah 40

verses 1 to 3 how second isaiah begins he begins saying speaking to the people of god who have the holy spirit who understand the gospel he instructs us comfort you comfort you my people comfort my people and tell them that

tell jerusalem that her warfare has ended because god has meted out her punishment and he says in another place say unto the cities of judah behold your god somebody understands this somebody understands what's going on in the earth and specifically in the theater of the middle east and is able to commentate and narrate the events accurately and bring the scriptures to life precisely so that these people can say this is this is true we never understood these scriptures but these people are these people are gentiles and they're telling helping us understand our scriptures and they come to repentance as a result

so we

we must understand what is this work that god is doing upon upon mount zion and jerusalem once it's done we can we can comfort her because now god is going to turn as moses said and take all these curses and put them on your enemies deuteronomy 30 i believe verse 7 i will punish that once once this work is done and i get the fruit out of zion in jerusalem i will punish the fruit of the stout heart of the king of assyria and the glory of his high looks all of this is end time this is done by god right before or as christ returns back to micah 5 and verse 7. so when all of this happens in the end time and the remnant of jacob shall be in the midst of many people

as a due from the lord all these people who are fighting against jacob this great tribulation which is the time of jacob's trouble jacob is is just targeted targeted targeted but when christ returns the remnant that's left from all of this warfare and destruction there will be a remnant that's saved that remnant will be in the midst of many people as a due from the lord as a blessing to these people as the showers upon the grass that that tarries not for man nor waits for the sons of men so there's nothing the sons of men have nothing to do with this

the dew comes when it comes the rain falls when it falls and all of this is the blessing of god and men's wishes and desires and efforts notwithstanding isaiah says in isaiah 66 verse 19 regarding this remnant of jacob and i will set a sign among them

regarding this remnant of jacob and will set a sign among them and i will send those that escape of them

unto the nations this is what god is going to do with the remnant of jacob i'll send them to the nation so he says that here in micah says that jacob shall be in the midst of many people as a blessing from heaven here isaiah says

he will send those that escape of jacob unto the nations to tarshish pool and lud

that draw the bow to tubal and javan to the isles are far off all of these that have hated jacob god is now going to send the remnant that's left to these nations

that have not heard my fame

neither have seen my glory and they this remnant of jacob shall declare my glory among the gentiles they will be a blessing among the gentiles that hated them and they shall bring all your brethren for an offering unto the lord out of all nations upon horses and in chariots and in litters and upon mules and upon swift beasts to my holy mountain jerusalem says the lord as the children of israel bring an offering and a clean vessel into the house of the lord and i will also take of them for priests and for levites says the lord these physical human beings this remnant of jacob they're going to be established as a kingdom of priests on the earth and human beings will see their fellow human beings as a source of knowledge of the god of israel this is this is what's happening on the earth we the first fruits are up above this overseeing this operation with christ what a glory to be first firstfruits verse 22 for as the new heavens and the new earth which i will make shall remain before me says the lord so shall your seed jacob and your name remain as much as the gentiles have done everything they can under the guidance of the devil to destroy completely judah and to destroy completely the nations of israel god says unless those days should be shortened no flesh of the covenant people would be saved alive but

for the elect's sake that is the covenant people i will shorten these days because there will be a remnant and as as the new heavens and the new earth which i will make shall remain before me says the lord so shall the seed of jacob and the name of jacob remain forever and it shall come to pass that from one new moon to another and from one sabbath to another shall all flesh come to worship before being says the lord and and this uh this remnant of jacob will be a blessing to all this flesh that comes to understand the glory of the god of israel verse 8 of michael 5 and the remnant of jacob shall be among the gentiles in the midst of many people many overwhelming number of people and this small remnant of jacob will be among the gentiles in the midst of many people as a lion among the beasts of the forest as a young lion among the flocks of sheep you can just a lion just has its young energetic hungry lion just has its way with the flocks of the sheep this is micah's prophecy and his vision of what's going to happen with the remnant of jacob coming through this great tribulation how will they end what's their end they will be like a young lion among the flocks of sheep who if he go through both treads down and tears in pieces and none can deliver this is the power that is promised to the remnant of jacob zechariah says verse 8 of 12 in that day shall the lord defend the

inhabitants of jerusalem remember jerusalem is going to be surrounded by armies by all these gentiles but in that day shall the lord defend the inhabitants of jerusalem and he that is feeble among them the weakest among them the injured among them at that day shall be as david david was this mighty warrior and even the most feeble and and lame iew will be like david and the house of david shall be as god wow am i reading did i just did we just read that together that in this end time after this tremendous tribulation this remnant that's left the house of david shall be as god as the angel of the lord before them like a young lion having its way that god is going to empower them supernaturally now verse 9 of micah 5 your hand shall be lifted up upon your adversaries and all your enemies shall be cut off this is good news this is the u.n galleon good tidings good tidings come from the battlefield and this is the good news that god's people that god will be triumphant over his enemies and judah will be triumphant over god's enemies this is this is the gospel according to micah he goes on now in verse 10. not so good news now he returns to the covenant curses on these people so that is the ultimate good news and

that's really the centerpiece of his message

but he wants to warn them and the reason we can appreciate

the good news so much and so deeply is because it's in the context of

horrendous news

and it's in the context of news that is

so bad there is no escape

nobody can escape this

and that's why we appreciate the good

news so much when god swoops in to save

yesha yahoo god saves

saves who saves his people his covenant

people

so here he returns to the covenant

curses he says in micah 5 and verse 10

and it shall come to pass in that day so

this is really preceding what we just

read says the lord that i will cut off

your horses out of the midst of thee

and i will destroy your chariots

so all of your military might that

you've depended on

i'm going to destroy it i'm going to cut

it off

and again we had a glimpse of that when

the

democrats uh in their bill cut a billion

dollars in funding

to israel's iron dome which is a

completely very phenomenal defensive uh

technology just cut a billion dollars

out

fortunately a democrat said we can't do this and wrote an emergency bill to congress to say we have to fund we can't this is our ally we can't do this and so they managed to reinstate that funding but that's just a glimpse of what's coming this anti-semitism which when i was in high school there

was no hint of any anti-semitism

anywhere you just like never again never again was the whole thing today we're seeing increasing anti-semitism jews can't live in europe they've all i think they've all fled france by now they there's just so much anti-semitism growing and these movements these social justice movements are all empowering this anti-semitism so that little hint that was put down of cutting the the apparently um uh uh ortega artezio cortez alexandria artezio cortez apparently when the funding was reinstated she broke down crying in the congress hysterical hysterical that the funding has been been reinstated can you believe this but she's not crying over what all of the misery on the southern border haitian women being raped and children being raped left right and center where is she now why doesn't she go down to the border with hysteria there because she doesn't care it's all about power but that's just a glimpse as i was saying this cutting off that billion dollar funding to allow this phenomenal defense mechanism uh god is saying he's gonna cut it off that's where it's going i will cut off your horses out of the midst of me and i will destroy your chariots you you they feel they're independent they feel they don't need god god is going to take them to a place where they've got nothing nothing nobody no allies everybody's betrayed her the only thing she has now the only thing she has is the defense of

misawa and that's where she has to come just as she says blessed is he who comes in the name of the lord isaiah says this reflecting what micah the sentiment in micah in chapter 2 verse 6 this he says therefore you have forsaken your people the house of jacob why did he forsake them because they be replenished from the east and are soothsayers like the philistines and they please themselves in the children of strangers so they don't depend on god they have found ways and means to get on without god their land also is full of silver and gold neither is there any end of their treasure so they're doing really well and when micah was prophesying the economy was very strong and so they don't think they need god their land also is full of horses neither is there any end of their chariot so lots of military power isaiah says their land also is full of idols they worship the work of their own hands i mean that iron dome that's some pretty fascinating technology as rockets try to come into israel they're just intercepted and blown up in the air and then the people are safe that's pretty phenomenal but isaiah says their land is full of idols they worship the work of their own hands

hands
that which their own fingers have made
that he said i said no we're interested
in worshiping god we want to praise
themselves of how clever they are
isaiah micah says
verse 11
and i will cut off the cities of your
land

and throw down all your strongholds god is doing this on the one hand he's going to make judah as like a like a lion among the sheep and judah is going to be empowered but that's going to come from god after

he takes all their power away from them and allows the gentiles to completely have their way that judah and

israel

finally acknowledge
without god we are doomed
and then somebody's preaching the true
gospel to them so they come to
understand we've got to turn to god and
then they turn with their whole heart as
moses prophesied

but god is god is working but he's doing this this

until he's completed his whole work upon zion

that he will not he will not crush the assyrian

until the assyrian the assyrian has helped him perform his work on zion and on jerusalem and i will cut off the cities of your land and throw down all your strongholds

and i will cut off witchcrafts out of your hand

and you shall have no more stoothsavers so this is how god sees what's going on with these people your graven images also will i cut off

and you're standing images out of the midst of you

and you shall no more worship the work of your hand so micah says they're worshiping the work of their hands isaiah says micah says god's going to bring them to a point where they're going to stop doing that and that's why he's allowing the assyrian and the gentiles to have their way with them verse 14 and i will pluck up your groves out of the midst of you

so will i destroy your cities this is how i will destroy your cities and isaiah asked god how long do i preach to them and

how long do i preach to them and they have no clue what i'm saying and god says until until the cities of judah are destroyed and so god is doing this he's destroying

and so god is doing this he's destroying the cities and this is going to break them up break them out of their stupor and allow them to finally acknowledge jesus christ as lord

final verse here in micah 5 and i will execute vengeance in anger and fury upon the heathen so god is going to perform his strange work upon judah but once it's done then he's going to execute vengeance in anger and fury upon the heath and moses said this this is exactly what moses said we see this in torah we see micah amplifying what moses said in torah and

not heard isaiah says we'll just finish here in isaiah 66

i will execute vengeance in anger and fury upon the heathen such as they have

verse 15.

for behold

the lord will come with fire and with his chariots like a whirlwind to render his anger with fury and his rebuke with flames of fire

rebuke with flames of fire for by fire and by his sword will the lord plead with all flesh and the slain of the lord shall be many so god will act to ultimately

protect and defend his people but not before allowing them to go through their paces and it's going to be epic and the slain of the lord will be many first among judah and israel and then among the gentiles and in all of this in all of this chaos and bloodshed and tragedy somebody needs to be narrated somebody needs to be explaining and somebody needs to be preaching the gospel the good news of the kingdom of god and so brethren that's why we're here at this feast of tabernacles is to fully comprehend the counsel of god this strange work of god this mysterious work that god is doing so that we can be preachers of the good news the good tidings of god i hope brethren that you found today's uh episode helpful uh god willing tomorrow we move on to micah 6 where again god through micah is going to detail what he's going to do to judah in order to bring her to this place of repentance god bless brethren have a great fifth day of the feast of tabernacles
