this wonderful letter that Paul wrote to

the a beautiful congregation of Philippi

chapter of the book of Philippians that

that we're going to be looking at the

last chapter of the book of Philippians

before we do that I just want to remind

you of the the central scripture in this

book are the central verse and that's

verse 27 where he is asking the

02:48

congregation in Philippi to ensure that

their conduct is fitting for their

02:56

knowledge of the gospel that this good

02:58

news that Jesus Christ brought us is so

03:01

profound that it should change

03:03

completely the way we behave and that's

03:06

what Paul was requesting from the church

03:10

at Philippi that even though he couldn't

03:12

get to them he wanted to hear that their

03:15

conduct matches the gospel of Christ

03:19

now there were some risks that the

03:21

congregation was facing and just to

03:24

remind you about those risks

03:26

the first one was in Chapter 1 there was

03:31

external persecution that that Paul

03:33

warned them that they shouldn't be

03:35

terrified of their adversaries and so

03.39

that was we saw that in chapter 1 this

03:41

external persecution on the church and

and he showed them how to how to handle

03:45

that then in chapter 2 we saw another

03:48

risk or another threat and that was

03:50

internal strife

03:51

and he showed them that the way to

03.53

handle that is to put on the mind of

03:56

Christ and to ensure that everybody is

03:59

esteeming others better than themselves

04:01

and they're willing to humble themselves

04:03

and sacrifice themselves for the welfare

04:06

and benefit of others if they do that

04:08

that will eliminate the risk that comes

04:11

from internal strife which is actually

04:14

the greater risk it's a greater risk

04:15

than external persecution external

04:18

persecution tends to bind the church and

04:20

strengthen the church

04:21

whereas internal strife is what destroys

04:24

the church and then the third risk

04:27

was an approaching risk and that was the

04.30

threat of the Judaizers people who were

04:33

going around there were Christians there

were Jewish Christians and they were

basically going around saying that the 04:39

sacrifice of Christ was not enough that 04:42

in addition to the sacrifice of Christ 04:44

to really obtain salvation they had to 04:47

observe the law and specifically they 04:49

had to be circumcised and and Paul was 04.52

basically inoculating the congregation 04:55

against this threat and telling them 04:57

that there is there these are enemies of 05:00

the cross of Christ that that we must 05:03

really understand how profound the 05:05

sacrifice of our Creator was and not to 05:09

attach anything to that that bet 05:11

enables us to have this free gift of 05:13

salvation so he's covered these three 05:16

risks and of the three the second one is 05:19

is really the the big one and and now 05:22

he's wrapping up the letter in chapter 4 05:24

and it actually is going to address this 05:27

second risk of internal strife more 05:29

specifically in chapter 2 he's

addressing it generally now in chapter 4

05:34

he's going to be very specific and again

05:37

appeal to them to fulfill his

05:39

instruction in verse 27 which is to

05:43

ensure that their conduct becomes the

05:46

gospel of Jesus Christ so let's begin

then in verse 1 of chapter 4 where we

see he says therefore as he concluded

05:56

now my brethren dearly beloved he really

loved this congregation the brethren

06:04

here and not just that he loves them

06:06

they are longed for he longs to be with

06:10

them again he really misses them and

misses the support and love that they

enjoyed that mutual support that they

had for one another so their beloved and

06:19

longed for and again that goes back to

the beginning of the chapter or the

06:24

beginning of the book chapter 1 where

the age so with that knowledge as we're 22:40

facing these different challenges we 22:42

just go to God and we asked me to help 22:44

he says anything that you need ask and 22:46

you'll receive as long as it's within

22:48

God's

22:49

and God's will is that we bear fruit we

despite whatever persecution we may face 22:54

so we asked with prayer and supplication

with Thanksgiving so we acknowledge the 23:01

blessings that we do have we're there 23:03

able to return to Phillipi because he 24:12

knew that he was useful to God and he 24:13

was bearing good fruit so we must follow 24:16

this same example finally brethren and 24:20

so now he's sort of concluding and this 24:22

this is the bit from verse 27 of chapter 24:26

1 right through to verse 9 of chapter 4 24:30

all of that is sort of one profound 24:32

thought that that has to do with 24:35

ensuring that their behavior matches the 24:39

gospel of Christ and so now he's come 24:42

finally coming to a conclusion of that 24.44

verse in verse 27 and that's why I was 24:46

saying earlier I think was

in Episode one that I said we've got to 24:50

be careful of scriptural amnesia where 24:53

we read a scripture and then we forget 24:55

what it says as we go on to the next 24:57

verse and and we've got to keep the 24:59

Scriptures in context especially when 25:01

we're reading letters from the Apostle 25:03

Paul he can go for a very long time 25:05

where he has one train of thought but 25:09

because of these different chapter 25:10

breaks and burst breaks we think that 25:13

he's on to another thought and so from 25:14

verse 27 of chapter one right through to 25:16

verse 9 of chapter four he's dealing 25:19

with one train of thought so now he's 25:21

concluding it finally brethren 25:23

whatsoever things are true whatsoever 25:26

things are honest whatsoever things are 25:29

just whatsoever things are pure 25:31

whatsoever things are lovely whatsoever

things are of good report if there be 25:37

any virtue and if there be any praise

think on these things and really what 25:44

he's saying here again it's in the

25:45

context going back to chip verse 28 of 25:47

chapter 1 it's in the context of this 25:51

persecution that is on the church and it 25:53

could be a very depressing time if you 25:56

were to look at the persecution for what

25:57

it is

25:59

rather than looking at it for what it is 26:02

enabling and it's enabling them to come 26:05

together in unity it's enabling them to 26:07

bear fruit and so what Paul is really 26:09

telling them here is think of the big 26:11

picture think of the gospel think of the 26:14

good news of Jesus Christ and as you 26:17

meditate on that good news and the 26:20

ultimate outcome of all of this it puts 26:23

everything into context and this is 26:25

where that that peace of God just it 26:27

just didn't braces us and just enables 26:30

us to face anything calmly and 26:33

faithfully so think of the big picture

really meditate on the gospel of Christ

it's not saying just again just randomly

oh just think of good things you know

don't don't try to think of anything

that that's bad but we have to think

so there was this period where you 29:39

couldn't care for me and you were you 29:42

were still very caring in that period 29:44

you just weren't able to get your you 29:46

express your care to me now that period 29:50

when you weren't able to care for me he 29:52

says in verse 11 not that I speak in 29:55

respect of want don't get me wrong 29:57

don't give me head I don't want to make 29:58

you feel guilty that you weren't able to 30:01

care for me you know I'm just saying 30:04
