07-Judges-06-Transcript

welcome to Wednesday night Bible study just want to confirm that you're hearing my voice if somebody can type in the chat that you do hear me loud and clear we'll be starting in just a little bit again just checking doing an audio check just confirming that you can hear my voice and we'll begin the study great very good so we have sound but it's a bit low we can fix that so I think we're good to go [Music] well good evening brethren and welcome to tonight's study or up to judges chapter 5 which is a song of celebration last week we covered judges for and we saw the victory through Deborah and Barak and Yael and so this week is a celebration the song celebrating that victory that we read of last week will spend about half an hour or so on tonight's three and then pastor Murray is going to join us and we'll have a Q&A I think as we go through these books I just want to do a check-in every once in a while make sure that everybody is tracking if you have any questions rather than leave it all the way to the end we'll do these of these check-ins every 4 or 5 chapters or so and answer your questions live on air so pastor Murray will join me for that let's open with a word of Prayer and then we can begin tonight's study our Father we bow before you just ever so grateful father that we have access to you through Jesus Christ we thank you Father for the many blessings that we enjoy we have so much to be grateful for

despite the uncertainty and and quite frankly the evil that we are seeing in

the world around us we thank you Father for these lessons that we draw from these scriptures and particularly the book of Judges now we ask your blessing on our understanding and we ask this in Jesus name Amen so let's do this just make sure that this is muted there we go yes judges 5 so as I mentioned this is a song of victory based on the tree that we read up last week through Barack and governed and guided by the prophetess Tabora now this is not unlike the song of Moses after God's triumph over Pharaoh so let's go ahead and read this victory song judges 5:1 then saying deborah and barak the son of ABY know'm on that day saying crazy the Lord for the avenging of Israel and this is what we see that God is in love this is the Bible is the greatest love story of God in Israel and he has a covenant love for Israel and he will avenge Israel eventually and so Israel suffered significantly but then God rose up and he avenged her so crazy the Lord for the avenging of Israel when the people willingly offered themselves so there came a point where Israel finally woke up and repented and and was willing to offer themselves for the Lord and that's when he supported them that's when he backed them up and they were able to be victorious because he got God could do it himself but he does it through the people and so again as we're going through judges and using it to reflect on ourselves especially as we're going through these feast of weeks are we at that point where as God's church we offer ourselves willingly that we are living sacrifices that at baptism we died in the Lord and so there's nothing for us to hold on to because we gave our commitment and we gave our lives at

baptism and so we came up out of the grave a new man or a new woman and so now there's no fear because we've already confronted death we've already died to Christ are in Christ and so here God was able to do mighty things through Israel when the people offered themselves willingly and then she says or sing here oh you Kings give air oh you princess now remember this is pre Kings Israel didn't have Kings the Israel had one King go to their king and here now she's telling the Kings to listen it's like when we read Psalms 2 and some of David warnings of the two he didn't take warning so here she's she's speaking to Gentiles it really judges you know maybe another title for judges would be pre Kings or Gentile kings and through the period of the judges Israel should learn just how evil man is and the difference between rule of law and rule of man and when you when deed these nations had all these kings they were not subject to rule of law they were subject to rule of man and and men different rulers could just on a whim kill to promote do whatever they want whereas Israel really learned rule of law so she said to these Gentiles hero you King Kings give ear o you princess I even I will sing unto the Lord I will sing praise to the Lord God of Israel this is the God this is the true God they're all worshiping God this is a very religious time everybody has their gods but there's only one true God and she is now singing praise who has now defeated these armies and with their false gods and I'm sorry I just notice I have judges for up in the title there let me just quickly fix that for the

sake of the archive they changed that to judges five there we go so yes so she is singing to the true God the God of Israel then she begins the song Lord when you went out of Seir when you marched out of the field of Edom the earth trembled and the heavens dropped the clouds also dropped water so this was a time when she's really counting in the past how the God of Israel acted on behalf of Israel the mountains melted from before the Lord even that Sinai from before the Lord God of Israel in the days of Shamgar the son of Anathoth and of course we we read of Shamgar at the end of Judges 3 the Elgon fell and then there was this period after it hood or maybe I should say during the hood but maybe in a different region of Israel when Shamgar rose up and and put down a revolt or an incursion from the Gentiles in the days of Shamgar the son of Anitha in the days of Yael the highways were unoccupied and it's like today with this economic lockdown the highways are unoccupied there's this so oppression and people are not allowed to go free and so there was this maybe there's you can get the sense of armies interfering with anybody who's travelling and so in these days the highways were unoccupied and the travellers walked through by way so they had to be careful choose their paths carefully for fear of their lives the inhabitants of the villages ceased they ceased in Israel until that I de Bora arose so there was a problem of fear and oppression until I do bora arose that I arose a mother in Israel that to me sounds like a condemnation of all of the men in Israel where is their backbone why was there no man to stand up and put down this oppression what is

the thing when when brave men when courageous men stand up and speak the spines of weak men straighten and where were these courageous men well it took a mother in Israel somebody who actually cared so much about Israel she was willing to stand up and put her life on the line and when she spoke the spines of weak men strengthened now what did Israel do why were they in this state of affairs they chose new God's they abandoned Yahveh they chose new gods then was war in the gates that that was their comeuppance that's the result of a man of abandoning Yehovah war was in the gates was there a shield or sphere seen among 40,000 in Israel cowards all cowards all could could we find a warrior could we find somebody who's looking at the oppression and and and the the humiliation and the degradation of their people could we find somebody who would stand up and say I've had enough

there wasn't cowards all my heart is toward the governors of Israel that offered themselves willingly among the people so it came to a point where there were people now who were willing to stand up and she's pointing them out and her admiration her respect is toward these people and again if that begs the question of the church do we have cowards in the church well of course we do if we are just relying on our human inclinations we are all cowards

but we've sieve the Holy Spirit of God which is not a spirit of fear it's a spirit of boldness it's a spirit to sound mind it's a spirit of love and so if we are infused with the holy spirit we offer ourselves willingly and and if we have this spirit of fear and anxiety

and oh no I I don't want to be seen I don't want to be associated then something is wrong we need to get down on our knees we need to repent we need to be baptized we need to have hands laid upon us we need to receive the Holy Spirit we need to renew the Holy Spirit we need to stir up the Holy Spirit so that we can have the boldness that Jesus Christ expects us to have especially in the face of the great evil that we see in our lands today but her heart she says is toward the governors of Israel that offered themselves willingly among the people bless you the Lord speak you that write on white donkeys so this would be the the noble class you that sit in judgment and you that walk by the way so there's another class of people that have to walk but there's a class that rides and you know today we might say fancy vehicles and others not so much it doesn't matter what your rank is you're an Israelite you need to stand up for what is right they that are delivered from the noise of the archers and I just want to say as well at this um again just want to go back here that her heart is toward the governors of Israel that offered themselves willingly among the people and we know where to be a living sacrifice and we're gonna see it later in the song but we need to be at the point where we you know the in Revelation it speaks of a people who loved not their lives unto the death and this this can only be a baptized people people who have given themselves over to the Lord and will do will go where where he sends us so she says then speaking to the different classes here they that are delivered from the noise of archers in the places of drawing water there shall

they rehearse the righteous acts of the Lord even the righteous acts toward the inhabitants of his villages in Israel so those that have come through this he they offer themselves willingly God goes before them he gives them the victory and they're rehearsing now the richest acts of the Lord then shall the people of the Lord go down to the gates awake awake

Devorah so it seems like now so she is singing and it seems now like the Israelites are are part of this this rejoicing and this celebration as well and so now they turn to her and they sing to her awake awake Devorah awake awake utter a song now they turn to Barack arise Barack and lead your captivity captive you son of AB in Om and this is interesting language because we've seen it before leading captivity captive and in fact we just saw it not that long ago when we were in the Psalms and we saw that this was quoting or was quoted the Psalms were quoted in Ephesians when Paul says after Christ descends wherefore he says he ascends upon high he led captivity captive so from reading in judges we can get a sense of what this means that Israel was under oppression Israel had captors Israel was under captivity and then these judges arise and they take the captors and lead them captive and so this what we are seeing here is that Christ a sense is this the same God of Israel and the same love he has for Israel to lead captivity captive and then that was of course quoting Psalm 68 where the psalmist writes you have ascended on high you have led captivity captive so so we now are very very clear on what this means it has to do with the oppression of Israel and that the Holy

One of Israel the suffering servant he comes specifically to loose them that are bound he comes specifically to redeem Israel back to judges 5:13 then he made him that remains have dominion over the nobles among the people so this is him that remains though so there's great battle and there are those who are courageous in the Lord and then there's this remnant that comes through the battle and they now are given dominion over the nobles among the people among the Gentiles the Lord made me to have dominion over the mighty these are mighty people and here now we see this mother in Israel we see Barack we see the faithful people in Israel now having the upper hand over their captors and so again we can take lessons from judges and gain inspiration from judges as well because as powerful as these people are and we have some very powerful people you know we're dealing with people who negotiate in the trillions of dollars I don't even know what that number means but this is what they talk about trillions of dollars they have a lot of power they have a lot of wealth they're very mighty and a lot of them are extremely nefarious in fact the scripture tells us the love of money is the root of all evil and so nothing wrong with being wealthy but if it's your God if you can be bent by it if you can be bribed by it then you will have an evil heart and there's people many many people with a lot of power and they're very evil and they mean no good to humanity and yet God is going to take the meek of the earth the faithful of the earth and give us dominion over the mighty and she goes on out of Ephraim was there a root or a remnant of them

against Amalek and this is interesting wording it seems that it's not all of ephraim that rose to the occasion but there was a remnant in ephraim that rose to the occasion occasion against emilich after you Benjamin among your people out of Macker came down governors and out of Zebulun they that handle the pet handle the pen of the writer so you know people put down their day to day work and they came to the battle because there was a higher priority than their personal career or their personal endeavors they saw a bigger picture and they were willing to sacrifice their lives for the bigger picture and we have to be this way today yes we all have careers yes we all have pursuits yes we all have our own interests but there's a higher order interest that all of us who are in Christ have been called to and we need to put all these things aside and make the main thing the main thing seek ye first the kingdom of God and then all these other things will be looked after they'll be added so she praises

Zebulon and the princes of Issachar were with Tabora

so she praises this a car even it's a car and also Barak and we know that he came from Naftali he was sent on foot into the valley for the divisions of Reuben

there were great thoughts of heart and now this is interesting so Reuben had good intentions but then she says to Reuben why did you abide among the sheep falls why didn't you come to the battle so it seems to me a condemnation of the tribe of Reuben and again if we think of the church today not everybody is willing to go into

battle

in fact the scripture tells us and our Lord tells us that some will be true now I shouldn't say some he actually says many will betray so again we have to look at the people of God and take warning and see the natural inclinations and we need to overcome our natural inclinations so she says to Reuben why did you abide among the Sheep to hear the bleating of the flock slike she said I don't get it I'm confused why did you do this for the divisions of Reuben there were great searchings of heart so there's a question mark over Reuben Gilead abode beyond Jordan and why did Dan remain in ship so as far as the boar is concerned she feels like all of Israel should have risen to the occasion and she's confused as to why there are certain in Israel that did not and so in this time of celebration in this time of victory and there's high regard for those that were faithful she's now a pointing out those that didn't come to the battle and why did Dan remain in ships

Asher continued on the seashore and abode in his breeches that I take that as condemnation and again as the church when the time for battle comes and I speak spiritually and we have to really sacrifice ourselves and maybe here I mean physically as well will everybody rise to the occasion or will there be a song of victory and then an identification of those who did not rise to the occasion

Zebulon and Naphtali were a people that jeopardized their lives unto the death in the high places of the field wow what a contrast between Dan and Reuben versus Zebulun and Naphtali they were a people that jeopardized their

lives unto the death in the high places of the field where were the others and I think this um phrasing of jeopardizing their lives unto the death it's got to put us in mind of the account of John in Revelation and they overcame him speaking of the successful Saints we overcame him by the blood of the Lamb so there's an intimate relationship with our Savior and we understand what his sacrifice means because we've rehearsed it over and over every year if we pass over getting a deeper and deeper understanding we're now we're totally in we are totally in and we we understand what the blood of the Lord is and we use that to overcome any fear and so these faithful Saints overcome him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony and again we understand the nature of God that when he speaks his word he never ever ever goes back on his word that is what makes him God is the about the ability for him to speak a word and then make it happen and he never speaks a word and then he has to apologize for it because it comes back void it comes back empty but it didn't accomplish the thing that he said never in fact he makes the argument and we saw it in Isaiah that his proof that he is God is his ability to declare the end from the beginning and from ancient times that which is not yet done saying what my word my counsel my plans shall stand and so as we come to know this God we become like him the thought of speaking falsehood of lying of breaking promises of breaking oaths this is the furthest thing from us as we mature in Christ that our word is our bond if I say I'm gonna be there I'm gonna be there unless some unforeseen thing happens and you know Wow

a Christian said he would be here don't worry he'll be here unless it's completely out of his control because we are we are human but we have to be faithful and so when

but we have to be faithful and so when we make a testimony and we say I am in Christ our commitment to our word gives us the strength and the courage and the boldness to overcome so we overcome by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of our testimony we've made an oath this is it

and what we jeopardized our life unto the death this life compared to what Christ offers us is nothing let the pagans let the atheists let the agnostics freak out over the threat of death

let them panic over the threat of death and let everyone who names the name of Christ

stand firm look evil in the eye like Shadrach Meshach and Abednego and say do your worst

our Lord is able to save us but even if he doesn't he has promised us the resurrection and that's what we're striving for an eternal life that we will live forever so this is nothing it no matter what we do we're gonna die this is a physical it's a temporary existence so you know we could betray your our life is threatened and we betray to kind of save our life and one minute later two minutes later we get struck down by a car or we suffer a massive heart what was the point what was the point we can't hold on to this life and every hair on our head is numbered and so we're willing like Natale and Zebulun to jeopardize our lives unto the death and they loved not their lives unto the death there's a vision that these Saints have that we

must have that is so clear that nothing frightens us and we understand what what we're a part of and the agenda we've been called to fulfill back to judges 5:19

inst Sisera so they're worshipping the heavens but God is using these these these curse his creation to fight against them the river of kashan swept them away again God is the god of creation so they can worship these things all they want and these Canaanites were environmentalists they worshipped the environment and that that religion has cascaded it doesn't it didn't go away it's just come up now and we call it but you know we have sophisticated terminology for it but it's the same worship where we will degrade a human being made in God's image and we will prioritize instead the worship of nature this is Canada this is Canaanite religion and so the creation that they worshiped was against them because God is the God of the creation the river of Keshawn swept them away that ancient river the river Keshawn oh my soul you have trodden down strength because that is miraculous how is it that the the children of Israel this is the success that they have here was what was intended from the very beginning from the time of Joshua that they should have gone into the promised land and you're systematically moved out and ruled out and destroyed every trace of this pagan idolatry but they back slid and they were unfaithful and they decided to coexist with these people but now they have the victory that they should have always had all my soul you have trodden down strength then were the horse hoofs broken by means of the prancing 's the prancing zuv they're

mighty ones so they're the imagine these powerful well-trained horses and and they're suffering misfortune kursi meraz said the angel of the Lord curse you bitterly the inhabitants thereof what is meraz is Murrah are these

thereof what is meraz is Murrah are these Gentiles or are these Israelites in a particular geography that didn't come to the war not sure either way someone is being cursed bitterly by the angel of the Lord curse he virtually the inhabitants thereof and this is why I say these are Israelites even though Meraz is not an Israelite tribe it's probably a geographic location that the tribe has taken but they have their other priorities and when the Bora calls everyone to battle they came not to the help of the Lord to the help of the Lord against the mighty we needed all hands on deck these are mighty mighty people powerful Kings who have thrown themselves totally into this war this is life or death and Israel we need everybody and these people didn't come and so they were cursed mightily and again it begs the question in the church age are we all gonna get are we all gonna be united and move forward as one flock or they're gonna be divisions among us and I've got a better idea and I don't think that's a priority right now and I you know I've got my little business and I want to hold on to my career or whatever the case is so these people were cursed and now there's a blessing and who is the blessing pronounced upon blessed above women shalya ell the wife of eber the key night be now Yael is this a Israelite woman that married a key night or is it a key night that like Ruth threw herself into the Israelite lot and

said yeah I'm in with Israel one way or the other but she now is identified and remember Tabora told Barak this is your glory but he said I won't go unless you come with me she said okay I'll come with you but your glory will be transferred to a woman you will not get the glory a woman will and this is a prophetess so the word she spoke he came to pass and now this this should have been Barack in fact I think when I read chapters 3 4 & 5 together my sense is that had Barak been courageous and just yielded to the call and went out and and conquered and delivered Israel I think chapter 4

would have been about Barack and de Bora probably wouldn't even been mentioned we don't know how often they all came to know that he was to deliver Israel it's not mentioned and I think had barackman courageous he would just be known as the the next judge and that he delivered Israel but because of his cowardice and his hesitation his initial hesitation I think now we needed the backstory of what went on there and we see that it was de Bora who had courage and strengthen the spine of weak men and that it was actually Yael who actually delivered Israel but this glory is should have been Barack's blessed above women this is quite a blessing bless it above all women shall Yael the wife of Eber the key might be so she came to Israel's assistance blessed shall she be above women in the tenth and this is what the scripture says that all those who bless the descendants of Abraham will be blessed and anyone who curses the descendants of Abraham will be cursed so all of these Gentiles because of their cursing of Israel are cursed

they're condemned and this I think it's a Gentile woman who threw her lot in with Israel but because she blessed Israel she is blessed now I wanted to talk for a moment about Yael because what she did was quite brutal you know she kind of lulled this guy to sleep and then she drove a tent peg through his temple and that seems pretty brutal pretty violent and yet God praises her God lifts her up above all women and she's blessed under the inspiration of de Bora the prophetess she's blessed above all women now look at David and and look at what he says in Psalm 137 verse 8 o daughter of Babylon okay so we're speaking of this Gentile people o daughter of Babylon downstream it's in the future who art to be destroyed happy shall he be more blessed shall he be that rewards you as you have served

so there's a blessing pronounced here on anybody who deals with Babylon the way Babylon has dealt with Israel that's what David the Prophet says he says blessed shall he be that takes and dashes your little ones against the stones so David is saying if you will take these infants and grab them by the feet and smash their heads against the rocks you will be blessed now that is violent and I really should have put up by I meant whenever we do judges to put our viewer discretion is advised because God pull it's God doesn't hold anything back here in the book of Judges so as we go through judges just bear in mind viewer discretion is advised so this is a blessing and that seems pretty brutal but remember what he said he's not saying take the little ones take the babies and smash their head

against the stone because of what you know people will take this and they'll criticize the Bible for this but what David is saying is actually it needs context so if we look at the context he says in the previous verse blessed shall he be that rewards you as you have served us and we know that when Christ comes this is exactly what he's going to do this is from Deuteronomy 30 that all of the designs of the Gentiles that are upon Israel when God rises in defense of Israel he takes all of those designs and turns them back on the heads of the Gentiles so yes very violent very brutal language but we have to understand just how much the devil is working through these people and you even look at somebody like a Melek who saw spared and and he was supposed to completely destroy these people and years later we see them come up in the time of stur I'm gonna rise up to destroy the people of Israel it's in the DNA and so God is clear you got to you've got to clean this out clear these people out and yeah don't worry there's a resurrection they will be brought back to life and they will be taught what is what and who is who back to judges he asked water so remember he came in in the asked water and she gave him milk so she ingratiated herself to him she brought forth butter in a lordly dish so he's feeling quite safe now she put her hand to the nail and her right hand to the work man's hammer so while he's fast asleep there he's probably snoring he's exhausted and she takes the tent peg and just positions it right in the perfect spot and then she takes the Workmen's hammer she's determined she has a clear intention she is standing for Israel and God is rewarding her and blessing her

for this act and with the hammer she smoked Sisera she smote off his head when she had pierced and stricken through his temples now Devorah puts this to music you know you know from my parents are from Jamaica and and the reggae music historically was it was like news that they would take incidents that happened and they would put it to music and then that music would travel all over the island and it was a way of news spreading because it could be easily remembered it would rhyme it had a good catchy beat people would catch on and and so it could be replicated and spread through the island that's how news used to travel and so the Bora knows what news she wants remembered and spread and this is the news that she puts to music and this this very violent act is something that she regards very highly as a prophetess of God and so clearly God regards this very highly and he wants Israel to know this is what I expected of you when you came into the Promised Land this is what you were to do God has had it with these people these filthy people they were to be wiped out but Israel lost nerve and lost backbone but yeah L didn't at her feet he bowed he fell this mighty warrior this mighty general at a woman's feet he bowed he fell he lay down at her feet he bowed he fell where he bowed there he fell down dead and again you just think this is put to music and so this is gonna be very memorable and generations later they can be still singing this song and all over Israel they can be singing this song now the fact that he died at the hand of a woman in this time was brutal you know we'll come to judges later but in judges 9:53 a certain woman cast a

piece of millstone upon the Benelux head and all to break his skull so he realized he's gonna die now so while he realized this woman has done this to him and he's on death's door then he called hastily unto the young man his armor-bearer

and said unto him draw your sword and kill me that men say not of me a woman slew him that's this is how humiliating this was at this time that I know today if you watch any kind of Hollywood nonsense

women are drop-kicking men and beating up men and they're just so powerful and men are so weak but you know Satan is just twisting everybody's head but back in the day men were warriors and they protected their women and the idea that you were slain by a woman was utter humiliation for your whole line and family and so this man Abimelech said you can you need to kill me fast lest when I die and they you know the cause of death a woman killed him draw your sword in slay me that men say not of me a woman slew him and his young men thrust him through he understood how important and urgent this was he didn't hesitate and and his young men thrust him through and he died that was close

was nearly said of him that he died of a woman well this general this mighty warrior

he gets the honor thousands of years later here we are talking about him he died of a woman the mother of snow now read look at this now verse 28 the mother of Sisera looked out at a window so so Deborah understands that while all of this is happening the mother of this general this wicked wicked brutal man his mother just sort of think you know

the mother of adolf hitler the mother of sister of Sisera looked out at a window and cried through the lattice this is this is sister of my baby my baby boy and he's missing and so she cried through it through the lattice why is his chariot so long in coming so she did not expect this cicero goes out Sisera comes back cicero goes out you know lutz steals plummets rapes murders there's all kinds of atrocious things and then he comes home to mommy and mommy hugs him up and kisses him up and says there there my little baby boy you're just so wonderful and so there's this great bond between mommy and Sisera and this time sister didn't come home why tarry the wheels of his chariots like what's going on here this so while all of this is happening in the tent with Yael Cicero's mommy is wondering I wonder what's taking usually he takes her it makes a short work of slaughtering people and then he comes right back home and I cook him his favorite meals what's taking so long this time why tarry the wheels of his chariots her wise lady's answer her ves

she returned answer to herself have they not sped have they not divided the prey so they have absolute confidence in Cicero's ability to win every battle and so she answers herself yeah they've gone quickly and then when they win they divide the prey now remember these are Canaanites and and today the descendants of these people are Muslims and Islam it's like the Roman Catholic Church the Roman Catholic Church basically took the paganism of the day and just packaged it so the pagans continued to do what they always did they just call themselves Christians Islam is the same way it took the

paganism of Arabia and the paganism of that whole Middle Eastern culture and it just packaged it and put it in a package with a bow on it and then called it a religion of Abraham but it's full of paganism and so and that paganism is not new it goes all the way back to the original people and so they are came they they have Canaanite religion and they worshiped by all and so here they do what they always do they go into battle and they divide the prey to every man a damsel or two this is mommy knowing that they go into battle and they kidnap women and they rape them on the very day that they hidden you know Mohammed slaughtered nine beheaded nine hundred Jews on the very day he took the leader of that tribe took his wife after slaughtering her father slaughtering her brother slaughtering her husband slaughtering her children that day he took her to wife and took her to bed this is Canaanite religion it's brutal and so this is what they did but mommy doesn't see a problem why doesn't mommy see a problem because he comes back with riches and gives her riches so she turns a blind eye and that's exactly what they do to this day as long as they're enriched by it who cares what happens to others so every man takes a damsel or two maybe one maybe two whatever they're fat whatever they fancy to Sisera a prey of diverse colors a prey of diverse colors of needlework of diverse colors of needlework on both sides he gets the best of everything meat for the necks of them that take the spoil so she's just got it all figured out and this this is just habit now is no problem but that didn't happen he didn't come back he had a temple or a nail driven through

his temple and then what does the Bora say she has no pity for mommy mommy Sisera these are wicked people and God instructed Israel to go in and wipe them out and and God Himself will do this when he comes he comes in Wrath and he coming in wrath over his land and there's controversy over his land and Jerusalem will be surrounded by armies and the abomination of desolation will be set up but that's when he will act and he will wipe these people out once and for all and zechariah 14 tells us a Canaanite will never ever ever ever enter into jerusalem again god is sick of these people in their nastiness so let all your enemies or so let all your enemies that is Jehovah Zenna me so the enemies of Israel are the enemies of God so let all your enemies perish Oh Lord but let them that love him be as the son when he goes forth in his might and isn't that the promise that we will shine as the Sun in its full strength in our resurrected bodies but it you know we have to love him and love his purpose and be behind his purpose and support his agenda and love and bless Israel not not I don't just mean the land called Israel today I mean the tribe of Israel the descendants of Israel did the DNA stalk of Abraham let them that love him be as the son when he go when it goes down when it goes forth in its might and the land had rest forty years and so judges five comes to an end with this wonderful celebration it was a wonderful victory in judges four wonderful celebration and we see what's important to God by how this prophetess was inspired to put it to music and this is what God wants remembered and spread and so the land now had restauranteur all these enemies are subdued the land has

rest 40 years now lest we think that that's the end let's just read verse 1 of chapter 6 where God willing we'll be next week and you guessed it after 40 years of rest the children of Israel did evil in whose sight in their own sight not in their own sight they're quite pleased with themselves they're quite self righteous they did evil in the sight of the Lord and the Lord delivered them into the hand of Midian 7 years so next year we'll read about that the land of Midian and our how they how they suffered under the hand of Midian because of this evil so this is judges like it's it's crazy you know this is wonderful victory that de Bora sings of this should be the beginning of the Kingdom of Israel being established but these people's heart is inclined to do evil not in their own eyes if you were to interview them they'd tell you how wonderful they are and they're the people of God and how the feast that they keep but in God's eyes they did evil and again it begs the question as the Church of God is the firstfruits Israel of God I know in our own sight were righteous people and we keep the feast days but in the sight of God if we were to reconcile our behavior with the Word of God are we doing evil in the sight of God this is a good place for us to end as judges 5 what we'll do now is open this up and just have a conversation with you about the studies that we've had so far and if there are any questions if on CGI that church online org if you can post them there I'll also take a quick look at Facebook if we don't see your question you know the way with Facebook live it'll just pass and we won't so if we didn't answer it and you wanted answer maybe just post

it again but pastor Murray are you there okay good really good thanks for joining tonight I really appreciate that thank you thank you maybe we'll get before you get started we'll just infirm that's how everybody can hear pastor Murray well and I'm ER if you can just talk for a little bit maybe just tell us uh you've been doing the count for us onslaught really appreciate that how do you manage to keep up how do you manage that all the things that you're doing for us well they want you to manage all the stuff that you're doing yeah just to find time to prioritize the important things in the counters is important it's just a small thing but small things matter to goddess we're going through the book of Judges right so yeah very good and that's actually what struck me and judges there where you see the boar is confused you know why didn't Dan and why didn't move in why didn't they come to the battle they had other priorities and then she highlights Zebulun and Naphtali the people who hold the pen for the writers they put it down and they came to the battle so I think that point that you make about prioritization is so critical and all of us as Christians we need to really need to be asking ourselves do we have God's priorities as our priority did you give me feedback customer is perfect it's wonderful good good so I know there was a question pastor Murray from our sister Laurie and this came on the slot channel and it was regarding a video from a rabbi and I forget his name now but it was to do with the feast of weeks and 11:00 and how there's leaven there's no leaven in the wave sheaf offering but 50 days later at the

firstfruits offering there is leaven with the offering and so she he had an approach or a thought or a theory that you know leaven represents doctrine and so you know there's there's this new doctrine that we have to take on I believe I'm summarizing this correctly maybe you can correct me if I'm wrong so it's been a little while since I looked at it but the the offering with Lebanon to cost represents new doctrine that were to take on so maybe if you don't mind just sort of summarizing your understanding of the question and then you know what are your thoughts on this sure yeah no that's summarized very well I don't remember the gentleman's name either his website was learned the truth and he had dealt with the in generally speaking he was dealing with the validity of the feast of weeks and overall he did a very good job he cited a lot of references that we would support that the feast of weeks is a good thing it was just this one point that caused some confusion for her sister

in that as you as you correctly noted what he said was that 11 is doctrine so there's bad life and bad doctrine good leaven good doctrine and that the inclusion of the is offering in Leviticus 23 on the day of Pentecost of these two Leben two loaves had to do with the implication of good doctrine over the course of the feast of weeks and that was well that does sound plausible it does so that therein lies the confusion so I'm certainly glad that sister rory reached out and asked about that it was interesting to me that in his overall handover the feast of weeks he posted a lot of scriptures which in invalid support of the feast of weeks

and Pentecost but he referenced he didn't show any scriptures and just referenced his thought on this being leaven being doctrine and he referenced Luke 12 with Christ warned to beware of the doctrine of the Pharisees I think is how we put it actually when I remember watching the video because I picked that up as well that there was no scriptural support for his thought that leaven represents doctrine he just sort of threw it out there that Christ taught that leaven represents doctrine and I can't find that teaching in the Bible I don't start anywhere where Christ said Levin represents doctrine and that's always a key when somebody has a theory is to find out if they actually quote a scripture and he just would I believe the certainty he was referencing was beware the leaven of the Pharisees but he didn't quote it right because he said the doctrine of the Pharisees and he then went on to say that Levin was doctrine that's me said you know can be good doctor to the bad doctor but he never actually went to the scripture when you go to the scripture and it's a Luke 12 it actually says beware of the leaven of the Pharisees which is hypocrisy so it's actually not doctrine at all for attitude and then you go into first Corinthians 5 but Paul really digs a deeper into why we need to deal Evan ourselves

we see leaven being a puffy substance can represent pride arrogance hypocrisy and in fact in 1st Corinthians 5 pulling finger sis to put on the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth truth is doctrine so when we actually go make this unleavened bread is dr. represents dr. so the absence of leaven is a doctrine which then brings us to what -

these two leaven Lowe's what could that possibly mean now the Bible doesn't directly interpret this one and it is interesting that a lot of Church of God groups well they don't really address it in too much detail we've got a couple of sources one it is in our a correspondence course there's also a blog I found by one of our pastors that does address this briefly and not most churches don't really go into a whole lot of depth here so it leaves this open to interpretation which is why gentlemen like this could say this and cause some confusion from my perspective and I'll throw this out and see what you think he brought it Feist is the perfect offering and was accepted by God before the feast of weeks began the firstfruits are represented at the end of the feast of weeks on the day of Pentecost so why these eleven rows the best that most most people can come up with is that these represent imperfect offerings that mere still imperfect now perhaps you know Pentecost pictures the distribution of the law and the holy spirit and that we come into the church age so as we as we are baptized and we come to God is imperfect imperfect beings as the first fruits beginning our journey upon the receipt of the Holy Spirit the whole process of perfection begins but we are imperfect and we need God's mercy to come before Christ so really most interpretations that I've found within our movement within the church regard specifically CGI will say that this

to mean that we are this has to do with the imperfect we the firstfruits being imperfect you may have a we there are various other interpretations that I've

read that made that play off of this that what could what could these two lowest mean could they represent two types of group of people specific groups of people again all all interesting to consider and and could be valid interpretations but I think when you boil it all down the fact that leaven pictures sin it seems most reasonable that these two leaven blows have to do with the first groups being imperfect offerings because Christ is really only pert the only perfect I love what you're saying there and I think it's very consistent with Scripture I think that the scripture James says that we are a kind of firstfruits so we you know we call ourselves first roots because we are in the first fruits harvest but the scripture more specifically says that Christ is the firstfruits of them that slept and then it goes on further to say we are a kind of firstfruits so we're it were a kind of firstfruits so I think we're a kind of firstfruits because you know we are leavened we are not we are not the perfect offering as Christ was but Christ Cain as the Holy One of Israel to redeem Israel so because of his offering this offering can now be acceptable to God so I think that's very acceptable I think the two loaves that just in my opinion would represent two types of firstfruits and I think we have the Old Testament Saints and then we have the Saints in Christ baptized into Christ in the new in the New Covenant and you know again we have 144,000 which is twelve by twelve we've got the Twelve Apostles and we've got the 12 the twelve tribes the heads of the tribes so to me that is consistent that there are two types of firstfruits because there were many that had the

holy spirit historically that are going to

up in in in the first resurrection but I

do think I love what you've done here with this and again it's scripturally supported and it's consistent it is consistent I didn't like the inconsistency with the rabbi I thought he was be was all he was doing really well and then it just sort of really struck me that he's quoting Christ without actually going to the scripture and he's just saying Christ Christ said this yeah misquoting Christ to me that's that caused me to serve but I I think that's great and maybe we'll see if there's any further conversation or discussion on this but you know there as you mentioned as well that there's some things that are not quite clear so that hidden things belong to God but he gives us what he gives us and we work with what he gives us wonderful wonderful I'm not seeing any questions on I'm actually looking at the Sabbath service not at the study I just saw somebody is saying god I need you on the Facebook with any any questions or comments there on the on the channel oh great okay perfect and so just while you're talking to Elena aim says thank you Marie interesting and it also thanks me as well so thank you for that Christy Roman says hi everybody hi Christy thanks so much for joining us and Brenda ray says hello hello Brenda Moses Moses father must refer to suggest

in chapter 2 verse 18 to us really well so come to some sort of consistency here well the best explanation is also supported so it's an explanation sure so the Hebrew contain the same concerts

and are only differentiated by their vows originally well it wasn't before because there was the oral tradition and they were constantly rehearsing it but after some of the oppression that they suffered and then these people were lost but then they were facing the text and the people didn't remember how to actually interpret it so now they just have to rely on those who can read Hebrew and try to figure out from the context what are the vowels that should be there and that's where they came up with the vowel markings without changing the clients cuz they the text was sacred didn't want to change it so that's where they came up with the ball marketing so absolutely I get what you're saying they see the consonants that helps to find who that is actually Moses brother MA the son of and that's that's fervent to find there so when you go into when you take judges for verse lending to so many other translations that has been corrected or reinterpreted to state brother-in-law but is just something that's didn't last week that I've always known Moses father to be Jethro ya know and now here's a third name so I just wanted to put a little bit of color there that's great I really appreciate that very very good very good just checking the checking the church online here have a note here from the Lisa Simpson she says what's going to make greetings in the Lisa thank you for joining us from Jamaica that's great great

yes greetings as well just some comments here sister Donna says we cannot be seen from search again supports that you said I'm sister Olivia courts Matthew sixteen there's 12 in regard to the eleven of the Pharisees sister Sylvie had had a comment a crisis about sin and yeah just no other questions so far here on the chat

and just a comment here from Ardath Dillard hi from cliff and ardath's from Kansas happy to get our Bible studies hello cliff and Ardath great to have you as part of our virtual congregation here hopefully you're able to join us on Sabbath as well we have a Sabbath service at 2:30 Eastern Time 1:30 Central right here in that CGI dr. Tom line org and I guess it goes onto Facebook as well

we'll be speaking of Sabbath as well in the past an interesting leads not very good the concept of the fast actually came from the chat on this study about two weeks ago their summers here on the chat from around the world started to throw the idea back so that was put forward really looking forward to that and I think just going back to the question that you started off with pastor Murray and and just was artists that says cliff and Ardath enjoy the studies I think what's important about these studies is their line by line we open up a book and we read it line by line and everything is now in context it may be very familiar verses i know when i was reading isaiah verses that i know coming into the church i learned them they're very poetic when actually sit down and read it in context it doesn't say what i thought it said or it doesn't mean what i thought it meant and i think the same way with that rabbi where he just says oh you know christ says well he's a rabbi

so i'm just gonna sit there and I'm going to accept what he says but what God wants is for us to search the Scriptures to see if these things are so

and searching the Scriptures means reading it upon test line by line what what you know what's happening before what happens after what does that what would the scripture mean to the people that Christ was speaking to how would they have interpreted it we can build on that but it can't mean the opposite of what Christ originally meant so I think that I appreciate the opportunity we have to do these studies and lift up the word of God above the word of men you know the Bible is the let's take it it's the word of God let's give it high regard and then study everything in context yeah absolutely and please everybody don't take anything anyone says here whether it be a tree and I or anybody else on any message just at face value open up your Bibles that's right open up different versions I mean you'll see and as you see different as you come to study the scriptures you'll see even some of the more modern versions have taken liberties that are against the true meaning of the text it's so much so and I don't mean to get off on a tangent here but you go into some of the more liberal translations or paraphrases and there's a complete elimination of things like Satan and Lucifer and in Christ and Christ

so yeah I've really become really if there's anything that we can take from this set of studies here it's as you said it it's the line by line very very good very good so you gave us a preview of what you'll be speaking about this Sabbath so we're looking forward to that what is the purpose of fasting and certainly God expects that of his people so we'll be encouraged very much look for time I see a Elena says that's why I
