07-Judges-12-Transcript

well greetings brethren and welcome to wednesday night bible study just doing a sound check i'll just see who's logged in here at cgi.churchonline.org i see uh denuta greetings sister john marion sister with love greetings pastor murray rrj rick for slg and willie greetings everyone christine greetings denise greetings let's see who else i see here rick4 so if you can just um confirm that you hear my voice that'll be great just doing a quick sound check before we get started on judges chapter 11 i'll just wait for a confirmation that i'm coming through loudly and clearly again just looking for some soundcheck good great thanks pastor murray so that's great we can get started well greetings brethren hopefully uh i'm coming through loud and clear uh we've it's been a little while we've been off for a couple of weeks but we're back we're going to be covering this evening judges chapter 11 god willing and then after judges 11 uh pastor murray is going to join me and we're going to do some live q a so any questions that you have about the study this evening or any of this any of the content that we've covered in the book of judges um or even in some of the sermons that you've heard over the last month or so in the last six weeks uh happy to just have some live q a with you as brethren this evening let's go ahead and open with the word of prayer and i apologize for the abrupt

start i usually start with the the uh the music and the the intro as i apologize for the abrupt start just rusty it's been off for a couple of weeks let's open with the word of prayer our heavenly father great god almighty we come before your holy throne we're just so grateful father because you have handpicked us you've given us of your holy spirit you've made us brethren to one another through jesus christ through his sacrifice we thank you so much father that as we see the world around us unraveling so quickly it is very worrying many many people father are being plunged into depression into anxiety some to the point of suicide and yet father we thank you for your word because christ said that he gave us his word your word which is truth so that his joy might remain in us that no matter what happens around us no matter what happens to us we have this incredible joy because of your word we praise you father and we thank you for this and we thank you for the opportunity that we have to study your word so that your word might remain in us we praise you we ask your blessing now in jesus most holy name amen so i mentioned that uh we're going to cover judges 11 and i just want to go back a little bit just to pick up the tail end of judges 10 again it's been a little while uh since we've been here so just reminder halfway through judges 10 i want to just pick this up

as context where god says you have forsaken me and he's speaking to israel and he says of israel you have forsaken me imagine that and then again you know we're studying judges because god says that these things are written for our examples whose example who who is it written for for our example upon whom the ends of the world have come

i hope it's clear to us that we've turned the corner and and we're in this new chapter we're in the concluding events of the history of mankind without god or the history of mankind rejecting god god will soon act he has to act because the earth abides forever and human beings

human beings must be here when he returns and if things

are allowed to go the way satan wants them to go not a single human being would be left and certainly not a single jew or israelite would be left so soon god is going to act but his people forsook him

is it possible that in the end time especially when jesus christ says that many will have their love grow cold that many will betray their own brother in the faith is it possible that we in the church of god could forsake him you have forsaken me and served other gods therefore i will deliver you no more so god has been delivering and delivering israel and every time he delivers them there's this

pattern where

they they apostasize they they

they are then beaten they're punished

for that and they cry out to him and god

has tender mercy for israel he's in

covenant with israel

and so he delivers them but when he

delivers them

their their repentance is short-lived as

soon as they have abundance again they

forget god and they forsake god

and so now they're calling out to god

and he reminds them you know what

you've forsaken me and served other gods

therefore i will deliver you no more go

and cry

unto the gods which you have chosen

let them deliver you in the time of your

tribulation and last week or

three weeks ago when we studied this i

was specifically calling out the

brethren

who are worshiping balim they have ran

they've run after ba'al

black lives matter and they are standing

up and fighting and throwing their

energy

into black lives matter and my message

to you brethren

who if any of you are listening is you

have forsaken god

you have forsaken god for other for for

gods that are not gods

but you believe in them and then the

message to god is he will deliver you

from god as he will deliver you no more

and when your calamity comes go and cry

to balaam go and appeal to black lives

matter

and let them rescue you because you've

chosen them you rejected jehovah

you rejected yahweh and you chose balaam

so go and cry onto balaam

when the crisis comes and see how much

they love you

see how much they love black lives see

how much they believe in black lives

especially those that say they believe in christ

let them deliver you in the time of your

tribulation

now this is ancient but it's for our time

and john 15 verse 7 is really critical

for us to understand here

christ says if you abide in me

and my words abide in you so if you

abide in me

and my words abide in you

he says you shall ask what you will

and it shall be done unto you so we have

on on the one hand people who have

forsaken god

and god says i i won't deliver you

anymore go and cry unto the gods you've

chosen

but here we have christ saying look if

you

abide in me and my words abide in you

you shall ask what you will and it shall

be done unto you

so there's an intimacy here with those

who do not forsake god

and how do we know whether or not we

have forsaken god

well christ is giving us an indication

right here it's in our language

it's in our vocabulary he says if my

words

abide in you those who have forsaken god

those who have forsaken jehovah are

speaking a language

that is foreign to the scriptures

their vocabulary does not come from the

scriptures

so when we hear people talking about

social justice

when we hear things like white privilege

when we hear things like white fragility someone says to me the other day you're throwing shade i

researched these this terminology where does this language come from what is the etymology of this language and it's all demonic all of it all of it is demonic

but because it's in you know political correctness it's in the atmosphere people speak this way then we pick it up and we use this language but christ says if my words stay in you and you stay with me then you'll ask what you want and in the time of crisis it shall be done unto you

so we have to be careful with our language with our vocabulary when we speak do we speak about sin or do we speak about social justice the bible doesn't talk about social justice so where does our language come from because the key to enduring to the end is to speak from the

to speak the words of christ and let these words stay with us so caution brethren the marxists the cultural marxists are infusing the postmodernists are infusing new language

bible

into the culture we mustn't speak this language

it's the language of ba'al let the language that we speak come from the scripture come from the text back to judges 10 and i just can't emphasize

the stakes are so high you might hate me but i love you the stakes are too high this we we are we have hit a crisis and brethren are being seduced by very very clever people very very very clever people
we must stick to the word and we don't
have to be that clever
we just have to be faithful and if we're
faithful

none of their cleverness will work because we have the text and the children of israel said unto the lord we have sinned so they finally acknowledged okay you know what we were off we've sinned do you unto us whatsoever seems good unto you deliver us

only we pray you this day so they are in a crisis they are getting a spanking they have woken up prior to this they were very arrogant prior to this you couldn't talk to them prior to this you couldn't correct them but now that the calamity has come now that they realize what they are involved in

and and and what what's going to befall them now they're saying to god do whatever you like just please deliver us and then we'll take any punishment from you

and they and they put away the strange gods

from among them this infiltration how this infiltrated into israel but they got rid of it they realized okay we're wrong let's get rid of it now they didn't get rid of it because they disliked it they didn't get rid of it because they hated it they got rid of it out of convenience it's like oh we're in big trouble and the reason is these strange gods so let's get

rid of the strange gods so we can get

out of trouble it's not it's not

repentance of the heart

it's repentance of convenience and self-preservation and they put away the strange gods from among them and served the lord and his soul was grieved for the misery of israel

so they served the lord but not with a true heart with a heart of convenience self-centeredness

self-centeredness me me me my family my race my people not really a heart of god for all humanity and so they're serving god out of convenience and still despite their flaw remember and sorry some of you may not be following our sermons but we've been talking about the power of story and understanding the hero's journey and how the hero the protagonist is working for something

but the protagonist has a fatal flaw and that's what gives the antagonist power over the protagonist so god sees this flaw in israel but he's in covenant with them the israel is his bride unfaithful though she may be and so his soul grieves for israel for the misery of israel and so israel is in the pit of misery and again we talk about storytelling but

he grieves for her then the children of ammon

were gathered together and encamped in gilead and the children of israel assembled themselves together and encamped in mispa so they're getting ready now to face off

and just go back just before we go into

judges 11 just let's go back to the very beginning

of judges now after the death of joshua

so joshua was a very strong leader moses was a strong leader joshua was a very strong leader now after the death of joshua it came to pass

so over time that the children of israel asked the lord saying who shall go up for us against the canaanites first to fight against them so they really don't know there's no there's no leadership

they're they're not just like we're lost who should do what what should happen here

keep that in mind now as we come to coming into judges 11 the tail end of chapter 10

and the people and princes of gilead said one to another

what man is he that will begin to fight against the children of ammon he shall behead over the inhabitants of

he shall behead over the inhabitants of gilead

so they're lost they lack leadership they lack leadership with courage they lack leadership with backbone they lack leadership with vision they're just a scattered people they're

they're just a scattered people they're just a mess

and so even the princes are here but they don't provide any leadership to the people are ready they want leadership

but even the prince is among them there's no leadership there's no vision and so the people and the princes of gilead they're talking to one another

saying who which man will fight against the children of

ahmad and whoever he is look at this he shall be head over all the inhabitants of gilead you know

what when you're desperate you give up your freedom when you when you feel like you're endangered when you're threatened you'll throw away your freedom and that's what israel is willing to do here we will throw away our freedom we'll make who whoever can get us out of this situation you know they've pleaded to god but now they're looking to man and any man that can get us out of this situation will give him totalitarian control over us now jephthah the gileadite was a mighty man of valor this is now there's some courage there's some backbone there's some strength in israel but he was the son of a harlot so he was a and so a prostitute so he's the son of a prostitute even though he's a gileadite and gilead begat jefftha so not necessarily the head of gilead but gilead could be but could be a man named gilead uh who begat jephthah so he's definitely a gileadite and gilead's wife bear him sons so so he has jefftha but he has multiple he has many sons so gilead's wife bear him sons and his wife's sons grew up and they thrust out japhtha and said unto him you shall not inherit our father's house for you are the son of a strange woman so again talk about racism and prejudice and all of this you know he probably looked a bit different than they did and they certainly knew his origin that he wasn't from the wife

and so in terms of any inheritance they

just felt like no you're not a part of us

why should you participate in the inheritance so they got rid of him then jephthah fled from his brethren fled

so he was in trouble and he realized he couldn't stay

maybe if he stayed they would kill him so he had to run for his life so jeff the fled from his brethren and dwelt in the land of tobe and they were gathered vain meant to jephthah

and went out with him so just the rejects basically went with him and it came to pass listen to this now in the process of time that the children of ammon made war against israel so it didn't happen right away it wasn't

apparent

the danger when they thrust out jephthah they were in they were in trouble among god was actually raising up ammon so amman was growing in strength but israel was blind

and so you see today israel is blind the the nations of israel are blind we don't understand the danger we are in and so we can't wait this man donald trump now

i'm not political never i've never voted in my life i don't intend to vote i'm not political i know nothing about the republican party

i do know something about donald trump i know he's surrounded by betrayers in the republican party that politicians are corrupt

i do think there are some exceptions in the republican party but don't ask me about their policies and what they stand for i don't know and i kind of don't care i know a lot about the democrats because they've been taken over by communists and on a global basis i care about what communists do and their strategies and their tactics so i've been studying the democratic party don't know much about the republicans don't really care about them but this man donald trump who kind of came out of nowhere who they hate with with intensity it's incred

if i say karl marx who's responsible for the death of

100 million people nobody cares but if i say donald trump the the hatred the veins the

people their heads are gonna burst with hatred for this man

and all i see him doing is this man that kind of came out of nowhere this wild card

fighting for the american people fighting for the american way of life fighting for freedom that's what i see and he's rejected they want to throw him out of town

you're not part of our system you know one year it's the bushes the next year is the clintons and it kind of goes back and forth

and it's a whole closed system you think you're voting oh i don't like the democrats i think i'll vote republican it's all the same and this wild card comes in out of nowhere and they can't control him he says what's on his mind he does what he thinks is right he's not particularly refined but he's fight he's a patriot

and they hate him and they're turning

the whole nation about against him and they want to run him out of town and they are blind to the children of ammon they are blind to the enemy that's rising up so once they finally assassinate him or get rid of him by hook or by crook and then the enemy can now strike because there's no strength in the nation then you will see the nation change it's like you know this news story i heard the other day when uh chaz uh i don't know i don't know if it was chaz but the the black lives matter folks they were burning burning and looting and and one of these commentators uh in his blog said yeah burn that stuff down and then the next day they were right outside his neighborhood and he's like these animals are outside my where are the police they need to be arrested oh funny how things change when it touches you same with chas the mayor of seattle oh it's going to be a summer of love oh it's going to be wonderful let them just have their fun while they're murdering and raping and stealing oh it's a summer of love until it came to her door and then she said we have to shut this down with half a net within half an hour it's all shut down it's funny how people's perspective changes when they think they're in peace and safety and people have so much things to say when it's peace and safety the minute the danger is on their doorstep their whole perspective changes and so it's going to be amazing when

this man is finally taken out of out of his office

who has a bit of backbone like when i think of the forces the global forces the most powerful forces that he's up against i i'm impressed

that he's up against i i'm impressed i'm impressed now he wasn't a politician he's been in the office now for almost four years maybe he's becoming a

four years maybe he's becoming a politician

and if he does become a politician well then he's useless because politicians are useless

but really interesting how he came outside of the system and he had backbone

so and eventually he'll be gone so in the process of time the children of ammon finally made their move and they made war against israel people act like america has no enemies i'm canadian i'm british canadian

why do i care about america because it is the last hope for freedom in the world

everything everything else has gone socialist there's no other country that is built upon the ideas that america is built upon so baked into the fabric of america's founding

are biblical concepts of freedom no other nation has this that's why america is the prize that's why the communists and the all the globalists and the islamists everybody has to bring down america and the

strange thing is americans and people who love freedom in the west we're helping them we're empowering them we're giving them strength and support and we're cheerleading them and once america falls

we'll finally realize oh this thing is on our doorstep this thing is going to hurt me personally this thing is going to destroy my my family i thought it was all theoretical then we'll change and then we'll call it to god and god will say you don't call me you call your gods that you have given yourselves to and let them deliver you and the anger of the lord was hot against israel and he sold them he sold them into the hands of the philistines and into the hands of the children of ammon so these enemies are rising up the communist party of china the the jihadists the the uh different uh extremists and activist groups within the country of america they're all god is giving them all strength he's empowering them because he's going to deliver us into their hands and he sold them into the hands of the philistines and into the hands of the children of ahmad and it was so that when the children of ammon made war against israel the elders of gilead went to fetch oh we remember now you know that guy we hated you know the guy we despised you know the guy that we wanted to kill remember how courageous he was remember the backbone that he had the elders of gilead went to fetch **jephthah** out of the land of tobe and they said unto jefftha come and be our captain that we may fight with the children of ammon so you

know what we

need we have another army we just don't

have anybody who's courageous or

strategic in their thinking

why don't you come and be our captain

and jeff the said unto the elders of

gilead

wait a minute hang on a second time out

can we talk for a minute didn't you

hate me and expel me

out of my father's house and why

are you come unto me now when you're in

distress

so you know i don't think this will be

the case with donald trump but

he's an older man but it would be like

you get rid of him finally

actually you know a good example would

be churchill winston churchill

they hated winston churchill he kept

trying to warn them there's a problem

look germany is rising hitler is right

there's a he had intelligence

as in military intelligence and he was

warning england

nobody cared nobody listened to they

listened to chamberlain

peace in our time waving the paper and

they

they despised churchill until they were

in trouble

then they fetched him and said will you

be our leader

so that's the way fickle human beings

think it's kind of

it's in vogue to reject somebody and you

just pile it on

everybody's going that way i think i'll

go that way too instead of pausing and

kind of getting a big picture on what's

going on

didn't you hate me and expel me out of

my father's house

and why are you come up unto me now when

you're in distress and the elders of gilead said unto jephthah therefore we turn again to you now

that you may go with us and fight against the children of ammon and be our head so it's the gun from captain to now we want you to be our head

so now they're sweetening the deal over all the inhabitants of gilead this is what we'll offer you and jephthah said unto the elders of gilead if you bring me home home again so he was he was in exile like that's my that was my

country that's my home so if you're going to bring me home again to fight against the children of ammon

and the lord deliver them before me

shall i be your head so let's make sure we get this clear i'm going to be head over all of you and and there's a sense here from jeff the of narcissism

and usually you know when you see the sort of the top ceos

when you see these sort of top performers many times they suffer from narcissism and self-reliance they think they're just so wonderful so now this guy is very ambitious and he's like i like

i like the sound of this i'm going to come back but make sure i come back to the highest honor make me the head and the elders of

gilead said unto jephthah the lord be witness between us if we do not sow

according to your word so they're they're serious that we we really want you

and god will be our witness then jephthah went with the elders of gilead and the people made him head and captain over them so immediately he hasn't even won anything yet but they're so desperate and they really need his support that they made him head and captain over them and jephthah uttered all his words before the lord in mispa so there's something in jephthah that that seems an element of faithfulness and people this is the thing nobody's perfect people are a mixture and and so when you when you act like somebody's all evil you know orange man is all evil there's nothing good about him then something's warped people are a mixture and so jephthah here has something in him that acknowledges the lord and jephthah sent messengers unto the king of the children of ammon saying so now he's taken up his role and he's now sending messengers to the king of the children of ammon saying what have you to do with me that you are come against me to fight in my land so he's taken the role i'm basically king of gilead why are why are you doing this what what's the issue here and so the messengers go and then the king of the children of ammon answered unto the messengers of jesus you can see people going back and forth because israel took away my land so remember god said you go in and you clear the land but they didn't do that

so now their disobedience is coming back

to bite them because israel took away my land when they came up out of egypt from arnon even unto jabock so he's given the geography and unto jordan now therefore restore those lands again unto me peaceably and then you can even hear to this day over in the middle east you hear the palestinians saying to the jews you've taken out this is our land give it back to us it's the same thing and jephthah sent messengers again unto the king of the children of ammon and said unto him thus says jephthah israel took not away the land of moab and i think my if my wife is watching i forgot to bring a handkerchief if you don't mind uh passing a handkerchief to me i'd

appreciate it um and said unto him thus says jephthah israel took not away the land of moab nor the land of the children of ammon so he's that

ammon is obviously concerned just with ammon but jephthah now presents his defense with moab and ammon that we did not do this and and that in fact he he again jeff is demonstrating a degree of understanding because this comes from the torah and in the torah here in deuteronomy 2 and

god says to moses and command you the people saying you are to pass through the coast

verse 4

of your brethren the children of esau which dwell in seer and they shall be afraid of you take you good heed unto yourselves therefore meddle not with them

for i will not give you of their land no not so much as a foot breath because i have given monsieur unto esau for a possession

so that was a very clear instruction when they came in leave edom alone and the lord said unto me distress not the moabites thanks so much distress not the moabites so in addition to the

he says here distress not the moabites no bites

neither contend with them in battle so don't have anything to do with the moabites either for i will not give you of their land for a possession because i have given r unto the children of lot

for our possession so so very clear that there's very clear instructions here with edom with the moabites and then verse 19 and when you come near over against the children of amon distress them not nor meddle with them

for i will not give you of the land of the children of ammon any possession because i have given it unto the children of lot for a possession so jephthah is very clear that the children of amman yes we took land but we didn't take land from moab and we didn't take land from ammon so if there's any land in dispute that means that you took land that didn't belong to you and so the land that we took it has it's none of your business

so jephthah now continues to recite his understanding of the past but when israel came up from egypt and walked through the wilderness unto the red sea and came to kadesh then israel sent messengers unto the king of edom saying

let me i pray you pass through your land but the king of edom would not hearken thereto and in like manner they sent unto the king of moab

and he would not consent and israel abode in kadesh

then they went along through the wilderness and compassed the land of edom

so he's got his history he knows the history

and came by the east side of the land of moab and pitched on the other side of arnon

but came not within the border of moab for arnon

was the border of moab and israel sent messengers unto saihan king of the amorites the king of heabhon and israel said unto

the king of heshbon and israel said unto him

let us pass we we pray you we ask you threw your land into my place but saihan trusted not israel to pass through his coast but saihan gathered all his people together

and pitched in jihad and fought against israel

and the lord god of israel delivered sihan and

all his people into the into the hand of israel and they smote them so israel possessed all the land of the amorites the inhabitants of that country so

jephthah has all of this history and he's able to contend with the king of ammon with this history that his claim is false

this is what actually happened and and he understands that the lord is the one who delivered israel so he takes up the offer from his brethren knowing this history that god does in fact love israel he's in covenant with israel and he delivers the gentiles

into israel's hand and they possessed all the coasts of the amorites from arnon even into jabba and from the wilderness

even unto jordan so so he's showing here how

um it was

really saihon but so saihan trusted not israel to pass through his coast but sion gathered all his people together and pitched in jahaz and he's the one that initiated the fight and the lord god israel delivered saihun and all his people into the hand of israel and they smote them so it this is how israel possessed all the land of the amorites not the ammonites the amorites the inhabitants of that country

and they possessed all the coasts of the amorites from arnon even unto jaboc and from the wilderness even unto jordan so now

the lord god of israel has dispossessed the amorites from before his people israel

and should you possess it so you're going after this

land when when god is it's the god of israel that dispossessed these people and now you want to take it won't you possess that with which kimash your god gives you to possess and then there's a question here because their god is really molech but maybe he's teasing them to say well if molech was your god why why did why don't you have the land why why was why

do the people of kimash the god of kimash have the land will you not possess that with kimash your god gives you to possess so whomsoever the lord our god shall drive out from before us them will we possess so what happened to your god molech you know so so our god is giving us land as he promised and obviously is able to subdue these false gods and now are you anything better than balak the son of zippor king of moab did he ever strike strive against israel or did he ever fight against them while israel dwelt in heshbon and her towns and in aurora and her towns and in all the cities that be along by the coast of arnon 300 years so there was no issue here are you better why therefore did you not recover them within that time therefore i have not sinned against you so very good recounting of history first of all is like what's your problem and then now uh when the problem is defined no you've got a wrong understanding here's the history so i haven't sinned against you therefore i have not sinned against you but you do me wrong to war against me the lord the judge be judged this day between the children of israel and the children of ammon so quite a good strong theological basis so a good understanding of the history and the theology very very interesting and uh where were the other leaders in israel in gilead they just weren't there but this man comes out of in the sense the wilderness out of nowhere

and he's able he's ready to take them on and he has backbone howbeit the king of the children of

ammon hearken not unto the words of jephthah

which he sent him now notice this so up to now there's no language from the author

that indicates that god chose jephthah that god raised up jephthah it seems like the people went and got him because they they lacked courage and they remembered his courage and so they went and they got him

but in no way did the author give us any indication

that god raised up jephthah but regardless

god loves israel and now that jephthah is in this role

the author says to us the spirit of the lord came upon

jephthah and he passed over gilead so that

so it came so we saw before where the spirit of the lord clothed uh gideon and and god's spirit just comes on over these people and and these

people are not

converted it doesn't say the spirit of

the lord came into

it just comes upon and gives them supernatural ability

so so you see a man in a high office in the land

accomplishing you know supernatural feats

maybe the spirit of the lord has come upon him why not because he loves the man

but because he loves israel he loves israel

then the spirit of the lord came upon jephthah and he passed over gilead and

manasseh and passed over mizpah of gilead

and from mizpah of gilead he passed over unto the children of ammon so he's on the the um

he's being proactive on the offense and jephthah bowed a vow unto the lord and said if you shall without fail to deliver the children of ammon into my hands

then it shall be that whatsoever comes forth

of the doors of my house to meet me when i return

in peace from the children of ammon shall surely be the lord's and i will offer it up for a burnt offering so this is going to be an issue i think if most of us are familiar with this story

when we get to the end of the chapter we're going to see a real issue here but the issue is the vow so and you know today we don't care about vows we make vows and we break them and it's nothing but to god vows are everything

when you vow vow into the lord you keep your vow

and and the culture understood that you know back in the day even uh gentiles understood when you make a vow

you keep it now this vow is unwise but he is so ambitious and so dead i think when you're rejected then you fight harder to come back and so you see somebody like donald trump rejected and mocked and laughed at and ridiculed

and now you see him fighting to prove all of my critics

you are all wrong you know look now and so you can kind of see if you look at

donald trump and how he's responding how he has responded you know what's the i forget the exact saying but the the sweetest uh revenge is victory something like that so so he's just like he wants to win big and silence all his critics

and i think i can see that same kind of psychology here with jeff the that he he wants to win so he's you know he's confident of the history but he's not a hundred percent confident and so just to reinforce his confidence he is now bribing god he's basically saying to god

if you do this for me i'll do this for you completely unnecessary he just really needs to understand the way when you look at when we study psalms

and you look at david's understanding and he reminds god of the covenant and he acknowledges the unfaithfulness of israel but he reminds god of his covenant and his covenant love and and he appeals to god in the in the covenant love

to to come back to it to faithfulness to despite israel's unfaith wants to be faithful to israel jephthah doesn't have this

jeff is just very ambitious and really wants to come back can't afford to lose might be killed in battle but worse just to lose and come back to the gileadites and be rejected again maybe even more and so he vows this vow to kind of reinforce his victory and it's a foolish vow but it's also a very um cruel vow because he says it shall be that whatsoever comes forth

of the doors of my house

to meet me and that language in the hebrew

indicates he's expecting one of his servants

to come and meet him so he's already in in into human sacrifice which was common in in this land in this time and so whoever that servant is that comes to meet me

i'm going to sacrifice that servant and he says

um they shall surely be the lords and listen

i will offer it up for a burnt offering so maybe it's an animal because there's you know they did the burnt offering but he's quite willing if it's a human being because he doesn't really know what's going to meet him so if it's one of his servants he's going to offer up that servant

going to offer up that servant as a burnt offering so jephthah passed over unto the children of ammon to fight against them

and the lord delivered them into his hands which he would have done anyway so jeff there's lack of understanding lack of confidence and deciding to bribe god is it's going to end in disaster for him and he smote them from aurora even till

you come into minith even 20 cities and unto the plain of the vineyards with a

very great slaughter it's supernatural it's like how is this even possible you know that god is behind it thus the children of ammon

were subdued before the children of israel

and so his whole understanding of the historical context of this battle was right on and just in that he should have understood the faithfulness of god to israel then jephthah came to mizpah unto his house so now after all this phenomenal victory he comes home and behold his daughter came out to meet him remember his vow whoever comes out to meet me first his daughter came out to meet him with timbrels and with dances and she was his own so she's the only person that came out to meet him and she was his only child beside her he had neither son nor daughter and it came to pass when he saw her that he tore his clothes and said alas my daughter you have brought me very low if it was so if it was another human being if it was one of my servants then i would just be in such joy and such victory because now i'm gonna be head over all of gilead i'm gonna i'm gonna realize my ambition and i'll have a human sacrifice along the way but i made that vow to god so i'm quite happy that's okay but it's my daughter and human beings have this very selfish way of thinking that we don't care if it's somebody outside of our family we don't care if it's somebody outside of our race we're just very myopic and very self-centered and only care about ourself and the extended self and so his daughter is part of his extended self you have brought me very so it's just like you have done you've done this it's not i have brought me very low i made a foolish vow somehow this is her fault coming out to

have joy that her father survived and he's victorious and he's come home i'll ask my daughter you have brought me very low

and you are one of them that trouble me so he had enemies

his own brothers were his enemies and they troubled him

and now she's saying to his daughter you're among my enemies why couldn't you have stayed in and let somebody else come out

first you are one of them that trouble me

for i have opened my mouth unto the lord and i came

back so again people are a mixture so there is a part of his character that when he's given his vow he's not going to go back on him there's a part of his character that's

there's a part of his character that's very courageous there's a part of his character that

understands the history of israel there's another part of his character that's very ambitious and there's another part of his character that's very insecure and

there's another part of his character that's willing to bribe god

and so people are a mixture and so in this

mixture now he sees he realizes he has to

sacrifice and burn alive like the pagans around him

burn his daughter in the fire and she said unto him

and not just on this point uh again i just

because i've been in this battle with my own black brethren about black lives matter trying to show them the danger they are in and how they are being pawns to the white marxist intellectuals they think they're doing the work of black people when in fact they're destroying black people and they're destroying their own fami

and they're destroying their own family that when black lives matter is successful

their children will be burnt offerings they will watch while their children are sacrificed

on the altar of black lives matter they will

watch while their sons are rounded up and have their penises cut off because black lives matter is about transgenderism

they rejoice in transgenderism they want to enforce transgenderism they want to destroy the nuclear family they want to remove the father from the

nuclear family so all you brethren that are running

after balaam you're going to sacrifice your own children

and you're going to realize what trouble you've brought on your own family as you play the pawn to the white socialist intellectuals who are laughing at you

they're laughing at you i'm trying to help you

i'm trying to show you i'm trying to open your eyes

and you're hostile to me while you're being manipulated by the white man by the white socialist these people are powerful intellects

and you have to go back to the 1920s you have to go back to the front you have to go back to

sorry earlier to karl marx then you have

to go to the frankfurt school then you have to go to cultural marxism then you have to study post-modernism and then you can have an opinion that matters about black lives matter but if you're just kind of caught up in the day-to-day and watching cnn and you want to have an opinion about black lives matter sorry your opinion doesn't count you don't know anything you're blind you ever hear that nursery rhyme three blind mice three blind mice see how they run see how they run they all run up to the farmer's wife who cut off their tail with a farmer's knife have you ever seen such a sight in your life as three blind mice except it won't be their tail

that the farmer's wife will be cutting off

the marxists will be cutting off the penises

of your sons they'll be removing your children from the home they're not your children they're the children of the state

i'm trying to help you i'm trying to help you

and she said unto him my father if you have opened your mouth unto the lord do to me and you know in fact i was sitting on the i went i had to get outside today get a bit of sunshine before i came in back for the study and i sat down on the park bench and i said

you know these folks who are fighting for balaam do they really understand what's going on and i said you know to understand what's going on you have to see all these forces and how they're shaping our society and how they all work together and i thought let me just make a list to myself of 10 things 10 things that if you can't explain how these ten things link together then you really don't deserve to have an opinion

so i started to write you know in five minutes can i come up with ten things to say can you explain to me how these things are interrelated and and how these these forces that are changing society are interrelated because if you can't then i'm not interested in your opinion because it's it's misinformed so i sat down i give myself five minutes to come up with 10 things

and in less than two minutes i came with up with 20.

and i said okay well 20 is good but i i wasn't finished

so i came up with 30. and i still wasn't finished so i came up with 35 and then i thought okay 35 that that's enough

and then they just kept coming so i finally came up with 40 and i said adrian stop

but i couldn't stop i ended up with 46. but let me just quickly throw these out at you and say to you do you understand how all these forces that are shaping our society are interconnected how are they woven together

what is the thread that ties them all together

because if you cannot answer this then you don't understand what's happening in the world around us and you don't know where it's heading so very quickly the covid quarantine the communist chinese party and that

it's not it's not criticized it caused this virus globally and nobody cares they only care about donald trump and destroying trump and bringing down america when the chinese communist party released this virus whether purposely or accidentally it came from them and it was negligence but nobody cares nobody's outraged black lives matter and their claim of systemic racism systemic it has to be systemic again this language doesn't come from the bible but systemic so that we have to bring the system down we have to remove the system entirely because it's systemic racism islam and the growth of islam in the west burning the american flag that people are joyfully burning the american flag the um criticizing america only only things that happen in america are bad even though things that happen far more egregious all over the world they're never mentioned uh the catholic church and it's its decadence antifa the the news media mass uh mass media manufactured consent the corporate cooperation that the major corporations support movements like black lives matter and antifa the whole epstein suicide and what's going on with with that case post-modernism the riots the and i just wrote this so quickly as i'm having struggle reading some of the writing cancel culture the palestinian uprising

sex education for your children

transgenderism

agenda uh i can go on and on abortion spygate fatherlessness google twitter facebook and and their censorship uh the 150 billion dollars that was given to our iran sworn enemy of america the toppling of statues uh the immorality of youth the the churches pursuing social justice leaving the gospel

and pursuing social justice um hollywood and the fact that you never see a movie anywhere that in any way comes close to criticizing china

everything coming out of hollywood everything produced on netflix is criticizing america and if anything it praises china and

shows how wonderful china is the hashtag metoo movement the climate change movement

the intelligence community and the corruption of the intelligence community at the highest levels

the demoralization of americans the the language of churches even cgi leaving the scriptures and being informed by

demons i could go on and on and on unless you can sit down and say adrian all of these things that you mentioned i understand

how they're all interwoven and how they all connect and how they are and then the future

and how they are and then the future that any one of them but how all of them combined

the future that it will bring if you don't know if you're just kind of it's all just sporadic to you

sporadic to you
you're really really uninformed and i
would say that

and i'm just again i'm speaking out of

love the stakes could not be higher the stakes could not be higher so these things are examples to us upon whom the ends of the earth should come the ends of the world should come why that we should not lust after evil things

covetousness is evil wanting the wealth that others have is evil do you have food do you have raiment be satisfied contentness contentment with godliness is great gain

that's what comes out of the scripture so don't lust after evil things we are part of something so grand like get this vision when we have this vision

it's like nothing else matters we have the pearl of great price everything else fades into obscurity but if we don't really have the vision then all these things matter to us and we're easily confused and manipulated let's just finish the chapter here he says

um do to me according to that which proceeded out of your mouth so a very loyal daughter and and not at all like the children today and again the marxist children when the children when the marxists get a hold of your children

they will betray you as fast as lightning so that cute little girl that cute little boy that you have once they're finished once they go through the university system in the grade school system you're going to lose them but here so loyalty together she says for as much as the lord has taken vengeance for you of your enemies even of the children of

ammon so she's like she's just really happy for him go ahead and do what you need to

and she said unto her father let this thing

be done for me let me alone for two months

and uh pastor i'm going to bring in pastor murray shortly so pastor murray when you do come in if you can just look at your camera i'm just

i'm seeing a bit of a challenge there maybe you need to just log out and log back in to see if we can fix that issue with your camera

so pastor murray will be joining soon and we can have some discussion and she said unto her father let this thing be done for me

allah leave me alone for two months that i may go up and down upon the mountains and bewail my virginity i and my fellows or i and my friends

and he said go and he sent her away for two months and she went with her companions

and bewelled her virginity upon the mountain so he didn't have any children she didn't have any children she wasn't married

and again at least at this time you know she cared about the fact that she was a virgin

today even in the church that people don't care about this and it came to pass at the end of two months that she returned unto her father who did with her according to his vow which he had vowed and she knew no man and it was a custom in israel

that the daughters of israel went yearly to lament the daughter of jephthah the gileadite four days in a year so

very stupid vow very unwise vow by a very ambitious man who was insecure and really not fully confident in the lord and and what what should have been a great victory ended up a great tragedy and so sometimes um we because of our lack of relying on god we can set things up in such a way that even when god delivers even when god comes through it's actually a it's not a full it's not a full victory so that is judges chapter 11 and uh what we'll do now is have a bit of time for q a and i'll just uh go ahead and bring in uh pastor murray and uh brother murray can you hear me okay yeah i can hear you well i i cannot hear you so that means i need to uh let's see here what is happening let me just change just give me a second number i just need to change my sound and i think what i can do is put on my headphones let me see if this helps can you hear me murray yeah i can hear you well can you hear me perfect and i can hear you perfectly well as well so that's great so thanks so much for joining us it's been a couple of weeks since uh we've been together like we've been together on the sabbath but since doing the the study yes so um how have you been uh good good uh really uh uh appreciate being back together here and uh getting back into the book of judges it's been uh pretty timely with all that's been going on around us

especially with uh you know the study of uh

gideon which took a few weeks and all that got

all that uh god says about israel and his people that is pretty relevant today so yeah

it's good to be back together very very good so um we have

good so um we have um if you can watch the church online feed i'm watching the facebook feed and i'm just testing out the ability to show facebook messages so we see brenda saying thank you god bless and zippy saying uh we have to have faith and do good deeds be strong that's we have to encourage each other to be

um here we see robert saying even the people who are not baptized see the vision of god amazing and that's that's another point robert i appreciate

strong

i'm bringing this up that social media that there is a note here there's a note here from book there's a note here just if i don't uh sorry for interrupting but from both wesley

and christine that i'm quite louder than you are so there's something uh an issue with your

your vlog so uh can you just does my volume sound louder now it does to me yeah we'll know in about 30 seconds okay so yeah so i just turned up the volume so thanks very much for that

um but this is very interesting by and i wonder what you think about this i'll share my thoughts on this he says even the people who are not baptized see the vision of god

and i think this is very important the

scripture shows us that there's going to be a wholesale repentance in the end time

but some of our brethren their posts on social media

are are about activism they're social activists they're not preaching the gospel

eden

and people are overwhelmed with negative news and they're falling into depression they're falling into anxiety and if they come across then and read our posts we're driving them further into that depression instead of showing them the vision of god and i just wonder what your thoughts are marie yeah um ever since the garden of

that man has had a hole yeah a godless hole in him that he seeks to fill and he'll fill it with something and our job is to help them fill it with the truth of god with the with the true gospel and you're right uh go back to judges eight and nine the point that you made uh where uh god said uh i'm just paraphrasing it right now but uh if if you're going to go that way make sure it better be for the four that you that you were in it wholeheartedly and just misguided uh but uh don't don't go in

uh trying to you know play both sides right right yeah that's i think when uh when uh abimelech's people were like okay

you're going after abimelech and you're doing it sincerely that's one thing but if you're doing it strategically and politically and playing both sides that's completely different yeah and i think what we're going to talk about uh

this sabbath i'm working on a message relative to conscience and timothy well the new paul paul is several times in the new testament talks about this concept of conscience which is

was really a greek term a greek concept uh much like logos was that paul then adapted

into understanding of into an understanding

and what's coming to light here we're going to look at a little bit deeper this the sabbath

is this concept of conscience is the ability to

to understand where your motives lie that your motives are clean or evil or pure

and my fear is

uh that some of our brethren are not not uh um they're not doing out of malice they're absolutely absolutely misguided here

with their with their intent yes and and that's why we need to

uh um make sure we check our intent and and our our moral compass and synthesize it because that's that's what we're going to see is that's this greek word

um it has to do with synthesizing our morality

um and we need to make sure we synthesize it

with the right document which is god's word nice uh and that's what i was saying in the study today that if my words abide in you

so we got to make sure that his words are abiding in us but uh that's a nice teaser

and i really uh really enjoyed that we're looking forward to that

um so uh is my sound any better uh it's much closer to even uh good good much closer um i was gonna say something else in response to what you said you were talking about yeah so just a little bit that i saw the title of your sermon and the scripture that you chose it sounds very very intriguing it sounds like it's gonna be a very very interesting study appreciate that any any other comments or questions i have a few more from facebook but any on the uh just just a comment from the sister that uh samuel and first daniel 12 uh refers back and includes jeff that as as one of the folks that uh god uh uh ascends to to help deliver israel right um and i think another um another message that we want to get across here is that the judges are chosen not because they're wonderful people but because god loves israel and there's something in them that he can work with so it's not that we're looking for perfect these many saviors have to be perfect they don't have to be perfect they just have to have some attribute and usually it's courage but they have to have some attribute that god can use to to deliver israel through through the human affairs right and it is interesting some of them were mentioned in hebrews 11 uh as as being [Music] we call it the hall of faith yes the pillars of babe uh jeff that was one gideon was one

that's mentioned in there i think barack as well

um but if you go even going before the the folks that are listed there as the judges and going all the way back to the patriarchs uh you can do a study and see that all of the patriarchs there are sins

they were not perfect people right exactly

and the bible the bible doesn't hide it god doesn't hide it no in fact um he shines the light on

no in fact um he shines the light on that so that

uh much like paul said it's not it's not neither doing this is it's god i'm just going to understand

now to me uh pastor murray what you're touching on here is so critical because there's a lot of brethren who hate america

and and inwardly they're glad that america is failing

because they don't see america as biblically based but what you just brought out

speaks to the judeo-christian principles behind america

when the marxists speak they speak of utopia their rhetoric is wonderful we want to see a world where nobody is poor everybody nobody is forced to work everything is just so beautiful and wonderful and it's it's animal farm but this utopia you just have to give me the power and we just need to keep making the

government stronger and more powerful to do this distribution of wealth and then once they get in power they bring hell but america

is founded on this concept that man must be free because that's a god-given right but how do we

govern men who have the right from god to be free

if we ourselves are corrupt and so a lot of effort was put into building this constitution in such a way that it acknowledged

man is flawed and if he has too much power

he will abuse it so let's set up this system in such a way because the bible shows us how flawed men are even the best of us let's set up this system in such a way that there are checks and balances and no one man or one branch of government or or or

institution
can have too much power wonderful
yeah for sure yeah absolutely i
completely agree and i think what
uh what lies behind america's greatness
and again not perfect and and they were
led by flawed people so there's no
there's no debating that but it was it
is and was a great country
uh and you used the phrase judeo
christian principles and we do have a
couple of comments here i'll just sort
of finish my thought here with you

in the cursings and the blessings with uh there are certain natural ramifications of doing things god way now were they were they

um that goes to uh what god had set up

uh first fruits uh it doesn't seem to be uh some of our the the american the uh forefathers

but some of the principles they practiced are biblical principles and they're just natural blessings that result from absence of the knowledge of absolutely you can have no knowledge of god but as long as you're practicing these principles they're natural right yeah very very good so yeah i completely agree with you there so uh uh one sister here says jeff his faith seemed weak but his daughter still managed to have her own relationship with god sometimes the children have to lead the way

wow great comment and you see that i saw that you're fragile

yes exactly they're very good and uh that's what we need today we need that next generation

to come up and to have that faith because the scripture shows us that in the end time the people of god are going to do

exploits so as our generations fade away and the new generations come up we need them to have that strong faith absolutely

another sister makes a comment uh um it seems as if jeff that was trying to be diplomatic

with the king of ammon yeah great great comment and i think absolutely that if this could have been handled diplomatically

he seemed to have a lot of uh abilities that you know they rejected him and threw him out because he was the daughter of a prostitute and of course they're perfect

but he's not so they get rid of him uh then suddenly they realize they need him and he when he shows up there's a lot of things there that are

commendable his his understanding of the history of israel his belief in god uh his his courage and his diplomacy and you see even uh even his negotiation ability

you know when they say oh come back we'll make you the captain he's like uh not so fast that maybe

i need i need more than that okay what about the head uh okay yeah and you think of

again donald trump the art of the deal uh he's he's

not just a businessman he's a negotiator but he's also this he's ready for war if like china wants to go to war let's go to war previous

administrations republican and democrat were giving away the country to china and there's sort of this global collusion that china will take the lead in ushering this

communist future but he's like no we've got to stop this this doesn't make any sense

and so he's demonstrating a lot of capabilities beyond the typical politician and he's somebody that was just laughed at and ridiculed and rejected

and so yes absolutely i think that jeff the

had demonstrated significant uh skill in diplomacy but it was rejected yeah and it's interesting too as you walk through his handling of israel's history um we've said it many times over the last five weeks and even before that those who forget their history cease to become a people this is evidence this is evidence here that

um this rejected uh son of a prostitute kept up on his history uh cared enough about his people that he kept on their history and was able to exactly very good and you could imagine the media the cnn of the day oh
this is this mother she's horrible she's
a prostitute and just they just would
not they would not let that go
uh and yet god chose this man um and so
let's let's be careful and you know
we're looking for perfection
we're all none of us are perfect you
know i wanted to mention in the study
pastor marina i just mentioned it now i
don't know if you've seen this
this is a chart done by the medical
association in texas
showing the risk of contracting coveit
19.

what are listing all these activities from low risk to high risk and uh this the high among the highest risk second from the bottom is attending a religious gathering of more than 500 people this puts you at the highest risk of contracting covid19 it doesn't say of risk of dying but just of contracting covid19 so i thought it was quite interesting that

you know we think of the feast and we want to gather at the feast and they're already flagging this as of the highest risk activity but um things like uh obviously the riots rioting for black lives matter that's not a high risk activity and they have all these other activities that are considered low risk but attending a church service if there's more than 500 people there that is of the height that's the worst thing you could possibly do it just goes to uh uh speak to more and more of the conspiracy behind all of this thing not that not that the virus isn't dangerous it is

but it's being used uh for reasons to uh and and when you understand the bible and you understand biblical prophecy and where things are going um satan's target is god's people so exactly this is all part of uh um everybody else is what do they call uh uh casualty of war exactly right murray that's a perfect perspective if only we could get god's people to understand that we are the highest prize the spiritual children and the genetically descended children of israel and judah this is the target of satan and everything that's happening on the chessboard that's the prize and and what you said a lot i think i fear a lot of people don't understand i just have a couple of uh more comments here arlene says uh thank you for the bible study tonight really missed the past two weeks always look forward to the bible study so that's one of the brethren that certainly appreciates and i did get a lot of uh emails and uh messages from people asking you know do we have a study tonight so something pastor murray people do appreciate um i just wanna just a couple more uh civility being destroyed and losing freedom uh that's certainly a trend and again if we understand marxism and cultural marxism we'll understand the agenda and what's going on uh and and that's something that god's people need to be wary of that we can't be uncivil we must rise above our behavior must

must manifest what god has taught us to be right on right on very very good did you have some more um comments from the oh just one just came through yeah uh sister says ruth is set on the time of the judges does the kinsmen redeemer idea translate into the into being a judge in the book of judges uh state the question again customary ruth is set in the time of the of the judges does the kinsmen redeemer concept translate into being a judge in the book of judges yeah and judges we define as a savior or or redeemer a mini redeemer but the redeemer has to come from among the people and so you will never see among the judges that is a gentile that god raises up and puts in the office to deliver his people the gentiles are genetically wired to hate israel and to destroy israel and so god then from among his own people there's a redeemer that rises up to to to claim uh i think more study could go into that and specifically the definition of kinsman redeemer but it definitely has to be a redeemer from from from kin right i absolutely agree and uh for the very reason that christ uh had to come from within the people of uh of judah yes yes uh no other comments here so far uh just those three great and just uh um a question here from willow which i'm not sure if you're able to answer this a lot of city and county

in south carolina have a mandate to wear a mask policy so you have to wear a mask my question some have added a clause that if it's against your religion you do not have to wear a mask what does the bible say i know romans chapter 13 and why don't we just quickly go to romans 13. sure this was actually a scripture that i wanted to cover in the sermon on sabbath but uh let's just quickly look at that let every soul be subject unto the higher powers for there is no power but of god the powers that be are ordained of god whosoever therefore resists the power resists the ordinance of god and they that resist shall receive to themselves damnation and again this is i didn't cover this on sabbath when i was dealing specifically with black lives matter but all of our black activists who are getting behind black lives matter you are going contrary to the word of god the word of god says that christians should be subject to the higher powers we are not revolutionaries we are not trying to overthrow government we're not trying to tear down society that's not what christians do that's not what jesus taught that's not what his uh his apostles taught there is no power but of god so god allows these powers these people to be in office the powers that be are ordained of god whosoever therefore resists the power resists the ordinance of god and they that resist shall receive to themselves damnation so based on the strength of

this romans 13 1 and 2 and we can go on uh to read the best the rest but i think the essence of it is here

um i would say that if the mask becomes mandatory uh then christians are not going to rise up and fight against me personally i i don't think there's science enough science to support the wearing of masks i think there's a lot of people that are wearing them incorrectly and they're actually damaging their

health rather than supporting or strengthening their health but if i'm going somewhere and they say you know for this particular time you need to wear a mask

then i can choose not to go there nobody's forcing me to go there so maybe i'll say you know what no thanks i'm not going to go but i'm not going to start a revolution over this but what happened to my body my choice

you know when it comes to killing a baby hey my body my choice but now suddenly when it comes to wearing a mask my body not my choice i have to do what the government tells me and where is all this heading so so it's these sort of incremental encroachments on freedom and especially i think for americans america was built on freedom so that's

top of mind thoughts to that pastor murray

sort of my my

murray
yeah no i completely agree uh i'm not a
fan of the masks
um i think that um
there's there's too much there's too
much evidence the other way that that

the masks cause more problems than they than they than they solve uh but that being said you know i i'm a younger man of in good health uh i do understand that that the there are we have older brethren that are a little susceptible um and i i think you make a good point um that uh we are not to be revolutionaries for this world we are here to shine on the gospel in fact i'll throw another scripture and i don't know if you have time to throw it up on the board or not but it's first of all first timothy hang on let me just let me get there first verse one the universe one till about uh three i suppose first sorry hang on a second i'm all thumbs first timothy two go ahead yep uh beginning of verse 1 it says so after he he's really just introducing timothy to the concept of of uh um why he's leaving him uh kind of mentoring him here and as he leaves him here to to to raise up the church and take care of the church he begins in uh the the bulk of the letter in chapter two verse one he says i exhort therefore that first of all supplications prayers intercessions and giving of thanks be made for all men for kings and for all that are authority and here's why here's some what we overlook that we the body of christ exactly quiet and peaceful life

in all godliness and honesty for this is good and acceptable in the sight of god our savior

this goes completely this this gives us reason not to be

revolutionaries to to change this world today exactly

and you know exactly and you know pastor murray this is a fantastic scripture because

we know the history of america and we

have to ask ourselves up to now have we been able to preach the gospel

you know when the worldwide church of god was one of the most powerful broadcasts in the world did that happen in america

were we able to go about our work under the auspices of an american flawed system i think the answer is clearly yes

absolutely if we give power to balaam if we give power to black lives matter and all the marxists

allow us to preach the gospel they're already saying that attending a church service is one of the most dangerous things that you can do they're already saying that there's no

they're already saying that there's no place for jesus

they're already saying take the father out of the home they're already saying the children belong to the state not to the family

so we want to give these people power we want to put these people in power and do we think we'll be able to go about a peaceable a quiet and peaceable life in godliness and honesty or will we be forced to give our children over to transgenderism will we be forced to educate our

children at the earliest ages

in sexual activity because the marxists know that the sooner they can get children to engage in sexual activity the less likely they will be successful in pair bonding that the more sexual they are at an earlier age

the less the less successful they will be in marriage

the more pure they are at an early age when they do bond with another human being they'll be able to bond for life the marxists know this they learned a painful lesson in world war one and world war ii

the power of family and they are set out to destroy it

and all i can say is woe unto any of our brethren

who are supporting these marxist movements this is a great scripture murray did you want to read a bit more on this

uh no no that's i think that's that's enough for today it's great yeah from great scripture but that really goes to uh um

that is why they are saying that uh going to church is very dangerous it's not because of the virus yeah it's because it's because it wouldn't it's what inoculates us against all that they're trying to indoctrinate and they're acting like the virus is the most dangerous thing that we could ever face

meanwhile communist china is arming itself

it is doubling down on its military power we've got islam that is doubling down on its military power we've got all kinds of threats things that will clearly annihilate us and they're using this covet 19 this is the most power this is the only danger that we should care about and therefore if that's the only danger we should care about attending a church service

is the biggest the riskiest thing we could ever do meanwhile the communists are taking over our country and taking away our freedoms um there's somebody here that is uh philip you're asking where is cgi located in toronto and you've given us your phone number we'll definitely reach out to you

and and give you that information so thank you so much for your interest and others are just saying that uh they really appreciate our teachings and jan your teachings murray and jan as well and a couple just a couple of comments here relative to uh the masks and and uh uh dr fauci uh flip-flopping on on masks being completely ineffective in january

to being the only thing we need now and and you know there's a place for masks and doctors wear masks for a reason

uh but they know what they're doing and they know how to handle the masks and and you know you look up a disease like hypoxia

and hypercapnia hypoxia being the lack of oxygen in the bloodstream people are hyperventilating ventilating and passing out and getting into accidents and getting into danger because there's not enough oxygen in their blood because they're cutting it off with these masks and hypercapnia is when the

uh ratio of carbon dioxide and oxygen in the blood is out of balance there's too much carbon dioxide in the blood uh hypercapnia leads to organ failure ultimately

so so all of this where mass wear masks wear masks and there's no instruction on how to wear them and the danger and how to how you can make a mask a cesspool for fungus and how that can lead to

uh lung infection no instruction on this and no instruction on what to do to protect your immune system and how to make sure you're strengthening your immune system over time no

none of this just mass mass mask and vaccine it's very very strange very strange indeed and i i'm sure uh i'm sure there's uh many many uh uh terrible reasons behind it this is they're not they're not worried about our health for sure yeah there's uh agendas agendas behind us for sure

amen and zippy says can't stop her worshiping the lord of lords and she's concerned about the mark of satan that's not for her amen and uh rod says we're so courageous in canada you know what god's people are courageous all over the world why because christ says that if we if we uh deny him before men he'll deny us before his father and and that's what

these communists they hate uh they hate um and i just see a comment there about the mask as well

they hate christ and they they are going to force us and position society in such a way that we'll be canceled if we stand up for christ and these black lives matter they hate jesus christ they hate christ

i just i'm still trying to understand why anybody would support these people um and so we cannot deny him so yeah we've got to be filled with the spirit and and and the other thing that christ said pastor murray is that he tells us these things beforehand so that his joy will remain with us so despite everything that's happening there's a joy that we have because everything is happening exactly as he said it would absolutely pastor adrian for sure that's why god gives us these prophecies so that we uh read and as you know begin beginning revelation we read and reread them so we don't think exactly because when these things happen we we it gives us a sense of calm and peace of mind that uh god god is in charge and he'll take care of us amen amen to that brother so uh did you want to say anything else uh just about the uh upcoming sermon on the sabbath and i i i love where you're going with this when i say the same i saw the title and i saw this scripture reading i thought wow this is going to be very interesting yeah i think it's just a you know it's been a heavy five weeks of uh covering uh your three messages and my message and jan's message as we reacted to uh some of the feedback about black lives matter and some of the marxist agendas we're seeing so i i didn't want to i wanted it's almost like a bit of a um a segway into where do we go from here it's a segue into you know we've done the heavy lifting and we've done a lot of

uh a lot of emotional uh processing of things but now now it's time to understand uh how do we keep moving forward

properly as god's people amen and again the offers out there for those brethren are having difficulty processing where we're coming from and have very strong opinions on the other side

we're happy to have a roundtable discussion and we'll record it a digital round table we'll record it we'll make it available to the brethren so that people can hear the other side as i said in my sermon we can reason let's reason together and bring your information bring your scriptures and let's explore this and help each other but we're speaking from a place of passion and love for you and and inviting you to research the scriptures to see if these things are so absolutely and

if these things are so absolutely and it's it's when we can't reason together that uh

it's a huge red flag that something's not right and and just on that as well when we can't reason together and when christ says

look i'm giving you a command make sure that you

love one another until i come so if we find within ourselves something is bubbling up

that is causing us to despise one another causing us to hate one another causing us not to be able to forgive one another

when the command is to love one another the way i have loved you so that when people see us they're like wow there's something different happening there all this racial unrest in the world and clearly these people love each other they don't see race they don't see economic status

they don't see age they just love each other

that's that's what we've got to pursue and you know

what's ominous is that it's christ says it's the sign of discipleship that's that's the sign do you want a sign of how you're my disciples there it is so so if we're not feeling that

it's a big it's a big mirror being held up yes yeah a major red flag you know that the the danger in the reality is god will separate some of his people from him

and he personally will throw them in the lake of fire

so we cannot take god for granted we have to have a godly

fear about us and people need to see that we don't fear men we fear god absolutely and i i think

we fear god absolutely and i i think i think that um that's what people need to understand here is

is the passion we've displayed and and you addressed it in your sermon last week that that

sometimes that passion comes out um rather forcefully um but to understand where that's coming from

because our our

uh modus operandi is to help save people from eternal death that's our job that's our responsibility

if you love me feed my sheep and sometimes it sometimes it means taking each other to task like paul took peter to task

yeah exactly and it's and it's not you know bring smooth things so

so you know am i a pastor murray that you would say that adrian i should check in with the people and see what they would like to hear and and then when you when you take their temperature then preach according to the things they would like to hear or should i just study the scripture and preach what's in the scripture and if people can't handle it and they have a problem with god i can't make their problem with god my problem because then i'll have a problem with god

i just have to preach what's in the word absolutely absolutely you know and you know isaiah talks about you know preaching

that preach to us nice things and preach through soft and soft and easy things now if the congregation is saying hey we don't understand this can you cover this that's a difference that's a way different thing uh for sure but uh yeah a big long road ahead of us but uh uh appreciate all that you do pastor yeah and likewise and and we'll get there we'll get there um you know god loves israel

and we are the first fruits of israel and he's going to have a first fruits harvest

and then he's going to have a fall harvest and then the rest of humanity will come into the harvest as well so we know that god is coming for his people

let's get ready and let's let's take him seriously take his word seriously and let his word abide in us absolutely absolutely so brother really looking forward to your message on sabbath it sounds very intriguing and and very comforting and uh i love you my brother love all that you do and uh i just really appreciate the opportunity to to minister alongside you yes it's uh it's uh great to have you at my six someone at some point it's great to be at your stick someone i

it's great to be at your stick someone i don't remember who said that it was uh i think it was chris somebody named chris yeah chris somebody named chris said

yes so that's uh i haven't forgotten that yeah yeah let's have each other six that's for sure and then for those who didn't see that that's a military term for having your back having someone else's back so amen looking forward to sabbath uh brethren god bless thank you so much for joining us
