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well welcome to another Wednesday night

Bible study and can you believe it we

are at the end of book one God willing

we'll finish book 1 tonight

and what I'm going to do at the end of

each book god willing I will just um

break out and do another smaller book of

the Bible and then come back and

continue with sobs just so that we will

break up the Psalms a little bit a

little bit at the end of each book we'll

go out and do another smaller book of

the Bible and that way we'll we'll get

more coverage so what I'm planning to do

God willing after the study tonight

beginning next week we'll study the book of Zephaniah so you might want to read ahead and God willing we'll go through the book of Zephaniah together and that should take us to the Feast of Tabernacles and speaking of the the feasting coming feast days murray pastor maria and i will be hosting the feast in Collingwood Ontario so if you haven't solidified your plans and you're wondering if you're enjoying these studies why not come out to Collingwood and enjoy the feast with us with that let's uh let's go ahead and open with a word of Prayer and then we can get into the study for this evening and at the end of this study pastor Marie will be joining me live and that way we can answer any questions comments concerns insights that you have with respect to book one of Psalms let's open with the word of Prayer our Father we pause as we always do to acknowledge you to thank you to praise you and to ask you Father to bless our study we thank you for the hunger and thirst that you've given to us for your word and for your righteousness and we pray father that your word will not only inform us but that it would also transform us we thank you Lord we know these are very dark days very tumultuous times very important times and we just pray father that we will all fulfill your expectations and the role that you've carved out for us we praise you Lord and just pray that you'll bless our study tonight we ask this in Jesus most holy name Amen we're up to Psalm 38 38 and 39 our lamentations 40 is a Thanksgiving song and then 41 will be another lamentation so let's go ahead and get straight into the study for the evening and we can

just go ahead in Psalm 38 let's just set up here get the scripture lined up and we will begin with Psalm 38 he says it's a psalm of David to bring to remembrance Oh Lord rebuke me not in your wrath it just opens up right away in this um relationship that he has with God where he's seeking God's forgiveness so Lord rebuke me not in your wrath neither chasing me in your hot displeasure for your arrows stick fast in me and your hand presses me sore so the king is in a very difficult situation and he's interpreting it that it is at the hand of God and and so he's pleading for God's mercy he says there is no soundness in my flesh because of your anger so something is obviously wrong here he's he's unwell and because of this sickness that he has or sorry this sickness that he has he's attributing it to God's anger with him he says there's no soundness in my flesh because of your anger neither is there any rest in my bones because of my sin so for this particular situation that he's in this sickness that he has he's able to create a direct link and this is not always the case you know in the case of Joel Joel was very ill and it wasn't a direct correlation his friends were trying to make this direct correlation you must have done something wrong and whereas God was working with him but here David is in a situation where he is making a direct correlation between his sickness and his sin he says for my iniquities are gone over my head as a heavy burden they are too heavy for me so he's a lot of introspection here many of us perhaps could do with more introspection David is certainly thinking about his life looking at his

character looking at his flaws and also at the situation that he's in and he says it's a heavy burden my wounds stink and are corrupt because of my foolishness so whatever this sickness is it is similar to Joel perhaps where he had boils and something is terribly wrong with his skin and he says it's corrupt because of his foolishness you know we don't know what happened here again but I have known people or I know a person I knew a person who got into a terrible situation with his health because of sexual sin and he did repent but he did he pay a price and and so you know sinfulness and foolishness has consequences and David certainly is making a connection between his sinfulness and this these wounds and this corruption in his body he says I am troubled

I am bowed down greatly I go mourning all the day long so this is something very serious it's not it's not a trivial I've got a cold or the flu whatever he has here it's very very serious and he's bowed down greatly he goes mourning all the day long for my loins are filled with a loathsome disease and the disease is supplied but it is something that the Hebrew implies heat and something that's hot maybe you know when you get these ailments these boils it burns and so there's a something is burning for him he's filled with a burning and there is no soundness in his flesh

I am feeble and sore broken so this is David who was so healthy and ruddy and strong sickness befell him and any of us from day to day we can just find our circumstances change and so we cannot take health for granted and we cannot take our circumstances for granted and

here certainly David is in trouble
he's feeble and sore broken I have
roared by reason of the disquiet nough
some I heart again it just gives us the
sense of how serious this illness is
that he's facing he says Lord all my
desire is before you and my groaning is
not hid from you so he is in this and
this is something we really do learn
from the Psalms just how transparent
David is with God as his father my heart
pence my strength fails me as for the
light of my eyes it has gone from me and
again the what I said earlier from day
to day we give God thanks we don't know
from day to day what can happen but
certainly David now finds you know a he
has a brightness in his eyes and people
look at him and interact with him and
you see you see brightness in people's
eyes and then we also have seen dimness
in the eye and here David is so troubled
and so mournful that he says the light
of his eyes it's gone then he goes on to
say my lovers and my friends stand aloof
from Mysore and and this certainly puts
us in mind of job and how Joe was so
powerful and so influential and was
surrounded by his family and loved ones
and friends and then when he went into
this deep severe trial his lovers and
his friends stood aloof from his sore
and David is in this situation now and
my kinsmen stand afar off so he's
basically saying god I've got nobody and
in ancient Israel that is a real that's
really something we don't have it so
much today the way we live
you know diversity is our strength how
complete not I guess is gonna say it's
complete nonsense but I guess maybe it's
not it's a true statement depending on
how we define our if we say diversity is
our strength and we think we're talking

about a society as a whole that's
complete
the greater the diversity in an in a
society that the less trust there is in
a society so diversity is our strength
if we're talking about the elite if if
we define our as the elite yet diversity
is the strength of the elite as society
breaks down that works in their favor
but because of this way that we live
with a lot of anonymity we don't
understand what it means to say our kin
my kinsmen stand afar off in ancient
Israel and in these ancient cultures
your tribe your clan was everything and
your position in your clan meant
everything in fact as I think about this
in studying the life of Muhammad this is
a man that would have been destroyed and
killed and wiped out because of the
trouble that he caused in Mecca at the
time of his starting his his movement
but the reason he was not dealt with was
because of his kinsmen that he was part
of the Quraysh tribe and that meant
something and so when somebody in that
tribe sponsors you and looks after you
your your your gold and this is the way
it was anciently in these in these
ancient cultures your tribe your clan
meant everything and here
David is saying I'm a reject my my clan
doesn't know me anymore
they also that seek after my life lay
snares from me so a David is saying that
there are people who actually want to
see him dead and they're laying traps
for him and they that seek my hurt speak
mischievous things and it's funny I was
just looking at this trailer I don't
know if you've seen this movie or Denis
he's not playing but this trailer for
this movie called the hunt which is the
they just love it as this this is cinema

that sinks its claws into your back
it's soap spellbinding and so compelling
and five stars and four stars and
everybody loves it and fundamentally
it's a movie about hunting down
Christians and destroying Christians and
that certainly you know puts me in mind
of Nimrod the mighty hunter for the Lord
against the Lord who was hunting human
beings and here we have a film now
hunting human beings and so again
these psalms matter to us because
we are going to find ourselves in
situations that we cannot foresee right
now but God has foreseen them and he's
given us everything that we need and as
we interact with the days ahead we are
going to have to interact with the
psalms it took to get through them and
to encourage each other and to find
strength and to know that we're not
alone that others have gone through
these difficult situations and trials
that we will be going through so he says
they also that seek after my life lay
snares for me and if this isn't the
future of Christians that I'm not
understanding the Bible and so we have
to understand this that there will be
those who hate us and will be laying
traps for us they also that they also
that seek after my life lay there for
me and they that seek my hurt speak
mischievous things and imagine deceits
all the day long this is what they do
and you know I was thinking about that
the power of the devil that the mighty
power of the devil is deception and the
power of deception is perception and so
narrative the storyteller the person who
can explain what's going on and give you
a view a lens through which to interpret
what you're seeing this is extreme power
and this is the power of the devil devil

and so what we hear about you know fake news this is the devil's work to to twist our heads and to get us to miss perceive what's going on around us so that we side with the villains instead of siding with the heroes we side with evil instead of siding with good all of this comes down to the power of narrative and so these people who are imagining deceptions they are very very clever and I don't know if you've seen the news in the or the article about the New York Times and how the New York Times I think it was just this week has has somebody basically they had this that the chief editor had a what he called that not a press conference but uh Town Hall have a town hall meeting with his staff and basically told them the whole Russia thing that we've been on for two and a half years it didn't work so let's switch from Russia Russia Russia to racism so we need now we need to now push the whole race that that Donald Trump is a racist and we need to stir conflict between the races between the races and stir up this whole white supremacy and and white nationalists and their and Trump is empowering them and he's against blacks this is mischief this is mischief and it's very clever mischief and this is what these people do and we've been warned about this by this xkj KGB officer Yuri Desmond off who said that the Communists in their desire to destroy America had four stages of subversion how to destroy America and I said it would take 20 years to do this basically a generation that you start with a generation that then becomes adults and we're seeing this now with all the whole antiphon movement and all

the chaos that's in society today so the first step of these four stages is demoralization so they came in and they took over the universities and they've been teaching their Marxist ideology to our children and our children now come out with these these socialist concepts and that's what that's the first step of the subversion the second step now is where we are today disturbs destabilization so they want to ruin the economy they want to destroy our relationship Foreign Relations destroy our defense systems and just create all of this civil unrest and so we look around us today and the unrest is unbelievable I personally have never seen anything like this in my lifetime I I was too young to understand what was going on with Vietnam but but this is crazy and there's that there's a level of insanity that has gripped the nation's the Western nations well this is the Marxist agenda once they get this other steepest destabilization and that you know open borders and open migration and bring everybody in and and diversity is our strength how nonsensical and and we believe things that are just crazy we believe that men are women and women are men and pedophilia is wonderful and and and Islam is wonderful and beautiful and and female genital mutilation should be protected and we've just we can't think straight this is the destabilization and all of this is now leading to crisis there is going to be chaos lawlessness everywhere and when they reach this level of crisis we have no choice but to beg the government to come in and take control and that leads to normalization where now they can implement stability which basically means socialism so this

is this is what this is what we're
undergoing and so this mischief that we
see them involved in where they did this
level of hatred for Donald Trump he is
clearly the most evil man that has ever
existed there is nobody more evil than
Donald Trump this is a man that has no
loved ones oh wait no what Satan loves
him so so this is a man that has no
loved ones except Satan that this is
what's happened to America the most
powerful empire that has ever been the
most benevolent empire that has ever
been used it's unique in the history of
mankind

we've never seen anything like this and
we're watching the destruction of it and
when it falls woe unto Christians and
Jews because this is an empire that has
actually been founded with Christian and
Jewish ideology or philosophy that
underpins it which basically means
respect for human beings and and there's
you know Oh slavery slavery slavery you
show me an empire that has repented of
slavery because I don't know any except
the Western empires who have been
influenced by Christianity and have said
no we have to stop doing this every
other Empire just took it for granted
and so we're we're being manipulated by
these Marxists and we don't understand
what they're doing to us and now they're
turning us against each other and we
have to be so careful not to fall into
their trap but david says that they that
seek his hurt and those that seek our
hurt speak mischievous things this is
what we call fake news today they're
speaking mischief and they imagine
deceits all the day long they just are
so clever and intellectual and figuring
out how they can put false narratives
out there basically to turn us against

each other and and bring down all all
sense of lawfulness and respect for
human life
most empires and this is something we
don't understand most empires had no
respect for human life this movie the
hunt this is the typical Empire that
human life means nothing and there's
always these two-tier systems where if
you're not in our criminal gang then
you're not a human being and you're less
than human will we destroy you and we
just enslave you and take advantage of
you this is the way most empires run and
we have no idea what's going to replace
the American Empire once it falls but
then a David says despite all of this he
says but I as a deaf man heard not and I
was as a dumb man that opens not his
mouth so these are wicked people that
are surrounding him he has every reason
to complain but somehow he has put their
persecution in the context of God's hand
upon him so he's basically saying he
deserves this
and so he's not going to push back
against it so despite the fact that they
are wrong despite the fact that they are
evil despite the fact that he's
afflicted with their persecution he does
not say he does not complain he does not
retaliate he says thus I was as a man
that here is not and in whose mouth are
no reproofs so as much as there they
have all of this fake news about him and
all these false accusations about him
and and you know he's the king but he's
a racist he's the king but he's oh he's
a rapist and he's a destroyer and all
kinds of false accusations he's saying
hey I I'm not responding I'm not
listening to this
thus I was as a man that hears not and
in whose mouths are no reproofs for in

you or Lord do I hope you will hear O
Lord my god so he is just crystal clear
God is gonna take care of this I don't
have to retaliate this is unjust and
uncalled for and they will have their
comeuppance for I said hear me lest
otherwise they should rejoice over me
when my foot slips they magnify
themselves against me so he's just
totally putting himself in God's hands
he says for I am ready to halt and my
sorrow is continually before me so he if
it's up to him his life is lost so now
he's just casting himself casting all
his cares upon God for I will declare my
iniquity so I I will admit any
wrongdoing that I've done yeah they've
got all kinds of false accusations but
I'm not a perfect person and I will
declare my iniquity and I will be sorry
for my sin but my enemies are lively and
they are strong and notice this and they
that hate me wrongfully are multiplied
so this is what's happening now is the
wicked are multi
so when when the wicked are empower the
people mourn and when marks that Marxism
has done nothing for Humanity except
destroy it
and so when Marxists are in power woe
unto Christians woe unto the Christian
and and so even though he's justifying
what he's going through in his own mind
as something that look I'm not perfect I
have iniquity I've sinned these people
are really it's God's hand upon me
that's how he sees it but at the same
time he's very clear that they hate him
wrongfully there's no reason for them to
have this derangement syndrome against
him he says my enemies are lively and
they are strong and they that hate me
wrongfully are multiplied that there's a
salt once more there's a benefit to

being against him and so people are joining their lot with their enemies for spoil for the benefit for the financial reward or the reward of power or the reward of sexual favors whatever it is that that floats their boat they also that render evil for good are my adversaries so this is who they are you do good to them they come back with evil they just have this wicked agenda because I follow the thing that good is forsake me not oh Lord oh my god be not far from me make haste to help me O Lord my salvation and so that is the first Psalm of lamentation in this set let's look at the second one - the chief musician even to jettison a psalm of David so jeddah 'then we have to go back to chronicles to see who jettison was and it says here in chapter 16 forty one of first chronicles and with them he men and jeduthun and the rest that were chosen who were expressed by name to give thanks to the Lord because his mercy endures forever so this is the getting the Ark of the Covenant back and and these were the chief musicians who were to praise God for His mercy in returning the Ark of the Covenant and so with them Haman and jeduthun with trumpets and cymbals for those that should make a sound and with musical instruments of God and the sons of Jeddah 'then were porters so a very very significant musician a very prominent position in terms of those that were responsible for leading the praise of God I said I will take heed to my ways that I sin not with my tongue so again there's all of this persecution and affliction on him it seems as well that he's suffering some form of illness and he's careful

like job was not to sin with his tongue
so he says I will take heed to my ways
that I sin not with my tongue I will
keep my mouth with a bridle while the
wicked is before me so the wicked are
full of accusations they're full of fake
news they're full of these false
accusations and persecution and and just
wicked wicked accusations and he's not
saying anything
he's just set his mind that he's gonna
keep a bridle on his mouth and I'm not
sure that this Psalm is directly
connected to this incident in 2nd Samuel
16 but the principle I think we can see
very clearly how David approached
persecution from the wicked so here in
2nd Samuel 16 I think you'll remember
this incident beginning in verse 5 and
when King David came to Baja rim by
harine behold events came out a man of
the family of the house of Saul whose
name was shimmy shimmy or shimmy and the
son of Gera and he came forth and cursed
still as he came and he cast stones at
David they throwing stones at David much
like we see an Tifa today throwing
stones at people to kill them to harm
them and he cast stones at David and at
all the servants of King David
and all the people and all the mighty
man were on his right hand and on his
left so this is quite a revolt and thus
said Shem I when he cursed come out come
out you bloody man you man of Belial so
David is of the devil not Saul Saul is
righteous and wonderful and we wish we
had more leaders like him David is the
problem David is in the way and so David
is the son of the devil and David is the
murderer not Saul so again this is your
woe unto them who called the good evil
and the evil good the Lord has returned
upon you all the blood of the house of

Saul in whose stead you have reigned and the Lord has delivered the kingdom into the hand of Absalom your son and behold you are taken in your mischief because you are a bloody man again the power of narrative this is fake news the power of narrative epsilon is the good guy David is the villain and this is this is the power of narrative and this is the work of the devil to get people to see through a lens that is mistaken and to misinterpret the players on the stage then said - I the son of zerah zerah unto the king why should this dead dog curse my lord the King absolutely why should we allow this let me go over I beg you and take off his head I can understand this but David is operating on a much higher level and the King said what have I to do with you you sons of zero zero ayah so let him curse because the Lord has said unto Him cursed David so again you saw the reasoning in the psalm where the the wicked are wrongfully accusing him but he sees it as that he's worthy of it that he deserves it and it's the hand of the Lord upon him because of his iniquity and so he's not resisting it and you see that same logic here so let him curse because the Lord has said unto him curse David who shall then say why have you done so and David said to a be shy and to all his servants behold my son behold my son which came forth of my boy owls seeks my life this is again bright no man's enemies will be they of his own household this is what can happen in these times of crisis and again that the the Marxists are spinning a subversion in Western civilization that's going to lead up to a time of intense crisis when Christ tells us a man's enemies will be

they of his own household
he says my own son which came forth of
my bowels seeks my life how much more
now may this Benjamite do it let him
alone and let him curse for the Lord had
bidden him it may be that the Lord will
look on my affliction and that the Lord
will requite me good for his cursing
this day and as David and his men went
by the way Shem I went along on the
hillside over against him and cursed as
he went and threw stones at him and cast
dust and the whole time David bridled
his mouth and he disciplined his tongue
and he just depended on God so we see
that a very clear example of that
approach that David had here in the
Psalms continuing he says I was dumb
with silence I held my peace even from
good and my sorrow was stirred so it's
not something that it was easy on him it
caused him a lot of pain my heart was
hot within me while I was musing the
fire burned then spake I with my tongue
so he's bursting he's doing his best not
to speak out the wicked are accusing him
of all kinds he's the sees a man of
Belial he's the murderer he's the one
that's doing everything wrong and
Absalom is son and Saul they're just so
wonderful
so his heart was hot within him while he
was musing the fire burned then he
finally speaks and what does he say he
says Lord make me to know my end and the
measure of my days what it is that I may
know how frail I am this is what he
speaks so in in the midst of all of
these false accusations like this is
amazing and this is something that we
have to develop because Christians when
the LGBTQ are in power when the
transgenders are in power when the
Marxists are in power when the Muslims

are in power when the atheists are in power it's not going to go well when the Jews that's the way that say they're Jews are not in power it's not gonna go well for Christians it's not gonna go well for those who declare Christ and yet we have to have this response Lord make me to know my end and the measure of my days what it is that I may know how frail I am behold you have made my days as a hand breadth and my age is as nothing before you so he just realizes here that it's it's going quickly verily every man at his best state is altogether vanity and we have certainly seen that in the current news with this whole Jeffrey Epstein Empire falling apart this very very powerful untouchable man so well connected with the elite and he's gone every man at his best state is altogether vanity this was a very powerful man that was untouchable nobody could touch him he was above the law and yet at his best state he was vanity surely every man walks in a vain show surely they are disquieted in vain he heaps up riches and knows not who shall gather them so this this whole Epstein saga and again I just want to mention here this whole notion I mentioned

last week of transhumanism that this is a guy that was storing up his DNA so that he could impregnate many many women so that quote-unquote he could seed the human race he could seed the human race he wanted to seed the human race what does that even mean that he wanted to seed the him what does that mean we have 7.5 billion people on the earth why does he need to seed the human race unless being plugged into the elite he understood the plan and the crisis the global crisis that's coming and the

amount of lives that are going to be lost and so he sees this opportunity to reseed the humans almost like coming in he sees himself as Noah coming through the crisis coming through the flood and having to multiply and replenish the earth so they have a plan and that's why they have no regard for the for the nations that we live in and they're happy to bring everybody in open borders no wall no no what is it no USA at all no borders no wall no USA at all from Palestine to Mexico all borders have to go they don't care about the nations anymore and they don't care the danger I used to puzzle over England to see these this industrial scale gang rape of young girls and I thought why don't they care and they did they just don't they don't care because they are the clients of Jeffrey Epstein those judges are the clients of the likes of Jeffrey Epstein the elite are pedophiles this is very clear now and so when we come to them and say hey look what's happening to the to the young girls they don't care those same girls are being pimped out to them and they absolutely don't care we even look at the news about Jeffrey Epstein he's dead we don't care about Jeffrey Epstein anymore he's dead he got his deserts and he'll face Christ what about the network what about all of his clients why aren't we doing investigative journalism to see who are all these people that have destroyed so many lives no we just talked about Jeffrey Epstein and that's it they don't care and they don't care because of this transhuman agenda where and this he says that you know they told me I could be anything I wanted so I became a god this is their philosophy that they can take artificial

intelligence and and integrate with it
in such a way that they become gods and
they can have the human body replace all
the parts and and be young forever and
they believe they can live forever as
these AI gods and who cares about
humanity this is what we're facing this
is the this is the the nimrod agenda
that's in their imagination and and god
is not going to allow it the same way he
stopped it
previously he is gonna allow it for a
time but the same way he stepped in in
Nimrod's time he's going to have to step
in in the time of this beast power in
the end he says surely every man walk
every man walk surely every man walks in
a vain show even the beast as powerful
as the beast power is going to be
it's a vain show surely they are
disquieted in vain he heaps up riches
and knows not who shall gather them and
now Lord what way tie for my hope is in
you deliver me from all my
transgressions very interesting how
introspective David is and and despite
all of this stuff that's going on around
him instead of pointing the finger he's
just looking at himself and his
relationship with God and using this as
an opportunity to get right with God
deliver me from all my transgressions
make me not the reproach of the foolish
the fool says in his heart no god I was
dumb I opened not my mouth because you
did it again somehow David understands
that you know you look at that situation
with Shem eye he understands that this
is at the Lord's hand that that whatever
uncleanness is within him this is an
opportunity for him to get right with
God and so as much as they are wrongful
in their approach as much as they are
wicked and evil he's saying I just have

to go through this and so I'm not going
to complain I'm not gonna strike back
I'm just gonna rely on God I was dumb I
didn't open my mouth because this is
coming from you remove your stroke away
from me I am destroyed by the blow of
your hand this is this is too much for
him and he's he's saying to God please
have mercy upon me when you with rebukes
dude thus correct man for iniquity you
make his beauty to consume away like a
moth the David again very healthy very
rugged individual very handsome man and
yet he's in this sickness he's in this
persecution he's in this affliction and
he's seeing that it's God's hand upon
him it's God's hand upon him and he's
being corrected he understands that he's
being corrected and so he's saying God
you yeah all my beauty is just slipping
away from me surely every man is vanity
Selah this is the king and this is the
conclusion he's come to that Wow
without God every man is vanity hear my
prayer O Lord and give ear unto my cry
hold not your peace of my tears for I am
a stranger with you and a sojourner as
all my father's were so he's saying like
I'm estranged from you God and I've so
first he says that he's estranged from
his family his loved ones his kinsmen is
his tribe and now he's saying I'm even a
stranger with you God I've got nobody
I must a journey as all my father's were
Oh spare me that I may recover strength
before I go hence and be no more so this
is a very deep and very personal
complaint that David has before God and
it's very it's a just begging for God's
mercy before his life runs out he's it's
almost like he's on the edge and he's
contemplating that he may not recover
from this and he may go from wherever he
is to the grave and so he's pleading for

God to intervene he's doing everything
he can to get
right internally with God and hoping for
God's mercy now we're gonna actually see
now with Psalm 40 a psalm of
thanksgiving which being so tightly
coupled to 38 and 39 seems like he did
receive an answer and now he's praising
God for the answer that he received to
the chief musician a psalm of David I
waited patiently for the Lord so he
didn't open his mouth he didn't complain
he just went to God he took his tears
before God and he waited patiently for
the Lord and He inclined unto me and
heard my cry he brought me up also out
of a horrible pit out of the miry clay
and set my feet upon a rock and
established my goings and I hope Tommy
Robinson he's in jail until September
15th I hope that has he you know he's
understand he's being treated while he's
working out he's he's eating I hope he's
studying the Bible and and coming to
Christ that would just be a wonderful
outcome and then for him to come out of
this situation really understanding
God's Word and God's will for his life
eventually we hope that you know all men
will repent and come to Christ he
brought me up also out of a horrible pit
out of the miry clay and set my feet
upon a rock and established my goings
and he has put a new song in my mouth
even praise unto our God and I think
this is really the Christian perspective
that whatever we face whatever trial we
face we know that it's a season you know
yes we go through this dark valley but
but Christians always come out on the
other end and that's why God gives us
the book of Revelation and when we
studied it we saw all the dark news and
all the bad news and how rough it's

going to get but we also saw the outcome at the end and that's why that's what God wants us to understand that he is faithful and he will always bring us through our trials and so David now we just read how how much in despair he was and now he has a new song in his mouth even praise unto our God many shall see it in fear and shall trust in the Lord so he's seeing that the deliverance that he's experienced as he shares this and praises God for it it's going to have an impact on others and here we are thousands of years later reading this and being impacted by it and so this should be an example for us as well as we come through our trials and we share how the Lord has delivered us we can have this impact in our sphere of influence as well blessed is that man that makes the Lord his trust this is the conclusion that he went through all of this he trusted God you know what blessed is that man that makes the Lord his trust and respects not the proud nor such as turn aside to lies so again we are living in a time of incredible deceit and we need to be careful that we don't respect these people who are proud and we don't join these people who are full of lies and deception many Oh Lord my god are your wonderful works which you have done and your thoughts which are to us word so David is very clear that God has done wonderful works and that he has many thoughts which are turned toward us and this is one of those scriptures that we need to be careful that we interpret it properly when David is saying this this is not just oh god just loves all mankind and he has wonderful thoughts for all mankind this is specifically to deal with God's covenant love for Israel and

and David coming through all of this he just sees the love that God has for Israel that the wonderful works God has for Israel and the thoughts which he has toward Israel they cannot be reckoned up in order unto you if I would declare and speak of them they are more than can be numbered David is overwhelmed with God's thoughts toward Israel and this should actually put us in mind of the scripture in Jeremiah which I another highly abused

future if every time this scripture was quoted and it was quoted incorrectly there was a deposit in my bank account I'd be a very wealthy man Christians don't read carefully that if we read this carefully this is speaking very specifically of Israel and God is saying to Israel despite that the troubles that they have to go through because of his covenant faithfulness to Israel God is saying for I know the thoughts that I think toward you Israel read it in context for I know the thoughts that I think toward you Israel so there they're going to be crushed by Babylon and they're gonna suffer under the hand of Babylon for 70 years but God is saying I know the thoughts that I think toward you says the Lord thoughts of peace and not of evil to give you an expected end and this is the whole breakthrough insight of the Bible that when we understand that God is covenant faithful to Israel and he's going to save the whole world through his covenant with Israel this makes the whole Bible make sense and if we don't understand this we will be deceived and we will fall into false narratives

he says sacrifice and offering you did not desire my ears have you opened burnt offering and sin offering have you not

required then said i lo I come in the volume of the book it is written of me so David began to understand that he had a role and that God had such a a great love for Israel and and tremendous thoughts towards Israel and wonderful works that he was going to deploy for Israel and David came to understand as the king of Israel that this is all written beforehand and that he has a role to play in in bringing about these blessings upon the nation of Israel this passage is quoted in Hebrews regarding the Messiah where in Hebrews 10 verse 5 he says therefore wherefore when he comes into the world he says this speaking

Christ's sacrifice and offering you would not but a body has you prepared me have you prepared me so this is his his sacrifice in burnt offerings and sacrificing for sin you have had no pleasure then said i lo I come in the volume of the book it is written of me to do your Will O God and that will that that Christ performed is his will toward Israel his covenant faithfulness to Israel to bless all mankind and to bring salvation to all mankind through Israel and so Christ came as that faithful Israelite to do the will of God and this is the same understanding that David came to as he came through his trial and it was established now as the king of Israel in peace having come through the the saving grace of God and saying Wow God has tremendous thoughts for Israel and I've come to do his will and so he says right here the very thing I delight to do your will oh my god yes your law is within my heart so this whole process of trial and tribulation and affliction and persecution that David went through it actually transformed him and he

understood partially while he was going through it that God's hand was upon him and then as he came through it he came to realize Wow in the volume of the book it is written of me and I'm now going to do your will and I delight to do your will because I understand this is how you're going to bless Israel and ultimately all mankind and this is exactly then what Christ took to describe his mission coming as that faithful messiah and king for Israel I have preached righteousness in the great congregation lo I have not refrained my lips o Lord you know so having come through all of this when David is now preaching to the congregation he's telling them how wonderful now righteous and how glorious God is he says I have not hid your righteousness within my and I think we need to be like this as well that when God helps us when God blesses us we should be sharing this with others and not hiding it within our heart I have declared your faithfulness and your salvation God is covenant faithful and we need to keep reminding everybody of this so that they don't misinterpret the scriptures so that they don't misinterpret what's going on in the world around us the way we get through the way we endure to the end is not through our own strength the way we endure into the end the way we cross the finish line is through our unshakable belief our unshakable belief that it's impossible for God to lie and that God will be faithful to his covenant and everything is going to happen exactly as God says and so we have to declare his faithfulness and his salvation to Israel so that all mankind can be saved through Israel I have not concealed what your loving-kindness

your cassette your covenant faithfulness
I haven't concealed it I understand it
and I understand why it David I
understand why you have been so good to
me because you are working through me to
bless Israel through your covenant
faithfulness

I have not concealed your cassette and
your truth from the great congregation
and again this is quoted and alluded to
in Hebrew saying I will declare your
name unto my brethren in the midst of
the congregation well I sing praise unto
you back to Psalm 40 withhold not your
tender mercies from me O Lord let your
cassette cassette your covenant
faithfulness your covenant love let your
loving kindness and your truth
continually preserve me so it's not that
I'm just this wonderful person it's that
you are faithful you have spoken your
word and you're going to perform it and
so I'm going to base like Abraham it
wasn't counted to Abraham
as righteousness why because he was such
a righteous person no because he
believed God he believed it's impossible
for God to lie and this is how David was
now thinking and how we have to think
let your love and kindness and your
truth continually preserve me and and
God's Cassette will preserve Israel and
we who were grafted into Israel God will
preserve us he has to this is his
promise it's impossible for him to lie
we can have strong consolation in his
word he says for innumerable evils have
surrounded me my iniquities have taken
hold upon me so so there's two things
there's the external the wicked around
me and there's the internal the evil
within me and and David was grappling
with this as he held on to God's
loving-kindness innumerable evils have

surrounded me my iniquities have taken hold upon me so that I am not able to look up they are more than the hairs of my head therefore my heart fails me be pleased O Lord to deliver me O Lord make haste to help me sow sow again he I just love his his humility - to say yes there's a wicked that are surrounding me but I have problems as well and I'm bringing it all before you God and I'm trusting you he says the Lord make haste to help me then he says let them be ashamed and confounded together that seek after my soul to destroy it and again we need to be looking at what's happening in the world around us because this is what's gonna be happy this this is our future this is our future and so we need to be careful what is what is the narrative that's being spun you know aunty far they really such wonderful wonderful beautiful souls who just want what's best for Humanity or are they being set up as thugs that are untouchable to bring about this crisis that the Marxist want to see in society he says let them be ashamed and confounded together that seek after my soul to destroy it and and make no mistake those that are in privileged positions really privileged positions in society not the fake you know white privilege and pink white one male patriarchy and all this deceptive narrative I mean The Untouchables the people who clearly break the law and get away with it they all hate Jesus Christ and because they hate Jesus Christ they hate those who follow Christ and so we will be we need to understand David's plight because it's here for a reason it's preserved for a reason let them be ashamed and confounded together that seek after my soul to destroy it

let them be driven backward and put to
shame that wish me evil let them be
desolate for a reward for of their shame
that sound to me ah-ha-ah-ha so they're
plotting they're planning they want to
take us down they want to take down
innocent people they want to further and
you know the way you know that somebody
is instance here is when you see a
double standard when they speak in such
lofty ways and they have such high
standards but that only applies to
others that when it applies to them or
their cohort or give them a pass hey
wait a minute I thought this was such a
high noble value and standard that you
have how is it that you can just quickly
relax it because you don't really
believe in this value you're just using
it to further your agenda and that's
what we're surrounded with today very
very wicked very very evil people who
are in positions of power who have an
agenda you have a Marxist agenda of
subversion and they're following their
playbook and so they're saying aha ahá
hoping to bring us down let all those
that seek you rejoice and be glad in you
so there's going to be a clear
separation between those who are seeking
mischief and those who are seeking God
let all those that seek you rejoice and
be glad in you
let such as love your salvation say
continually the Lord be magnified and we
know from Malachi the Lord will be
magnified from the borders of Israel so
the Lord be magnified from the borders
of Israel but he says but I am poor and
needy yet the Lord thinks upon me you
are my help in my deliverer make no
tarrying oh my god so now we come to the
final psalm of our set here psalm 41 -
the chief musician of this is going to

close the book one of Psalms - the chief musician a psalm of David blessed is he that considers the poor and this is why we don't need socialism we do not need socialism because the way God designs his economy is those who have look after those who don't have and charity not socialism we don't need massive government and this is the whole sales pitch of the socialist Oh what about the poor what about the poor if we're in power we'll look after the poor and so they have all these programs which require bigger and bigger and bigger government and the bigger the government gets the more powerful it gets oh we need health care for everybody it just means that we need a much bigger government we need food stamps for everybody it just means we need a much bigger government and as the government gets bigger and bigger the poor are not looked after and I think in the States again I really following what's happening in the states because it is the most powerful Empire and it's really what's preserving any ability for Christians to have any kind of life today that once America goes down we're going to see the end of Christian opportunity for Christians to live freely but here I think Donald Trump did a great job when Elijah Cummings congressman Cummings was was saying how terrible it is that migrants are coming into America illegally and they're just not being treated well and that no human should have to live like this and then Donald Trump just said hey why don't you look after Baltimore you've been there for 25 years you've gotten billions of dollars to help the poor there and it's rat-infested

it is rat infested it's full of crime no
human being should have to live the way
some people live in Baltimore and the
people there were so grateful that
Donald Trump brought attention to what's
happening in Baltimore so we see this
double standard we see this hypocrisy
from these communists that they don't
care about the poor and they don't care
about children being raped and destroyed
they just don't care they only care
about themselves and about power and so
the way God works is those who love Him
will look after the poor we will give we
will naturally we'll just naturally be
charitable and that's why you see when
we read the New Testament people would
be in front of the temple if they were
crippled or they had a they need it and
so people going into the temple to
worship Yahweh would look after the poor
they would look they were blessed
because they would know that God would
bless them and again Christian nations
are the most charitable when there's an
earthquake or a disaster somewhere it's
the Christian nations that quickly rush
in to save and to relieve them from
famine or relieve them from natural
disaster because that's what the
Scriptures do so we don't need big
government we need we need big hearts we
need people who are influenced by God's
Word so he says blessed is he that
considers the poor and this whole
picture on the poor is the agenda around
Marxism so that was the whole pitch and
then when they slaughtered a hundred
million people it sounds like it's just
a statistic it's great evil it's it's
the work of demons
that's what communism is it's a great
evil but they sell it
oh the poor the poor what about the poor

the Lord will deliver him in time of trouble so those who look after the poor have a special relationship with God and God will deliver us in time of trouble the Lord will preserve him and keep him alive and he shall be blessed upon the earth and you will not deliver him unto the will of his enemies and the will of our enemies is not good there in the pocket of the devil and the devil's will is similar we just have to go back to Genesis 11 and see what what Nimrod had in mind and this is not good and god says that he will not deliver us unto the will of it the enemies the Lord will strengthen him upon the bed of his languishing so we saw earlier in Psalm 38 that David was in the bed of languishing and he cried out to God and God strengthened him upon the bed of his languishing you will make all his bed in his sickness I said Lord be merciful unto me heal my soul for I have sinned against you my enemies speak evil of me when shall he die and his name Peres so again we see this dual affliction where he's sick he sees that he has sins but also his enemies are trying to destroy him and take him out and so he's just putting all of this to God and now we see the deliverance and then Thanksgiving and if he come to see me he speaks vanity his heart gathers iniquity to itself when he goes abroad he tells it so this is that's why I said I'm estranged from even my own kinsmen even my own friends all that hate me whisper together against me against me do they devise my my hurt so again he's you know the king and they want to take him out so that they can have power and evil disease say they Cleaves fast unto him so instead of being merciful to him at least job's friends they didn't seem

to care at first and then they just became self righteous but here David is in distress and they're happy they're like well an evil disease cleaves fast unto him and now that he lies he shall rise up no more so they didn't so David was contemplating this could be the end for him but he was hoping for God's mercy they didn't see God's mercy at all like okay he's got one foot in the grave he'll be gone soon he says yes my own familiar friend in whom I trusted which did eat of my bread has lifted up his heel against me and this is this is the effect of power you know sometimes families when there's an inheritance and the person dies and they leave the well you see now what money can do to people and the true person comes out and you're like wow that the hatred and that the plotting and the scheming because of money and the family just breaks down but here with power we see the same thing and and David's saying like my own trusted friend I I fed him we ate together has lifted up his heel against me and of course we know that Christ quoted this exact situation with Judas he says I speak not of you all I know whom I have chosen but that the scripture may be fulfilled what Scripture is that the scripture we just read he that eats bread with me has lifted up his heel against me and then that was a pattern that God is telling us in the end time that Judas pattern will be repeated that there will be wheats and tear together and those that eat with us will lift up their heel against us and we can't be caught off guard and then shall many be offended and shall betray one another and shall hate one another's we have to work against this we have to be really

going out of our way to make sure we are not touched by this this syndrome we're not influenced by fake news we're not deceived by false narratives and false perspectives and Marxist agendas so that we begin to turn on each other we don't want to be Judas's but even if that happens to us so be it because in the end it's all gonna work out but you oh lord be merciful unto me and raise me up that I may requite them by this I know that you favor me because my enemy does not triumph over me so you'll see that we're and I'm just gonna say quite frankly again just observing what's happening in America

my observation is that every single person that has gone up against the President Trump publicly has been disgraced every single one so God is doing something and it's not again he's not a perfect man you know if you look at Gideon Gideon was not a perfect man but he was the judge that God was working through at that time to preserve Israel and then ultimately you saw his after he did his work he then showed his corruption that he then you know if you if you continue reading the story of Gideon he was clearly a he became corrupted and got you know drunk on power and wealth so we don't see Donald Trump as a savior we don't see him as a perfect man he's clearly a very flawed man but he's not the son of Satan and you know he wasn't this dark mediocrity darling until he ran for office and once he ran for office he became the devil incarnate this isn't this is nonsense this is this is mischief but we are seeing America being preserved through this man's efforts and we need to give thanks for that because as long as America is strong and influential

Christianity can be strong and influential once the American Empire collapses that's it for Christianity and that's it for Christians and and we have no idea what is coming to replace it but if history is anything to go by if we look back at Kings like Sargon and shellman easer and and if I forget some of the names now Pig left Eleazer NIM well Nimrod obviously but this that the children of Nimrod who've been influenced by his system empires have been ruthless human life has meant nothing and that's the future we're going into so I wouldn't be so quick to want to see the collapse of America God God actually says woman to you who desire the day of the Lord we need to understand what this means and and the devastation and the loss of eternal life for many and just be praying and working that that ultimately God is going to favor his people he says I know that you favor me because my enemy does not triumph over me and you spend fifty million dollars to take out the president and you fail you have you have a blank check take as much time as you want spend as much money as you want just destroy this man and you fail all these false accusers they've all come unstuck somehow God is preserving this man again not that he's a perfect man but God is giving us a bit of time and so we need to redeem the time because the days are evil and as for me you uphold me in my integrity and set me before your face forever blessed be the lord god and again that integrity is just how transparent he was with God he was not double minded he was just very transparent with God and he seized how God responded to him God upheld him very

different from Saul and set me before
your face forever blessed be the Lord
God of Israel he's the Lord God of
Israel his name is attached to Israel
forever blessed be the Lord God of
Israel from everlasting and to
everlasting and and people like to say
that God is outside of time God exists
outside of time no he's from everlasting
to everlasting where he's from
and where he's to is the same thing he's
from everlasting to everlasting the God
of Israel is eternal he's the pagan God
is infinite and limitless the God of
Israel is eternal that's not the same as
infinite blessed be the Lord God of
Israel from everlasting and to
everlasting amen and amen
and so that brings us to the end of book
1 and I just remember that we're gonna
take a pause of a brief pause from
Psalms next week we'll go on to the book
of Zephaniah and then after Zephaniah
we'll begin with book 2 of Psalms and
then again when we finished book 2 God
willing we'll just pop over and
another short book so at this time if
you have any questions comments or
thoughts both on Facebook and on the
live chat please go ahead and load up
those questions and comments and I will
just wait for pastor Marie to join I
think that looks like he's joined us
here
pastor Marie is that you and you I guess
just sorting out his microphone good how
about you
very good good and maybe we can just
confirm on the chat that everybody can
hear you sure it'll take 30 seconds yeah
a little bit of a delay there so I'll
keep the chat sure thanks I guess we'll
start with thank you for your hard work
and putting together or not the entire

is not a Bible study since we started a few years ago the song particularly meaningful really appreciate and really appreciate your your support throughout all of this and and also I don't mind you as we start our prison ministry last month the last Sunday of each month and so I was not available you went into the prison and I believe you said that you were you were going to spend a bit of time in Psalms with them I just wonder if you could maybe tell us a little bit about that you don't have to go into too much detail but just tell us a little bit about it and and how do you feel the the inmates responded to your insight around the Book of Psalms sure and just for clarity here there is confirmation that this is coming through clearly right yeah so we started the prison ministry last Sunday evening of July is in a women's prison in Kitchener Ontario sister Avenel from the Toronto congregation has some experienced there and that's how we got involved there were eight ladies that attended in addition to the local chaplain that is there and obviously this being our first foray into this we decided to go into the Psalms to provide at a different level men we've covered here the Bible studies but just some some encouragement that God sees through prison bars and they are not well they may feel alone they may feel abandoned and they feel kind of like Elijah there's no one else in the world hear about can't see me these Psalms provide encouragement in that regard we went into I don't have these scriptures exactly with me went into maybe Psalms 139 and get Psalm 107 and someone just sort of cursory coverage there did you sorry did you get a sense that they had

thought deeply about the Psalms before
was this something that you think was
impacting them in a new way a fresh way
I can't imagine what it's like to be
incarcerated do you think that it was
encouraging for them or do you think
that they just sort of were just happy
to have sort of a day out are believers
in God others others like it maybe just
I don't know whether it was it was maybe
more of a habit to come to this or maybe
they're just a little more stoic on the
outside it was again our first I first
foray into this and our ability to
interact one-on-one it's limited by the
prison rules but there were if there
were definitely three or four that were
engaged you know nodding and showed that
looked like bit like they definitely had
a belief in God and that this was an
encouraging message for them so it's
great we will get to see some more fruit
of this as we before wonderful wonderful
I just see a comment here from rod
Koosman on Facebook saying that David
might have been depressed and I'm not
sure which part of the psalm I was
reading there but I think yeah I think
clearly he was really really down in the
pit and at the same time he held on to
God but yeah I would
with that prod I think what's been
interesting to see as we walk through
the first book of what one of the Psalms
is the gamut of emotions that David
you use the word transparent today you
know David has had a gamut of emotions
and we all do yeah if we think back to
our personal lives and our time with God
there's times that we're happy there's
times I would praise where there's times
that we feel alone there's times that we
feel home all the times when we feel
ashamed it's time to feel scared it's

interesting to see a pillar like David and not afraid to express all varieties of emotions that he has it certainly gives us encouragement that God God created us with Felix exactly and and it's good to be real like let's not be fake Christians we need to be real but also you know it's amazing and as you were just talking about the the gamut of emotions that David went through it was also amazing to see the discipline he had over his tongue that while his enemies were accusing him he just determined and just resolved himself set him set his mind that he was not going to answer them yes and I think that goes back to something you said I didn't say we've said in most of the studies that is complete and utter conviction that God is coming to faithful yes that that he can he can bite his tongue because he fully believes that the promises he read in the Torah another passed down through the generations are completely true and he has exactly and I think that's what's gonna get us through the crisis that God laid out in Matthew 24 and then he says he that endures to the end shall be saved I I think it's that understanding of God's covenant faithfulness that no matter what happens we understand that all of this is happening exactly as God intended it to happen and and we know that he's faithful to Israel he's faithful to his covenant and that's what we hold on to and I think that's what David held on - yeah absolutely and we can see that at play and refer back to a lot to the political situation that surrounds us and it certainly seems to the disciples of Christ that the presence of the force like Donald Trump was really giving God's people time to get right yeah does that mean he's going

to be reelected in 2020 it kind of looks that way right now but if he's not and things proceed the way it looks like the left to take them that should not scare us that should not get us off of Earth that should not shutter us it should just we should be the same regardless of who in Canada if she wins or Trudeau wins u.s. if Trump wins or whoever did the left nominates which we should be the same either way

well I would just say in the time we have so you know the previous occupant of the house of the White House the previous administration the name of Christ was expunged from from anything to do with the office this president is happy to have the name of Christ spoken and spoken very clearly under his administration now does he understand Jesus Christ as he know the Bible you know he doesn't he's certainly growing into his office he's not the same man that entered the office but as Christians we need to redeem the time we need to make hay while the Sun shines you know we meet we need to be doing what we can while we can

Christ says the night comes when no man can work so while it is day we need to be working and I think every every single Christian needs to be praying and and and working and and contributing and understanding that this window of time that we have to do the work that we're doing now it's not forever it's going to close so while we have opportunity let

let's work absolutely and you know what has Hezekiah was a great example of that he asked for extra time he got extra time he used it wisely for a little bit but not for the entire duration and he certainly did not finish strong so we

must take and I think when the window closes we're gonna kick ourselves and thought I could have done more I wish I said more I wish I contributed more and the opportunity will be gone absolutely William hello Avery a great study tonight you do a great job of explaining and adding to other scriptures that add to the songs for example well that's good thank you here's going thanks again for that Thank You William and then from my sister Denise now she goes back to Psalm 40 verse 12 and quotes it then said i lo I come in the volume of the book it is written of me I'm amazed on how complete and deep the Bible is as me speaks fully of Israel David and Jesus Christ could have also a volume of the book her question is that that phrase volume of the book can it mean Psalms the Bible and all other Testament Scriptures that Psalms 40 verse 12 yeah great question I took it to mean the the body of scripture that David would have access to so the writings that the Torah the history the historical books all of what we call the the Old Testament that he would have had access to at his in his time that's what I see he would be searching and coming to understand God's will and his role in God's will yeah that makes sense obviously he would not have had access to the prophets and some of the other writings right in fact that the wisdom he was busy writing it as he lived right exactly exactly and just before you say the other question Rebecca cutting game says hold on endure we read the final chapter God wins and that's exactly the perspective we have to have and that's why God says you know blessed are they who read and keep reading the book of Revelation

those who read it hear it and do those things that are written therein because we see that we see the outcome and then any defund he says God will be with us so very very good and that I didn't look at the scripture but she just corrected in history a nice person that it's worse seventh son boy refers to the appointment book and just in reference to what you were just a question from I forgot the name you say Rebecca Rebecca kind I think and you've brought this to light throughout all the Bible studies and they think Psalms is another great example is that the Scriptures are from the law and tour of the wisdom the writing prophets through to the New Testament relation it's all the same narrative the same storyline and it's interesting that God can tell that story line through various mediums through externa through history through poetry through song through a pestle through revelation and it's just it's fascinating to see it be the same story the same simple story God wins yes do we want to be on his side God wins and he's faithful to Israel and I think this point that you're bringing up Maria is such a profound point because it's how we withstand deception that Satan has a narrative he has many narratives and they're all designed to confuse and twist and destroy God has one narrative and when we stick to that narrative we cannot fall into Satan's deception and that narrative drives us to good behavior to godly behavior you know I was looking I was looking at this news item on ant and Tifa and just the the spirit of destruction that they have they they just want to destroy so they're buying this narrative that they have to be these warriors

against white supremacy and so they're out there fighting against white supremacy but if you listen to them or and look at them all they want to do is destroy and this is the work of the devil God is a creator God is about life and so when we buy the true narrative we want to love others we want to help others we want to see people succeed we want to see people thrive we want them to have an abundant life we want to help we want to support we don't want to destroy anything absolutely and when you when you consider all that you hear evil say that the last immerses the projection that they that they of their own behavior that they throw unto others that is satanic and goes right back to Genesis 3 Satan the city was projecting his own lying light upon God exactly and pastor Murray this is such an important point that you're raising here I have learned to listen carefully to accusations that are embedded in accusations is projection and so if you want to know what particularly the Marxists are up to listen to their accusations because whatever they're accusing you know to come up with the concept I would I could never come up with this concept of a manufactured crisis what how do you come up with that idea well out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks and so when they're accusing the president of a manufactured crisis that's a clue into how they think and what they're up to and what they're doing great they're manufacture manufactured totally and that's what they're currently doing so just listen to accusations very carefully now because of what you said about Genesis 3 and that that Satan

projects absolutely questions yet but just a couple other points that came to mind it's been interesting as we walk through the songs to see the against the backdrop of some of the biographical accounts that we see in the books of the Kings so while we read the books of the Kings we can then go into the book of the Psalms and actually get inside David's head yeah and and see you would see what he was thinking when he was going through this especially that that long story about Absalom in second second

15 16 17 that's working yes yeah very good and and again I think this wonderful privilege we have to sort of see this very intimate relationship between David and God and and that can help us in building our intimacy with God and I think we're going to see more of it in book 2 as well book 1 and book 2 a lot of it is from David and there are a lot of lamentations in there a lot of transparency as we get into the later books I think it's going to be a lot more prophetic absolutely well another comment here from sister can you send a comment not a question in these end times she says she appreciates your understanding that we need to be strong and you know in our faith that our loving father cannot lie which preserves us yeah very good and I would say as well to assist it Denise into all of us we need to obsess on loving one another it can't be this sort of just yeah I've got brethren yeah whatever Satan will absolutely hijack that I I think it's like if somebody's sauntering it's easy to twist them around and turn them around if somebody's sprinting and running to a finish line it's almost impossible to

turn them around they're so focused
youth maybe you can slow them down you
might be able to trip them up but you're
not going to send them in a different
direction so I think I think this whole
emphasis from Christ in the end time for
us to love one another we need to be
doing this passionately and then when
these different you know black lives
matter and Tifa
white supremacy all these nonsense
narratives
they'll just bounce off us because we
see the finish line and we're running
toward and we would never betray one
another so I think this whole um
commandment you know there's a scripture
that Paul says they're ever learning and
never coming to a knowledge of the truth
and I think what he means is they think
all of this is academic and it's not
it's transformative and it's behavioral
that the more we understand as we just
saw with David the more of a
transformation process we undergo and we
become a comprise
and so this this drive I think that that
Christ had in his imperatives and the
Apostles love one another love one
another I think that's the antidote to
all of this insanity that we see around
us absolutely and you know we were
talking at our service recently courted
Paul and you're talking here about the
love of the Brethren I can't recall
which end of which epistle I think it
was might have been in Thessalonians
where he basically said listen if you
can't figure any of this stuff out for
sure at least this love each other no
that's playing the rest of me I think
that we were at some chapter 11 of first
Corinthians first Corinthians all right
yeah

right at the end of that he just says
look you make this set this is your
priority everything else I'll deal with
when I come that's right yeah very good
very good

I'll just see if there's anything on the
Facebook here give me a second
of Charles Robert says hello from Iowa
he signed on late

Rebekah's encouraging him to go back and
and listen to the study very very good
and there is a request here from one of
the followers here that and I get on
video next time and I know and they've
got a try yeah yeah the picture of my
sweater apparently is a little dated
it's a pretty picture so either I get on
video or I send us an updated picture
preferably get on video so I just say
we're coming up on nine o'clock any
final thoughts pastor Murray before we
leave book one of songs

yeah just one final thought the scholars
like when I was studying to this and I
don't recall these said it so if I you
did say I missed it

the last verse in each of the each of
the books is just a simple doxology or
short hymn of praise to God at the end
of each each book and then the final
song of book 5 actually is an entire
talk

that just praises God and we see that in
verse 15 of psalm 41 nobody concludes
blessed be the Lord God of Israel from
everlasting to everlasting amen and amen
which really sums up David's reason for
writing the psaltery and that is simply
about your praise of our God and just
for some who may not be familiar with
the term doxology to want to just define
that yes doxology is a shorthand of
praise at an end of a either scripture
or a hymn or a something of grace to God

very very good and and before I laid
some appreciate that I didn't mention
that
and that'll be great when we come to the
end of the psaltery to see that final
doxology in an entire Psalm what did you
think of have you seen the preview of
the movie the hunt I have not seen the
preview but I saw write up about that
and you and I haven't had a chance to
connect in a little while I was gonna
send this and that's it see if you've
heard about that complete globalist
ideas here of taking down a human
hunting I can't believe with all of the
backlash against you know El Paso well
well that's why it was it was supposed
to be launched in September but because
of these reasons recent shootings
they've decided to delay the launch of
it yeah I did hear that and just it's
amazing that the Hollywood left which is
supposed to be the enlightened side what
that the Hollywood left that is is
supposed to be the enlightened side
could even fathom a story like this
based off of what they what they again
this is all about projection yeah this
is really what's in their hearts yeah
forget what they're saying yeah all of
these sorts of natives in Iran would
even come out somebody came up with this
idea they shared it with somebody else
whoever they shared it with said what a
fantastic idea this is wonderful they it
got funding it
was encouraged I think it was released
in some other markets
and if it were not for the recent
shootings in America it would have been
in theatres in September so there is it
there's definitely some psychological
problems with people in power also we
know that Hollywood has been bought by

the communists particularly the Chinese Communists and so I just pray that our brethren familiarize themselves with Marxism and specifically with cultural Marxism because I think if you don't understand cultural Marxism if you're a Christian that doesn't understand cultural Marxism you're going to misinterpret what's going on around here and it's amazing to see the what Hollywood is producing these days the the filth that person in their right mind could never even dream up and yet its pervade so yeah so it'll be out of there and then you wonder how and then you see the Harvey Weinstein's the Jeffrey Epstein the Kevin Spacey's all of this filth that goes into just staying in Hollywood you can see how that comes about so easily now exactly and and that all that filth I know you know I don't watch these movies but apparently there's more and more pedophilia creeping into entertainment so the movies that people are watching the shows that they're watching it's just it's um softening the beachhead and and making them become more familiar with these perversions so I think Christians we need to be very very careful about what we allow into our minds because these people have an agenda and it's too corrupt you know and in Noah's day all flesh had corrupted themselves and Christ said it's going to be the same way in the time when he returns and we need to be careful we need to be careful not to fall into this and that pedophilia now is is now I think you played a video on it and one of the previous Bible studies several months ago that is now just minor affected minor
