well welcome to uh another bible study i was about to say wednesday night bible study

um but of course we're celebrating the feast of tabernacles so happy feast to all of you i'm broadcasting here from ottawa ontario with where we're celebrating with uh 20 brethren here gathered to celebrate

the feast and
we watch with great interest and

we watch with great interest and anticipation the ordination of our brother

jim french in collingwood so congratulations to you jim and the brethren here are very excited and very supportive of your ordination i am not i was not expecting to have uh brethren watching live i just thought for the sake of the archive i'll go ahead and record

this study on the book of ephesians but i do see that we do have a few people quite a few people actually are watching live so thank you very much

for tuning in

um this book of ephesians is an extremely important book for us believers and and it has a lot to do

with the feast of tabernacles in terms of this tie-in

that uh where the ancient israelites were commanded in deuteronomy 16 verse

15

that for seven days they were to keep a solemn feast unto the lord their god in the place which the lord shall choose because the lord your god shall bless you in all your increase and in all the work works of your hands therefore you shall surely rejoice now the ancient israelites were commanded to rejoice because of the tremendous blessings that

because of the tremendous blessings that god had blessed them and would bless them

physically because of the blessing of their increase

that's why they were to celebrate and rejoice before the lord

how much more if the ancient israelites were to rejoice

because of the physical blessings that they enjoyed

how much more should we first fruits israelites

rejoice before god because of the spiritual blessings

that we enjoy from his hand and that's what the book of ephesians

is going to show us it is mind-blowing what the apostle paul has to share with us in terms of why we should rejoice how much more we should rejoice

because of the spiritual blessings that we enjoy

from god's hands so we're going to get into this over this study over the next uh

through this feast of tabernacles i'm going to show you what the apostle paul was showing the church at ephesus before we do that let's open with a word of prayer and today just by way of introduction

i want to retrace uh some some ground that we covered

when we did the book of acts because that's

background for the church at ephesus and also when we did the book of revelation there's a verse there
that i want to pick up as well as
background before we get into
uh ephesians proper so let's open with
the word of prayer
and then we'll get into the introduction
to the book of ephesians
our heavenly father we come before you
now

those of us who are here live during this feast of tabernacles to rejoice before you father and just to to celebrate with each other the miracle that you have been working in our lives and to look forward with great anticipation

the return of our lord our savior and the introduction of the kingdom of god on this earth we look so forward to that father and we know that you do as well but we know that there's difficult times ahead and so father we pray that you will help us to fully understand uh what the apostle paul was trying to convey to the church at

and we know that some brethren did fully understand but there were many that did not

ephesus

and we pray god that you'll help us to be among those who truly understand what the apostle is conveying in this book of ephesians we praise you father we praise jesus christ we we thank both you and christ and we pray in his most holy name amen so brother and i want to apologize um you know obviously i'm not at home i'm not in the studio and i hope the sound is very good i apologize in advance for the video i know that the the lighting is not great

and um also i got to apologize that for

some reason i'm unable to share my uh scriptures with you uh so hopefully you can turn to the scriptures and and read along so

by way of background to the book of ephesians we need to go to the book of acts

and we'll pick it up in acts chapter 19 and these these chapters are in the archive where i go into much more detail

into what is in these the content that's in these chapters but we just want to read through it

to get content or context for the book of ephesians

in acts chapter 19 and verse 1 we read and it came to pass that while apollos was at corinth paul and so apollos was in

ephesus but he went on to uh corinth and while he was in corinth

paul having passed through the upper coasts came to ephesus and finding certain disciples

he said unto them have you received the holy spirit since you believed and they said unto him we have not so much as heard

whether there be any holy spirit and he said unto them

unto what then were you baptized what when what unto what were you baptized and they said unto him unto john's baptism

then said paul john verily baptized with the baptism of repentance so yes he did that saying unto the people that they should believe on him which should come after him that is on christ jesus when they heard this

they were baptized in the name of the

lord jesus and i said when we covered acts 19 how pastor murray often points to this because sometimes people come into our fellowship having been baptized in a church where they did not understand truly the lord jesus and then the commands of the lord jesus and how to repent and so the need to be re-baptized and these these brethren were baptized in the true ministry of john just that they didn't understand christ and when we're not baptized to receive the holy spirit and so they were very humble and willing to be re-baptized so that righteousness could be fulfilled in verse 8 and paul went into the synagogue and he spoke boldly for the space of three months disputing and persuading the things concerning the kingdom of god and so again when we studied um acts 19 i have mentioned how some brethren feel like we should never dispute we should never debate we should be quiet we should be unnoticed and here's the apostle paul the example of this great servant of god who for three months was disputing and persuading concerning the kingdom of god but when certain men diverse were heartened and believed not but spoke evil of that way before the multitude he departed from them and so it's no surprise for us if we are spoken evil of if if the teachings we have from christ or spoken evil of this is how it was in the first century

this is how it will be until christ returns so they did they did not believe they spoke evil of the way so he departed from them and separated the disciples disputing daily

in the school of one taranis so you know he was uh

persuading uh for three months in the synagogue every sabbath after three months then he separated himself from those people and now he's in this school of tyrannos and he's disputing and debating daily the apostle paul and this is this is going to be very important context when we get into the book of ephesians but let me say

for now the apostle paul stood in confrontation with evil the apostle paul was not afraid to dispute and debate and confront evil he had an adversarial relationship

with evil this is going to be become very important context and here it is in ephesus that he's doing this it's going to be critical context when we get into the book of ephesians and this continued by the space of two years he was doing

daily for two years so that all they which dwelt in asia heard the word of the lord jesus

this

both jews and greeks so asia we would call today

turkey so this man's preaching was so powerful

that all over what we call turkey or

everybody heard both jews and greeks heard this powerful man's preaching because he was

constantly contradicting false teachings he was constantly contradicting deception he was constantly in debate with false teachers and because of this confrontation between christ teaching and evil and deception all asia heard it and it's so sad as we think today if i say turkey to you the last thing you would think of is christianity so just think of the amount of slaughter and torture and mayhem that that took place historically to convert asia from this understanding of christ into an islamic country verse 13 then certain of the vagabond jews or the wandering jews exorcists this is again going to be very important context when we get into the book of ephesians and and come to understand the blessings we have and why how much more we must rejoice at the feast of tabernacles compared to ancient israel so this is just important context that we're laying the ground here as we get into the book of ephesians certain of the wandering jews exorcists took upon them to call over them this is verse 13 to call over them which had evil spirits the name of the lord jesus saying we adjure you or we command you by jesus whom paul preaches so paul's preaching was just renowned and now they're picking up on this

preaching their exorcist by by trade

this is what they do and and they see the power of the name of jesus and so they're picking up on this as well

and they now see these people who have evil spirits they call them over and they command this the spirits by the lord the same lord jesus that paul preaches

watch what happens verse 14 and there were seven sons of one skeva a jew or a prominent jew and chief of the priests

which did so so these seven sons of skiva

they have a reputation their father has a great reputation and so they're seeing paul his reputation growing

they want to jump on the bandwagon what

happens

and the evil spirit answered and said okay jesus i know and paul i know but who

are you and the man in whom the evil spirit was

leaped on them and overcame them and prevailed against them so that they fled out of that house

naked and wounded this is

very important context for what we're going to see when we study ephesians but let me suffice it to say at this

point as for context

that paul was in constant contradiction with evil he was constantly debating falsehood

he was constantly exposing deception and he was constantly frustrating the work of the devil and the works of demons

these men were exorcists and they were building a profession around helping people be exercised or to remove evil spirits from people

but in reality whatever they were doing and whatever level of success they thought they were having in reality they were not standing in contradiction with evil they were not confronting and debating evil

they were not frustrating the major tool of the devil and the demonic world which is deception paul was removing deception he was enabling people to see

these men were not doing that and so the evil spirit

didn't know them these men the seven sons of skeva

were not doing anything of significance that would cause the spirit world the demonic world

to pay attention whatever they were doing they were in the clutches of the demonic world they were in cooperation and subjection to the demonic world and so now when they're commanding this this demon to remove themselves or itself from this man

themselves or itself from this man this team is like who are you i know paul

paul is getting i know christ christ frustrated us christ interfered with our agenda

and then paul came along and followed in the footsteps of christ and interfered with our agenda we've never

you you have we never see you you're not on our radar

and so playing with this game and we have sometimes people among us who think they can play this game playing this game and at the same time

you you want to remove evil spirits from people but at the same time

you're nowhere to be found when it's time to stand up and contradict deception

when it's time to debate and and show people the false

false ways of their teachings you're not doing anything

to frustrate the demonic world's major tool

of deception and yet you want to claim you're you're an exorcist and you're here to remove evil spirits and the spirit world just says look we know jesus

we know paul we're going to see in ephesians

how the spirit world must know the church

but if we're not in contra distinction to the evil spirit world they don't know

and we will get into that when we get into the book of ephesians but these people suffered

for thinking they can play games here for taking all of this lightly

he says

verse 17 so this event this was known to all the jews and greeks also dwelling at

ephesus all of this is happening in ephesus it's background for us it's context for us when we get into ephesians

and fear fell on them all and the name of the lord jesus

was magnified and many that believed

and confessed and showed their deeds this is the fruit of paul's work contradicting and destroying deception many of them also which used curious arts

brought their books together and burned them

before all and they counted the price of them

and founded 50 000 pieces of silver this is massive and this is context for the book of ephesians the the city of ephesus

was steeped in these mystical arts in this demonic world in the in the in this

idolatry and the work of evil spirits and witchcraft this was ephesus and it's in this context that paul was in ministry in contradiction to all of this he was not just quiet

unnoticed

he understood the evil and and the contradiction that he suffered and the persecution that he suffered he understood

these are human beings this is flesh and blood

and as he's debating and contending with human beings

he understands that the real contention is with the principalities and the powers

that are influencing the human beings and we're going to see this play out as he teaches the ephesians what he understood

so that they could follow his example in verse 23

and the same time there arose no small stir

about that way for a certain man named demetrius

a silversmith which made silver shrines for diana

brought no small gain onto the craftsman

so this uh diana is basically the equivalent of uh semoramus uh this whole um asterisk that this these different names it's the

same

religious worship system all around the world

this this demonic practice to ultimately have human beings come under subjection to satan

now this man is making significant you know

follow the money the love of money is the root of all evil

so we follow the money and all that um all those books that people were buying and

50 thousand fifty uh thousand pieces of silver

that's a lot of money this this was a a trade

that people were happy to give themselves over to because of the opportunity to make money and so this man demetrius he's a silversmith and he made silver shrines for diana brought no small gain

unto the craftsmen they were making a lot of money in other words whom he called together with the workmen of like occupation and said sirs you know that by this craft we have our wealth moreover you see and hear that not alone at ephesus

but almost throughout all asia this paul has persuaded and turned away much people saying that they be no gods which are made with hands notice that they don't say you know we make a lot of money from this craft not realizing that the demonic world has hoodwinked us and

kidnapped us and hijacked us so that as we're pursuing our lusts we're enslaved to this demonic world what they don't say is you know what this paul and the seven sons of skiva they have been contradicting this deception and so this is why we can't make the money that we make no it's paul the seven sons of skeva whatever they were doing they were not contradicting evil they were not fighting against deception they were not teaching true doctrine they were just trying to make a reputation for themselves paul was contradicting evil paul was teaching against false doctrine paul was exposing false teachers and paul understood that he wasn't wrestling with flesh and blood but against principalities and powers behind the flesh and blood and that's why the principalities and powers say jesus we know paul we know but who are you we don't know you you're not on our radar you don't cause us any trouble so just because people are running around claiming to be exorcist doesn't mean that the demonic world actually cares about them even though they would like for their reputation to enhance their reputation to make that the case he says verse 27 so that not only this our craft is in danger to be set at nothing notice they don't care about truth they just care about their craft and their wealth but also

that the temple of the great goddess diana should be despised and her magnificence should be destroyed whom all asia and the world worships now red flag here if we're getting caught up in emotional movements that the whole world agrees with i would say that's a major red flag that that probably means we're falling into the demonic world influence christians like paul should be contradicting the demonic world christians like paul should be exposing false teachings false doctrine false worship and we should be known like paul like jesus to the demonic world because of our contradiction to their teachings because of our exposing their deception and bringing down their falsehood he says and when they heard these things verse 28 they were full of wrath and cried out saying great is diana of the ephesians here we are 2 000 years later and we have the same immature emotional reactions in human beings why because that's how the satanic world the demonic world works it hijacks people's emotions it gets them all upset and and in turmoil and hysterical over their worship system when it's when it's falling when it's being exposed verse 34 and when they knew that he was a jew that paul was a jew all with one voice about the space of two hours cried out great is diana of the ephesians here's the hysteria

we think hysteria is new we think this kind of hysterical

uh um what shall i say this hysterical whirlwind

that is just spreading through the land through the world

it's not new it's thousands of years old this is the influence we don't wrestle with flesh and blood this is the

influence

influence of principalities and powers and when the town clerk had appeased the people so he finally calmed them down after two hours he said you men of ephesus

what man is there that knows not how the city

of the ephesians is a worshiper of the great goddess diana and of the image

which fell down from jupiter and if you go into the archives

uh for the book of acts i go into far more detail on this

but for context as we get ready for the study of the book of ephesians let's understand that this city was immersed

in witchcraft this city was immersed in idolatry and the apostle paul

stood withstood this evil and stood against

all of these men to contradict their false teachings

he debated he contradicted he confronted and today if he was alive today people would be saying oh he's so confrontational

we don't like the line in his forehead he's so confrontational if he was alive today but he's not alive today but his words are here

and his example is here and what we see

is

he is known to the spirit world because of his contradiction to human beings

because of his debating with human beings the principalities the powers knew him as they knew christ now chapter 20 just a little bit more context and this is a very important context as well before we get into ephesians acts chapter 20 break it in at verse 17.

so um basically uh paul had kept the days of unleavened bread uh he he will not go into

ephesians he when he founded the church he's now coming back

the people from ephesus want to see him but he doesn't want to get waylaid so he won't go to the city of ephesus on his way back because he's trying he's counting the feast of weeks and we had a question last week on you know did the early church keep the feast just reading acts 19 to 20 you'll see he kept

the passover the days of unleavened bread uh now

he's coming back and he wants to get to jerusalem

for pentecost so he's counting the feast of weeks

and he's trying to get to pentecost before the seven week count is up so that he can keep pentecost in jerusalem

so go back into the car archives and i explained that in more detail but here in verse 17 of acts 20.

so you see now he from miletus he's sent to ephesus

he's not going there he's in he's in militants he's got to get to jerusalem so rather than go to the city of ephesus he summons the elders of ephesus to come to so that he can teach them and from miletus he sent to ephesus and called the elders of the church and when they were come to him he said unto them you know from the first day that i came to asia after what manner i have been with you at all seasons so he was consistent serving the lord with all humility of mine he's contradicting he's debating he's confronting people are speaking evil of the way they're speaking evil of him and they're saying he's arrogant you know why does he always have to be that way he's so arrogant he's telling look you guys know how i was i was consistent serving the lord with all humility of mind and with many tears and temptations which befell me by the lying and weight of the jews and he knows that we wrestle not against flesh and blood so all of this contradiction that he's suffering he he's on a higher plane and how i kept back nothing that was profitable unto you but i've shown you and have taught you publicly and from house to house so so he was iust open and he wasn't quiet if paul was alive today he'd be all over social media and you would know his position he would not be somebody who's just trying to get by unnoticed verse 22. sorry verse 21

testifying both to the jews and also to

the greeks repentance toward god and faith toward our lord jesus christ and now so that's all in the past here's where we are now and now behold i go bound in the spirit unto jerusalem not knowing the things that shall befall me there so you know satan always infiltrates religious systems and here we are with the people he's infiltrated all the world but here we are with the people of god the covenant people of god and the place where god has placed his name jerusalem and he's taken it over and so paul is saying okay you know christ was crucified in jerusalem the prophets were crucified in jerusalem i'm bound in the spirit now to go to jerusalem i don't know what's going to happen to me because i'm going to contradict these human beings who are animated by principalities and powers behind them i'm going there and i'm going to just praise the lord and preach the lord and contradict and debate and confront so he says and behold i go bound in the spirit unto jerusalem not knowing the things that shall befall me there except that the holy spirit witnesses in every city saying that bonds and afflictions await me abide me so i don't know what's going to happen but everybody who's inspired by the spirit is telling me i'm going to be in big trouble when i get there but none of these things move me neither count i my life dear unto myself

and in revelation it speaks of the faithful

being those who love not their life unto the death they have the testimony of christ

the commands of they obey the commands of the lord and they love not their lives unto the death paul is setting an example here he says none of these things move me neither can't i my life dear unto myself so that i might finish my course with

joy he understands as christ taught that many will allow themselves to be deceived

many will not be in opposition to the deception

and to the demonic world many will be caught up with it and follow false teachers

so he's saying you know i understand what christ taught

i am doing this so that i may finish my course with joy

and this is part of our rejoicing and we'll see when we get into ephesians that we are set up to absolutely 100 percent be successful here and to finish our course with joy following paul's example so that the spirit world can say jesus we know

paul we know and these faithful in christ

we know them too but who is everybody else to testify

he says i might finish my course with joy and the ministry which i have received of the lord jesus to testify the gospel of the grace of god and now behold i know this is paul taught by christ having the eyes of his understanding

opened he says i know that you all among whom i have gone preaching the kingdom of god shall see my face no more this is it i know that whatever awaits me in jerusalem i'm not coming back to ephesus you won't see me again this is it goodbye i know this is the end but i'm going to finish my course with joy therefore because of this understanding that i'm not going to see you again and i'm not going to see the brethren in ephesus again therefore i take you to record this day sounds like moses yes it's the same struggle that moses had with the ancient israelites here paul the apostle paul is having the same struggle not with first fruits israel but with the elders of first fruits israel a warning to all is first fruits israelites and especially us as elders that the same stubbornness that moses had to deal with in the ancient israelites the apostle paul is dealing with it here and so we shouldn't be too uh con confident in our spirituality here rather we should be humbled by this and take warning he says therefore i'm not going to see you again therefore i take you to record this day that i i am pure from the blood of all men here we all are gathered and paul is saying to us record this day that i paul i'm not

including any of you in this category

you have to work this out for yourselves i'm just letting you know that i paul i'm pure from the blood of all men by implication not everybody's going to be pure from the blood of all men this is terrifying there's no more terrifying words that paul could speak if you fear jesus christ if you take jesus christ for granted no big deal but if we fear jesus christ there's nothing more terrifying than this for paul to say i when when the lord returns in his great severe wrath i'm pure from the blood of all men you may not be it sends chills what do we have to do to make sure that we're on the right side of christ when he returns he says that i am pure from the blood of all men for i have not shunned to declare unto you all the council of god there is a council of god and when we get into the book of ephesians we need to understand what is this council of god whatever it is paul declared it all unto them he didn't hold anything back

you know um isaiah says

needed and some of it was

he gave them the whole

what they want

that the people of god will want

smooth things paul didn't care about

what they wanted he gave them what they

rough but he didn't hold any of it back

counsel of god and some of it is really rough when john when the apostle paul or john received the whole counsel of god he said it was like honey in my it was so sweet in my mouth

but then when i actually understood it it was

bitter in my belly that's the whole counsel of god

yes some of it is really sweet but some of it

when we really understand is really bitter

and paul didn't hold any of it back he gave it to gave all of it to them he says for i have not shunned to declare unto you all the counsel of god

take heed beware take heed therefore unto yourselves so pay attention to yourself

and to all the flock over the witch the holy spirit has made you overseers so the holy spirit is working here on the earth and the holy spirit empowers men with certain gifts and through those gifts the holy spirit then

uh puts these men as overseers and their our brother a pastor murray in the ordination ceremony yesterday he spoke about ephesians 4. we're going to get there as we study this book of ephesians

but he quoted ephesians 4 as we prepared to

ordain our brother jim into the ministry and he focused on the word gave that christ gave that these are gifts and that is an operation of the holy spirit with a purpose for the flock the giving is not for the men

the giving is for the flock and so it's an operation of the holy spirit and that's why a beautiful ceremony yesterday and great teaching and so here he says that you must beware and pay attention to ourselves as elders and to all the flock

over the which the holy spirit has made us overseers have made them overseers to feed the church of god you're never going to see me again this is it until christ returns and i don't know how it's going to go with you whether you'll be on the right side of christ or not but i'm warning you

the most important thing you can do is to take heed to yourself and to the flock that the holy spirit has made you overseers over and feed them feed them feed them

because we are going into battle and the troops must be nourished if they are malnourished and they fail i'm telling you i'm free from the blood of all men because i gave the food i didn't hold back any of it this is what you must do to feed the church of god which he has purchased with his own blood there is no higher price to be paid there is no higher price to be paid he paid the ultimate price for this flock you better do your duty of feeding the flock

now why is he emphasizing this so much to the ephesian elders he says in verse 29 for i know this i absolutely know this this is i have eyes and i can see and i'm telling you what i know for i know this that after my departing so i'm leaving now you're not going to see me again i know this a prophetic understanding that after my departing shall grievous wolves

enter in among you not sparing the flock we wrestle not against flesh and blood but against principalities and powers and paul understood this and part of that

wrestling is to be well nourished and part of becoming well nourished as pastor murray

identified yesterday is the role of the elders

through the operation of the holy spirit not for the

aggrandizement of the elders but for the nourishment of the flock so that they in turn can do their part and when the grievous wolves come in if they're well

nourished then the flock can participate in the overcoming of these principalities and powers but if they are not well nourished it

but if they are not well nourished it will be so easy for these principalities and powers to

overcome the flock and how do they do this through deception

when satan is bound for a thousand years the text says that he may deceive the nations no more

when he's released after a thousand years the text says that he immediately goes out to

deceive the nations this is what these sons of the seven

sons of skiva had no understanding of that the work of resisting and overcoming the principalities of powers is a work of teaching it's a work of

destroying false doctrine it's a work of of protecting the flock from the

infiltration of false doctrine that's why christ warned that in the end time many many will say i'm christ and they'll deceive many that in the end time there will be many false teachers and that in the end time many will follow them and many will betray it's all around teaching and that's what these seven sons of skeva who wanted to play exorcist who wanted to dabble and enhance their reputation they did not understand what paul understands that grievous wolves are going to enter the flock and i'm telling you elders feed the flock nourish the flock strengthen the flock protect the flock from false teachings as we'll see in ephesians 4 and again which pastor murray highlighted in the process of ordinating our or ordaining our brother uh jim and and the holy spirit counting him faithful and placing him in this ministry we see he says here for i know this that after my departing shall grievous wolves enter in among you not sparing the flock this how do you spell tragedy in all caps it goes further like as if that wasn't tragedy enough the tragedy is now compounded not only will you men be complacent and allow false teachers and false teaching to come into the church that's not the end of the tragedy it gets worse it goes from bad to worse verse 30 also of your own selves paul is looking at them and he's saying

i'm leaving now and i know something of your own selves shall men arise speaking perverse things to draw away disciples after them paul is

wrestling not against flesh and blood but against principalities and powers and how do they work deception that's why the role of teachers is so important

he says of your own this is this is bizarre he's looking at them and all the elders are there and you know of your own selves

shall men arise speaking perverse things to draw away disciples after them therefore watch and remember that by the space of three years i ceased not

to warn everyone night and day with tears paul was consistent his vision was clear

and he was passionate and he made sure that he warned these people the risk day and night for three years so just remember what i taught you and watch

same thing with the christ said watch so verse 38 now these elders after this pronouncement of incredible tragedy upon tragedy bad to worse to worst it doesn't get any worse than this after all of this teaching verse 38 they sorrowed most of all for the words which he spoke that they

should see his face no more just when i thought it can't get any worse it actually does get worse how does it get worse that all of this teaching of the

impending doom that many of them are going to be guilty of the blood of men that christ sacrificed his blood

to redeem after this very strong teaching verse 38 says all of paul's teaching straight over their head uh you know in one ear out the other i was going to say in one area out the other it wasn't it didn't even get in one ear just went straight over their head all they heard was they weren't gonna see him anymore and that's why they sorrowed instead of soaring over the spiritual tragedy that lay ahead and so they accompanied him to the ship we're going to study the book of ephesians together god willing this incredible start to this congregation in ephesus we know that what paul prophesied and what he saw prophetically came to pass how do we know because in revelation 2 verse 1 unto the angel of the church of ephesus right these things says he that holds the seven stars in his right hand who walks in the midst of the seven golden sticks candlesticks i know your works and your labor and your patience and how you cannot bear them which are evil and have tried them which say they are apostles and are not we always have that people who claim to be something that they're not let your works show who you are let your fruit show who you are don't come teaching us that you're an apostle that you're a prophet you're a prophetess you're a great evangelist somehow uh promoting yourself don't promote yourself

the brethren will know the works of the holy spirit always bear fruit and through the edification of the work of the holy spirit in you brethren will tell you

that they're being edified you don't have to tell us how great you are the holy spirit will tell us that we're truly being edified because as you edify us we'll be able to edify others

so these ephesians they tried them which said they were apostles and they're not and found them liars and have borne and has patience and for not my name's sake you've labored and haven't fainted unfortunately there's failure

nevertheless i have something against you

because you have left your first love and when we read the teachings that the apostle paul has for this city of ephesus

in the book of ephesians how on earth could they have lost their first love and yet it happened

so this book that we're about to study to see the

depth of rejoicing that we must have before the lord

for the depth of the spiritual blessings that he gives to us that he

bestows upon us somehow the ephesians lost it

they lost their joy they lost their first love christ for christ calls this out

he says then but this you have that you hate the deeds of the nicolaitans which i also hate so like five of the seven

congregations they have good points but there are some tragic failures and here in ephesus

they lost their first love unbelievable and then he says and this is going to be very important as well as we get into the book of ephesians

he that has an ear let him hear what the spirit says unto the churches to him that overcomes will i give to eat of the tree of life which is in the midst of paradise

so there's something about having an ear to hear

which not everybody has and this is brought to light

in ephesians as we get into ephesians so there's a few things that we've covered here

in acts 19 in acts 20 in revelation 2 that are just going to serve as great context as we get

into the book of ephesians i'm just going to read the first two verses of ephesians 1 and then god willing will continue

through the feast covering this wonderful book ephesians 1 verse 1 paul an apostle of jesus christ by the will of god he's not going around saying i'm an apostle i'm an apostle i'm a prophet i'm a

i'm a prophetess i'm a no by the will of god

he's been made an apostle of jesus christ to the saints which are at ephesus and to the faithful in christ jesus

grace be to you and peace from god our father and from the lord jesus christ amen amen amen so all today was just an introduction uh god willing will continue through the feast now to go through this

wonderful mighty amazing profound book of the letter to the ephesians so i hope

you enjoyed this i hope you're rejoicing before lord before the lord through this feast of tabernacles god bless you looking forward to uh what we will uncover together as we go through this this uh this wonderful book happy feast to tabernacles god bless you
