According to the foreknowledge of God, the father so relax. It's according to the foreknowledge of God, the Father True, sanctification of the spirit of the blood of Jesus Christ. So personally, I'm leaning more towards Paul's writing. Something about the way she writes the way articulate that the death of me, I really appreciate. Paul's writings, Peter is demonstrating to me. That's the same level of sophisticated. This was a fisherman rough-and-tumble fisherman out. They're just doing their work always call today. Maybe a blue collar. Worker has been educated in this beautiful. What does elect mean? And we are coming. Fortunately, we're coming out this writing of Jew. With his understanding of the Jewish scriptures. That is clear what he left me and so should we. So we know the elect are the chosen of God and God doesn't keep changing his mind and choosing different people. He's chosen one set of various dialects. And Gentiles are now grafted into this body of Alexis Covenant Community and the Apostle Peter had to go through some experiences to, finally, get to the point where the understood that the Gentiles are very much every much a part of the elect as the Natural Born

And how is it that we become left of the Spirit by God using the Holy Spirit into us and making us holy that's what separates us from the rest of humanity and that's what makes us part of the elect of God has infused us with his Holy Spirit. Should be about the father for the father himself. Told us instructs us to Focus On Christ. But but this is the operation of the father, are we? We read all of that through the Psalms and according to this, abundant Mercy is very good friends from the King James And so, we were conceived once and now sweetie operation of the Holy Spirit conceived again. An organelle. Unto a lively hope. There's a lot of This Is Us. And there's this Lively hope. Through God's mercy, we have this hope. The resurrection of Yeshua Messiah from the dead you shoot himself. God oversaw the destruction of his son. Three days. And three nights later through His abundant Mercy. Empower, he resurrected Christ from the grave and this is the foundation of our hope. This is the foundation of our faith. That this is a very, very critical understanding of the Christian that there is no, there's nobody on Earth. Apart, from the followers of Christ who have the special understanding that man is mortal. Man, conceived. Go to the gestation. He's born, he lives and then he dies. And when he dies, he's dead, he's in the grave. But we see Christ who overcame death through the power of the father and was resurrected from death. And this is the foundation of our faith, that there is a life after death. This is deep understanding that the Apostle Peter is giving to the followers of Christ because this is where the Hope comes from. To Suffern. That this is really a pistol with the letter about suffering. Is Christians, have to come to terms with suffering. And it's not just this week. I believe it was yesterday that in America, the world's superpower or first while superpower has been up to now. Has just signed over its sovereignty to the World Health Organization. The World Health Organization has written up this country and really our only hope is the United States of America. The Bastion of Freedom were supposed to be the Bastion of Freedom around the world. But in trying its Constitution Christian principle of freedom of speech, freedom of worship, freedom of speech and its Constitution. The current president has violated the Constitution and handed the country over to the World Health Organization in a time of crisis. When there is a pandemic that needs emergency powers are granted to the World Health Organization and their Authority. Supersedes, the authority of the member countries. And as the United States goes, so goes the rest of the Free World of the western world. So that's signed and the other odd thing about this apart from the fact that this treacherous to the Constitution, is the World Health Organization is the one that gets to declare whether or not there's a pandemic clear that whether or not there's a pandemic, meaning that they can mandate anything. And we spoke out against vaccine mandates one way or the other about the actual individual choice to be injected or not. With this experimental concoction, which is the ingredients of which are not shared what we said, it's a personal decision. If there's always just risk-reward calculation, the one has to make at least we had nothing but we did have a very strong opinion about was the government's Authority and whether it was appropriate for the government Mandate this injection and we spoke out against that we were criticized for that, okay? For those who supported the Mandate do you understand what this means? These member countries of the World Health Organization are signing over their authority, to the World Health Organization, pandemic or an infodemic whatever they decide. That they have authority to mandate. They can take your children away from you. They can, they can put you in a cab. This is no longer conspiracy theory. This is fact and the World Health Organization is not what I would call a Christian organization. Supposed to choose to live Godly in Christ. Where will that leave us? So again for those who supported the Mandate, get ready. We all have to get ready now. It's a different world. Now the Free World is subjected. What is subjecting himself to the World Health Organization? And we need to be alert and aware. What does this mean for us as Christians? How do we support each other through this? It's it's this is very, very serious and we need to help each other. So he says here. This is resurrection from the dead. The Apostle Paul speaks about the same. Hope several times that is based on the resurrection of Christ in this, this is an Epistle of suffering in the world change in ways that are hostile to Christ and Christians. Going to suffer. But this is how we get through it. This is absolute conviction that ask God the Father resurrected Christ so to he will resurrect us from the death of the Apostle. Paul speaks about it in Titus he says not by works of righteousness of the spirit. It's not by works of righteousness which we have done. By the washing of regeneration. And renewing of the holy spirit. Is this operation. This is a special operation taking place in a regeneration of the human. Into something else fashioned after Christ in 1st Corinthians. 15 says this is the foundation. This this man, this God became a man who was crucified. Who was dead. He rose from the dead. He was witnessed by over 500 people in, this is the foundation of the church and the face of the church at the foundation. That would just hope that we have this Lively, this Living Hope, but now it's Christ risen from the dead and has become the first fruits of them that slept with the first fruit. That means there's going to be another Harvest after him in Romans, 6 and verse 40 says, therefore we are very with him by baptism into death. That like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the father. Even, so even so we also should walk in newness of life. So this to our understanding of faith is rooted in this phenomenon, Of Christ dying and the father, raising him from the dead, that's where this Living Hope comes from. So bad to verse three, he says blessed be the God and father of our Lord, Jesus Christ. Which according to His abundant Mercy has begotten as again onto a lightly held by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. So that's what he has. He says here that he is begotten as again. Unto a lively. Why the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. To an inheritance, uncorrupt Incorruptible and undefiled. And it doesn't fade away and stuff. So it's not reserved in heaven for you and he doesn't say. We're going to eat at the same as Peters, a Julia understand. Understands, but this reward, it's being reserved in heaven for us. Christ is coming to Earth. The father himself, is coming to Earth. We are going to enjoy this reward on Earth or from purse. We're not going to heaven. But this reward is it. It's an inheritance. As brothers of Christ, we're going to ensure this. Hertz in church in the promises of the fathers and it cannot be corrupted file and it doesn't fade away. The rich of this world. RC Revelation, 18 and verse 11. He says here And the merchants of the Earth shall weep and mourn for her for no man buys their merchandise anymore. So this Rich trading counting in the trillions of dollars. Because it's not an inheritance that will last forever. The merchandise of gold and silver and precious stones in a pearls and fine, linen, and purple, and silken, garlic and fine wood, and

all manner of vessels of Ivory and all this material. is it that many of those slaves and Souls of men are Christians This is the world. We're heading into these. People are Drunk on Power. They're drunk on money and wealth. These are the gods they worship and they're drunk on sexual corruption is of the gods they worship. Yes, these trillions of dollars that they are counting in or trillions of Euros, all of this wealth of gold and silver doesn't matter how much it is. It's because in the fruits that you're so lost lusted after our departure from you and all things, which word, Indian goodly, our departed from you and you stopped buying them. No more at all. Where is your inheritance? Now, these Bloodlines of the try to keep this wealth in their bloodline, where's the inheritance? Now the merchants of these things which were made Rich by her, so they sold themselves over to her and just a system for the fear of her torment. A lot of us that Grace was clothed in fine linen, and purple, and Scarlet and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls. So great Riches of come to nothing, this was their inheritance. This is what they sold their lives for In one hour, turn into nothing. And every shipmaster all the company and ships and sailors. Now this inheritance that Peter speaks of Incorruptible and and and cannot cannot be diminished He says here it doesn't Fade Away. What is the, what is the Samaritans again? He's a Jew. Distance to promises in the Torah. Genesis 12, in verse 7 and the Lord appeared and said unto you have chosen Received the alert, will I give what this land. So, this is the Covenant involves learned. It involves a people on the land. It involves a check them of priests. That are going to be satisfied in service to God, to rule, over the whole earth and to leave the Earth to Salvation. This is the promise. This is the inheritance Unto thy seed will I give this land and water unto the Lord appeared unto him? That's the inheritance is not the Earth and this plot of Abraham and his Steed doesn't go back on his promises to the point where in Revelation, it is with John Cena Mercy, says 21. Verse 2, &. I John saw the Holy City Jerusalem coming down from God out of Heaven. This reward is reserved in heaven for us. coming down from God out of Heaven prepared as a bride adorned for her husband and he says this verse She was writing to. You never met them. They're scattered their under their facing intense persecution. Which is likely to get worse. He's encouraging them, he's reminding them of who they are. And where there were their hope is rooted. And now it says this, the disallowance are kept. They're guarded their protected. By the power of God. True face. Suitcase. Unto salvation. This complex way of writing, these masters of the Salvation articulating to us. These brethren. Are under intense persecution. So much. So remember of the Hebrews so much persecution that they were prepared to back away from Christ, the persecution Peter is now writing to these gentle Christian. He says that they are trapped, they are guarded. They are protected by the power of God. God is in heaven, watching this whole operation on Earth Watching The persecution of the Saints. Which for Saul and articulated to the prophets. Kept by the power of God through this phase. You're saying this is Central. We have this face that we are being sent ified by God with through this faith. And that is how God preserves us through this persecution. That's, that's the power of God. Is protecting us through face. The space that we have in Christ even though we faced persecution. Even though we suffer, even though some of us may be martyred, the point is, God is protecting us through faith. Unto salvation price, that not a hair of your head will fall to the ground in the same breath. As some of you will be put to death for, not a hair of your head will fall to the ground. Because you're being preserved unto salvation. So God Is Watching from heaven and through his power, he's protecting us. Undertale bation, this salvation is ready to be revealed. In the last time we spoke of this

salvation, they had the foreknowledge of this salvation. They knew that they would be a people and receiving Christ as he appears in receiving this salvation. Peter, the Apostle Paul speaks of the same protection and we did a study on Ephesians several Feast ago but this was really powerful. You are. All right? To the Gentiles in Ephesus, the eyes of your understanding and lighten your skin clearly confused. That you may know what is the hope of his calling. Speaking of that same old, Is calling mr. Father, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the Saints inheritance, What is the exceeding greatness of his power with dealing with, you sprain, their eyes, and our eyes extension. We come to understand the exceeding greatness of his power toward us who believe their sad face. That's take that stated that Peter saying that the father in his power and here it is again that we can come to understand this exceeding greatness of his power to those who believe that this Faith, according to the mighty power, which she wrought in Christ when he raised him from the dead and set him in his own race. And so that's in the archive, a study on the book of Ephesians. Are you doing that? But when you see, the apostles, truly understand something Magnificent about what God is doing this and threw us even through suffering through our face. That's where it all rest. He says, here in MLP was going to talk about this stuff during that, they're facing which he understands. He says, You greatly Rejoice. So we are greatly rejoicing in this face that God has extended to us. And in this great power, that is operating a choice. Now, for a season. Just as Christ suffering was for a season and then we just read God resurrected him through his power from the grave and sent him on his right side. And gave him a name. That's higher than any other name that's higher than any Glory. This is what the father is done and we are followers of Christ so there may be a season of persecution that we have to go through. In fact, here we are in the world is changing so rapidly around us. It's hardly a Christian nations are not even recognizable anymore. And that does not bode well for the question. But it's a season. That through the operation of God. Through our faith, we are being preserved unto salvation. We may suffer in this life, we may be martyred in the Bible. We are being preserved unto salvation. We have to keep our eyes on that are either enlightened that we see through all of this. We just read in Revelation the fools of this world. So, so rich and Powerful. They couldn't, they couldn't discern reality from from illusion and they were diluted by there. We should not in likewise, we should not be diluted by our suffering, so they were diluted by their wealth. We should not be diluted by suffer. Suffering is part of the package and that's what Peter trying to say to that will greatly Rejoice, even though for a season and this was some intense persecution, they were facing from the Roman. If need be, you are in heaviness to manifold many trials. And that's a heaviness. Has heaviness of spirit depression. Deep sadness grief which Christ said we will have grief in this world. He goes on now. Why that the trial of your face. So it's all about faith. The trial of your face, much more precious than gold. But we just read in Revelation. Don't have no meaning, no value. Look what Google has to go through this. But what the suffering is doing. Find the face of the Christian. This is incomprehensible. This is Travis. This suffering is putting our faith in the fire. And it is through this Faith. But God preserves us. It is through this faith that we attain salvation and soda space is being put through the fire, to be refined and to be tested. And then Peter is a Jew. Understanding the Jewish. History knows that God test his people. Tested people. The trial of your face being much more precious than of gold that perishes don't be tried with fire. So it's so cold is tried with fire in it but it's just dealing with something. How much more will I stay? Or should we expect our being metaphorical? Precious than of gold that perishes do. It be tried with fire fire be metaphorical for a face might be found unto

praise and honour great. I see a picture of Jesus Christ. So this is where the Christian pilgrims were just passing through. This Earth were not getting attached to material things and those of us in the west are Brethren who are not disturbing the western civilization. Cuz they really depend on God. They really built very strong relationship there. Their, they're really Community compared to the west where, you know, when the rest of them. Well, why is everybody trying to get into these countries? The Forest of us live, like kings compared to Kings of yesteryear? But that can sometimes take our eye off the ball and Peterson, keep your eye on the ball. The ball is the appearing of Christ. Lucia, when he appears in the clouds. So that's the prize eyes on the prize. In what we're going to ignore. We will be going through for the vision. Is for an appointed time. Wait for it cuz it's coming. But it is designed to, to refine our face. It might be found unto praise and honour and Glory of Jesus Christ. And so noticed that in verse five. He says we're kept by the power of God unto salvation. In verse 7 says, it's the trial of her face through fire, that it will be found unto praise and honour and glory of the Lord. Jesus Christ, the operation of faith. He says so, so this is, we're waiting for the appearing of Christ, and his right into these scattered, but they haven't seen him. Peter, saw him Peter knew him, but he's right into a people. Never met Christ. Is it to see him? They don't know him first, and, and he's acknowledging that. Pictures of Christ. How did not see you love? We lost in Christ actually said, you know, blessed are they who believe? Having not seen you in yet. You see him not yet the leaving unspeakable and full of Glory their deaths of belief their joy in these also encouraging them and getting through the persecution doesn't mean saving their skin. Russian them off to this place of safety, so nothing touches them. It means going through whatever trial May befall them, and keeping a weather eye. We rise to Glory. Yep, believe, and that's the key the face yet. Believing you rejoice with joy unspeakable. Again, this is the operation of the Holy Spirit. There's something happening, which is unspeakable because of this operation of the Holy Spirit, which is Bank Defiance. Rejoice with joy, unspeakable and full of Glory. Receiving the end of what receiving the end of your face. Which is what the salvation of your souls. That's what this operation is all about and so he's really encouraged, don't know but I know you love Christ and I know you're going through intense persecution. So I'm writing to you to encourage you to understand how precious your face in Christ. It's how precious your understanding that he was resurrected from the dead The ground your face. So that no matter what you go through your face gets stronger, that all of this persecution should strengthen our faith because it's the foreknowledge of God God said, all these things are going to happen. And if there's going to be an electric body that is waiting faithfully for the Lord, what? A mighty mighty God, we serve. So that takes us. Two verse nine will continue.
