Shocking Elements of Faith

FAITH (STP) DOCTRINAL STATEMENT

Faith is the absolute sure knowledge that God exists and He will accomplish those things He promised. Faith in God—trust in His promises and belief that He is in overall control is a major characteristic in the Christian life and is absolutely necessary for salvation.

Romans 1:17; 10:17; Ephesians 3:17; Hebrews 11:1-2; James 2:22-24


(**Rom 1:17**) For in it (*the Gospel*) the righteousness of God is revealed from **faith** to **faith**; as it is written, "The just shall live by **faith**."

(Rom 10:17) So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

(**Eph 3:17**) that Christ may dwell in your hearts through **faith** ...

(**Heb 11:1-2**) Now **faith** is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen For by it the elders obtained a good testimony.

(James 2:22-24) Do you see that **faith** was working together with his works, and by works **faith** was made perfect? And the Scripture was fulfilled which says, "Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness." And he was called the friend of God. You see then that a man is justified by works, and not by **faith** only.



4 Types of Faith

- 1. **Saving Faith** —For by grace are ye saved through **faith**; & that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God (Eph 2:8)
- 2. **THE Faith** Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the **faith**. Test yourselves...(2 Cor 13:5)
- 3. Living Faith ... The just shall live by faith. (Rom 1:17 NKJV)
- 4. **Personal Faith** Do you have **faith**? Have it to yourself before God... (Rom 14:22a NKJV)

Two more Types??

Blind faith - is believing something without reason to believe it. It can also be defined as an unquestioning belief in something, even when it is unreasonable or wrong. **Informed Faith** - is when proof (or evidence) allows someone to have belief, trust & confidence in something or someone else

• This distinction implies that faith is not always blind. If it were inherently "blind faith", there would be no point in making the distinction. Intuitively, we already know faith is not inherently blind.

For example, as a seven-year-old child, did you doubt your parents or guardians would protect you? Probably not. Why?

Not simply because they're your parents, but because for the entirety of your childhood, your parents **showed you** that they would protect you. From the past experiences of them always giving you this protection, you realized you can always have faith that they would always protect you. Notice what came first: the proof (or reason) that your parents would protect you came first. After the proof came your faith in them.

Consider it this way: A man might propose to his girlfriend *only after* she has shown him that she would be a good, faithful wife. In showing him this, he can have the faith necessary to ask her to be his wife

Are Christians supposed to embrace blind faith or evidential faith?

Perhaps a better way to ask this question is to ask: "With what kind of faith does Scripture teach Christians to live?"

Joh 20:30-31 And truly Jesus did many other signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book; but these are written **that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ**, the Son of God, and **that believing** you may have life in His name.

(If we are to only have blind faith, why would Jesus give us evidence that proves He is the Messiah? After all, blind faith asserts that evidence is not necessary.)



1Pe 3:15 (NIV) But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect

(The content gives us an idea of what kind of faith we should have. It is not only a "suggestion" to have an **informed faith**; this verse **commands** it! We are to know **why** we have faith in Jesus so that we can **share** not only <u>our faith</u> but <u>the reason</u> for our faith as well.)

So often ... we associate Faith with our belief that God can perform miracles ... to accomplish His will.

Shocking Scriptures about faith:



1. Faith Can Move Mountains

Matthew 17:20 – "So Jesus said to them, 'Because of your unbelief (*the disciples could not cast out certain demons*); for assuredly, I say to you, if you have **faith** as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, "Move from here to there," and it will move; and <u>nothing will be impossible</u> for you."

Shocking Factor: Jesus is saying that even the tiniest **faith** has the power to command nature itself!

2. Doubting Is Like Being Tossed by the Wind

James 1:6-7 – "But let him ask in **faith**, with no **doubting**, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind. For let not that man suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord."

Shocking Factor: If you pray with doubt, James says you shouldn't expect to receive anything from God!

3. Whatever Is Not of Faith Is Sin

Romans 14:23 – "But he who doubts is condemned if he eats, because he does not eat from **faith**: for whatever is not from **faith** is sin."

Shocking Factor: Paul is saying that any action not based on **faith** is actually a sin!

4. Faith Can Save the Sick

James 5:15 – "And the prayer of **faith** will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven."

Shocking Factor: Not only can **faith** heal sickness, but it can also lead to the forgiveness of sins!

5. Jesus Couldn't Do Miracles Because of Unbelief

Mark 6:5-6 – "Now He could do no mighty work there, except that He laid His hands on a few sick people and healed them. And He marveled because of their unbelief. Then He went about the villages in a circuit, teaching."

Shocking Factor: The Son of God Himself was limited by people's lack of **faith!**

6. Some People's Faith Will Be Shipwrecked

1 Timothy 1:19 – "Having faith and a good conscience, which some having rejected, concerning the faith have suffered shipwreck."

Shocking Factor: Paul warns that people can completely wreck their **faith** if they abandon a good conscience!

7. Faith Without Works Is Dead

James 2:26 – "For as the body without the spirit is dead, so **faith** without works is dead also."

Shocking Factor: Faith alone isn't enough—if it doesn't lead to action, it's lifeless!

8. Even Demons Believe—And Tremble

James 2:19 – "You **believe** that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons believe—and tremble!"

Shocking Factor: Just believing in God isn't enough—demons believe too, but they're still doomed!

9. Jesus Prayed That Peter's Faith Wouldn't Fail


Luke 22:31-32 — "And the Lord said, 'Simon, Simon! Indeed, Satan has asked for you, that he may sift you as wheat. But I have prayed for you, that your **faith** should not fail; and when you have returned to Me, strengthen your brethren.""

Shocking Factor: Even Peter, one of Jesus' closest disciples, was at risk of his **faith** failing—so Jesus personally prayed for him!

10. Peter Walked on Water Until His Faith Wavered

Matthew 14:28-31 – "And Peter answered Him and said, 'Lord, if it is You, command me to come to You on the water.' So He said, 'Come.' And when Peter had come down out of the boat, he walked on the water to go to Jesus. But when he saw that the wind was boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink he cried out, saying, 'Lord, save me!' And immediately Jesus stretched out His hand and caught him, and said to him, 'O you of little faith, why did you doubt?'"

Shocking Factor: Peter literally walked on water—but his fear and doubt caused him to sink!



11. Your Faith Has Made You Well

Luke 8:48 – "And He said to her, 'Daughter, be of good cheer; your **faith** has made you well. Go in peace."

Shocking Factor: It wasn't just Jesus' power—it was <u>her</u> faith that brought healing!

12. A Lack of Faith Is a Sinful Rebellion

Hebrews 3:12 – "Beware, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief in departing from the living God."

Shocking Factor: Unbelief isn't just doubt—it's described as an evil heart turning away from God!

13. Some People's Faith Will Be Overthrown

2 Timothy 2:17-18 – "And their message will spread like cancer. Hymenaeus and Philetus are of this sort, who have strayed concerning the truth, saying that the resurrection is already past; and they overthrow the **faith** of some."

Shocking Factor: False teaching has the power to completely destroy some people's **faith!**

14. God Has Dealt to Each One a Measure of Faith

Romans 12:3 – "For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of **faith**."

Shocking Factor: Faith isn't just something we build—it's something God gives!

15. Without Faith, It's Impossible to Please God

Hebrews 11:6 – "But without **faith** it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him." **Shocking Factor:** No matter how good your works are, if you don't have **faith**, you cannot please God!

16. Faith Works Through Love

Galatians 5:6 – "For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but **faith** working through love."

Shocking Factor: Faith isn't just about belief—it has to operate through love to be effective!

17. Jesus Questions If He Will Find Faith on Earth

Luke 18:8 – "I tell you that He will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless, when the Son of Man comes, will He really find **faith** on the earth?"

Shocking Factor: Jesus suggests that faith may be rare when He returns!

18. Faith Overcomes the World

1 John 5:4 – "For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world—our **faith**."

Shocking Factor: Faith isn't just for personal growth—it's the key to victory over the worldliness in society!

19. Jesus Rebukes the Disciples for Their Lack of Faith

Matthew 8:26 – "But He said to them, 'Why are you fearful, O you of little **faith**?' Then He arose and rebuked the winds and the sea, and there was a great calm."

Shocking Factor: The disciples were panicking over a storm, but Jesus expected them to have **faith** instead!

20. Some Will Depart from the Faith

1 Timothy 4:1 – "Now the Spirit expressly says that in latter times some will depart from the **faith**, giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons."

Shocking Factor: Some people will abandon their **faith** (& God's truth) because of demonic deception!

21. Faith Can Justify a Sinner

Romans 5:1 – "Therefore, having been justified by **faith**, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ."

Shocking Factor: Faith alone makes us right with God, not our works!

22. The Righteous Walk by Faith, Not Sight

2 Corinthians 5:7 – "For we walk by **faith**, not by sight."

Shocking Factor: You are meant to live by trusting God, even when you can't see how things will work out!

23. Even Jesus Was Amazed by Great Faith

Matthew 8:10 – "When Jesus heard it, He marveled, and said to those who followed, 'Assuredly, I say to you, I have not found such great faith, not even in Israel!" Shocking Factor: A Roman centurion's faith was so strong that it made Jesus Himself marvel!

24. You Are Saved by Grace Through Faith

Ephesians 2:8-9 – "For by grace you have been saved through **faith**, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast."

Shocking Factor: You cannot earn salvation—it's a free gift received only through **faith!**

25. Faith Must Be Tested


1 Peter 1:7 – "That the genuineness of your **faith**, being much more precious than gold that perishes, though it is tested by fire, may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ."

Shocking Factor: Your **faith** will go through **fiery tests** to prove its strength!

26. Faith Must Be Spoken

2 Corinthians 4:13 – "And since we have the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, 'I believed and therefore I spoke,' we also believe and therefore speak."

Shocking Factor: Faith isn't just believing—it's declaring what you believe!



27. Faith Can Protect You Like a Shield Ephesians 6:16 – "Above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench <u>all</u> the fiery darts of the wicked one."

Shocking Factor: Faith is a spiritual weapon that can stop every attack of the enemy!

28. The Power of Faith Can Be Wasted Hebrews 4:2 – "For indeed the gospel was preached to us as well as to them; but the word which they heard did not profit

them, not being mixed with **faith** in those who heard it."

Shocking Factor: Hearing God's Word means nothing if you don't mix it with faith!

29. Jesus Heals Because of People's Faith


Matthew 9:29 – "Then He touched their eyes, saying, 'According to your faith let it be to you."

Shocking Factor: The level of faith determines the level of breakthrough!

30. You Must Keep the Faith Until the End

2 Timothy 4:7 – "I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the **faith**."

Shocking Factor: Faith isn't just a one-time decision—it's a lifelong fight!



Summary: What is Faith According to scripture?

- 1. It is the substance of hope and evidence of the unseen (Hebrews 11:1).
- 2. It comes from hearing the Word of God (Romans 10:17).
- 3. It must be active—faith without works is dead (James 2:17).
- 4. It saves us—salvation is through faith (Ephesians 2:8-9).
- 5. It is a way of life—the just shall live by faith (Habakkuk 2:4).
- 6. It means trusting God even when we don't see the outcome (2 Corinthians 5:7).
- 7. It is complete confidence in God's promises (Romans 4:20-21).
- 8. It is the key to overcoming the world (1 John 5:4).
- 9. It is believing without seeing (John 20:29).
- 10. It is tested and refined through trials (1 Peter 1:7).

In the Hebrews 11 "**Faith** Chapter" ... we learn that God will grant these **faith**ful men & women salvation and eternal life in God's kingdom—why? Because they believed they would receive it, and because they had real **faith**. They will receive the reward they hoped for, because:

- they believe God exists and
- He is the rewarder of those who diligently seek Him (Heb. 11:6).

Our task is to follow their example, endure in **faith** until the end, and receive this same reward.
