# **It's in the Blood!**

*There is power, power, wonder-working power  
In the blood of the Lamb.”*

Those lyrics of a popular song ring true. Very true. He came, He did what He had to do and Jesus Christ accomplished His mission on Earth. He came, He died, and became the “firstfruits” of all those who are in Christ.

We just observed the New Testament Passover on March 31, this year, more than two months ago. Yet, for the saints of God, its deep meaning is carrying us throughout the rest of the year and for the rest of our physical lives.

The Eternal sent His only begotten Son to shed His blood for the sins of humanity. What’s the significance of the shedding of blood? **Hebrews 9: 11-15**, *“But Christ came as High Priest of the good things to come, with the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation. Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption. For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? And for this reason He is the Mediator of the new covenant, by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions under the first covenant, that those who are called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance.”*

We are no longer destined to remain dead in our graves because of our sins. Another song says, “Jesus paid it all and all to Him I owe.” We are now made righteous by the blood of “Our Passover,” Lamb, Jesus, the Christ. His death means life and His death means power—power over the grave.

The death and subsequent triumph over the grave mean the saints of the Most High God have been given power to resist the evil one and overcome sin. *“To him who overcomes I will grant to sit with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne,”* **Rev. 3:21**. The power that blood gives to us means one day we, too, will have victory over the grave.

During our Christian walk, there are many trials and hurdles to confront. The Holy Bible describes our journey as being a straight and narrow road. However, there's an alternative path, which is broad, but it is the way that leads to destruction, the Bible admonishes us.

We have been given power, not a spirit of fear, to overcome. **2 Tim. 1;7** *“For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and love and a sound mind.”* The shed blood of Jesus Christ should mean everything to us, especially when it comes to our fears or any temptation we believe we don't have the power to overcome.

Throughout the year is an opportune time to reflect on what “Our Passover” has done for us. It is equally fitting we meditate on what the spilling of blood means for the future of humanity. It's not just about offering power to overcome the challenges of this life, but more importantly, what the future holds for us when we experience the full measure of God's power and love for us.

Indeed, there's power in the shed blood of Jesus Christ. It's in the blood! It was no ordinary sacrifice – it was the ultimate sacrifice when He laid down His life for us. That was no mere act. In the fullness of time, humanity will come to see what His sacrifice means for our future. It's in His shed blood! Ω





# WE ARE TRUE CHILDREN OF GOD

The apostle John writes that we are children of God and shall be like God, for we shall see Him as He is (**I John 3:2**).

The apostle Peter writes that Jesus Christ is now in heaven at the right hand of God; angels and authorities and powers being made subject to Him (**I Peter 3:22**).

John also writes that those in the first resurrection will reign with Christ one thousand years on this earth (**Revelation 20:6**).

Notice what these two verses indicate what will happen when Christ returns to this earth:

**Revelation 20:6**... *“Blessed and holy are those who have part in the first resurrection. The second death has no power over them, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with him for a thousand years.”* –

**Zechariah 14:4**... *“On that day (Christ’s return to this earth) His feet will stand on the Mount of Olives, east of Jerusalem, and the Mount of Olives will be split in two from east to west, forming a great valley, with half of the mountain moving north and half moving south.”*

On that “great day of the Lord,” Jesus Christ will stand on the Mount of Olives and He will begin ruling this earth. His direct involvement with this world will begin changing everything as we know. It will be a remarkable time leading up to an absolutely unfathomable event!

## **GOD’S THRONE TO BE ON EARTH**

The apostle John writes (**Revelation 21 & 22**) that the New Jerusalem, the holy city of God comes down from heaven (to this earth) and God speaks out of heaven saying: *“Behold the tabernacle (dwelling place) of God is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people, and God Himself will be their God.”* So, in this round about way we can see that man will not go to heaven, rather God Himself will come down to this earth! Here's a little more "revelation" and admonition from the apostle John:

In **Revelation 22**, we find that Jesus Christ says (verse 7), *"Behold, I am coming soon! Blessed is he who keeps the word of the prophecy in this book."*

Continuing in **verses 12-14**: *"Behold, I am coming soon! My reward is with me, and I will give to everyone according to what he has done. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End. Blessed are those who wash their robes, that they may have the right to the tree of life and may go through the gates into the city."*

These few verses show very clearly that the saved man or woman will "NOT go to heaven when they die." Heaven is not the reward of the saved! The reward of the saved is eternal life with Jesus Christ as a part of the family of God...on this earth!

May God help us to not only obey His word...but believe in His promises. He's going to keep his word. Are we going to keep it as well? Ω

# Why does God forgive us?

**H**ave you ever done something really bad? Have you ever thought that praying for forgiveness just wouldn't undo what you did? Have you ever thought that God just wouldn't forgive you? Why should He? We certainly don't deserve His forgiveness.

The thing is, God doesn't want you to feel that way. He wants you to get on your knees and ask for forgiveness. And when you do, He forgives you. But why, why does He forgive you?

**Psalms 86:5** says, "For you Lord are good and ready to forgive, and abundant in mercy to all those who call upon you." The Lord is 'ready to forgive' all the people who call upon Him. They repent and in doing so, hold up their part of the bargain. (And I say bargain because that's what we humans have. We have the better/easier part of the "deal.") Then, God holds up his part of the "bargain." He forgives us of our awful sins. Why?

"The Lord is gracious and full of compassion, slow to anger and great in mercy" (**Psalms 145:8**). God is everything anyone wants in a person. In fact, if He were a human, He would be perfect and pure. He's loving, compassionate, merciful, slow to anger, good, kind and forgiving. All you have to do is ask Him to forgive you. You have to ask it from deep down in your heart and He will. Like it says in **Acts 2:38**, "Then Peter said to them, 'Repent and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.'"

But still, why? We aren't like that. We sin and we act like we're just like everyone else. When someone does something wrong, we don't correct them. We copy people and usually go with the flow. But God still forgives us.

**Mark 11:25, 26**, "And whenever you stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, forgive him, that your Father in Heaven may also forgive you trespasses."

So according to this verse, God forgives us if we forgive others. But He doesn't if we don't. So, there's one reason why He forgives us; because we forgive others. But there must be another reason for his forgiveness. First **John 1:9** says, "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us

from all unrighteousness." Sometimes, actually most of the time, when I repent and ask God for forgiveness, I feel like He didn't. I feel that I'm a sinner, which I am. I ask myself, "How can He forgive me when I've sinned so much?" It's a question a lot of people ask themselves. And here, in **1 John**, it says that He forgives us because we confess our sins to him. But wait, there's more.

In **Luke 15**, there is the parable of the lost son. You know how it goes. The son decides he wants to live his own life, a fun life. He asks his dad for his share of the money that he would have later inherited. He left home and after a while, his money ran out. He got a job of feeding pigs and even ate some of their food because he was so desperate.

Finally, he decided to go home. He didn't expect things to be like they used to be, but he did think he could get a job as a servant. But when he was walking back to his father's house, his dad saw him. He ran out to his son and hugged him. He threw a huge party for his "lost son" that was now found.

The father forgave his son of what he did, just like that. He forgave him in the blink of an eye. He forgave him because he loved him. God is like the dad of the lost son. The dad was standing in his door, looking for his son, waiting for his son. And when he saw him, he ran out to him. He forgave his son because he loved him so much and so dearly.

God's just like that. Actually, in fact, God is that father. He doesn't forgive us because he has to. He forgives us because he wants to. He wants us to have eternal life. He forgives us because He loves us.

When I think about this, I feel so happy and excited inside. I mean God forgives me of the sins that shouldn't be forgiven. He forgives me, the sinner who doesn't deserve even a millisecond of His time. But what makes me smile the most is that he does all this because he loves me. He wants the best for me. And that is the best thing in the whole entire world.

And I'm glad that he does forgive me because I want to spend the rest of my life, both physical and spiritual, with him. That's what I want more than anything and he wants the same thing as me.

# IS GOD STILL RELEVANT?

DISCOVERING GOD ANEW – A 4 WEEK SERIES

## May Campaign Report for Toronto

Is God Still Relevant? This was the theme for the CGI Toronto campaign for the first four Sabbaths in May. The series was designed to explore some of the big questions surrounding our Christian faith. We opened the series with the question of the gospel itself. Kenroy Allen gave a very compelling presentation entitled, "What Is the True Gospel?" He presented the gospel as not merely a religious concept but the "Good News" of a coming literal Kingdom; a divine government that will replace the flawed systems of this world with eternal peace and righteousness. We were reminded that God desires a relationship, not just a ritual, and that through Jesus Christ, we are invited to be reconciled to Him.

The second session was presented by Horane Smith, entitled, "Do We Still Need the Old Testament?" We learned that the Old Testament isn't just about a "harsh God" but provides the essential historical and prophetic framework for understanding Jesus Christ. From the "first gospel" in Genesis to the fulfillment of over 300 prophecies, we saw how God's plan for redemption has always been one continuous story. By understanding the Torah as divine instruction rather than a burden, we can more fully appreciate the grace and truth revealed through our Saviour, Jesus Christ.

The third session, presented by Courtney Edwards, tackled the question, "Why Do We Need God and the Church?" He presented God as the foundation of our existence, and the source of morality and hope. We were reminded that the Church is not a building, but a living body of called-out ones designed for mutual support. "Iron sharpens iron." Staying connected to the body of Christ is vital for our spiritual growth and accountability.

In the fourth and final session of the series, Courtney Scarlett addressed the difficult question: "Why Do Bad Things Happen to Good People?" Drawing from the life of Joseph and the powerful metaphor of a diamond forming under pressure, we were reminded that we live in a broken world, but our God is never distant. Whether we're in the "pit" or the "prison" phase of our journey, God is using the heat of our current trial to forge an indestructible character within us.

Each of the presentations were preceded by a lively song service consisting of hymns, spiritual songs, and special music items. And each message was followed by an engaging Q&A session that provided the brethren and guests the opportunity to dive deeper into the topics. Afterwards, we gathered together for fellowship and refreshments in the North Hall.

The series attracted a number of first-time visitors, as well as returning visitors, including a couple who had previously been in fellowship with the congregation over 30 years ago! The highest attendance came at the start of the campaign, with a slow decline towards the last session, which is a typical trend for these types of events.

This was the first time our congregation had ever participated in a multi-week campaign initiative. I believe the experience helped to strengthen our commitment individually and collectively as the body of Christ to share our faith with the broader community, and to recognize the opportunity we have to be a light in a very deceived and sin-sick world.

We're definitely thankful for the privilege God has given us to minister to those outside of the church and to plant seeds of hope and encouragement for their spiritual journeys. Our hope is that we were able to demonstrate that God is indeed still relevant, even in our highly modernized society.

Behind the scenes, our local evangelism team worked really hard in putting this event together to produce a highly positive outcome. Many thanks to Steve Agnew and his crew for the long hours of planning and preparation. Thanks to all of the CGI Toronto brethren for their active participation and enthusiasm in working together in unity.

Our next phase will be to analyze the results of our efforts to determine areas of improvement for the future, while we work to nurture the spiritual growth of our guests through email follow-up and encouragement.

May God bless our efforts to proclaim the good news of His kingdom to a world that so desperately needs it.

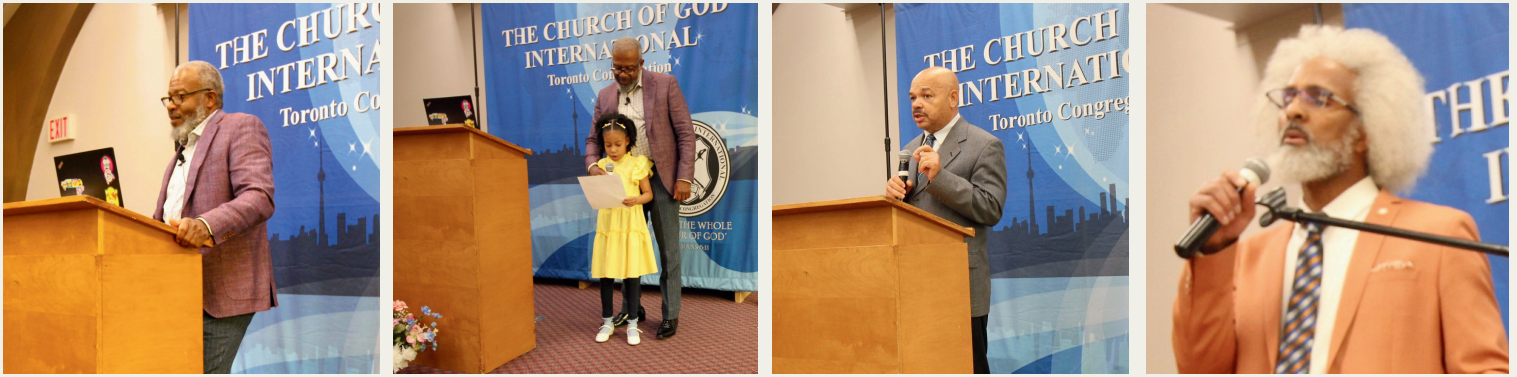

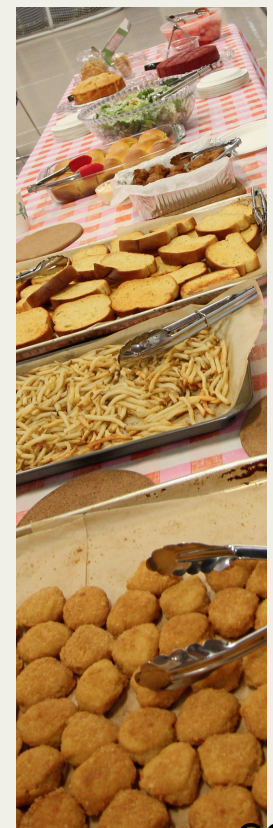
