

# CgiCanada Feast 2024 Checklist

**Exodus 19:5** Now therefore, if you will indeed **obey** My voice and **keep** My covenant, then you shall be a **special treasure to Me** above all people; for all the earth is Mine.

Lev 23:33-36 **Keep** the Feast of Tabernacles! Holy convocations on 1<sup>st</sup> day & on 8<sup>th</sup> day

Lev 23:40 **Rejoice!** before the LORD your God for seven days

H8055 - sâmach - Glee, Cheer, Joy, Celebrate, be Merry ... **“Party-eth On!**

**Nehemiah 8:9-10** And Nehemiah... and Ezra the priest... said to all the people, 'This day (*Feast of Trumpets*) is holy to the Lord your God; **do not mourn nor weep.**' For all the people wept when they heard the words of the Law. Then he said to them, 'Go your way, **eat** the fat, **drink** the sweet, and send portions (*share!*) to those for whom nothing is prepared; for this day is holy to our Lord. Do not sorrow, for the joy of the Lord is your strength.'

**Adam Clarke** - God's Feasts are **not** gluttonous & drunken festivals that weaken the body, & enfeeble the mind: from your **religious feast** your bodies will acquire **strength** and your mind acquires **power & fervour** (intense & passionate feeling), so that you shall be able to **Do His will**, & to do it **cheerfully**. **Religious joy**, properly tempered with continual dependence on the help of God & meekness of mind, is a powerful means of strengthening the soul. In such a state every duty is **doable**, & every duty **delightful**. In such a frame of mind the general **health** of the body is much improved; a **cheerful heart** is not only a continual feast, but also a continual **medicine**.

**Psalm 95:6-7** Oh come, let us **worship** & bow down; Let us kneel before the Lord our Maker. For He is our God, and we are the people of His pasture, & the sheep of His hand.



**Psalm 95:1-2** Oh come, let us **sing** to the Lord! Let us shout joyfully to the Rock of our salvation. Let us come before His presence with thanksgiving; Let us shout joyfully to Him with psalms.

**1 Chronicles 16:29** Give to the Lord the **glory** due His name; **Bring an offering**, and come before Him.  
Oh, **worship** the Lord in the beauty of holiness!

Look for Opportunities to **Teach or Learn from Children!**

**Deuteronomy 6:6-7** And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up.

**Mar 10:14b-15** Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of God. Assuredly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God as a little child will by no means enter it."

Practise Active listening

**Ecclesiastes 5:1** Walk **prudently** when you go to the house of God; and draw near to hear rather than to give the sacrifice of fools, for they do not know that they do evil

**Isaiah 55:3** Incline your ear, & come to Me. Hear, & your soul shall live; & I will make an everlasting covenant with you...

Participate! (In Feast Activities & in the lives of brethren)

**Hebrews 10:24-25** And let us **consider** one another in order to **stir up love and good works**, not forsaking the **assembling** of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but **exhorting** one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching

**Meet** some new people - or deepen the friendship with some brothers or sisters

Paul speaks fondly of when "they gave me & Barnabas the right hand of fellowship" (Gal 2:9)
