


Make a Mobile

using different shaped plastic bottles, fill each with bright colorful objects—stars, yarn, sequins, confetti. Use your imagination!



Punch a tiny hole in the lid, thread a piece of yarn or ribbon through the hole and secure it with a knot (or, knot the yarn around the neck of the bottle". Replace the lid on the bottle. Secure with glue or tape so the lid cannot be removed.

Directions:

Use your imagination! Mobiles can be fun for a child to watch as well as make.

Use plastic bottles and containers that have screw on or plastic lids. Rinse and remove labels. Fill with yarn scraps; confetti cut from colored construction paper; glitter; confetti, etc. Suspend from hanger with different lengths of yarn or ribbon.


Or cut pictures out of old magazines and glue to paper or aluminum plates. Suspend from a hanger with different lengths of yarn.

Or draw, color, decorate, and hang your own creations. Just have fun.

Materials:

- Light colored paper, and dark colored construction paper
 - · pencil
 - · Yarn
 - · White glue
 - · Hole punch
 - ·clothes hangers
 - · Scissors
 - ·strong light source

Directions:


Make silhouettes of each member of your class. Have each student stand between a strong light and a piece of light colored paper which is taped to a vertical surface. Trace the *shadow* with a pencil. Cut out the silhouette and glue it on a piece of dark colored construction paper.

You can choose to display from a mobile, a bulletin board, or mounted on dark construction paper as gifts for their parents, or family members.



We are His Sheep

Sheep Pattern:



Materials:

Heavy Cardboard
White yarn
black felt tip
permanent marker
black felt or black construction paper
red ribbon and bell (optional)
wooden clothespins
polyester stuffing (optional)

Directions:

Cut lamb's body out of heavy cardboard. Color half of the clothespin with black permanent marker. Attach clothespins to body. Color the head of the lamb black. Start in the middle of the lamb and wrap the yarn around and around the cardboard. Attach the ears and the tail to the lamb with glue. Tie the red ribbon with the bell around the neck of the lamb.
