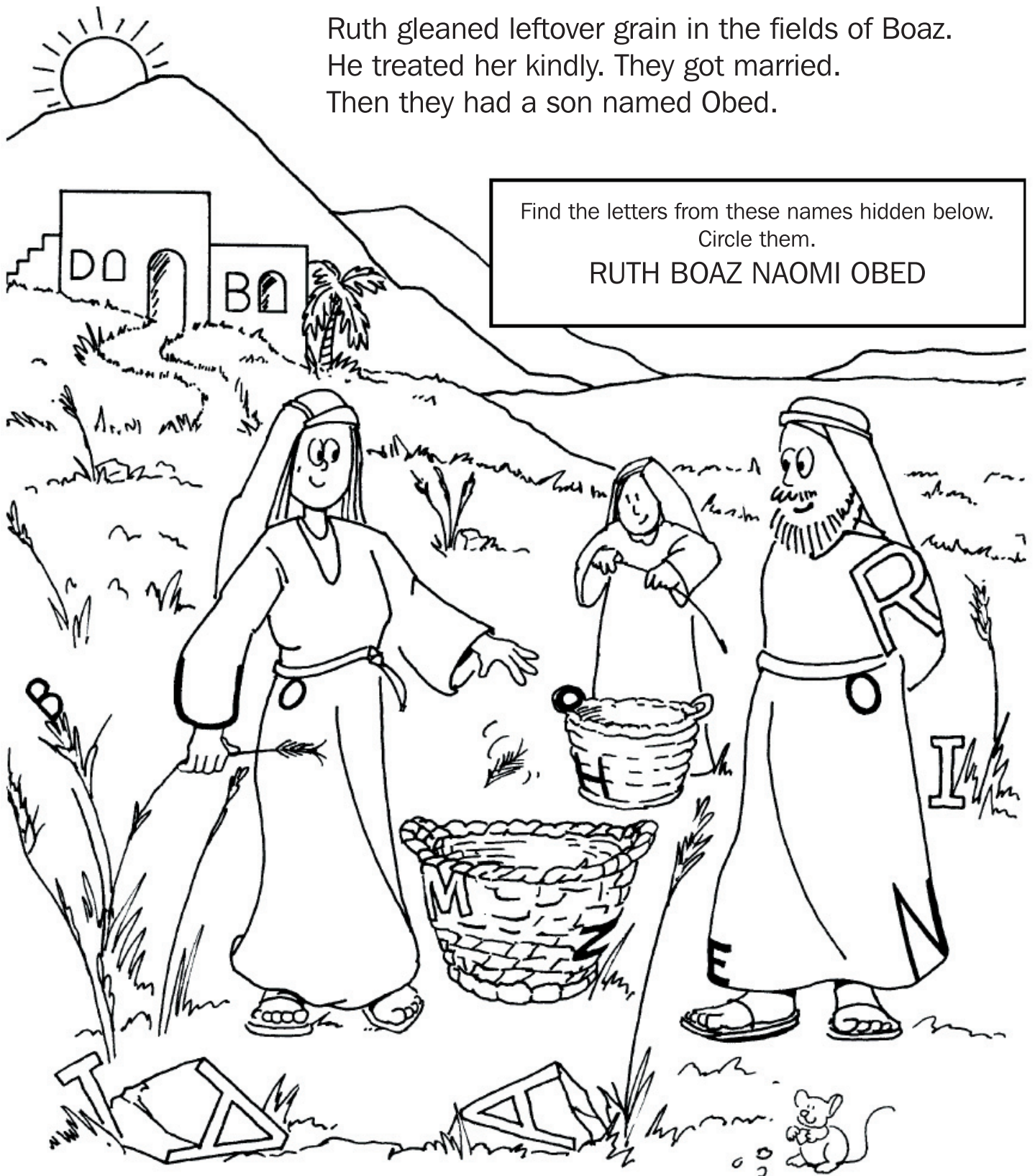


Ruth gleaned leftover grain in the fields of Boaz.

Then they had a son named Obed.

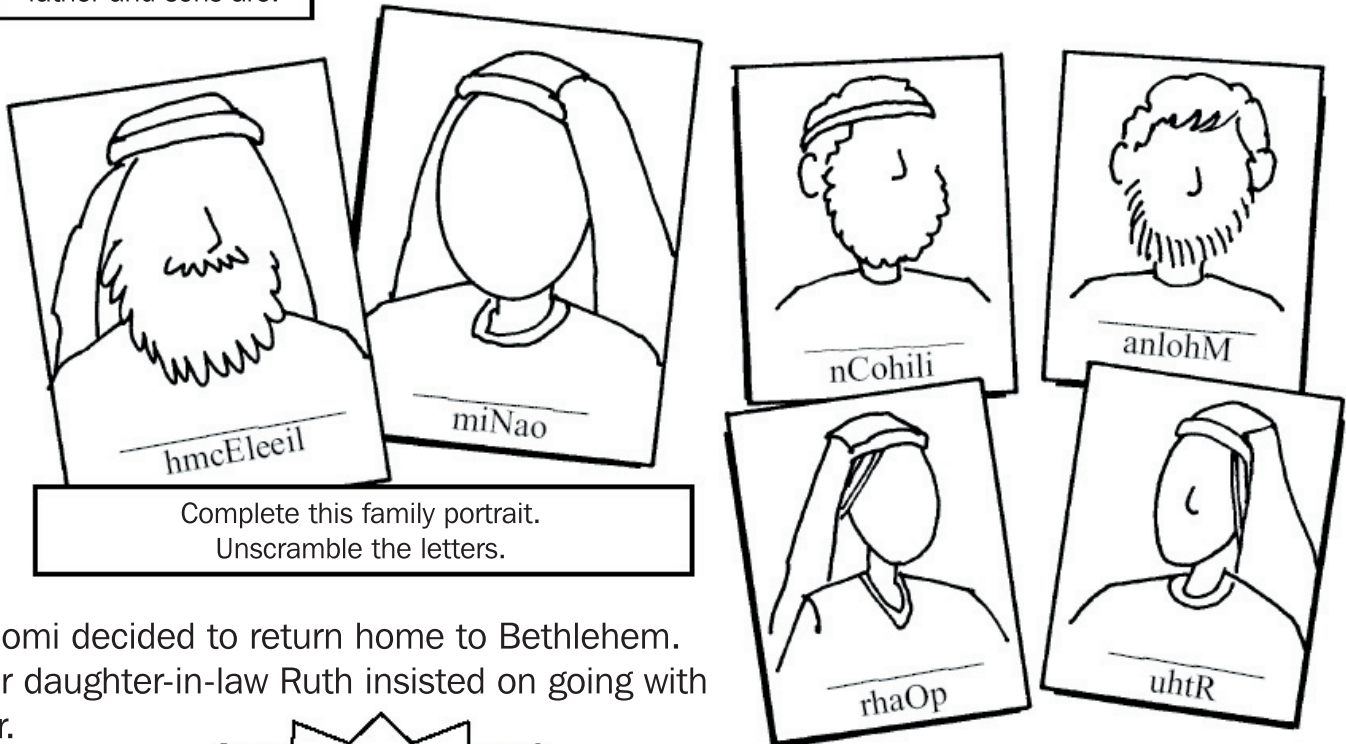

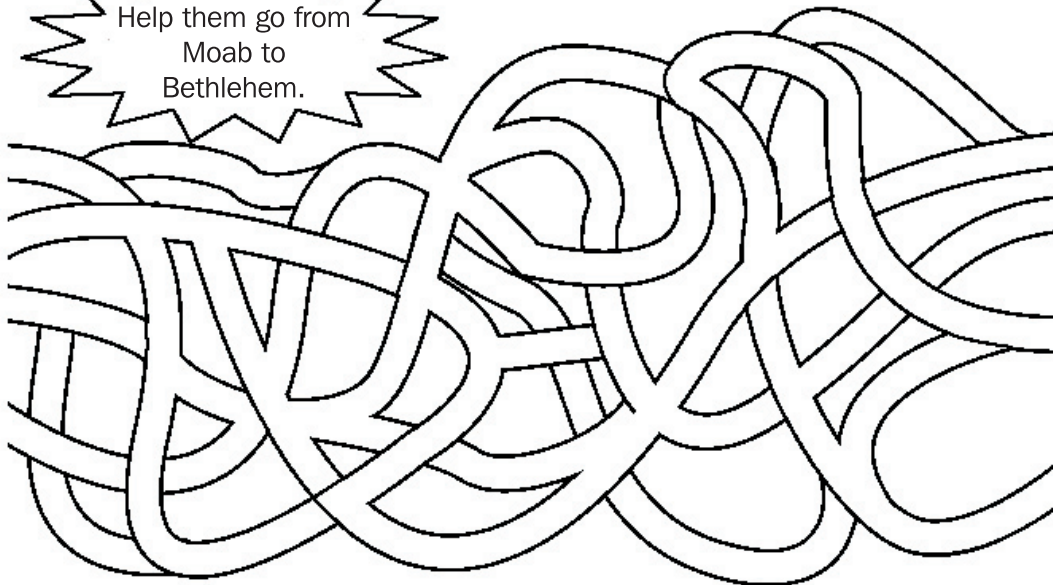
Check your Bible to find out who the mother, father and sons are.

Help them go from Moab to Bethlehem.

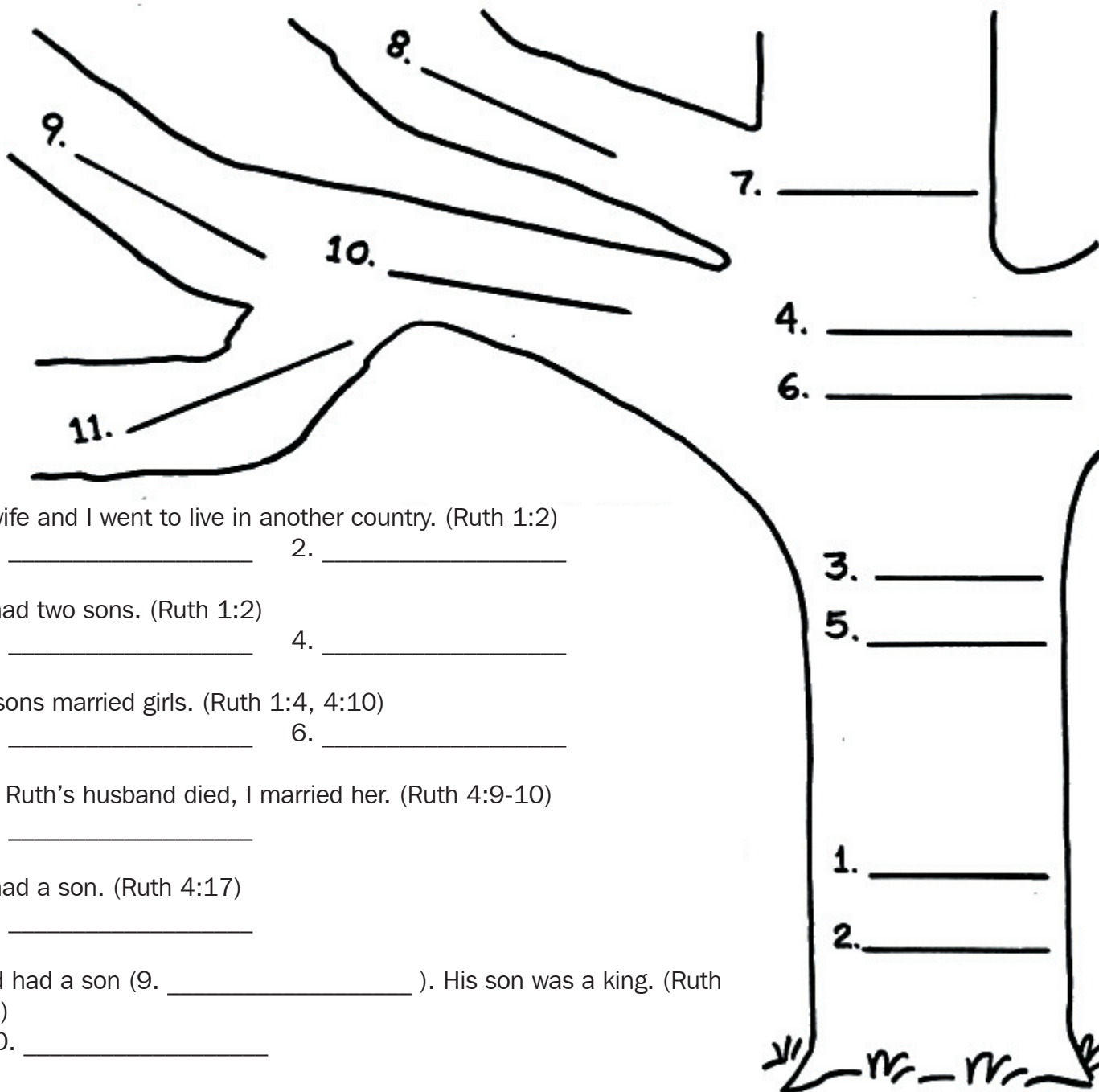
